

I know many of you disagree with my support of Nixon, but you will all (Continued on page 22)


n our last NEWSLETTER, issued Nov. 15, 1974, we presented a comprehensive expose of the John F. Kennedy assassination coverup, and revealed the evidence to prove the involvement of the CIA in the conspiracy. As a result, the CIA is now under investigation by the Rockefeller Commission, which, like the Warren Commission, will be a coverup. Of that, more later. However now we'd like to expose another organization that needs some investigating, the mysterious Bilderbergers-the most secretive coterie of super-rich, leftist internationalists in the world. This organization was first mentioned by Rep. John Rarick (D-La.), in the May 5, 1971 Congressional Record. Other than this and an article in the May 15. 1971 Washington Observer, this information has been totally suppressed in all of the national news media. The allegedly "free press" of America has cooperated in a great conspiracy to keep it secret.

The "permanent" front man of the Bilderberg group is Prince Bernhard of the Netherlands, royal consort of Queen Juliana. He is the only official designated by the Bilderbergs—all others are "honorary" or "temporary." But always in the shadows behind him are the Rothschilds, Warburgs, Wallenbergs, Rockefellers, and other great international banking dynasties.

You did not read about the Bilderberg meeting that was held Apr. 23-25, 1971, at Woodstock, Vt. in the "free press". The tight security and secrecy maintained by about 150 state and local policemen working under a task force of FBI agents kept all newsmen away. Never before had there been such an array of law enforcement officers in the village of Woodstock (population 1600). The Woodstock Inn is owned by Laurance Rockefeller, who lives in a spacious home on a hillside; everyone was barred from the inn except the Bilderbergers.

Prince Bernhard arrived in his private jet in Boston. As other foreign VIP's arrived in New York and Boston, three private Rockefeller planes ferried them to West Lebanon, N.H., where chauffeured limousines whisked them away to the Rockefeller estate or the Woodstock Inn.

Several foreign ministers of cabinet level rank attended. No Nixon cabinet officer was there, but Dr. Henry A.



Kissinger, assistant to the President for National Security Affairs, participated in the meeting. He arrived in a White House plane, accompanied by four U.S. Secret Service bodyguards, and Lt. Gen. John W. Vogt, director of the Joint Staff, Organization of the Joint Chiefs.

In 1937, Prince Bernhard, an impoverished German princeling, was working in the Paris office of I.G. Farben, when a telegram from his mother summoned him to Switzerland, where he met and wooed Princess Juliana of Holland. During World War II, Bernhard was Dutch liaison officer with the British Royal Air Force in London. After the war, he was public relations promoter of the NATO alliance and the European Common Market, and helped promote the sale of Dutch products to South America. Prince Bernhard was approached by the Polish liberal writer and political philosopher Retinger, with his scheme for a united Europe and eventually one-world government.

Bernhard thought Retinger had a good idea, but the Dutch ministers feared that the scheme might embarrass Holland. Bernhard took off for Washington, D.C., where he got support for the Retinger plan from Gen. Walter Bedell Smith, then director of the Central Intelligence Agency, and C.D. Jackson, a White House aide also closely connected with the CIA. Smith had been American ambassador to Moscow, where he had been thoroughly brainwashed. His first act as CIA director was to assemble all his top officials and announce, "We

can't lick world communism—no counter-insurgency plans will work. We must compromise and co-exist with communism." The CIA was in turmoil.

In 1953, President Eisenhower appointed Smith Under Secretary of State, and named Allen Dulles to head CIA. The first Bilderberg meeting occurred in the Bilderberg Hotel, Osterbeek, Holland, with funds from the Ford and Rockefeller Foundations, and covert support of the CIA.

Since 1955, the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace has administered funds for the Bilderberg organization, provided by the Ford Foundation and other sources. Joseph E. Johnson, head of the Carnegie Endowment, has been the Bilderberg honorary secretary general for the U.S.

The Bilderbergers held 17 meetings up to April 23-25, 1971. The 3-day Woodstock session was the third in the U.S. (St. Simons Island, Ga., 1957, and Williamsburg, Va., 1964—all three on Rockefeller-owned properties).

Bilderberg spokesmen say that Bilderberg is strictly a one-man thing, operated by Prince Bernhard without any permanent membership or even any permanent organizational structure. This is not true. The permanent Bilderberg secretariat is at 1 Smidswater, The Hague, The Netherlands. The secretary general for Europe is Ernst H. van der Beugel, professor of International Relations, Leiden University.

Not only are meetings held under heavier security than the U.S. National Security Council, but even the identity of the members of the international steering committee is secret.

