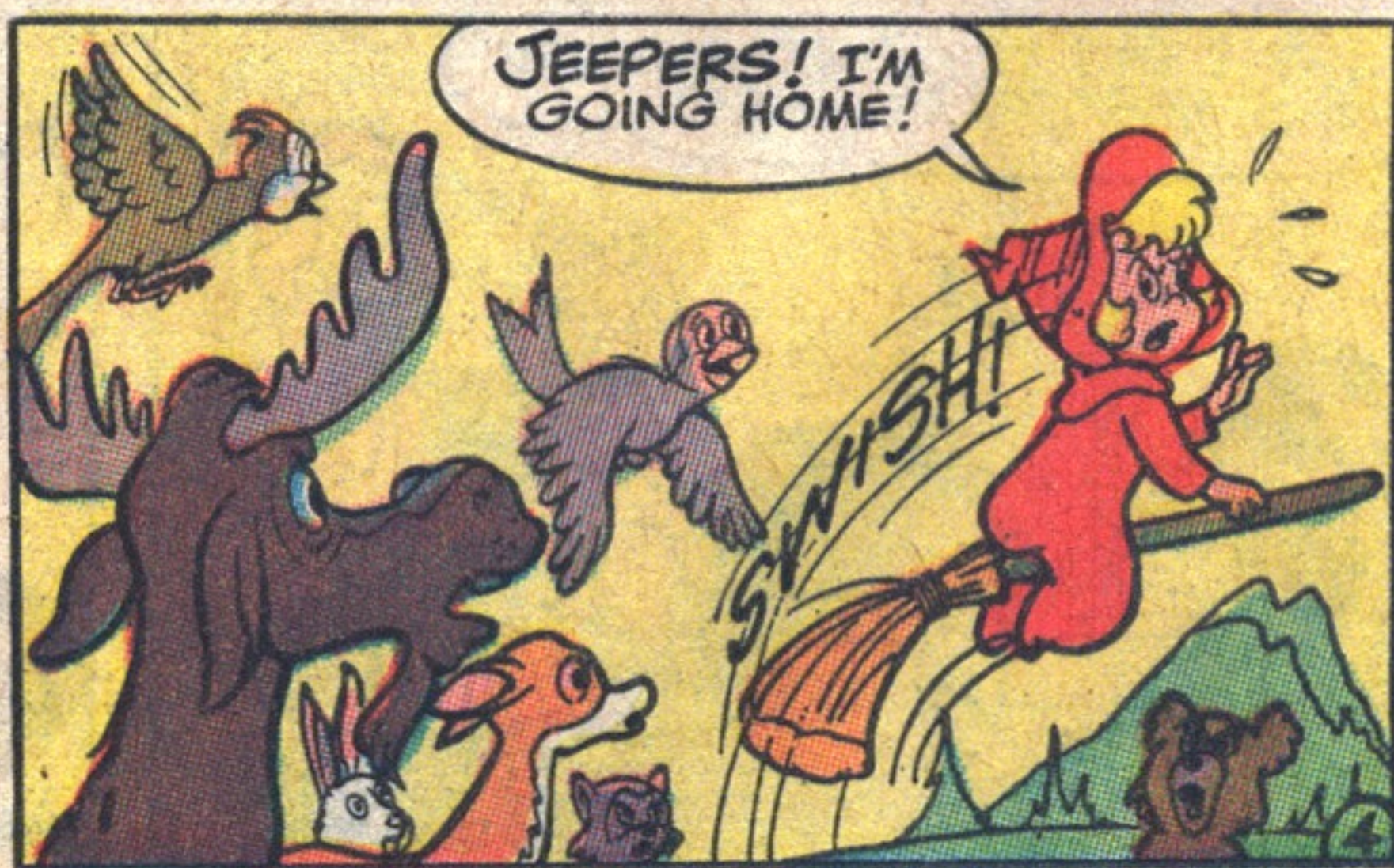
