He was among them, just as he is still among us.

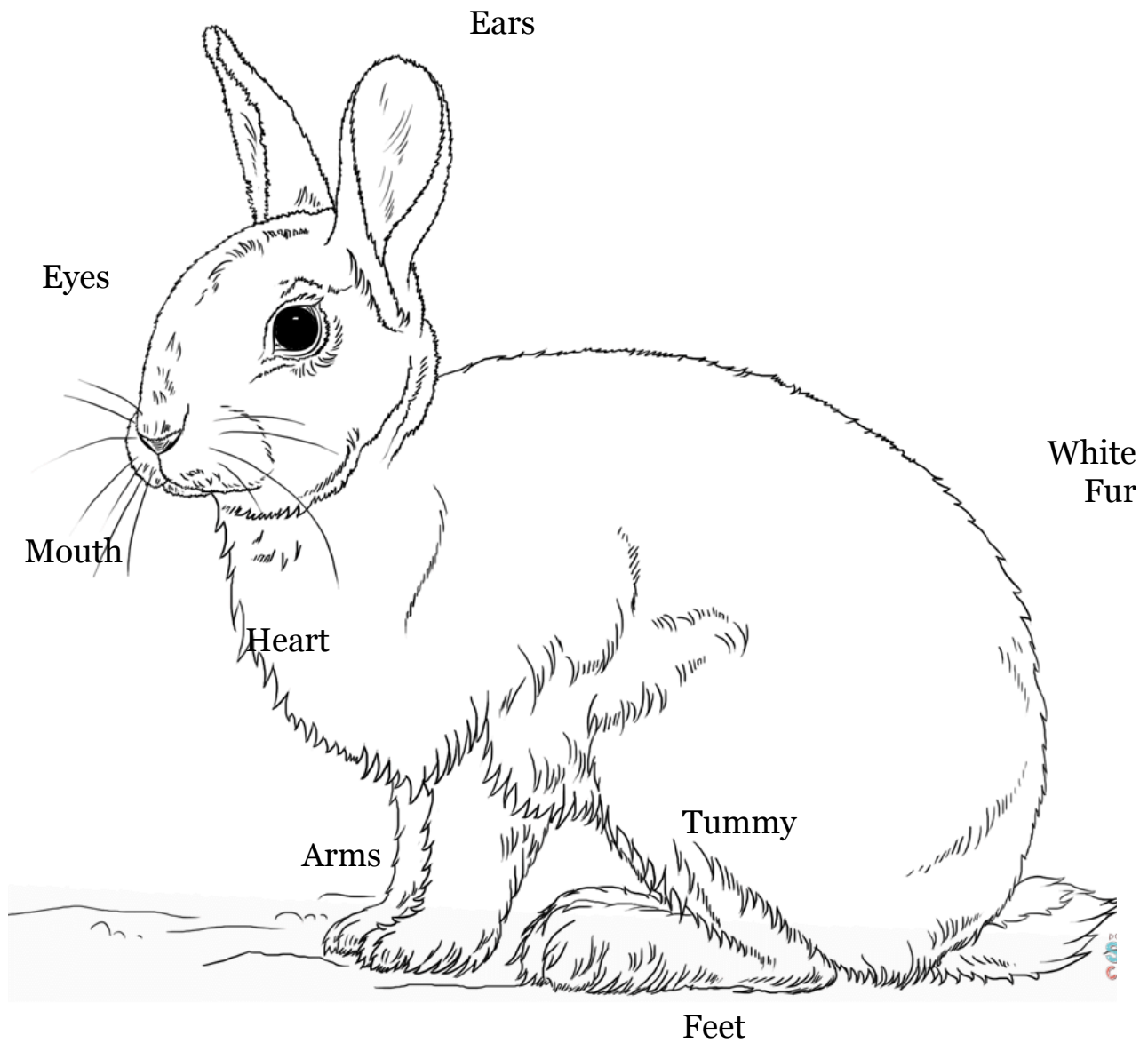
A symbol	Prophecy	Fulfillment	Christ	What they were looking for	Application
Bread Roll, Matza	Psalm 41:9 Shared bread & lift up heel against him	John 13:18 - Betrayed, heal again me	Bread of Life Living Bread	Someone who would break bread with enemies	Invite anyone and everyone to the table
Donkey /colt	your king is coming to you; ... and having salvation and mounted on a donkey, on a colt. Zech. 9:9	Matthew 21:2-7 rode into Jerusalem on a colt	Comes in peace and humility bringing salvation	A king to ride in on a donkey - to come in peace (horses are symbols of war)	Respond in peace and not as if going to war
Palm Leaves	Shouted praises, Hosanna, Son of David" Matt 21:9	They covered His path with palm leaves, flowering branches, and cloth. Matt 21	Victory over Death; Son of David	Someone who could overcome death and become victor Rev 7:9	All receive resurrection, how do you feel about this?
White Lilies	Lilies clothe the earth and represent temple	Lilies represent rebirth and hope, just as the resurrection Luke 12:27-8	Cleansed the Temple	Someone who will clean the temple of all ungodliness	How do you see the temple? Do you take advantage of going?
Mite (parables)	I will open my mouth with a parable;... (Psalm 78:1-2)	Jesus spoke all these things to the crowd in parables; Matt 13:34	Taught with parables	Someone who teach directly believers and through clothed stories to unbelievers	Learn the doctrine of Christ.
30 Pieces of Silver	Zech 11:12 Set price 30 pieces silver	Matt 26:14-16 What is he worth, 30 pieces silver	Sold for the price of a slave (30 pieces of silver)	Others would not recognize his worth, not see him as the True Shepherd	Recognize Christ's worth, the price he paid for all
Lamb	Ex. 12:3, 5, 21-27 Angel passed over those doors with lamb blood	1 Cor 5:7 Christ, our Passover, sacrificed for us	Our Pascal Lamb	Someone who was a sacrifice and that would deliver	Innocent delivered them, the whole story of the resurrection at the last supper