The Bilderbergers are the "civilian" arm of the "Hidden Government". Many of my readers have challenged me to name names, and because I have not (except in a very few instances), they have challenged the very existence of any secret government, of the "Organization". Well, those names have been listed many times, and they are not secret at all. So, here are just a few of the Bilderbergers, but they are very important ones. Naming them means nothing, because there is nothing that can be done about them! No more than you can do about the secret society of the Masons. But it is far safer to know them and to IGNORE anything they say or do as TRUTH, and at least you will not be led BLINDLY to the slaughter! The following are Bilderbergers on the "committee". David Rockefeller, chairman, Chase Manhattan Bank; George W. Ball, managing director, Lehman Brothers, Inc.; Arthur H. Dean, senior partner, Sullivan & Cromwell; Gabriel Hauge, chairman, Manufacturers Hanover Trust Co.; Henry J. Heinz, chairman, J.J. Heinz Co.; Thomas L. Hughes, president, Carnegie Endowment for International Peace; Howard Stein, president, Dreyfus Corp.; Emilio G. Collado, executive vice president, Standard Oil Co. (N.J.); Robert O. Anderson, chairman, Atlantic Richfield Co. and chairman, Aspen Institute for Humanistic Studies; and Ian K. MacGregor, chairman, American Metal Climax.

Why do great international financiers and noted educators want to conceal the fact that they are Bilderberg committeemen? The Bilderberger operations appear more like the clandestine meetings of the dreaded Mafia or the murderous Zionist Stern Gang than the harmless get-together of world leaders for a frank discussion of international affairs. Phyllis Schlafly, in A Choice Not an Echo, called the group an example of a "little clique of powerful men who meet secretly and plan events that appear to "just happen".

The noted British authority on internationalist groups, A.K. Chesterton, in *The New Unhappy Lords*, says: "If the facts concerning the Royal Institute of International Affairs and the Council on Foreign

Relations be accepted, it will be seen that the proper study of political mankind is the study of power elites, without which nothing that happens can be understood. These elites, preferring to work in private, are rarely found posed for photographers, and their influence upon events has therefore to be deduced from what is known of the agencies they employ. There are dozens of such agencies. Financial support received from one or the other or all three big American foundations-Rockefeller, Carnegie, and Ford-provides an infallible means of recognizing them. One of the most blatant of these agencies, despite its adoption of a secret society technique, is the Bilderberg group. Strange, is it not, that Prince Bernhard should be the 'front' man for a powerful left-wing secret society?

lthough it is not offered "publicly", it is understood Tamong the various branches of the secret service groups that it will be worth one million dollars for the "return" of a missing piece of "apparatus" used in World War I (one of a number in use). Among highly secret things, this is what might be called a "hypersecret". How would you advertise for a thing called "television" as used in 1917, a missing instrument that can be carried in the palm of the hand, capable of filming a scene on the battlefield, then "projecting" it either on the spot, or a long distance away, without any "receiver" being necessary, or even a projection "screen"? By simply pressing a button, the images being "viewed" by the instrument can be projected on such things as a pane of window glass, a rock, the trunk of a tree, or simply on the ground, a brick wall, or a wooden fence-in vivid color, with diamond-sharp clarity, in full motion. Thus, the instrument can pick up, from any other instrument, the signal which is projected before your eyes; or it can send a signal to any other instrument, which in turn projects the images so that the recipient can see what is occurring in the vicinity of the other instrument. Two-way television in full color, with a hand-held mechanism! They were used in World War I, assuring the victory for American Forces, and then the government). But one of them was not returned to its "donors"! It has been the object of a concentrated and continual search for more than fifty years.

The instrument can be readily recognized: it consists of a small box similar to the present-day mini-camera, except that it is very ornately and curiously worked with strange designs in its metal surface. It opens to reveal a "spool" of what seems to be white paper, two strips with a silvery "foil" laminated between them. The paper "rolls" from one spool to another, and can be reversed. The instrument is carried in an ornately tooled leather case, very much like the cases in which cameras of the 1880s were carried. It projects not only the picture on the tape, but sound as well, the sound being recorded on the strip along with the picture. The single spool of "tape" in the "camera" can record continuously for as long as ten years, and the record is permanent. Its tiny motor is radioactively powered, operating on background radiation. Its "carrier" is the electro-magnetic field of the Earth; its "pickup" is the atomic magnetic field of any substance upon which the signal is trained.

If you have such a thing in your possession, perhaps in your attic where it was placed by a relative who served in World War I in "Special Services", it may be worth a million dollars to you, and quite possibly your life. It might be better just to use it to spy on the girl next door!

n a remote island in the Aleutians, a giant computer is busily recording "noises from the stars", and feeding them into its memory bank. The stored information is being programmed continuously by expert computer program personnel asking thousands of very strange questions-and the computer is coming up with answers! There are three sources of information within range of the new receiving station in the Aleutians. All are being spied upon and correlated. Formerly the station was located at Lop Buri in Cambodia, the only other spot where such a station could be erected to receive a combination of the three originating points of the strange radio-signals from "space". The station is jokingly called Ufoland by its personnel, although a

more technical reference is UIS—unidentified intelligent signals.

The great bulk of the signals being received are "coded"; that is they can be likened to the sort of codes that are used in the memory banks of many instruments in use today in automation. For example, modern typographers setting type for newspapers and books and magazines are beginning to use automated typesetters programmed with a code that enables the machine to "read" a printed page, or even a handwritten page, and set it into type in seconds (or micro-seconds) ready for the offset process of printing. Work is progressing on setting type directly from the human voice. While the codes being picked up by the Aleutian Islands receiver are extremely complex, and little understood as to their actual function, the computers have already come up with analyses which make it possible to duplicate the instrument or process which is being directed by the broadcast code.