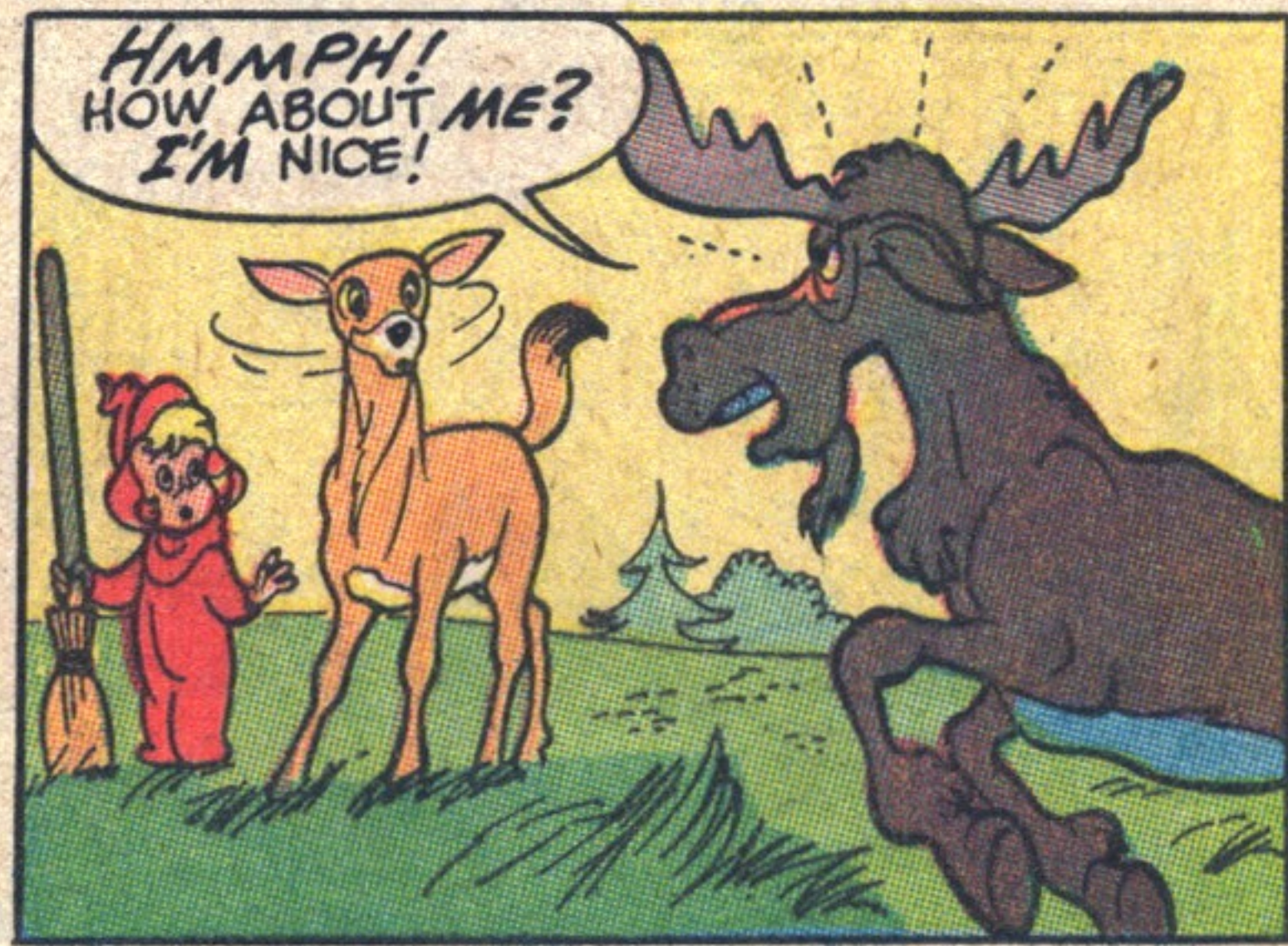




