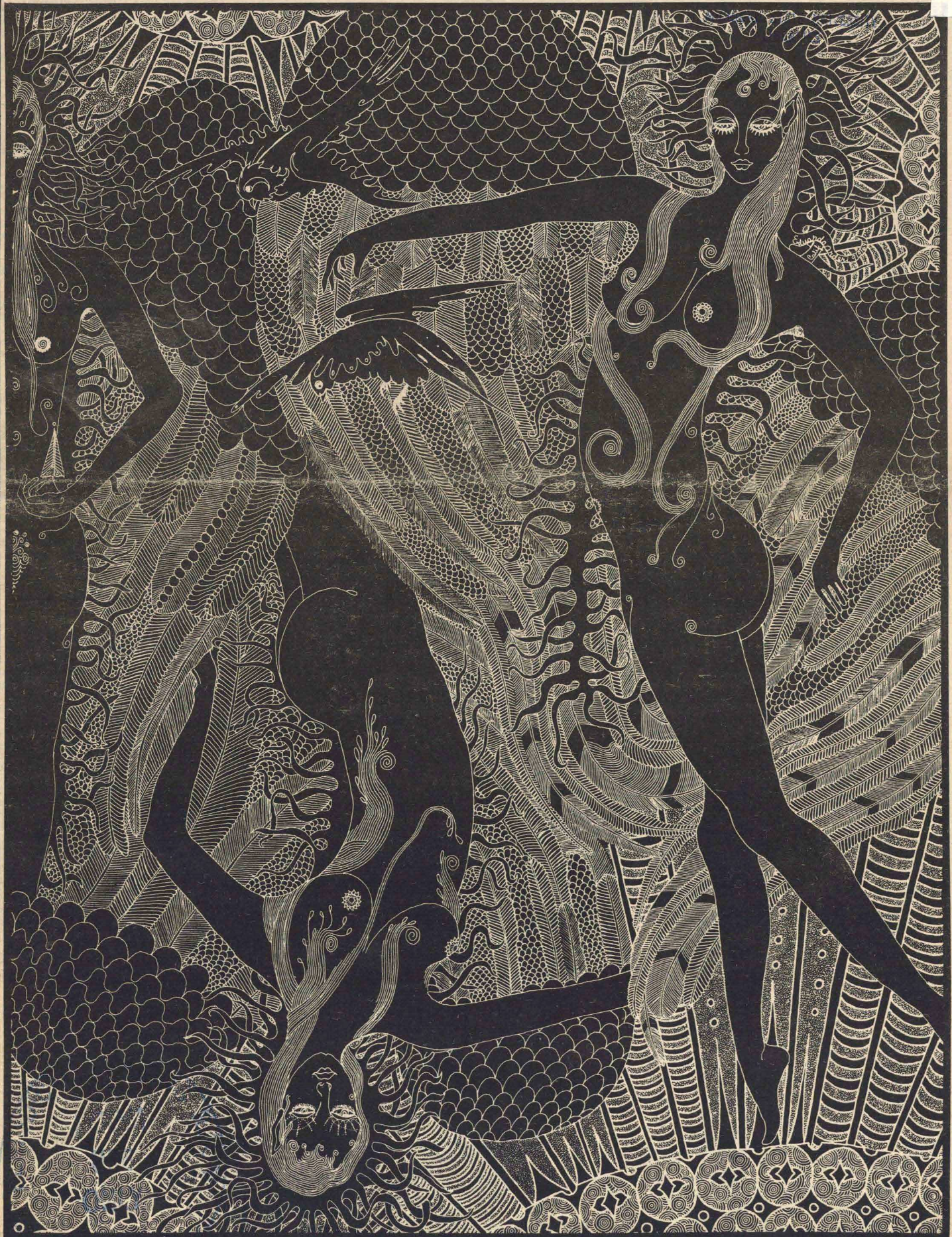

# Vendors Vamped, Machine Mutilated, Window Wiped-Out

## Which Is Real?

There is one thing certain: establishment and "revolutionary" elements agree on: they both want the BARB off the streets. Both groups do their part.