We are spying on a highly automated civilization and gradually learning their secrets. But frighteningly, the information being gathered is controlled entirely by the military-industrial complex which is working to set up a world state under one totalitarian world leadership. The installation at Lop Buri, in Cambodia, has been blasted into rubble to prevent

any of its instrumentation from falling into the hands of the Communist bloc.

ow more about the Kennedy assassination: Recently comedian Dick Gregory, film specialist Robert Groden and Ralph Schoenman, author and teacher, came up with a print of the famous Zapruder film (which is owned by Time, Inc.). Said Gregory: "I have in my possession evidence of value to a thorough investigation...which places some of the same familiar persons in the Watergate scandal in Dallas at the time of President Kennedy's assassination."

In my last NEWSLETTER I presented some of that evidence, films showing E. Howard Hunt on the "grassy knoll" in Dealy Plaza. Presented here are other views of that scene, in the possession of Gregory. They show both Hunt and Frank Sturgis present on the knoll. Compare them with photos of both men taken during the Watergate trials.

Groden's print of the Zapruder film is a blown-up version (from 8mm to 16mm). He is an optical specialist. He refuses to say how he got the film, but it is authentic as proved by frames from it published in Life Magazine in 1963 and 1964. This is the same film studied by the Warren Commission

before concluding that Oswald acted alone.

The film shows Kennedy being hit in the head, the force of the bullet pushing Kennedy back and to the left (in the photo), indicating he was shot from the front, and not from the back, as the Warren Commission concluded. The film also shows two men who were firing at Kennedy from the grassy knoll and from behind a tree ahead of the motorcade. The man on the knoll is known as "the man in black" because he was wearing a black cape, under which it can be assumed he hid the two guns he is shown firing at Kennedy in a sequence of frames.

Based on the evidence presented by Gregory and Groden, Rep. Henry Gonzales (D.-Tex.) is seeking a congressional investigation. In response to that, Mrs. Sargent Shriver, Kennedy's sister, said she was satisfied with the findings of the Warren Commission, and opposed any reopening of the investigation.

The Zapruder film is in color, and begins as the motorcade turns off Houston Street and turns onto Elm. The crowds are thinner here. Then the shots begin. The first to strike Kennedy is obscured by a street sign, but the second which explodes at Kennedy's right temple is clearly and horribly visible. When the film was shown at the Clay Shaw trial in New Orleans, spectators and jurors gasped


Frank Sturgis, Watergate trial, 1973

and groaned. Kennedy's head is driven backward and to the left, indicating a shot from a front or side angle (from the other side of the street from Oswald's position in the Book Depository). Mrs. Kennedy is shown climbing on her knees to the trunk of the limosine (not to escape, as some thought) to pick up something there (a piece of her husband's skull), then returning to her seat to clutch protectively at her slumping husband.

Acting independently, another man has come up with the same conclusions. This is artist John McClure, who spent 1200 hours recreating Dealy Plaza at the time Kennedy was shot. He built a 30-foot square model on a scale of one-eighth inch to one foot. It is now on display at the Movie Wax Museum at Estes Park, Colorado.

McClure crawled around Dealy Plaza with a 100 foot tape, examined a "pirated" (?) copy of a home-movie film of the murder (Zapruder's film), and took hundreds of pictures of the area. Working from a photo taken by James Altgens, McClure's diorama places the Kennedy car at a point where a tree shields it from Oswald's vantage point. McClure ran a wire from the depository window to the spot, simulating the line of fire, and found that Oswald could not possibly have hit Kennedy from that point. The


Warren Commission's measurements are different from McClure's, and are demonstrably inaccurate.


McClure's recreation includes 300 figures, all without detailed faces, but everything else is graphic, including all the buildings, a railroad underpass and even grass slightly yellowed as it appears in Dallas in the fall. Twenty trees are exact replicas, created by McClure's wife, Jean, who spent many hours gluing tiny branches to small tree trunks, with foliage made from seaweed. Teardrop pearls are used for street lamps, pinheads for parking meters, pinpoints for auto and motorcycle antennas. Says McClure: "It is physically impossible for Oswald to have shot Kennedy from the Book Depository Building-the first projectile hit Kennedy three seconds before the Warren Commission claims", and it came from the other side of the street. McClure has placed a lone figure in the position he concludes the assassin stood (although there were a number of other people in that area). More about those people now:

