 - O As you can see, the word לָסָד (chesed) is a very difficult word to translate into English.
 - ▼ This word definitely involves love a deep love.
 - ▼ This word also involves loyalty and faithfulness.
 - ▼ This word could be translated "loyal love".
 - ★ The most common translation "lovingkindness" conveys the key meaning of love in action.
