Kingsized Planet

Most interesting of the planets is Jupiter. It revolves around the sun at a distance of 483,000,000 miles and requires 4,333 days or 11.86 years to complete its revolution. the same plan

Jupiter is accompanied by no less than nine planets, four of which were discovered by Galileo in 1610. They can readily be seen by the naked eye. The others are very small and faint, and can barely be distinguished. The first four, or Galilean Satellites are known as lo, Europa, Ganymede and Callisto. The others have no names but are designated by Roman numerals.

Since Jupiter is the largest of the planets with the exception of Mars, it is always uppermost in any discussion of space travel. Who knows but that some day, in the none too distant future, there will be passenger ships carrying curious tourists to the laxy and Jupiter will be one of the main stopovers?