BARB vendors have been intimidated by both helmet-heads and long-hairs for selling the BARB. The Berkeley Police have courageously been stopping 11 and 12 year olds, and citing or warning them for such atrocities as "selling without a license" or "being out after the ten o'clock curfew." One 12 year old, busted on the curfew charge, was taken down to the station, locked in a room, fingerprinted, photographed, and told to never return to Berkeley. He is to appear in Juvenile Court next week.

At least a half-dozen BARB vendors were busted last week in San Francisco and Berkeley by the police on various farces. Sausalito has been a risky place to vend for a long time now. The State capitol in Sacramento is off-limits, and vendors have to be careful in Santa Cruz.

In Santa Cruz, the police rounded up all the BARB's sold there last week and confiscated them. Lt. Scheer deemed the cover "pornography". He is waiting for the D.A. to return before he instigates any action. This reporter asked Lt. Scheer if he read the lead article, which explained the drawing of President Nixon holding his eight foot...hot dog, from which our flag proudly waved. Lt. Scheer said that he hadn't read it.

He referred back to the previous issue, to the cartoon of the boy being repeatedly punished for masturbating, turning into a vicious cop beating peace demonstrators with a club bearing a striking resemblance to his prick. Now this cartoon required no explanation, but as all Lt. Scheer saw was a "boy holding his private part", Lt. Scheer's action requires no explanation.

On the local scene, the BARB has had a rock thrown through its window, one vending machine



demolished by a car, little posters saying "Communism works WHERE?" plastered all over the office front, and a number of vending machines systematically ripped off.

Obviously, this is not the work of the police, because of their age requirement. This is obviously the work of 8 year olds, who are known to throw rocks and fool with vending machines. They are too young to realize that in so doing they are taking bread out of people's mouths. But some people don't think everyone should eat. Eating is after all a capitalistic activity.

Children who are a little older just think that they should eat more than others. To wit, the "revolutionaries" who go around telling our vendors not to sell our papers.

At first they threatened some vendors, but finding this didn't work so well they resorted to the Big Lie, and spread and continue to spread fantastic lies about the BARB. This reporter has been informed by the most obscure going on at the BARB! How the BARB is counter-revolutionary, how it is backed by the CIA, how the Editor paid vendors \$5 to come over from San Francisco to sell the BARB, and how we at the same time cheat our vendors.

This reporter last Sunday saw Jon Jacobsen, Managing Editor of the Berkeley Tribe, go up to a young chick selling the BARB, and tell her not to sell the BARB. When I asked the chick what Jacobsen actually said, she replied, "Oh, I've heard a lot of ugly rumors..." and she reeled off a couple of

standard rumors.

Unfortunately, many people, having been brainwashed for 12 years in school, are conditioned to believe bullshit other than see the facts in front of them. Well here they are, folks, the facts right in front of you. This is the BARB, 16 pages of it, and there is nothing more to it than what you see. There are stories about atrocities in Navy brigades and articles on yoga. There is covering of fairs, festivals, city council meetings, and concerts. There are movie ads and diloo ads, clothing ads and music ads. There are pictures of naked ladies and pictures of renaissance dancers. Make what you will of it, but if a piece of paper moves you to hate, please take it out on the piece of paper.

An element of mystery has interjected itself into the upcoming rent strike; it seems that there are two, count 'em, two tenants' unions in Berkeley. One is the militant group which is organizing the much-publicized upcoming rent strike, based on the grievances listed below. The other came to light when a gentleman presented himself to the BARB on Tuesday saying that he was a member of a chartered organization called Berkeley Tenants' Union Inc.