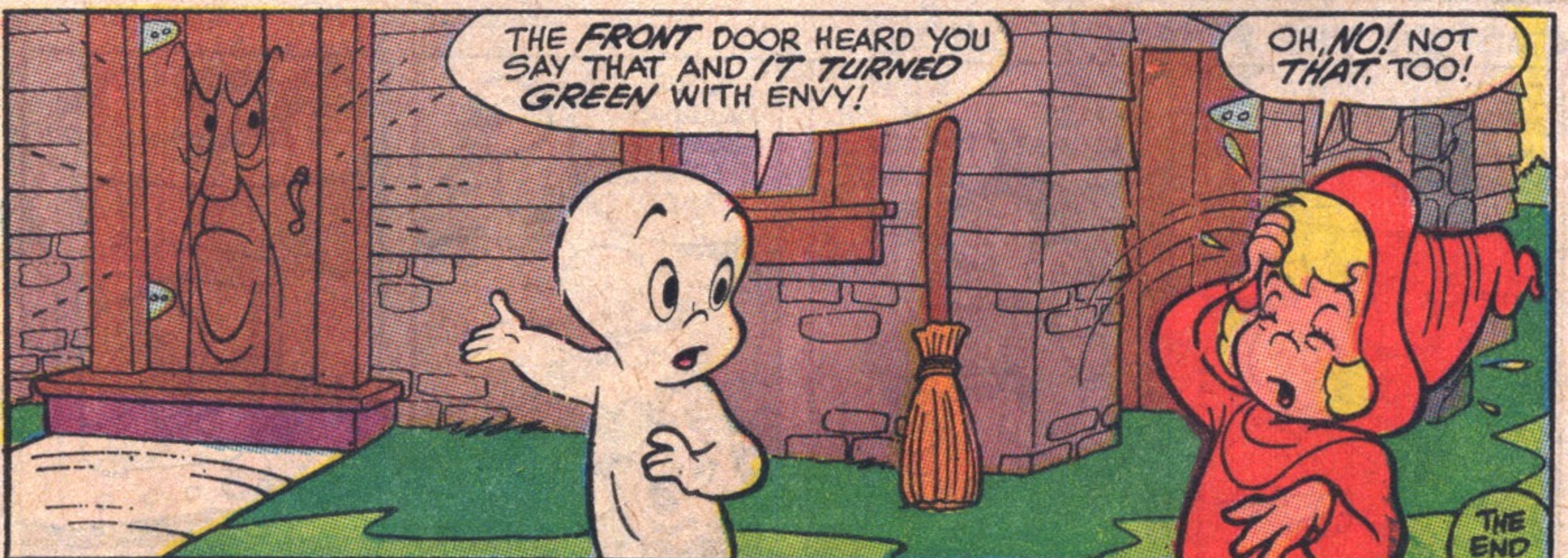
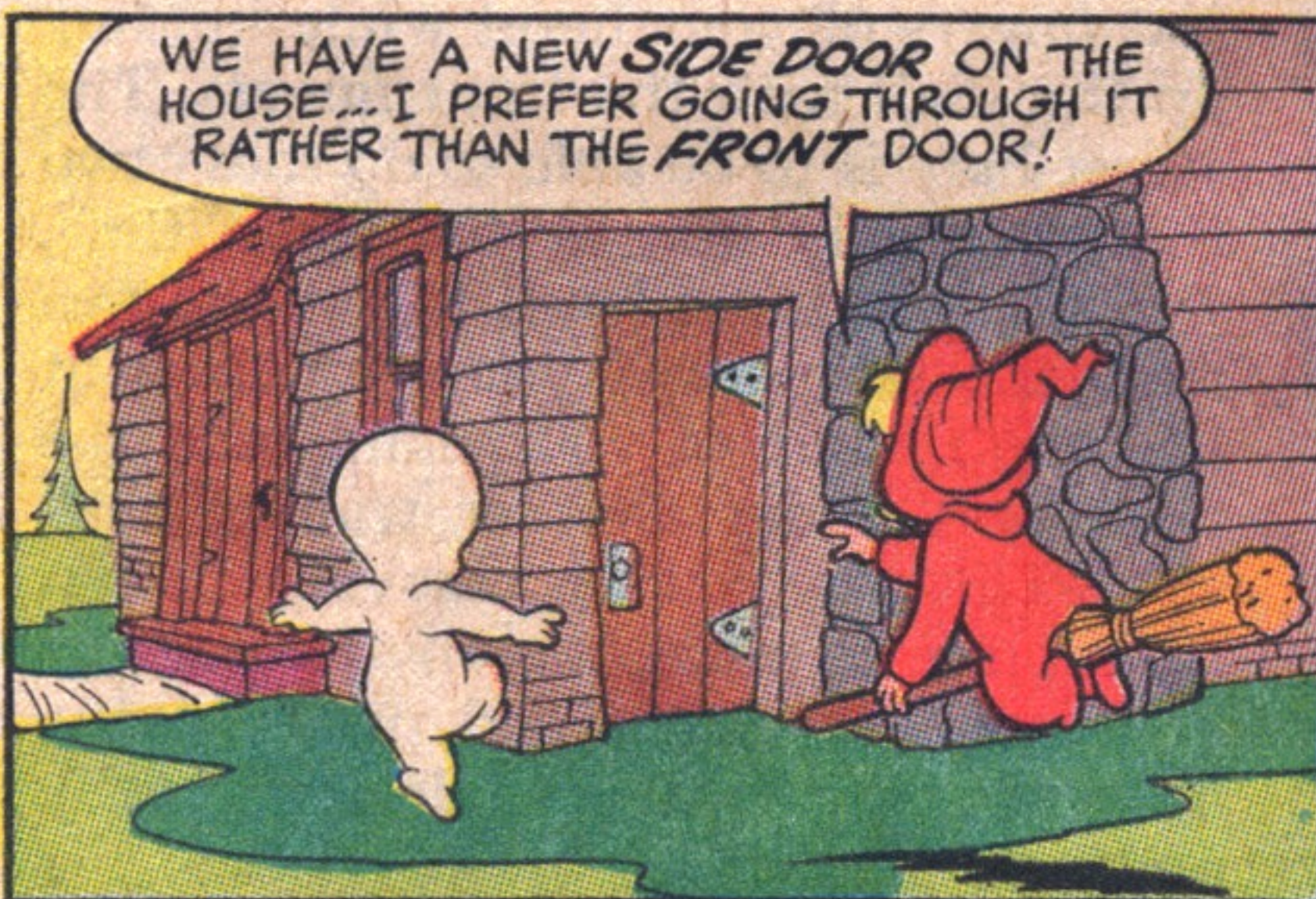