While there were over 40 persons standing on the grassy slope of Dealy Plaza awaiting the Kennedy car, only three are of primary importance. Life Magazine printed five frames from the Zapruder film which feature these three persons: frames 2 and 3 on page 24. Nov. 29, 1963; unidentified frame,

top picture, page 43, Oct. 2, 1964; frames 193 and 206, page 40, Nov. 25, 1966. The first three frames mentioned are reproduced as drawings on page 8 of this magazine. In frame 2, observe the man wearing black coat and hat; his right arm is up and elbow cocked as though ready to fire a pistol. Note the bend in his knees as though crouching to fire. A little girl, at his right, is running toward him. In frame 3, she is passing behind him. In the unidentified frame (which obviously follows very shortly after frame 3), the little girl having passed him, is standing with a clear view of the Kennedy car. Now look back at frame 2; a woman with her back to the camera is stepping up onto the curb in front of the man with the black coat; one foot on the curb, the other still in the gutter. Look at her in frame three; now the crouched man in black has his arm extended toward the presidential car. Has he just finished shooting? But notice the woman now, her legs are splayed outward; she is falling as her height is now below the armpits of the man in black. She has walked directly into the path of the gunman's bullets! If you will check with page 292, Vol.






gun. The gun has a rather long profile for a pistol—it has a silencer screwed into the end of the barrel? And in his left hand, is that another pistol? Surely the American People have a right to see the entire Zapruder film now. But, is the film Dick Gregory is showing a doctored one? If so, the fact would be apparent from these damning LIFE 1963 photos!

In addition to Kennedy and the vanishing woman, five other persons were hit by bullets: Malcom Couch on the sidewalk (Vol. 20, p. 410 & Vol. 6, p. 159); motorcycle officer on the north side of motorcade (Vol. 18, p. 763 & Vol. 19, p. 535); child at curb on north side of Elm St. (Vol. 11, p. 218); John Wiseman (Vol. 19, p. 535); Secret Service man in Kennedy car (Agent Bennett testimony and Vol. 20, p. 163); James Tague (Vol. 7, p. 552). In all 21 bullets or fragments of bullets were recovered, five times as much metal as could have come from Oswald's three shots, if he fired at all! Nor could Oswald have hit Malcom Couch, on the sidewalk below him.



Even Jacqueline Kennedy hints at a conspiracy in her classic and mystifying words as she walked down the ramp from the plane in Washington, still wearing her blood-stained pink suit, although she had plenty of time and opportunity to change: "I want them to see what they have done!" Who were "they" who would be present to see her coming down the ramp? Not Oswald, certainly! Present were many high dignitaries of the power elite, among them Earl Warren whose "commission" chose to ignore hundreds of facts, and while claiming one man did the deed, with complete solution of the crime, yet sealed up all the evidence for 75 years? To what end? Did Earl Warren know something when, almost as soon as Kennedy had been declared dead, he publicly announced: "A great and good President. . .suffered martydom. . .by bigots." He used the plural. Was it a slip of the tongue, or mere rhetoric? Who killed our president, and why is he (they) not being hounded down!



The Philosophy Of Magic

usebe Salverte was born in Paris in 1771. He became vastly interested in history at an early age, and began research to retrace it which resulted in publishing an "introduction" in 1813, merely to give an idea of the manner in which such research should be conducted. His primary motive in delving into the past was to discover to what extent the sciences had been carried among the ancients, and how much of it was now lost.

In the course of his inquiry, he discovered that much information was shut up in the temples, and employed there during many ages to excite either wonder or fear; but in the flight of time, decaying and at last fading away altogether leaving behind only imperfect traditions which have since been ranked as fables. His attempts to restore life to these ancient intellectual monuments led to publication in 1817 of a magazine article which received so encouraging a reception that he plunged into the writing of a book on the occult sciences he had re-discovered, which was published in 1829. The theory which guided him he summed up in these words:

"When the improbability of a fact is the chief objection to the belief in its reality, the evidence which attests it regains all its value, if the improbability can be proved to be only apparent. Can a similar test be applied with success to the greater part of the prodigies and assumed miracles related to the ancients? It is more reasonable, then, to admit to the truth of the facts and the accuracy of their explanation, than to condemn them as impostures. It is an incontestible fact that anciently science, and more especially that science which was confined to the temples, was enveloped in a thick veil to conceal it from the eyes of the vulgar public; and that it was employed to produce wonderful works fitted to subdue the obstinacy and credulity of the people. In the marvelous recitals which have been handed down to our times, some of this mystical learning may be discovered; and in prosecuting the research, we endeavor to complete the history of occult science and mankind."

The final version of "The Philosophy of Magic" was published in 1847, and is the version photographically reproduced by Ray Palmer as a very important part of his "Series of Lost Scientific Books" containing research which ought not to be lost to today's thinkers.

Salverte covers an enormous number of scientific subjects in his book, but a few of the principle ones

The history of civilization and of man is primarily occult in nature, and just as science today performs miracles, it was the science of the ancients which was responsible for the miraculous deeds told in fable. Just as it was in the ancient past, the priests of the religions of the more recent past keep secret important scientific knowledge which could even today solve many of our problems. Salverte, in his book, has exposed much of that hidden philosophy, and today his book, after having been out of print for over a century, is invaluable to the modern thinker. Much knowledge has been lost to our view which deserves to be restored to us. With its restoration, much tedious searching can be obviated, making unnecessary the task of doing it all over again. Also, from the clues to be found in this ancient lore, the impetus to even more wonderful "miracles and prodigies" may be given to a technician in some modern laboratory, or some philosophical theoriest in his university chair.

