DAY 1

GLENBURN

- · Fly Paro to Bagdogra
- · Transfer to the luxury Glenburn Tea Estate
- Cooking instruction

You'll rediscover the long-lost thrill of looking out of your airplane window as you make the scenic flight from Paro to Bagdogra along the edge of the Himalayas. Glenburn, your luxury estate hotel for the duration of your visit, is just a three-hour drive away at the far northeastern tip of India, just across the River Teesta from Sikkim. After settling, the balance of the evening is yours to relax.

DARJEELING

- · UNESCO World Heritage "Toy Train" through the Himalayas
- · Visit a Himalayan Mountaineering Institute and Tibetan Refugee Center
- Afternoon tea tasting session

After breakfast, your hosts at Glenburn show you around their lush, hilly tea plantation. Depending on the season, you may see the tea pickers moving through the fields, hand-selecting the leaves. At a Tea Tasting Session, you discover the differences in aroma, flavor and appearance of tea manufactured in different ways, at different times of the year.

Don't be fooled by the nickname: The "Toy Train" is an engineering marvel with UNESCO World Heritage Status. With rails that are just two feet apart, it's the narrowest of narrow gauges, and its route through the foothills of the Himalayas makes for a stunning journey. We'll also arrange visits to the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute and the Tibetan Refugee Center where the shopping for traditional crafts is especially fine.

Tonight: another elegant dinner in the hotel's fine restaurant.

DAY₃

BORA GAON / SIKKIM

- · Morning walk to Bora Gaon village into Simbong Forest
- · Explore River Rungeet with a walk across Manjitar Suspension Bridge
- Enter the Indian state of Sikkim

After breakfast, you're off for a lovely downhill walk through the lush terrain. Your naturalist guide will lead you to Bora Gaon village and into the Simbong Forest. It's a habitat rich with birds and butterflies. Your gradual 3,000-descent ends at the River Rungeet where you can go fishing, paddle in the rock pools or get in some croquet or beach cricket.

And we love the spectacular walk across the Manjitar Suspension Bridge. Two hundred feet across and 100 feet over the river, it's an adventure all its own. Even better, at the far end, you can enter the Indian state of Sikkim – and if you love to "collect" destinations, the chance to say you've set foot on its remote soil is a real treasure.

In the evening, you're invited to a cooking instruction in the gourmet restaurant's open kitchen.