Nail	Isaiah 49:16 Graven on palm of hands	John 20:25-26 prints of nails, hands pierced	Nailed to a cross.	Great love would be graven in his hands	Do you believe him? See the marks, the proof he loves you?
Cross	Num. 21:9 Nehushtan, brass serpent	John 3:14-15 As Moses... lifted up	Lifted up on a cross	Someone who would be lifted up	How often do you look up to Christ?
Tan Cloth	Psalms 22:16-18 Part garments cast lots	Matt 29:35 Cast lots on his parted garments	Robed and crown in jest	Someone who fulfills his promises	If that was fulfilled what other promises are fulfilled?
Cup	Psalm 69:21 Full of heaviness vinegar to drink	Matt 29:43 Gave him vinegar D&C 19:18 Drink bitter cup	Drank the bitter cup	Someone who experienced the bitter cup, the heaviness and longing for comfort	What sweetness do you see because He drank the bitter cup?
Rock	Isaiah 25:8 Swallow death in victory	John 20:10-17 Mary weeping at tomb	The Great Cornerstone	Someone who dries away tears, comforts	He knows our sorrows and heals our wounds



EYES: have big eyes to look carefully and choose what is good (1 Thes. 5:21)

EARS: have big ears that are quick to hear and heed the word of God (James 1:19)

FUR: is white as snow because Jesus take all sin away (Isaiah 1:18)

MOUTH: have no voice for complaining or arguing (Phil 2:13)

HEART: are gentle, kind-hearted, and forgiving (Eph 4:32)

TUMMY: feast on healthy things, feast on Words of Christ (Psalm 119:11)

KNEES/ARMS: are quiet in prayer but hop with thanksgiving and rejoicing (1 thes. 5:16-18)

FEET: have big feet to go tell others about Jesus (Matt 28:19-20)
