Some interesting facts:

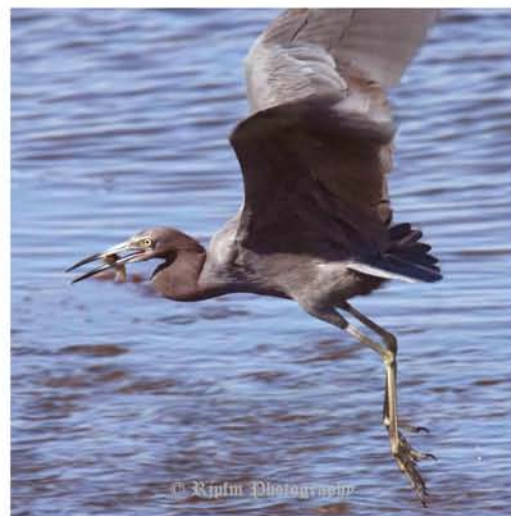
- *The Wampanoag Indians were the original inhabitants of Nantucket Island.
- *1641 - the island was deeded by the English (the authorities in control of the land from the coast of Maine to New York) to Thomas Mayhew and his son, merchants of Watertown and Martha's Vineyard.
- *From the mid-1700s to the late 1830s the island was the whaling capital of the world, with as many as 150 ships making port in Nantucket during its peak.
- *1880 - The American tradition of summer vacations was firmly established. Nantucket was discovered as an ideal spot for vacationing. Tourism became the principle source of income for island residents.
- *The Nantucket year-round population is a little over 10,000. At the peak of the summer there are as many as 56,000 people here with their cars.
- *Nantucket has the largest concentration of Native American place names in the country. Nantucket is translated as "far away land" in the Wampanoag dialect.
- *Nantucket's weather is affected by both the warm Gulf Stream and the cooler Labrador Current.
- *Nantucket has more than 82 miles of beaches.
- *Nantucket is a town, a county, and an island.

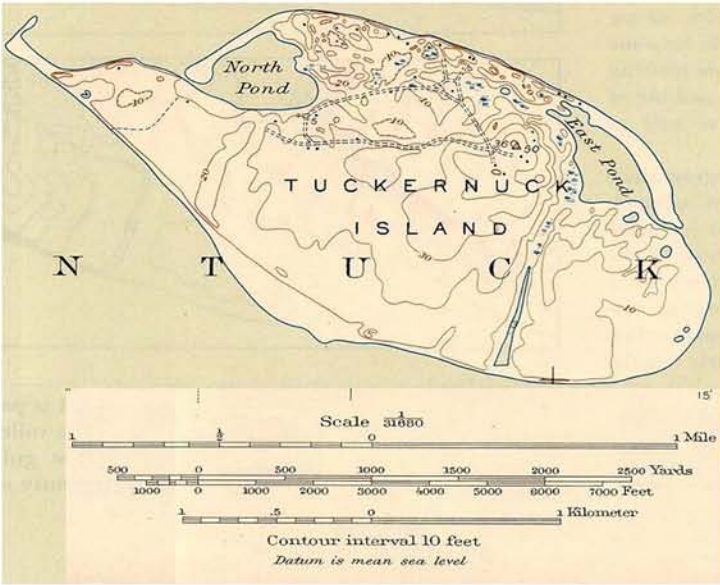

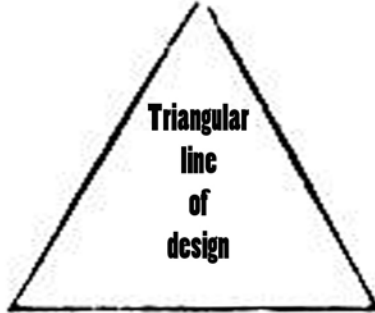

Art: Line of Design



The use of the visual triangle is a element of design that is used a lot by artists and very helpful when you are designing anything from paintings to scrapbooking. The visual triangle helps to unite the elements on a page and pull them together, and also gives the eye a natural path on which to travel around the canvas so that the viewer can take in all the elements one by one. The visual triangle is embedded in the idea that the eye responds far better to designs including odd numbers of features rather than even numbers and allowing the eye to take in the canvas as a whole.

RED EYE is caused by a reflection of direct light from the back of a animal's eyeball due to the fact that the pupil of the eye is widely dilated from the dark.

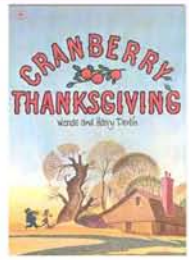


Artists use yellow to make light appear at night and often use it to reflect on subjects in the paintings that light would normally reflect off of.

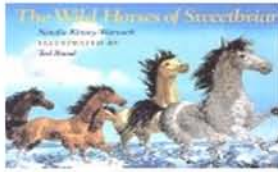

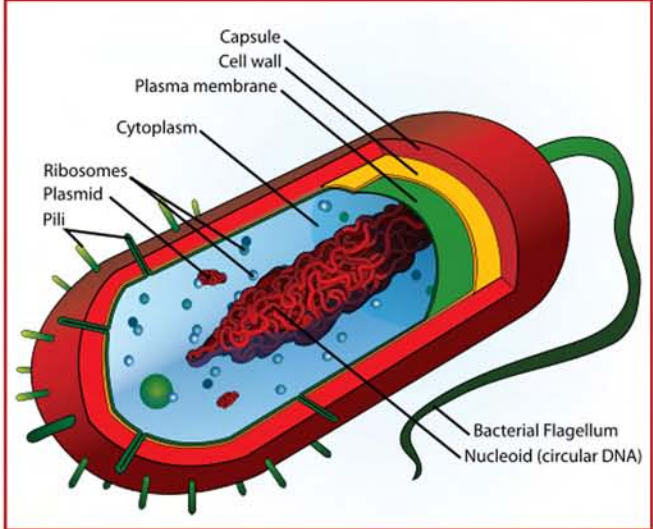
Bacteria

ubiquitous one-celled organisms, spherical, spiral, or rod-shaped and appearing singly or in chains, comprising the Schizomycota, a phylum of the kingdom Monera (in some classification systems the plant class Schizomycetes), various species of which are involved in fermentation, putrefaction, infectious diseases, or nitrogen fixation



Sterilization

Hand Washing Checklist

- o Turns water on and wets hands first.
- o Leaves water running.

- o Scrubs under finger nails
- o Rinses hands thoroughly
- o Rinses soap and any dirt down drain
- o Dries hands
- o Uses paper towel to turn off water
- o Throws paper towel in waste basket