The B.T.U. Inc., he said, was working on these problems through established legal channels and did not wish to be associated in any way whatsoever with the rent strike or the group called the Berkeley Tenants' Union which is organizing it. Did you follow that? Unfortunately, we have no further information on exactly what legal action is being taken by the B.T.U. Inc., and the promised phone call revealing that information has not, as of this writing, been received. A phone call to the Berkeley Neighborhood Legal Services office (legal advisors for B.T.U. Inc) revealed only that all information is considered privileged information of the client, and cannot be revealed without the client's authorization.

Meanwhile, back on the street, the militants are saying fuck the red tape and legal bullshit, let's do something NOW. To those ends they have called a meeting for tonight (Thur. Sept. 11, at 7:30 P.M., Longfellow School, Sacramento and Derby Sts.) of all interested parties to discuss grievances and determine action. Grievances documented thus far include:

Rent hikes of up to 30% are in progress all over Berkeley. The reason given for these hikes is the increase in property taxes, however in at least two researched cases (2535 McKinley, and 2430 Dwight Way) the extended income from the higher rents is considerably beyond that necessary to cover the tax increase.

To rent many apartments, you are required to sign a lease waiving certain rights accorded to renters by the California Civil Code, such as:

- The right to have the apartment in good repair when you move in.
- The right to have the apartment kept in good repair by the landlord.
- The right to make repairs yourself if the landlord refuses, and deduct the costs from your rent (up to one months rent).
- The right to move out of the apartment without liability if needed repairs are not made.

Other aggrieved leasing requirements are: paying the last months rent in advance along with a cleaning deposit which is rarely returned; and signing a morals clause which required you to agree, despite your wishes, not to have children, pets or friends living with you.

So...we have two separate groups working on the same problem from entirely different directions. Somebody ought to feel the pinch soon. As for B.T.U. Inc., if you're really accomplishing something on the establishment level, let's hear from you. Stand up and be counted!

## UNIVERSAL LIFE

Reports of the death of the Universal Life Church have been slightly exaggerated.

The ULC now has over 175,000 ministers and over 3500 branch churches scattered over the free world. It is incorporated and recognized in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and several foreign countries. The several hundred marriages performed by ULC ministers have been unchallenged. Many ULC ministers have received Draft deferments.

Kirby J. Hensley, founder and President of the ULC, has not spent one second in jail. He was

served an injunction by the California State Attorney General to cease and desist awarding honorary Doctorates of Divinity. This rather clumsy attempt by the established churches is being fought successfully through the courts.

The ULC was carefully designed to be legally airtight. Despite pressure from several sides; it is alive and growing! We expect to have over one million ministers by December, 1970!

We will still ordain anyone, for life, without question of sex, race or religious beliefs, for free

(though it would be nice to have donations--the mailing costs are driving us crazy!).

A convention of the Diocese of Berkeley will be held late in October. Further reports will be forthcoming.

# GAMES CITIES PLAY

The Berkeley City Council had a large agenda last night (Wednesday), and they were worried that they wouldn't finish all the business by 12:00 midnight. They were so worried about the lack of time that they spent most of the time worrying about it, rearranging the agenda, and debating among themselves who should say what, when, and for how long.

In fact most of the meeting was a constant hassle over the ways of the council. The political machinery that was supposed to expedite the council's workings seemed more like a cart in front of a horse. The meeting was strung in five minute intervals from Acting Mayor Bernice May timidly knocking her gavel, to exchanges over points of order, to consulting the city attorney over technical legalities, to asking the city clerk to give an account of herself.

The city council is a pot pourri of drama. At times it is like a situation comedy, at its slower moments it is theatre of the absurd, when things jazz up it is tragic-comedy, and even when the council members just sit and listen to the City Manager's reports its like they are all wearing ancient Greek exaggerated actor's masks.

The highlights of the meeting were item number 2, the City Manager's Report on the Telegraph Avenue Litter Problem, item number 9, the City Manager's report on the Status of the Model Cities Election, and Michael Miller's address to the city council regarding the Police Contingency Plans of Assault on the Black Panther National Headquarter. Councilwoman May's Ad Hoc Rental Housing Committee Proposal.