The Veil Lifted - The Science Of Spirit Photography

of spirits, but perhaps one of the best books on the subject was published in 1894. The evidence presented in that book has not been substantially surpassed by today's experimenters, and as a result, it is as vital today as in 1894. The book contains twelve famous spirit photographs plus a paper by J. Traill Taylor describing experiments in psychic



photography, plus other material by Rev. H.R. Haweis and James Robertson.

The term "spirit photographs" is generally used to describe photographs of psychic entities who cannot be seen by ordinary persons, but who can be photographed by a medium, or with the help of a medium, and with the cooperation of these unseen entities. Such portraits are obtained both indoors and in the open air, with and without a background, by natural light and by artificial light; and in the case of "materialized" forms at seances, which are visible to every person present, the portraits have sometimes been taken by light produced by the spirits, the exact nature of which is unknown.

Roughly classified, spirit photographs are:

- 1.—Portraits of entities not seen by normal vision.
- 2.—Pictures of objects not seen nor thought of by the sitter or the medium or photographer, such as flowers, words, crosses, crowns, lights, and various emblematic objects.
- 3.—Pictures that have the appearance of having been copied from statues, paintings, or drawings. Sometimes these are busts or heads only. The flatness in some photographs of this class is supposed, by persons who have not investigated, to be proof of fraud.
 - 4.—Materialized forms visible to normal sight.
- 5.—The "wraith" or "double" of persons still in the body.
- 6.—Portraits on plates which have not been exposed.

7.—Pictures not taken with the agency of a camera. Reproduced here is a photo taken on March 22, 1894 with a plate camera. This extremely rare photograph was taken by John Ballou Newbrough, the author of OAHSPE, who was undoubtedly the world's greatest psychic. This photograph is a part of the collection owned by Ray Palmer, who has made "The Veil Lifted" once more available, after being out for print for more than 75 years.

A JOURNEY TO THE EARTH'S INTERIOR

With the coming of the flying saucers, an old question has once more been raised, stemming from the puzzlement regarding the origin of the pesky UFO. Perhaps it is natural that conjecture should include the interior of Earth. It is not too well known by many people today that there is nothing new in this concept, and even less well known is the evidence for such a theory. Back in 1912, Marshall B. Gardner wrote one of the best books on the subject,

and covered it exhaustively with an acumen that is only becoming evident today with new discoveries by our space satellites, and the general acceptance of a theory held in low regard in Marshall's time, the vortexial nebula theory of the formation of planets, which Marshall stressed very strongly in his remarkable book. He was virtually alone then, but he is not alone now! In 1920 he enlarged and revised his book, and it was republished. However, since that

time the book has become unavailable, and rare copies of it are being sold at prices possible only to a collector. Recently photo-copied by Ray Palmer, it is once more available.

One whose acquaintance with cosmogony and physiography is confined to what he learned in school and afterward in popular publications, has certain very definite notions about the shape of Earth, and the construction of its interior. These notions, he thinks, are based on proven discoveries, or impregnable theories of scientists, so he accepts them on blind faith. While they hold to a general theory about the shape and size of Earth, that it is a rigid solid, a shell with a liquid (under enough pressure to make it have the properties of a solid) interior, they will admit that there are many questions that can be raised to dispute their theory. Gardner has "marshalled" an incredible number of these questions factual observations into his book, convincingly as to challenge all the old theories. Gardner collects the research stemming from the polar explorations of many explorers, including Peary, Sir John Franklin, Lieutenant McClintock, Dr. Kane, Dr. I.I. Hayes, Sir John Ross, Greely, Adolf Nordenskiold, Nansen, Admiral Melville, Captain Cook, Edwin S. Grew, and literally dozens of the best scientific minds of the day who did research on the discoveries and reports of these intrepid explorers.

To the student of the real nature of our planet,

Gardner's book is probably one of the most thought-provoking and stimulating available—perhaps even more valuable because it was written so long ago, yet has stood the test of subsequent discovery, such as the expeditions of Admiral Byrd and all modern explorers, plus new discoveries in science culminating in the research satellites of the space age. Marshall would be delighted today to know how more right he was than he knew, although it has not yet been proved that his concept of the interior of Earth is literally true.

One of the things he stressed was how difficult it is to acquire evidence of a hollow Earth, and how virtually impossible to find the polar entrances he postulates. He stresses Nansen's bewilderment at his failures of navigation, and points out that it is not a matter of "going there and viewing the spectacle of an entrance into. the planet" because mere observation is not enough. Man has always been limited in his concepts of Earth's shape because his eyesight tells him it is flat, so that he cannot accept without better evidence that it is a spheroid, which is hardly a reasonable theory based on mere eyesight alone.

