5,382 local care groups reached **746,990** mothers with the information and training they need to improve their children's health and nutrition.



82,697 local leaders were trained to lead lasting change in their communities.



7,247 local savings groups are empowering women and men to save money for the future, invest in their businesses, earn more family income, and meet their children's needs.



549,811 girls, boys, and adults now have clean water or better sanitation and hygiene for a safe and healthy future.



25,447 community leaders were trained in disaster risk reduction to help communities survive and recover more quickly when an emergency like an earthquake or flood strikes.

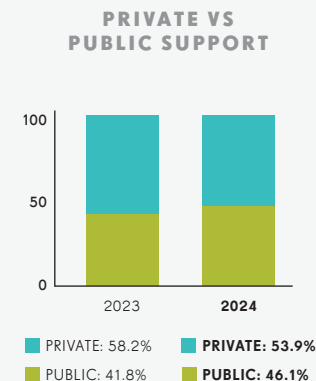
