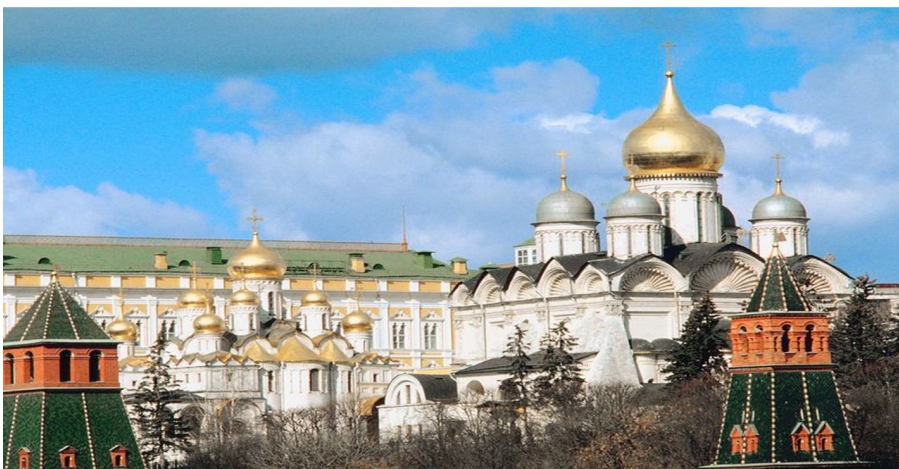
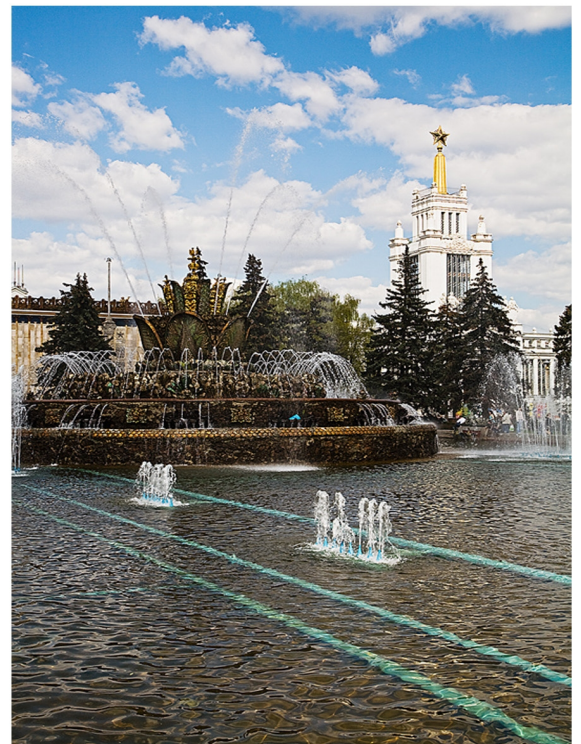


The flag of Russia

**Make a list and find pictures of the occupation(s) you wish to pursue when you grow up. What would you like to do?**



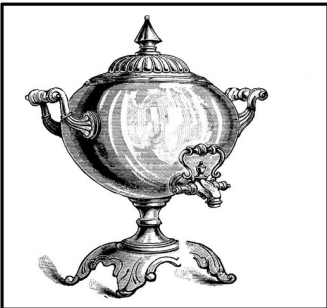
Czar: an absolute ruler in Russia prior to the 1917 revolution

Samovar: a metal urn with an internal heating tube, used in Russia for making tea.