With what we know today, Gardner's book assumes new stature, and should be a must on every thinker's reading schedule. It is a fascinatingly detailed, expertly presented, absorbingly interesting subject, convincingly handled.

rior to 1883, ghost stories were as popular as they are today—with one significant difference: the emphasis was on fact rather than fiction, and it was a serious research of the day to determine the reality of the visions reported by many people. The purpose of a "ghost story" was not to scare or to raise the hackles on your neck, but to relate an actual occurrence. Fiction in the case of supernatural stories was passed by in preference to the perhaps less sensational tale of an apparation reported by an observer. It was not a question of things that go bump in the night, but of the reality that was assumed to be behind such things. What was a ghost? Not, did ghosts really exist?—it was generally accepted that they did.

The Reverend Frederick George Lee, D.C.L., vicar of All Saints', Lambeth, England was such a believer, and he became an assiduous researcher into these glimpses of the supernatural. He investigated and collected accounts of this nature and finally presented them all in a book which he published in 1883. It remains today one of the best books on the supernatural that has ever been written. It has been out of print all during the twentieth century, during which "nonsense" such as this was overwhelmed by scientific logic and common sense. Superstition was frowned upon, laughed at, ridiculed.

However, during recent years there has been a revival of interest in supernatural things, partly due to the collapse of religion as an explainer of the occult, partly due to the new realization that the world of the unseen, the "other" world, does indeed exist, and can be detected by many of our new "mechanical" senses, such as radar. In fact, many governments of the world have spent millions upon "receivers" trained upon the local skies, endeavoring to pick up mysterious messages from unseen sources. Naturally there has been a revival of occult theory as to the cause of these messages and apparitions that effect our machines.

The incredible public popularity of such things as interpreting dreams, psychic phenomena, apparitions, wraiths, witchcraft, necromancy, ESP and prophecy has brought about a new awareness of "another world" that may or may not be psychic, perhaps even a new frame of reality existing alongside ours, or interpenetrating it.

In Reverend Lee's book already exists the most scholarly collection of actual supernatural occurrences, and due to the fact that it was unavailable and because of its excellence, it has now been photo-copied and is once more available. Whether you merely like the thrill of goose-bumps raised by fine ghosts stories, or you want to know more about actual cases which have been thoroughly researched and documented, "The Other World" is a very fine answer to your interests.

It took Reverend Lee twenty years to gather the material in this book, and throughout he dealt only with facts and records, rather than with theories. He leaves the theorizing to you. His are historical narrations, all of it personally gained by investigation, or from the investigation of friends and acquaintances who were of great aid to him in his search.

Encyclopedia Of Biblical Spiritualism

Prior to 1895 there was a great conflict between biblical Christians and the advocates of the then new "Spiritualism". Christians called it the work of the devil, while Spiritualists saw no connection between the two. The new "religion", which began with the Fox sisters and their "rappings", faced opposition which it did not deserve, and it wasn't until Moses Hull wrote a series of articles in Progressive Thinker that it was pointed out that Spiritualists ought to read the Bible for justification of their tenets, while Christians should read the same book for enlightenment as to the actual "spiritualism" cogent to their own religion.

Almost immediately, Moses Hull was importuned to write a book on the subject, and go into his research more fully so that a reconciliation between Orthodox Christians and Spiritualist Christians could be attained. Hull agreed, almost against his will because over a thousand subscriptions to the proposed book came in to back up the requests of those who wanted the book to be written. However, almost as soon as he started, he realized that to have striven for completeness would have resulted in a volume larger than Webster's Dictionary. As it turned out, he had to fight himself constantly to keep his book within reasonable dimensions. Even so, the book ran to

nearly 400 pages. When published in early 1895, it soon became evident that Hull had been successful in producing a book of inestimable value, and the printing was immediately sold out. Reference to numerous authorities was out of the question, yet research has always shown that backing could be found for all that is said in the book. Aside from the problem of Spiritualism, the book is a valuable reference work and commentary on the Bible itself.

The clergy, at the time of the "Rochester knockings", everywhere created the impression that no one could take hold of Spiritualism and at the same time maintain any sort of respect for the Bible; and if one gave up his Bible, he gave up his God and his religion, and, of course, his soul. Those who embraced Spiritualism did not study the Bible, as a consequence, concluding that the Bible was opposed to Spiritualism; but they could say, as Job did: "I know for myself, and not another" that Spiritualism was true. As a legitimate consequence, they sometimes, in language rather more expressive than elegant, told the churches to take their Bibles and go to—Sunday school with them; knowing Spiritualism to be a living truth, carrying the evidence of its

divinity wherever it went, it did not particularly need the Bible. Thus many Spiritualists, without any investigation, were driven to reject the Bible.

Moses Hull strove to reconcile this unjustified difference of opinion, and succeeded beyond all his dreams. However, like many valuable books, as soon as it was out of print, the value of his research was lost to any newcomers, and after having served the purpose of owners of the book, the volumes wound up in attics and lost their continuing useful purpose. Today the conflict is by no means solved, and with the addition to the subject of that amazing book, OAHSPE, written by spirits (!), there is more need than ever of understanding of the universality of Spiritualism in not only the Christian religion and Bible, but in all the world's major religions. Thus, this tremendous encyclopedia of Spiritualism has once more been made available, reproduced as a faithful photographic reproduction of the original. And this at an unbelievably low price sharply in contrast with the concept of an "encyclopedia". The book, like all the others in the series of "Lost Scientific Books", is offered for little more than the actual cost of production.