It seemed that the litter problem on Telegraph Avenue was that the City's contract with GIG to clean off the sidewalks of Telegraph Avenue was dissolved a month or two ago when GIG folded. There then followed a two month period when no one cleaned the sidewalks. As of last Thursday however, William Hanley, the City Manager reported, NOW (New Opportunities for Workers) was now doing the job diligently and effectively.

When City Manager Hanley finished his report on the note of a job well done, Councilman DeBonis spoke up, and said that the way to eliminate the litter problem was "to eliminate the litterers", those "panhandlers" and "tramps and bums with packs on their backs." That would eliminate the problem of that "filthy hog-pen." The solution, Councilman DeBonis argued, was to enforce the law, and issue citations to those who littered and broke other city ordinances. "Let them call it harassment," he said, "but harass them and harass them and harass them." What the "bums" called harassment, he called "enforcing the law."

In conclusion he exhorted, "Get rid of those pigs . . . (laughter from the audience) . . . I mean people."

Admittedly, Councilman DeBonis is the one who makes the council meetings worth going to. He is a decent, God-fearing, law-abiding, red-blooded American, and it blows his mind when anyone with hair over 2 inches addresses the council and says something else besides "Where is the money coming from to pay for such and such?"

He throws his pencil for more distance during a council meeting than Y.A. Tittle threw a football in a season. He squirms around and makes faces like he is about to pee in his pants. He can hardly contain himself even when there is dead silence in the council chambers, and besides his pencil yardage, he must have the all time record for being the lone dissenting vote. You can't help but like the cat.

City Manager Hanley replied to Councilman DeBonis's solution to the litter problem by saying that the litter problem had been eliminated by picking up the litter. He was dubious about the use of heavy harassment, saying that heavy

harassment was used in the Haight Ashbury, and only deteriorated conditions there. Councilman DeBonis countered by saying that what had happened was that all the hippies moved from the Haight to the Avenue, and that Berkeley should now send them back. As much as he is American, Councilman DeBonis is a Berkeleyan, and expresses a single-minded devotion to Berkeley irregardless of the rest of the world.

Councilman Price joined in the discussion, expressing concern over panhandling. He reported that one older woman was approached five times while shopping on the Avenue for spare change. He made the enlightened suggestion that the city should set certain standards of conduct and that everyone should abide by the rules of the majority. Which is, after all, the Democratic way. Enforce the laws, Councilman Price suggested, or change them. But he offered no laws nor changes. Thus item number 2 on the agenda bit the dust.

Meanwhile, back in the ghetto, the Model Cities Election was discussed. Back-slapping was in order for the large turn-out in voter registration. A few workers on the election complained about 300 people not being notified in time to register, and the council apologized saying nothing could be done. The City Clerk Edythe Campbell stated that she was doing everything physically possible to register as many people as possible, but that the people who received late notices just would not be able to register.

There was also the problem of registration being cut off at 5:00 pm, thus excluding many workers from registering, and after much confusion it was established that the poll booths for election would not close until 7:00 PM, as all other elections did. Besides, the election was to take place on Saturday, so the workers' problem didn't exist.

Trying to head off disaster at the pass came Councilwoman May's proposal of an Ad Hoc Rental Housing Committee. Everyone present was in favor of such a committee, but disagreed as to its nature.

The citizens who addressed the Council on the matter all tried to impress the sense of urgency of the situation, and the need for immediate action. The citizens who spoke wanted a committee with balls, that could actually accomplish something, and not study the problem for six years.

A Mrs. Slaughter ended her talk on the subject by suggesting that the University should share in the housing problem, since it was the students who created the shortage. She did not support a committee with no money and no power, because she didn't want to wait for "the Sheriffs and National Guard to face reality."

Councilman DeBonis had smelled this statement coming, and he started to talk about not backing down to threats and coercion. When Frank Darr of the Berkeley Coalition came up to speak, DeBonis knew what he was up against.

