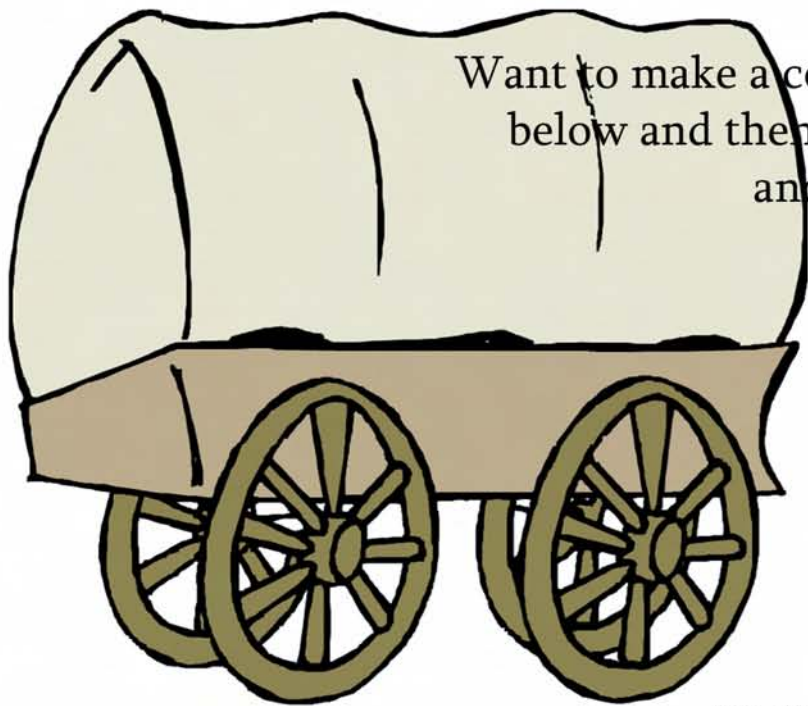

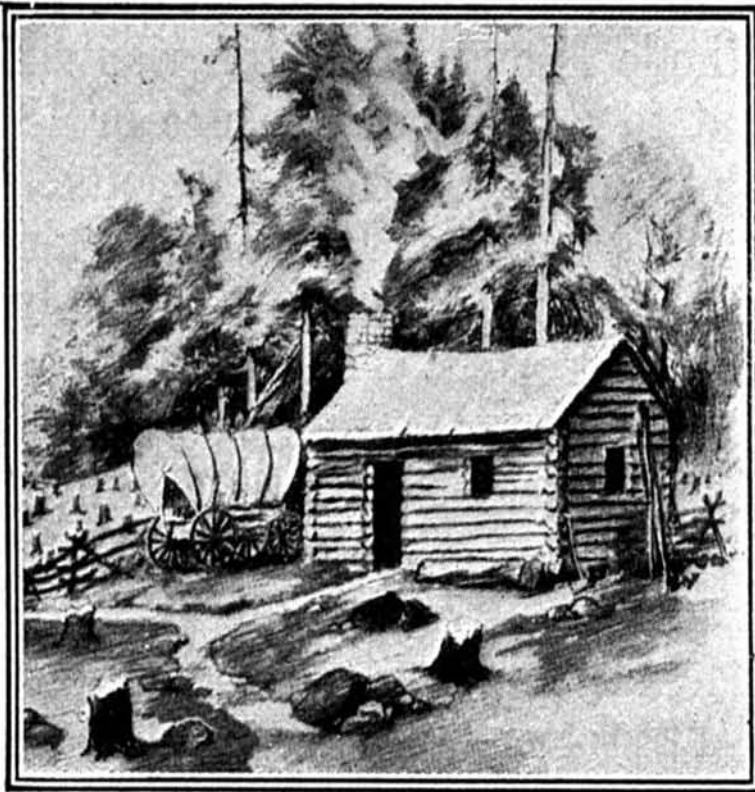

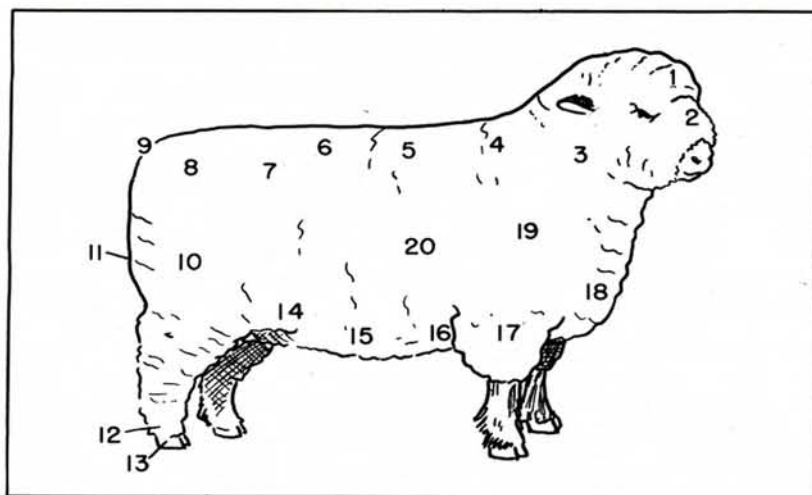


FIG. 187. Parts of the sheep.