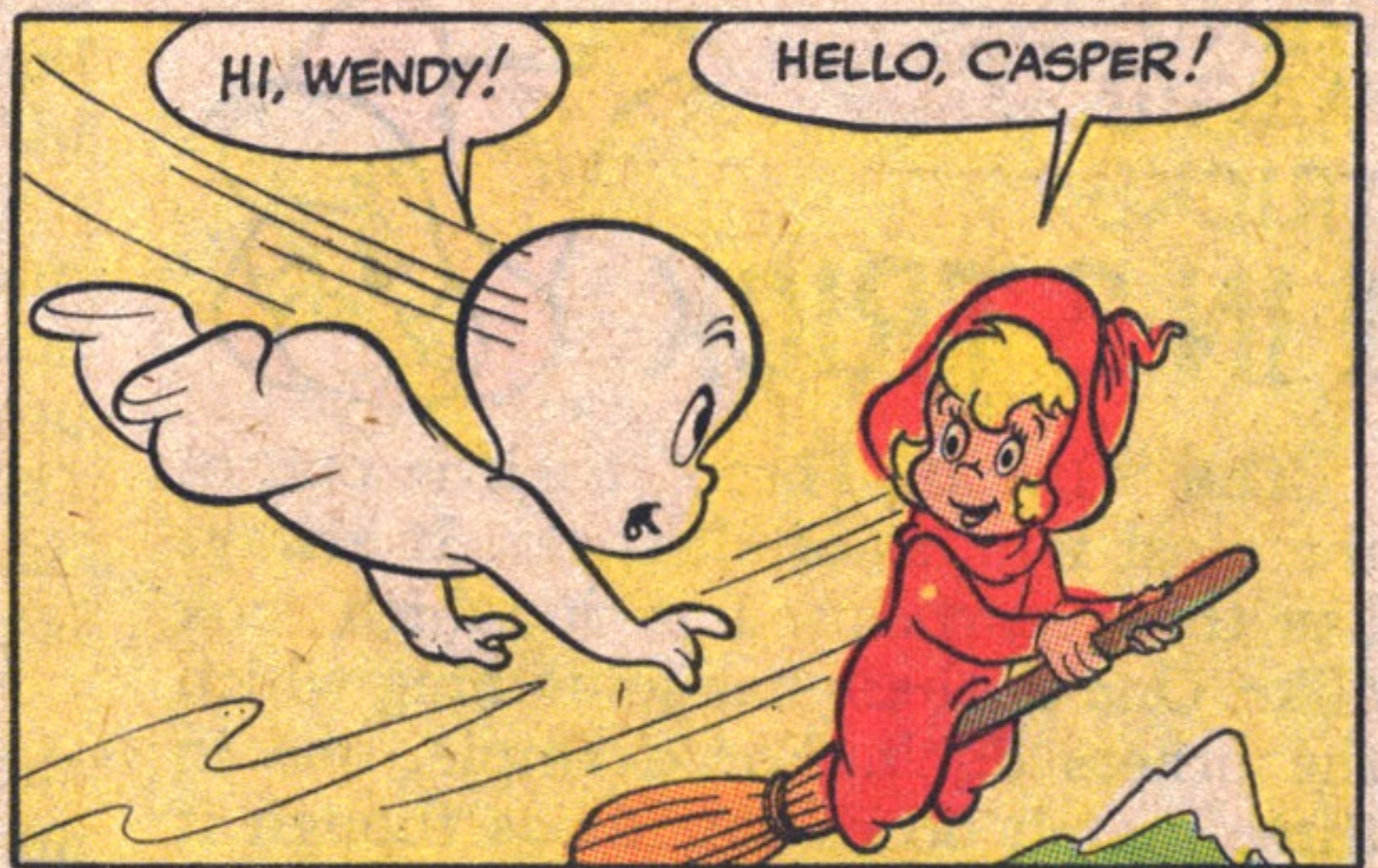