Darr talked about "far too little, too late." He talked about the broad emotional appeal a rent strike held for a large number of people in the community, but he wanted to avoid another "disruption." He wanted the Sheriff's Department left out of the matter, and was worried what would happen in the case of a rent strike and mass evictions. He hoped that the Council would take immediate action and do something to the point.

Councilman DeBonis launched into his thing about "having backbone" and standing up to these "threats", and how this country was built upon free enterprise, and how pecking away at free enterprise would bring the ruin of us all, and turn the USA into a China, Russia, or Cuba. He talked about having the right to rent to whom-ever he wanted, and how landlords had to pay \$500 or \$600 to "get the place back in shape" after one of those long-haired weirdos moved out. He said that the rent gougers were the young people who cut

their hair short, rented an apartment, and let their hair grow again, meanwhile subletting to 4 or 5 other long-haired weirdos.

Someone brought up the point that a number of short-haired weirdos had complaints about sky-rocketing rents, non-maintenance, and unfair leases, and Councilman McClaren said that even if young people were the real culprits, a thorough investigation would still provide the solution to the problem.

This intramural moderation didn't go over big with the people who wanted something DONE NOW. The Council decided that first they would choose the committee, and then let the people talk to it about the situation. Councilman Swingle said that he had talked to over 250 people from all involved parties, and that each group had nominated their own representative to the committee.

There was some confusion about not having "over 11 people" on the committee meant, and when it would meet. Councilman Swingle carefully worded his motion for the committee as a resolution so that immediate action could be taken by the committee, and after 10 minutes discussion about how soon the committee could start operating, it was brought to light that Councilman Swingle had carefully worded his motion in the form of a resolution so that the committee could take immediate action. Seeing that the committee could take immediate action, the council took no further action on the problem of rental housing.

The piece de resistance of the evening came when Michael Miller addressed the Council about the Police Contingency Plans to raid Panther Headquarters. He read from a prepared statement, and had begun his second sentence when chaos broke loose in the Council.

"The Berkeley Police have prepared contingency plans for an attack on the headquarters of the Black Panther Party," Miller read, "These plans are brutal and vicious and . . ." by which time Councilmen DeBonis and McClaren were hanging on to their microphones like Frank Sinatra on speed shouting him down. There was a few minutes spent deciding "points of order". Councilwoman May valiantly trying to get out of her dilemma with her most sugary recitation of Robert's Rules of Order. Mrs. May and Mr. DeBonis together really would have made it in vaudeville. They make Gracie Allen and George Burns look like Air Force recruiters. Mrs. May is the archetypal Aunt Bea (from Andy Griffith), and Mr. DeBonis is a militant Mr. Magoo.

The battle raged back and forth, Miller reading a little from his statement, Councilmen interrupting and Councilwoman May trying to figure a way out. Councilman DeBonis raised a point of contention when Miller started talking about the international industrialists meeting in San Francisco. DeBonis stated that Miller should limit his remarks to the Berkeley situation. Miller said that he was talking about the Berkeley situation. Councilwoman May finally established his right to speak and Miller started up again, only to be violently contested by George Jacks. Berkeley's own bi-blond cowboy, a cross between a dissipated Gorgeous George and Dale Evans. Mrs. May warned George that he'd better be quiet or be removed, but George couldn't stand to hear the "degenerate, commie, filthy, dirty, perverted, punk, etc. etc." so he left screaming down the hall.

Miller finished his statement denouncing the repression of the Panthers with a list of five demands: 1) that the list of 40 organizations and the police plans for those organizations be made public, 2) that the city council pass a resolution in opposition to these plans, in opposition to the general harassment of the Panthers, and guaranteeing the destruction of all such plans, 3) that the city council make a public apology to the Black Panther Party, 4) that the city council pass a resolution

and there is no health in us.