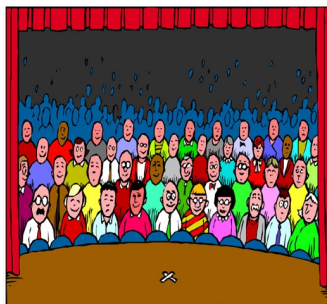


Magnificent: fantastic, wonderful

Comical: funny

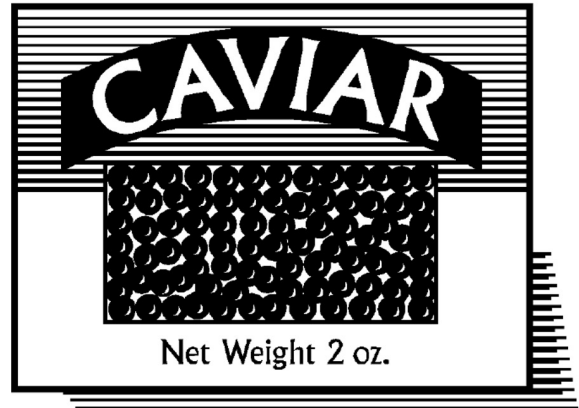

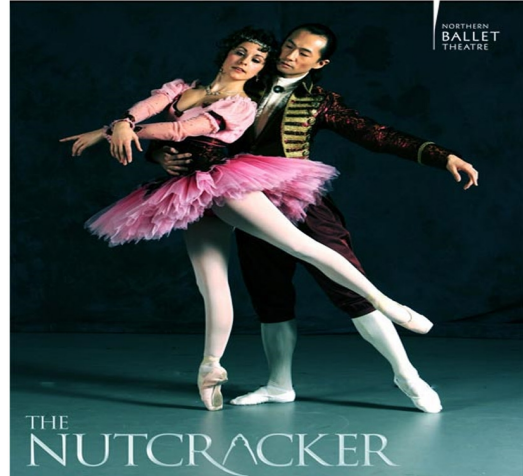

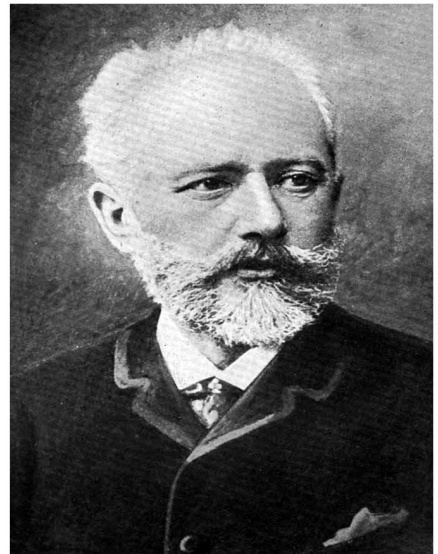

## LIST WAYS YOU CAN SHOW HOSPITALITY TO YOUR GUESTS

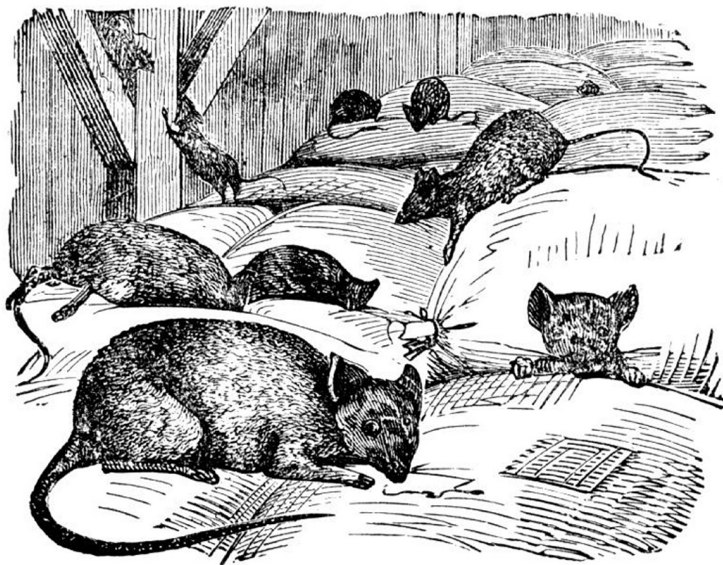


**There is an old saying:**

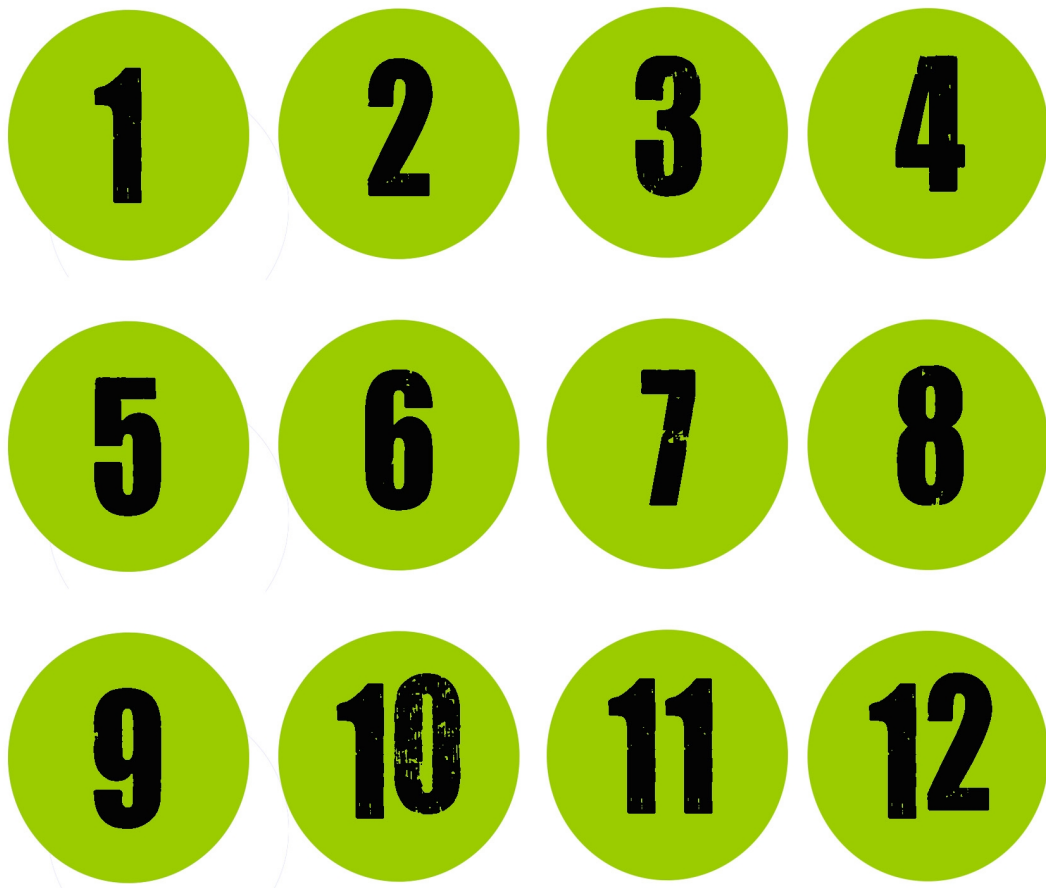