# WENDY'S MAGIC TRICKS: 1 IN 3 TRICK



The "One In Three" trick is one of the most famous of all tricks. It always has three parts used in it which look alike. One of these has something which the others don't. For example, one in three match boxes sounds as though it has a rattle inside when someone shakes it. There is a pea under one of the three empty walnut half-shells and only one out of three cowbells rings. Here's how these tricks are done.

Three match boxes are needed for the first of these tricks. You must have matchboxes which slide open when you push them apart. The three boxes are placed on a table and moved around and around. One rattles, supposedly because it has matches inside. When each box is in another spot from the one in which it began, people watching the trick are to try to guess which box has the rattle and the matches. The chances are nobody can find the box with the matches.

Do you know why? This would be because none of the boxes is full of matches. There is a rattle tied inside the magician's sleeve, or there is a box of matches up his sleeve.

The same sort of trick may be done with small cowbells. The ringing bell is hidden in the sleeve of the person who is doing the trick.

Each time that you do the matchbox

or bell trick, be sure to move one of the boxes or bells with the hand that has the hidden noise maker (the bell, rattle or matches in a box) when you want it to make noise. Be careful not to move another box with the hand that rattles until you've moved two with the other (silent) hand, as only one of the three boxes is meant to rattle. The same thing is true with the bells.

With three empty halves of walnut shells and a raw pea you can practice an interesting trick. Place the shells with the hollow part down in a row on a table. Under one shell-half put the pea. Now, what you want to do is make the audience guess where the pea is. Here's how to fool them.

Learn to pick up the shell with your thumb and forefinger. After showing the people watching what is underneath each half-shell, pick up the pea with your little finger and the fourth finger. Learn to hold the pea with the flesh near your thumb joint and the flesh in the center of the palm of your hand. You pick up the pea quickly with the last fingers of your hand while holding up the shell with the front fingers. The secret here is to be able to do these two things quickly and at the same time.

Next, you must learn to get the pea from the fat part of your thumb joint and the middle of your hand onto the table and under another walnut half-shell. This way you keep moving the pea from place to place, thereby fooling the audience. Pick it up and put it down, but you must be able to do it carefully and well.
