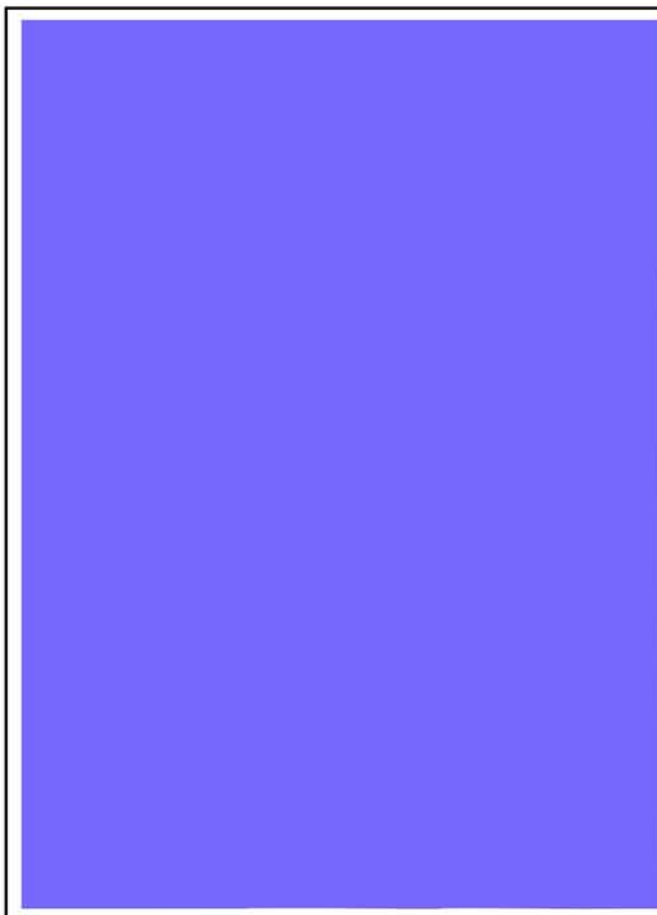

a branch of a tree



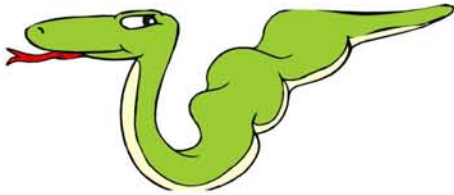
ERRAND

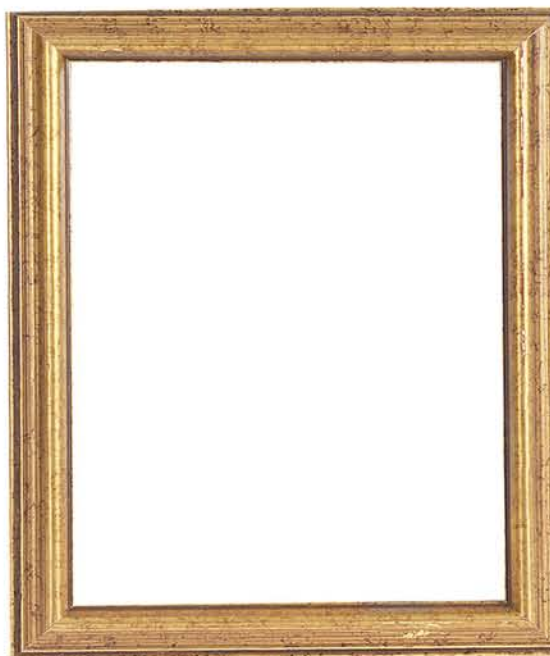
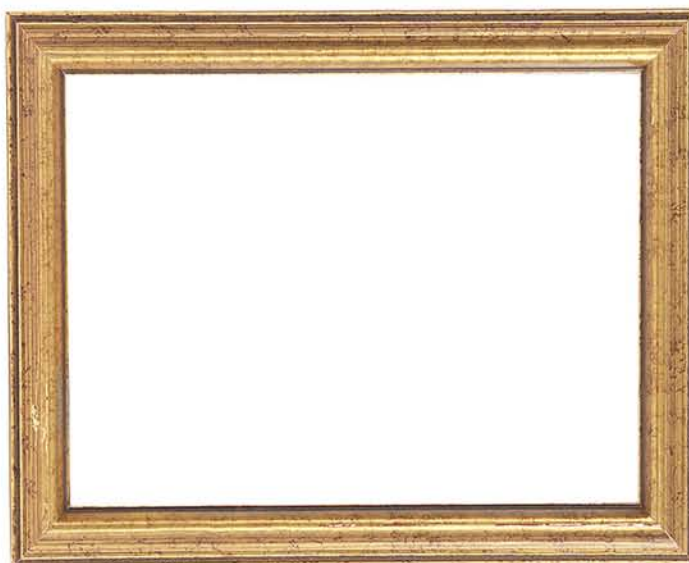