THE HISTORY OF MAGIC

oday magic is a subject of intense interest, and it has experienced a revival that is almost astounding. It is not the sort of "magic" that we have been accustomed to such as card tricks, sleight-of-hand and staged magical displays wherein people vanish from cabinets, women are sawed in two (why not men once in awhile?) and linked solid metal rings mysteriously become disengaged. Rather, it is the more ancient meaning of magic, which is interpreted as the sciences of the ancients. Research into ancient magic is difficult today because of the long interim during which it was in disrepute and literature on it became adulterated with mumbo-jumbo trickery and the so-called science of "illusion". Yet not all is lost in the limbo of the past, scattered in dusty archives whose location is difficult to find. It remained to a German named Joseph Ennemoser to perform with solid Teutonic methodic completeness the compilation of his 500-page book "The History of Magic". He completed the work in 1843, and it was published in Munich in his native language. Even today, however, it would not be available to English-speaking peoples except for the translation undertaken by William Howitt. This book was published in 1854 in London. Added to the

original work by his wife, Mary Howitt, was a selection of the most remarkable and best authenticated stories of apparitions, dreams, second-sight, somnambulism, predictions, divination, witchcraft, vampires, fairies, table-turnings and spirit-rappings.

It is this book itself, extremely rare, and certainly not available to the average person, which has now been reproduced as it was originally published.

Quoting the author, Joseph Ennemoser, regarding the subject matter of his book, he has this to say:

"Different readers will look at this book from very different points of view. By some it will be esteemed only as a curiosity, others will find matter for further research; one will wish to learn magic arts from it, another will draw from it philosophical conclusions. All will be welcome, and will find, I believe, if not instruction, at least amusement and uncommon effects, which have hitherto been looked upon as mere phantoms, or as belonging to a sphere quite unconnected with nature, but which nevertheless are a portion of history, and surely on that account are of universal interest."

That history leads us into a sphere which still, like a closed book, contains secrets of a higher order of things lying beyond the familiar, every-day history of nature. The reader in this work will be led into the land of the marvellous. He will be faithfully informed how these magical prophecies, the demoniacal powers of necromancy and of Christian witchcraft, at different times and among different nations, were brought about. Not merely the bare facts, but as much as possible the natural progress of them explained, in order that they will no longer be ascribed to the gods, but the causes be found in

human nature itself and in its inborn attributes. Man possesses unusual mental powers that arise from the depths of the spiritual world, through time and space, and abide by a fixed law of nature. The intensity and vastness of the human mind are not fathomed by the most faithful observations of physiologists; and these psychological wonders are still frequently enough ascribed to the gods. In this book you will find the mystical rendered scientific, rather than science mystical.

THE WONDERS OF THE INVISIBLE WORLD

In the spring of 1692, in the puritanical colony of New England, since better known as Massachusetts, an alarm of witchcraft was raised in the family of the minister of Salem, and some black servants were charged with the supposed crime. Once started, the alarm spread rapidly, and in a very short time a great number of people fell under suspicion, and many were thrown into prison on very frivolous grounds, supported, as such charges usually were, by very unworthy witnesses.

The new governor of the colony, Sir William Phipps, arrived from England in the middle of May, and he seems to have been carried away by the excitement, and authorized judical prosecutions. The trials began at the commencement of June, and the first victim, a woman named Bridget Bishop, was hanged. Governor Phipps, embarrassed by this extraordinary state of things, called in the assistance of the clergy of Boston. As it evolved, this turned out to be a very serious mistake.

There was at this time a distinguished family of puritanical ministers in Boston of the name of Mather. Increase Mather, a scholar and theologian, was president of Harvard College. His son, Cotton Mather, became even more remarkable than his father for scholarship, also gained a high position in Harvard College, and at the time of which we are speaking, was a minister of the gospel in Boston. Cotton Mather had adopted all the most extreme notions of the puritanical party with regard to witchcraft, and even in Boston had been the cause of persecution and hanging of an Irish woman for witchcraft. Consequently when he went to Salem, he embarked on a tremendous blood-bath of executions as a result

of the accusations of witchcraft being made by everyone who had a grudge against anyone else. Accusation was tantamount to execution.

So hysterical became the populace and Cotton Mather himself, that one Mr. George Burroughs, himself a minister, was hanged for expressing a disbelief in witchcraft. Mather, present at the hanging on horseback, delivered an impassioned speech condemning Burroughs as an imposter. But when the bloody business continued, and more unfortunate victims were added to the list of those hanged, the magistrates became alarmed, and called upon the governor, who required Cotton Mather to employ his pen to justify what he had done. The result was a book called "The Wonders Of The Invisible World".

