REACHER Skills (Curiosity)

- **Reach** for something better
- Desire to form new, better habits
- Searching for truth and wondering where to find it
- How to think both oriental and occidentally
- RR How to take notes

SEEKER Skills (Sin Offering)

- **See** others as people not objects
- How the search the scriptures for meaning and understanding
- How to ponder on revelation, give the spirit time to work in us
- Personal Sacrifice (right God, right altars, right time)
- Know your values and metrics
- RR How to take and review notes

KEEPER Skills (Burnt Offering)

- **Keep** responding not reacting
- How to recognize, listen to and follow the promptings of the Spirit
- How to think governmentally and be responsible
- How to discover principles and apply them in their lives
- Seek for ways to be intrinsically rewarded instead of extrinsically
- RR practice the doctrine of persuasion

TEACHER Skills (Peace Offering)

- **Teach** people not material
- How to serve others
- How to teach and Present (articulate)
- Family/Community Projects focused on others
- How to effectively communicate, articulate
- How to Rejoice - Celebrate! Memorialize
- RR doctrine of persuasion in writing