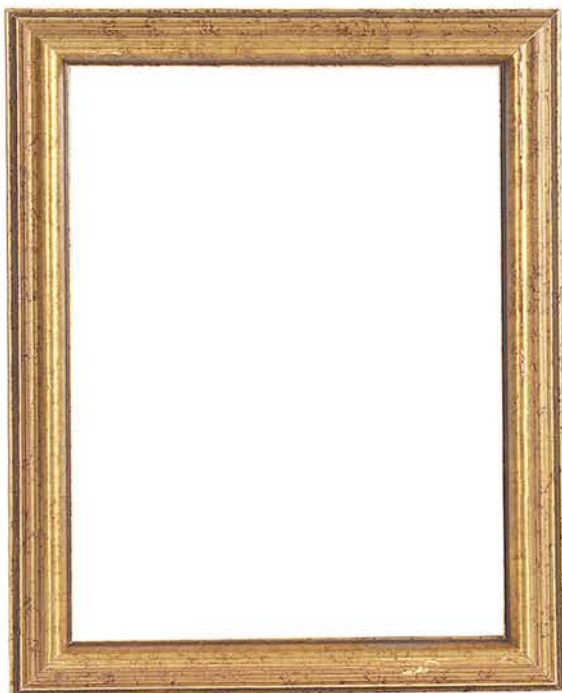


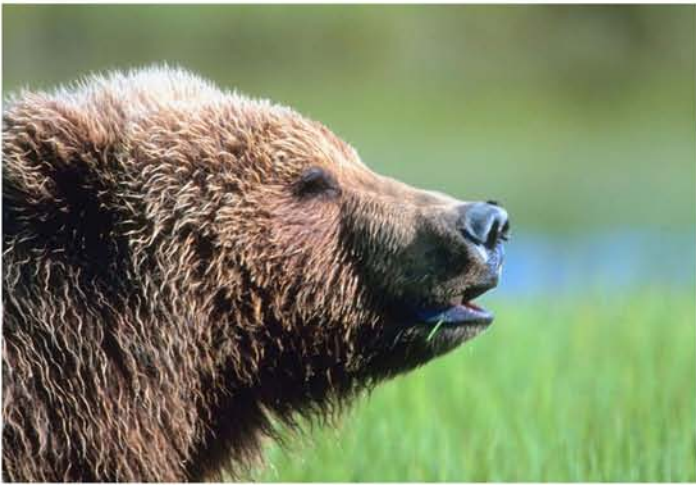
Look for the reflections in the pictures below. Can you draw a picture using reflections?

some pictures with the eyes in different directions.



