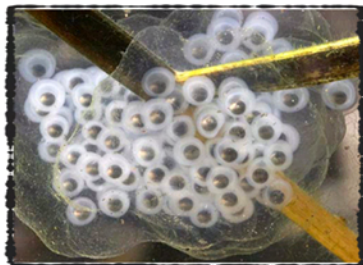

VOCABULARY

amphibian - cold-blooded animal with moist, smooth skin; lay shell-less eggs in water; larvae breathe with gills, adults with lungs

habitat- a place where a plant or animal can get the food, water, shelter and space it needs to live.

larva - The newly hatched, wingless, often wormlike form of many insects before metamorphosis.

metamorphosis - transformation of a larva into an adult that occurs in some animals

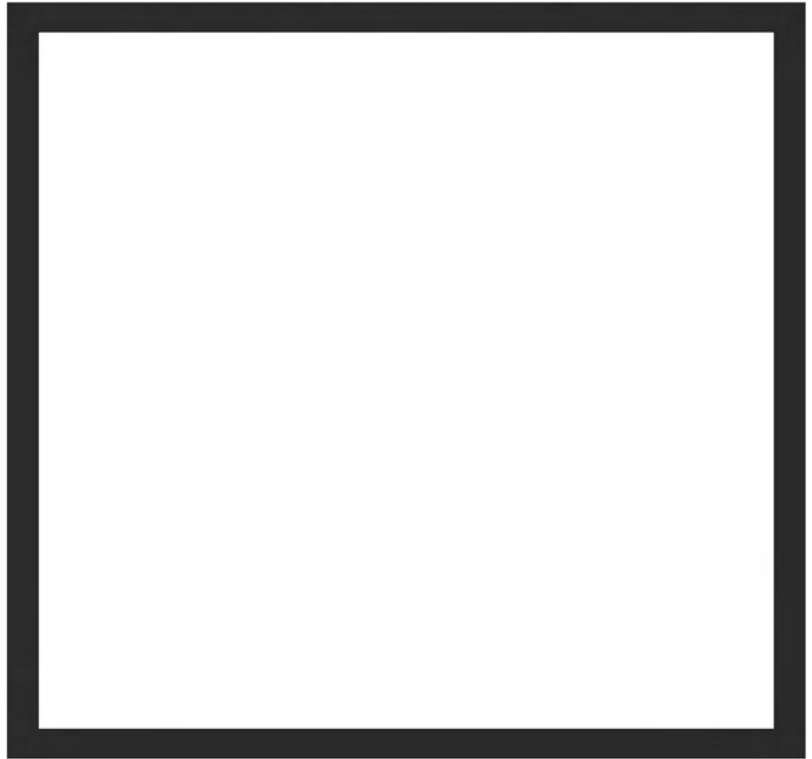