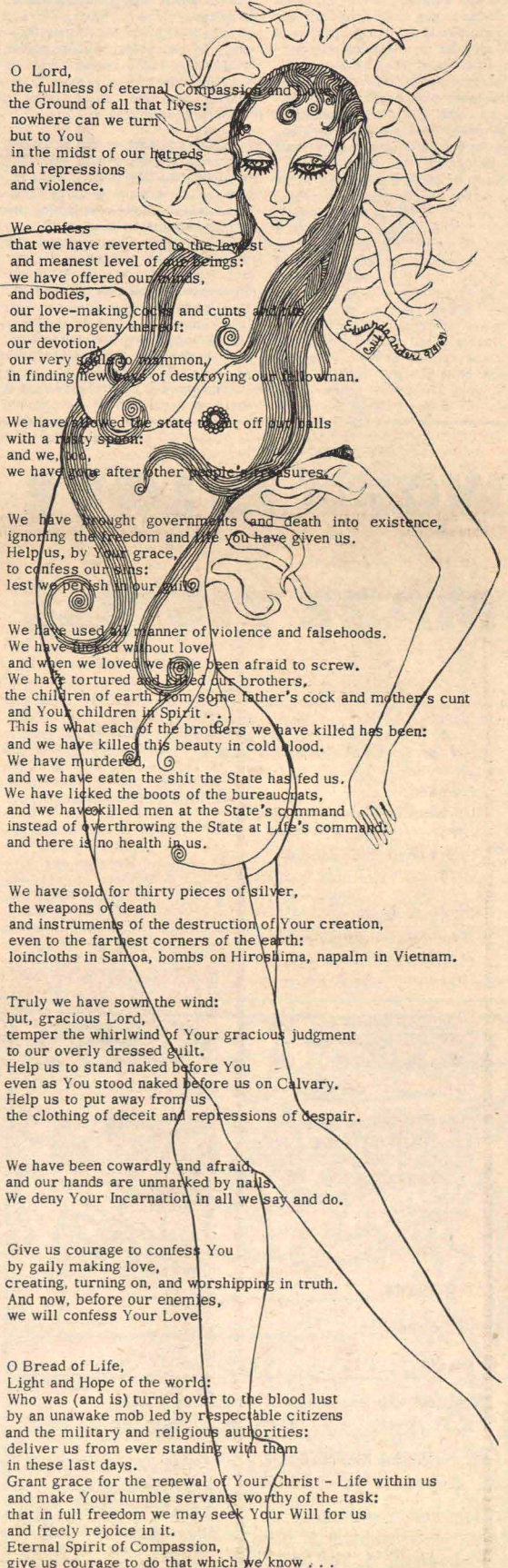
We have sold for thirty pieces of silver,

# BRIG BRUTALITY BAN

A temporary restraining order prohibiting the Marine guards at the 'Nava' Correctional Center at Treasure Island from beating their prisoners has finally been issued. U.S. District Judge William Sweigert handed down the order after 15 enlisted men filed suit against the guards for the acts of brutality they endured at the guards hands. The order prohibits the guards from "assaulting plaintiffs and others in the brig in any manner whatsoever or by intimidating them by threats of violence."

The fifteen men who filed suit ranged in age from 19 to 21, and most were in the brig for Unauthorized Absence. This is not surprising since most of the men in any military prison are young men who went UA or AWOL. Most of the rest are in on dope charges.

Traditionally, it is the men gone UA and the homosexuals who suffer the most from the guards. Homosexuals threaten the guards' with their own homosexual leanings. The UA's are considered real scum, being anti-American, e.g. being anti-Navy, or at least not being 100% Pro-Navy.

Navy brigs are supposed to be the worst of all types of prisons, worse than army or civilian prisons. The guards are Marine Vietnam returnees for the most part, and they generally consider it shitty duty. Guards are supposed to be sent to a psychiatrist after six months to make sure they are not total animals by then.

The Navy had no comment on the charges, which is not surprising since the officers do not know what goes on in their brigs. They come to their office in the morn-

ing and leave in the afternoon, and the guards run things the way they see fit.