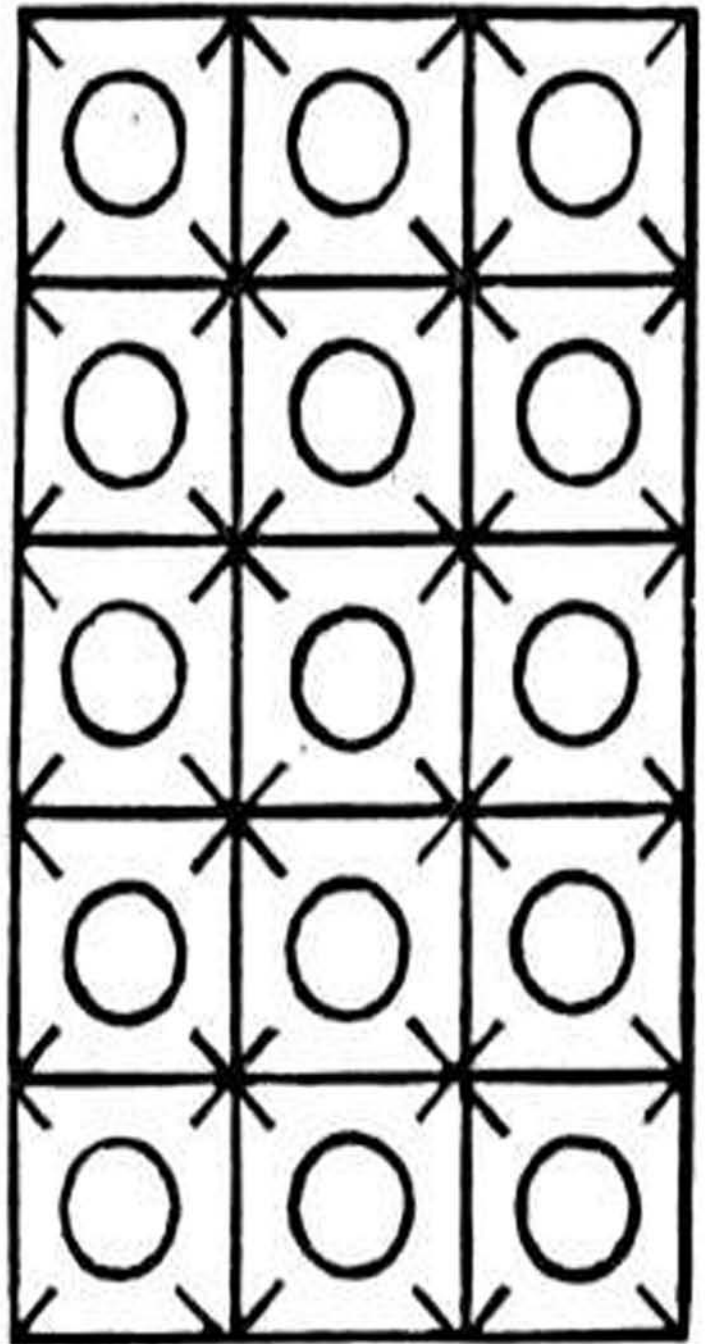
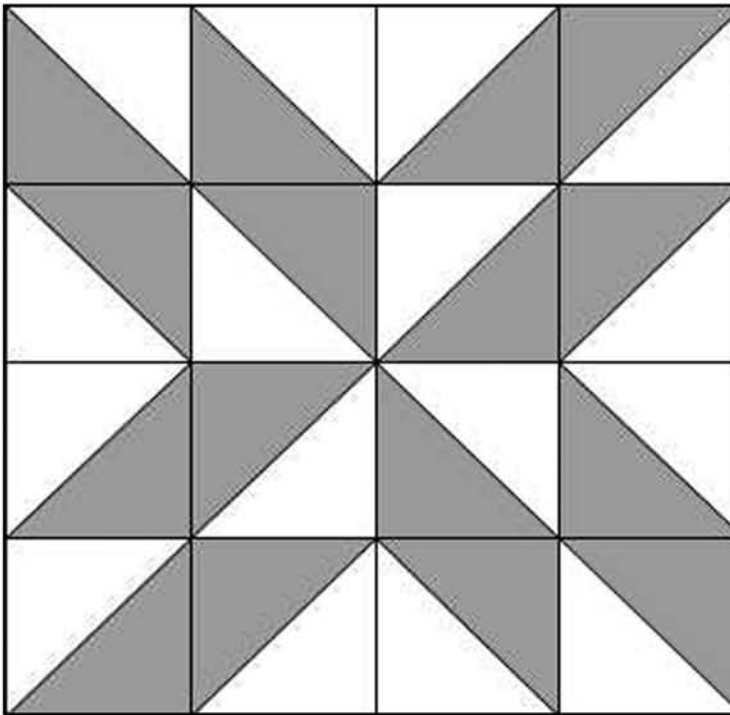
