Your luxurious stateroom has a wall of floor-to-ceiling windows and the ship's own crew is hospitable to the Nth degree. DAY 1

AVIGNON

- Settle in aboard the MS Lord Byron

Welcome aboard your luxury cruise ship moored in the heart of Avignon. You'll be greeted by your Classic Journeys guide – your new friend and local expert who will be with you all week to host you on immersive small-group explorations handcrafted exclusively for you. While your cultural and walking activities will be far above and beyond those available to the other passengers, you'll all share the 5-star attention of the ship's hospitable crew. After you settle into your stateroom, strike out to discover all of the facilities from the expansive topside deck to the fine restaurants and wellness center.

Tonight, your Classic Journeys guide will arrange a festive private dinner on shore in one of Avignon's exceptional Provençal restaurants.

OVERNIGHT: AVIGNON MEALS: D

DAY 2

AVIGNON

- Visit Sénanque Abbey
- Explore the enigmatic stone hut bories
- · Enjoy a guided walk of Avignon
- See the Palais des Papes, where the Popes lived in the 14th and 15th centuries

After breakfast, you'll wave good-bye to your fellow passengers as you head for the village of Roussillon. It's a startling sight, constructed as it was from 17 different shades of red sandstone. You'll take a short, enjoyable walk through the ochre quarries, then depart for Senanque Abbey, set in an isolated valley surrounded by a field of lavender and oaks. One of only three Cistercian monasteries in Provence, it is still occupied by the monks.

After lunch and a visit, it's an easy stroll to Gordes. Your trail winds past a borie, one of the trademark structures of Provence. Bories are amazing corbelled vaults of flagstones, stacked high with no mortar to secure them. Similar to Neolithic examples found elsewhere in Europe, these are believed to be from the 18th or 19th century. They're remotely located and some experts speculate that they were built to escape the plague. If you'd prefer to skip this walk, you can ride ahead in the van and arrive in Gordes early, with time to go people-watching and shopping.

Back in Avignon, your guide leads you on a walk through the streets. Dominating it all is the Palais des Papes, home of the breakaway papacy from 1316 until the 15th century. Today, its sweeping forecourt is sprinkled with lovely cafes and it's a stage for street performers who vie for your attention.

OVERNIGHT: ARLES MEALS: B, L, D

DAY 3 LES BAUX / ST. RÉMY

- Taste the olive oil at our friend's mill
- Stroll in the market village of Saint-Rémy
- Visit a 12th-century cloister once inhabited by van Gogh

That's Arles you see through your floor-to-ceiling windows this morning. Once again today, you'll put the river behind you and head into the scenic heart of Provence. The region is called the Luberon, which you may recognize from Peter Mayle's book "A Year in Provence". You'll stop at Moulin Barbentane, a traditional olive mill that's a labor of love for our friends Isabelle and Jean. Their pressings have won international awards, and they tell you about the art of raising and selecting olives before treating you to a tasting of their oils.

Next, you'll visit Saint-Remy-de-Provence, a pictureperfect market village that gives you a wonderful look at the quiet, quaint culture of the south of France. From Saint Remy, the path to Les Baux reveals this gorgeous medieval village perched on a rocky crest jutting up abruptly from the plains below. It is the perfect view to accompany the authentic pique-nique arranged for you by your guide

In a scenic rock quarry, you'll take in the town's monumental sound and light show, Carrieres de Lumieres. Here, projected images of famous artwork are dramatically cast upon vast stretches of natural rock. Inspired by the art, continue on near St. Remy, to St. Paul de Mausole, the 12thcentury cloister where van Gogh spent the last year of his life. Using reproductions, the caretakers make it easy to see how much of the local landscape appeared in his paintings.

After the quintessential Provençal day, you'll return to the ship for a relaxing evening. Perhaps you'll opt for a glass of the local wines in the panoramic observation lounge or choose to take a sauna or use the steam room before dinner.

OVERNIGHT: CRUISE TO VIVIERS MEALS: B, L, D

DAY 4

ORANGE / CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE

- Explore the Roman Theater in Orange
- · Savor a Châteauneuf-du-Pape wine tasting
- · Cook with a Michelin-starred chef

Today, while the ship sails ahead for a series of brief stops along the Rhône, your Classic Journeys guide will lead you on an immersive, unforgettable day in the real world of Provence. First, you'll enjoy a leisurely amble through the region's vineyards, before arriving at the Roman theater of Orange, another of the best-preserved structures dating back to ancient times.

After a morning spent among the vineyards, it wouldn't be right not to visit one of the finest! Even if you're not a certified wine-lover, you'll recognize Chateauneuf-du-Pape as one of France's premier wine regions. Because your group is small, you'll be able to enter the cellars for a tasting. You'll also see the ruins of Chateau des Papes, the summer retreat of the Popes. From the remaining walls, the view across the Rhone valley is breathtaking.

Your afternoon is the culinary pinnacle of the week as you join Michelin-starred Chef Alain for an amazing cooking instruction. He shares the secrets of cuisine a la Provencale, the complex and savory flavors built on fresh herbs, peppery olive oil, garlic, and tomatoes. With the kitchen full of fresh Mediterranean produce, you'll roll up your sleeves, fire up the stove, and get a memorable hands-on lesson from a true master. Appetites stoked by the aromas of Chef Alain's kitchen, you sit down to the spectacular dinner you helped prepare.

DAY 5

PONT-DU-GARD / UZÉS

- Follow a countryside path to the Pont-du-Gard aqueduct

Treat yourself to a hearty breakfast. From the dock in Vienne, you're off on a beautiful countryside walk. At the end: the Pont-du-Gard, one of the surviving Roman wonders of the world. An aqueduct system built over 2,000 years ago, the arched structure soars over the Gardon River. It's a classical treasure...and a monumental lesson in the vivid history of the region.

Later, your Classic Journeys guide will make sure you arrive in the charming village of Uzes in time for lunch at a cafe. You'll have the option of staying on a little longer to explore and shop, or you can choose from two walks into the Alzon River valley to see the old watermill houses. Afterward, you'll meet back up with the MS Lord Byron in Tournon for a fun evening aboard.

OVERNIGHT: CRUISE TO CHALON-SUR-SAONE MEALS: B, L, D

DAY 6

VINEYARD WALK / BEAUNE

- Taste the wines of Corton-Charlemagne
- · Explore the wine capital of Beaune

Open your eyes this morning in Chalon-sur-Saone, in the scenic south of Burgundy. With your fellow Classic Journeys guests, you'll leave the ship behind to wander in the medieval town of Beaune, the wine capital of Burgundy. Here, even the simplest lunch is a culinary treat that you won't forget. Afternoon offers an amazing walk in the countryside where vineyards stretch as far as you can see in every direction. The path leads to a classic vineyard where you enjoy an intimate tasting of the Grand Cru white wines known as Corton-Charlemagne.


