#### THE NEW WAY


- Smaller team

- A terrible way to make magazines, pamphlets, or posters





#### MIGRATING

- Pandoc
- Regex
- git checkout -b migration
- TOC, cross-references, variables, tables
- Prioritize aggressively
- Consultants exist

#### THE PROBLEM WITH MARKDOWN

- Feature-limited
- Needs variables, includes, cross-references, conditional processing
- RST and AsciiDoc do these things already

#### A SOLUTION WITHIN MARKDOWN?

- Use AsciiDoc or RST
- Improve AsciiDoc or RST
- Extend Markdown
