# Yosemite National Park

Yosemite is extraordinary: A valley millions of years in the making, soaring granite peaks meet groves of teetering sequoias, and the Merced River thunders down some of the tallest waterfalls on the planet.

Visit every year and you'd still discover new places—or explore the Classic Journeys way to experience the best of everything in six spectacular days.

A Yosemite local, your guide walks you through the sculpting effects of the ice age, the lives of natives, the great California gold rush, and the future of one of the world's last wild spaces. Spend your days walking, cycling and rafting through this UNESCO World Heritage wonderland, where enchanting wildlife encounters abound from bear cubs to butterflies. Enjoy hearty Californian cuisine at some of the most panoramic picnic spots in America. And in the evenings, stargaze worlds away from city lights in the region's loveliest lodges.

## DAY 1

## **FISH CAMP**

- Walk a winding trail at Mariposa Grove
- Settle in to your mountain lodge accommodation

After meeting your local guide in Fresno, you're off to see some of the largest living things on the planet. Hundreds of hulking sequoias make up Yosemite's Mariposa Grove, teetering almost as tall the Statue of Liberty. As you walk a winding trail between them, your guide will explain their mindboggling history—some feature in famous war photographs, while others have been alive since the days of the Roman Empire. Gazillions of bright and tiny monkeyflowers exaggerate the incredible scale of nature here, while wildlife abound: listen for the scatter of chickarees and chipmunks on the forest floor, as well as the rustle of grazing mule deer and grizzly bears, and the rat-a-tap-tap of woodpeckers.

After, journey onwards to Fish Camp on the outskirts of Yosemite. The charming hamlet is home to tonight's mountain lodge, where you're welcomed with a dinner of local, organic fare.

#### DAY 2

## YOSEMITE VALLEY

- Scenic drive into Yosemite Valley
- · Join your naturalist guide on a walk through the valley park
- Afternoon bike ride past meadows and river banks
- Evening stargazing

Fuel up on a classic Californian breakfast (think filled-to-bursting burritos, syrup-drenched buttermilk pancakes, and hearty oatmeal), before a scenic drive into the Yosemite Valley. You're welcomed by a naturalist guide from the Yosemite Association. Hear how Yosemite played a key role in the establishment of the National Park Service in 1916, as you join them on a walk loaded with lookouts of some of the park's most iconic peaks and waterfalls.

We've picked out our favorite spot for a picnic lunch where you can soak up the scenery and tuck into fresh farm-to-table fare.

Later, on a bike ride through the valley, pedal past meadows of grazing deer, lush forest and river banks. Interesting places to stop include the Happy Isles Nature Center (to learn about the biodiversity all around you), the Ansel Adams Gallery (for engaging photography exhibitions), Yosemite Conservation Heritage Center (formerly LeConte Memorial Lodge – a Tudor Revival building and the valley's oldest public information center) and Yosemite Museum (dedicated to the cultural history of the native Miwok and Paiute people).

Your bike ride's end point is your Yosemite Valley lodging for the next few nights. But the day isn't done yet—once night falls, spend an hour soaking up splendidly starlit skies with your astronomy guide, who'll point out the planets and constellations made vivid from a complete lack of city lights.

#### DAY 3

## MIST TRAIL / GLACIER POINT

• Mist Falls Trail

#### Visit Glacier Point and hike up to Sentinel Dome

Start the day on foot. You'll be following the legendary Mist Trail. Yosemite's signature hike takes you almost within touching distance of the thunderous Vernal and Nevada Falls, connected by nature's 'giant staircase'. The rainbows formed when the sunlight hits the spray are a sure sight to behold. You'll continue along Panorama Cliff (to see how it earned its name), then loop back to the valley via the famous John Muir Trail, which showcases the same waterfalls from a different angle.

Later, a short drive takes you up to one of California's most legendary lookouts: Glacier Point. You'll peer over Yosemite Valley, with your guide pointing out the monolithic Half Dome and Yosemite Falls. En route, keep watch for sightings of Yosemite's bird life—including spotted and great gray owls, and the peregrine falcon.

#### DAY 4

## **TUOLUMNE MEADOWS**

# • Scenic drive up Tioga Pass to Tuolumne Meadows • On your walk, enjoy staggering views of the Cathedral and Unicorn peaks

Cameras ready! Today, you're heading into the high country to explore one of Yosemite's most photogenic regions. Guarded by giant peaks and granite domes, Sierra Nevada's Tuolumne Meadows are a wildflower wonderland—awash with the pinks and purples of shooting stars, columbines and dog violets. Just getting here is a feast for the eyes: traversing the park, the Tioga Pass climbs to almost 10,000 feet and teems with views of lakes, meadows and mountains. With a driver taking care of the wheel, you're free to sit back, soak up the sights and spy grazing deer, grizzlies and golden eagles. Your local guide will pick the perfect walk and picnic spot for the time of year you're visiting, and they'll be spoilt for choice. Footpaths galore follow every direction, featuring peaceful pastures, bubbling springs, gushing waterfalls, glassy lakes, and the meandering Tuolumne River. Enjoy staggering views of the Cathedral and Unicorn peaks, spot some of over 100 species of butterfly, and listen out for songbirds like the American Dipper. Later, continue your journey west. You'll stop, if time permits, for a detour through sugar pines, where a peaceful trail takes you to the micro grove of mammoth trees that makes up ancient Tuolumne Sequoia Grove. This evening, settle into your forest lodge and enjoy California fare followed by some after-dinner stargazing from your private deck or hot tub.

DAY 5

Scenic drive to Hetch Hetchy

Follow a picturesque trail to Wapama waterfall

After a hearty breakfast (don't miss the lodge's legendary Challah French Toast), you'll venture through the forest to Yosemite's peaceful northwest corner.

Hetch Hetchy heaves with history: a sacred valley, submerged in the twenties to form the O'Shaughnessy Dam. Big restoration plans are in the pipeline, and as your local guide explains more, soak up sights of wilderness, wildflowers, craggy cliffs and hidden canyons.

One picturesque trail takes you along the shoreline to the two-tiered Wapama waterfall, while another wildlife walk leads to a lookout point with views of cascades, canyons and the reservoir, often with sightings of black bears and bighorn sheep spotted along the way. Take a break at your guide's favorite picnic spot, where you'll devour deli sandwiches made with fresh bread and local cheeses, meats and salads.

Later, enjoy downtime back at your lodge, soaking up a Sierra sunset from your private deck or scenic saltwater pool. This evening, farm-to-table food and California wines form a delicious farewell dinner for you to reflect on your time in Yosemite.

## DAY 6

## CARLON FALLS / FRESNO

#### $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Join a sunrise walk option to Carlon Falls for early risers $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Transfer back to Fresno

Sleep in, soothed by the sounds of the forest, or get up early, grab a fresh-brewed coffee and go off on a short morning hike to nearby Carlon Falls. The idyllic riverside path forms a lovely last look at the nature surrounding the Tuolumne river, passing ferns and flowers, and finishing at a tapered 35-foot waterfall. Blue herons and kingfishers can be seen fishing for rainbow trout in the river along the way, and at this time of day, it's likely to be just you and the surroundings. Later on, transfer back to Fresno and bid farewell to your guide before continuing your journey home.
