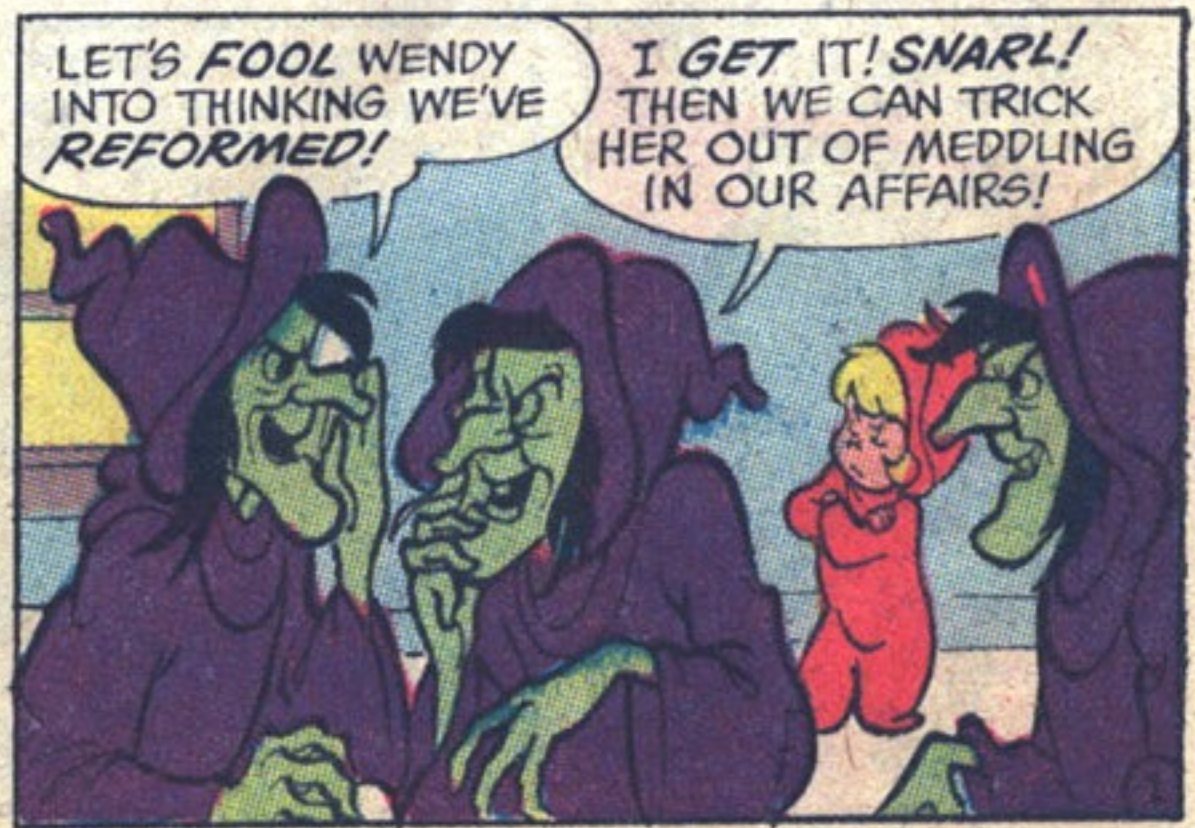
After knocking on the farmhouse door a few times, Spooky said, "Herk's not here—I'd better try the barn!"
