



## 2023/24 General Supply List

### **Supplies needed for school:**

- The Standard Works / Scriptures
- Pencils with erasers
- Colored Pencils
- Scissors
- Math Compass
- Straight Edge (or ruler)
- Lined Paper (recommend 8 1/2" x 11") and/or spiral notebook
- Plain White Paper
- 5" x 7" composition notebook or bullet journal (for Science)
- Art notebook (spiral bound book with thick, blank pages)
- Optional - art pencils and kneaded eraser

### **Learning Journal:**

Each student (and parent if they choose) will be creating their own "Book of Remembrance" or Learning Journal. Each book will be graded for neatness, order, completeness, and creativity. This is a grade for skills and character more than for academic ability. This provides for a measurement of the whole purpose of education: "correcting the temper, forming manners and habits, fitting for usefulness," as well as "enlightening the mind." (See education in 1828 Dictionary)

### **Supplies needed:**

- 2" or 3" three ring binder with view cover
- Notebook Tabs (that go into a 3 ring binder)
- Plastic Sheet Covers
- Card Stock to go in sheet covers (optional, can use regular paper)
- Markers (optional to create title pages)