The book was published in Boston in October, 1692. But the witch mania continued to spread. The assistance of Increase Mather was called upon, and he in turn published a book called "A Further Account Of The Tryals Of The New England Witches". To this was added "Cases Of Conscience Concerning Witchcraft And Evil Spirits Impersonating Men". The agitation now moved from Salem to Andover, where a great number of people were accused. A judge named Bradstreet refused to issue any more warrants for arrest, and was in turn accused of killing nine persons by means of witchcraft. He fled for his life. But when the wife of Governor Phipps himself was accused, matters came to a head. The accusers were themselves hauled into court on claims of damages, and Phipps was recalled to London. An influential merchant named Robert Calef opposed Cotton Mather in the matter of an accused witch named Margaret Rule, and proved Mather's accusations false.

He also wrote a book, which was seized and burned by the two Mathers. However, the insanity died down, and there were no recurrences of the witch-hunts.

The books written by Cotton and Increase Mather, published in 1693, were reprinted in 1862, and it is

this reprint, unavailable for over 100 years, which has now been photographically reproduced exactly as it was written. Here is the self-incrimination of the most sadistic member of the clergy who ever lived, just as it was written 283 years ago. It is fascinating, and at the same time incredibly blood-chilling.

The Encyclopaedia Of Death

Back in the 1880s, J.R. Francis wrote two books, "Search After God" and "Is the Devil Dead?" Both are out of print and virtually impossible to find today. There is a curious coincidence of subject matter in our modern day, referring to the more recent discussion on "Is God Dead?" More to the point however, is the intense curiosity regarding death itself that was engendered in author Francis because of his research in the process of writing his first two books. It became a more personal matter of whether he himself would be proper subject matter for a book called "Is J.R. Francis Dead?" As he puts it:

"I am certain that people generally take an exceptionally keen and lively interest in everything that relates to the change whereby the spirit is divested of its physical garments, and is thereby able to enter a new sphere of existence and realize more fully than ever the fact that so-called death is as natural as birth on the material plane."

It is doubtful if there exists a person who has not thought about death and what it would mean to him, if anything. Do we or do we not exist in a spiritual form? Is death the end? Or is it a new beginning? What is it really? Is there anything actually known about it?

Francis found that the answer to the last question was yes. But what is known about death in all its varied and comprehensive details is scattered through many volumes, hidden on the shelves of various libraries, public and private, and in countless magazines, papers and scrap-books, all inaccessible to the general public. Therefore, he felt it was necessary to collate these facts in a single book (or books), and proceeded to do so. The result was his "The Encyclopedia of Death" which bore as its sub-title "Life In The Spirit World". Originally it consisted of two volumes. Volume One is lost, and if copies exist, they have not turned up in recent searches. Volume Two, however, has been included in the republished

series of lost scientific books, and is once more available. It is not incomplete, however, in spite of the fact it is the second of two volumes—it is an entity in itself, and in actuality is only "more of the same", and thus constitutes a very complete collection, quite sufficient to serve its author's purpose.

A careful perusal of the book opens up to the analytic mind a vast field of thought, and carries the reader into the realm that has been very little explored, even by physicans themselves. The extreme subtilty of the multifarious phases of death, the varied phenomena connected therewith, and the strange symptoms (often deceiving the physician) that frequently greet the one who witnesses the final change, make it of special importance that the public should devote more careful, critical and painstaking study to that "dreaded" evolution which all must undergo.

It seems obvious that one enters spirit-life in precisely the same mental and moral state he possessed while alive. It also seems certain that tremendous problems will confront him, depending upon his relationship while alive with those who have gone before him. Will it be true that the legitimate consequence of his living acts will come to fruitage after his death? Will he find himself in a personal "hell" or a personal "heaven"? Will he have to confront those he has wronged, and will he find new joy with those he has loved?

You will be vastly surprised by the immense amount of lore on the subject of death that has been assembled into this valuable book. It may not answer your questions conclusively, but it will provide you with enough material to do some very satisfying thinking. The book is a treasure-house of examples of deaths and phenomena and evidence. Hundreds of cases are studied in detail, each one an absorbing true story in itself.

For nearly three decades controversy has continued unabated regarding the enigmatic unidentified flying objects (UFOs), more popularly known as flying saucers. One of the main arguments is about the point of origin of these mysterious craft. Many hypotheses have been advanced. In the second part of this book considerable modern evidence is painstakingly put forward, indicating that the earth is, indeed, hollow, with entrances in both the north and south polar regions.

In the final part of the book, Mr. Le Poer Trench advances reasons, based on the conviction that the earth is hollow, as to why most of the UFOs seen today, come from the earth's interior.

This book by a man widely respected in the UFO field is bound to cause a storm among scientists, ufologists and laymen, alike, but it cannot be dismissed lightly.

I read with great interest your article on the Kennedy assassination in the recent "R.P. Newsletter". I have read most of what has been written about the Dallas Affair and I came to the conclusion a long time ago that Oswald was either a conspirator or completely innocent in the killing of J.F.K. I also saw and read "Executive Action". The book reveals much that the movie glossed-over. 
