And you'll realize again how big the outdoors really can feel—whether you're picnicking on a volcanic slope, lacing on crampons for a glacier walk, or gliding past icebergs to a stunningly remote sheep ranch. Every step of the way, you'll be in the company of local guides as well as naturalists and other experts. And we love to show you every wonder in special Classic Journeys fashion—with unique events like a personal welcome at a premiere vineyard, traditional Argentine barbecues, and truly distinctive lodgings. DAY 1

MENDOZA

Journey to Argentina's famed wine producing region, Mendoza

We meet in Mendoza, a temperate and fertile region of Argentina. The climate is arid, but the land blooms thanks to the web of irrigation canals we'll see on our walk of the treelined city. Our country-style inn is at the meeting point for many of the wine routes in the area. Its swimming pool and gardens take full advantage of the mild microclimate that contrasts dramatically with nearby peaks capped with snow. In addition to wine, the region is known for its fine cuisine, and you'll have a wonderful taste of it tonight when we stroll to a restaurant in town.

DAY 2

MENDOZA WINE VALLEYS

- · Wander from vineyard to vineyard with a wine expert
- Join in the preparation and then dine on a traditional Argentine barbecue

Even if you're not a confirmed wine-lover, you've probably encountered wonderful Argentinean wines over the years. Today, we get a close-up look at art and science of winemaking. Our guide is an agronomist who'll take us from vineyard to vineyard, down local country roads. We'll be welcomed by a vintner who explains the winemaking process, and we'll learn about cultivation of the region's pre-eminent grape varieties.

Few wineries in the world are more beautifully situated with their neat green ranks of vines pointing to the jagged Andes. And all that scenery and fresh air do good things to your appetite. It's a good thing, too, because we're in for an exceptional barbecue today. We'll participate and learn the art of preparing asado – then enjoy the results as we lunch under the poplars and taste some fine Cabernet and Malbec wines. By late afternoon, we return to our inn with time to relax before dinner.

DAY 3

MT. ACONCAGUA

• Walk in the Andes foothills with views of one of the seven summits to a scenic picnic lunch

As close as they've appeared for the last few days, the Andes are actually a 1½ hour drive away. We'll make that scenic journey this morning past a major dam on the Mendoza River at Potrerillos, to the base of Mount Aconcagua. At 22,944 feet, it's the highest mountain in all of South America, one of the famed "Seven Summits", and a mecca for devoted mountain climbers. For us, it simply marks the spectacular backdrop to an extraordinarily scenic walk in its foothills that includes a delicious picnic lunch with views of the mountain.

After a beautiful day following our walk around Aconcagua's base, we return to Mendoza through the Upsala Valley. Along the way, we'll enjoy views of Mt. Penitentes and the famous bridge of the Incas, a fascinating geological and historic site where Incans stopped to soak in the curative hot spring waters.

DAY 4

MENDOZA - PATAGONIA

· Journey south to spectacular Patagonia

After breakfast, our scenery changes with a flight south to El Calafate, situated on the southern shore of impressive, icy blue Lake Argentina. Located in the heart of Patagonia, this is the gateway to some of the world's most spectacular glaciers. Our lovely boutique hotel overlooks the lake and is an easy walk from all the town has to offer.

We'll stroll together to see the sights including Laguna Nimes, a natural preserve for birds. Dinner this evening is at a small nearby restaurant.

DAY 5

UPSALA GLACIER

- Sail to Upsala Glacier for amazing views up close
- · Explore and lunch at a working estancia

After breakfast, we'll board a boat for an exciting day of glacier viewing and explorations. As we cruise Lake Argentina, we have striking views of Upsala Glacier, the largest glacier in Los Glaciares National Park. After weaving our way around enormous icebergs in the lake, we come to shore at Estancia Cristina in one of the most fascinating and remote valleys in Patagonia.

It's a good thing our traditional Patagonian lunch is so amazing because it has to compete with spectacular views of the Andes and the glaciers. Estancia means farm or landed estate, but the word doesn't begin to capture the colorful history of this remote site, founded in 1914 by an Englishman. Using nothing but a small rescue boat, the family gradually transported every stick of its belongings and every head of livestock across the lake. At 22,000 hectares, the ranch has pastured as many as 27,000 sheep at once. As we wander, we'll learn more about its colorful past and the sturdy pioneer souls who just barely civilized this amazing place. At the end of this full and invigorating day, we cruise back to our hotel.

DAY 6

PERITO MORENO GLACIER

- · Boat ride across Lake Argentina
- · Follow expert local guides on foot across Perito Moreno Glacier

Today is dedicated to the exploration of the impressive Perito Moreno Glacier, located within National Park Los Glaciares, a UNESCO World Heritage Site spanning nearly 1.5 million acres. The road from our hotel winds through the steppe and birch tree forests to the curva de los suspiros (bend of whispers), where we have our first breathtaking view of the glacier. We leave our vehicle behind on the shores of Lake Argentina and approach the glacier by boat.

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Arriving on the opposite shore, our guide shares with us the process through which the glaciers have sculpted the lakes and valleys in the region. The sheer size of the glacier is amazing, spanning nearly 15,000 feet and soaring 200 feet above the channel. Unlike many other glaciers that are receding, the Perito Moreno Glacier continues to advance towards the peninsula, creating tremendous pressure and resulting in random explosions as pieces of the glacier breaks off and crashes into the water below.

In the company of our local guide, we continue to approach the glacier on foot. Our path leads us through a quiet beech forest, whose woodland floor is dominated by vibrant yellow and orange wildflowers. If we're lucky, we are serenaded by the music of the world's most southerly parrot, the cotorra or austral parakeet. Our walk culminates at the foot of the glacier, where we have the unforgettable opportunity to explore the glacier up-close on foot. Donning crampons with the assistance of our expert guide, we follow a path past ice caves and seraks (ice towers), marveling at the distinctive blue color of the glacial ice, which we learn is a direct result of the oxygen trapped in the snow. At a nearby shelter, we pause for a picnic lunch with views overlooking the glacier. Our route back to the hotel takes us along catwalks that afford us with an even more spectacular view of its massive face. We may startle at the heavy cracking sounds as gigantic blocks of ice splinter off the face of the glacier to crash into the water below.

DAY 7

DEPARTURE

Part company with options to extend your time in South America or return home

Our time together comes to an end after breakfast. Relax this morning at the hotel, then make your way to the airport at your leisure. If your time is limited, you can head straight back to Buenos Aires for connecting flights home. And if you have some additional time to explore, we have a number of fine options to entice you to linger longer in South America. These include: Ushuaia in southern Patagonia with Tierra del Fuego National Park and penguin rookery, spectacular Iguazu Falls in northern Argentina, bordering Argentina, Paraguay and Brazil. You can even extend your time in the Galapagos on our island-based exploration.