The way the guards see fit is to beat prisoners, harrass them, threaten them, and play sadistic games with them. One of the men filing suit described the time he was "beaten by a Marine guard... he took me into a room, where no one except one other Marine watched me get beaten up ... I was kicked repeatedly and savagely in the stomach and ribs..."

One other prisoner described the time he had taken an overdose of tranquilizers in an attempted suicide. He was taken to the dispensary and then put in the brig still reeling under the drug. "The guards made me pretend I was an airplane. I was forced to run around the confinement area, flapping my arms and making noises while they stood on each side of me and hit me with their fists, stating that they were trying to 'shoot me out of the sky.'"

These are not isolated incidents, but isolated reports of everyday occurrences. Terrorism, brutality, and sadism are the norm at Treasure Island. This restraining order is a start to clean up the situation. Things may improve for a few weeks, or even months. But without Naval officers more interested in even Naval "justice" than getting home to mama, their white house, and their sailboat, and periodic surprise inspections, and a channel of communication to unbiased ears for the prisoners, conditions will deteriorate back to their present level, or worse.

# HOMOSEXUAL RIGHTS

At 7:15 pm yesterday, September 3, 1969 history was made in the annals of American scholarly and professional societies when the annual business meeting of the American Sociological Association meeting at the Hilton Hotel in San Francisco adopted the first resolution on the rights of Homosexuals and other Sexual Minorities ever adopted by such a body. The resolution, which was presented to the business meeting for vote with the endorsement of the Sociology Liberation Movement and the Ad-Hoc Committee for Homosexual Rights of the S.L.M., was presented by the most Reverend Micheal A. F. Itkin, Ph.D. Dr. Itkin is Bishop of the Evangelical Catholic Communion and Fellow of the Society for Social Psychology.

The resolution, in the form adopted, follows:

"Whereas members of the homosexual minority constitute an oppressed people in academic as well as non-academic environs, insofar as when their sexual preferences are discovered by university officials, faculty and students suffer economic reprisals by the loss of tenure, jobs, scholarships, etc, as well as suffering other reprisals in the form of arrests, blacklisting and other forms of intimidation; and

Whereas these reprisals constitute direct oppression of this minority group and violate all rights -- professional, academic and human -- and freedoms;

Be it resolved that the American Sociological Association condemns the firing, taking economic sanctions and other oppressive action against any persons for reasons of sexual preference."

Dr. Itkin's statement in presenting the resolution to the ASA business meeting follows:

"The invisible minority in our midst" -- thus one homosexual describes the 15 - 17,000,000 citizens in our society who are homosexual, most of whom are invisible, i.e. pretending to be heterosexual because of the fear of economic reprisals, social sanctions and harassment at the hands of the establishment. Dr. C. A. Tripp, speaking at the Continuing Education in Medicine Symposium at the University of California, March 1965, estimated the approximately 4% of the men in the United States, and about a third as many of the women, are exclusively homosexual during their entire lives, but that more than twice this many persons, some 10% minimum of the population, are exclusively homosexual for at least three years and that not less than one-fourth of the population engages in more than incidental homosexual behaviour during such a three-year or extended period.

"The question of homosexuality cannot, for social scientists, be divorced from the multi-valenced questions of human sexuality in general and the oppression of other minority groups. It is important to look at attitudes and concepts regarding homosexuality in the larger framework of the societal role of women and men, the role of women as an oppressed group, and the cultural oppression of all

other, disadvantaged groups from within the perspectives of our various disciplines as social scientists.

"For too long we have accepted, and indeed encouraged, the poorly authenticated studies and misdirected inquiries of sociologists and others who argue that homosexual and other sexual minorities are 'deviant', 'aberrant', and by implication, sick, weak or evil. Only a few people in the social sciences have found more rational grounds for investigation and discourse, and they are seldom heard.

"We are all aware of the many professors and teachers who have lost tenure, been given terminal contracts and fired, or refused hiring in the first place, and suffer other economic reprisals; and students that have lost scholarships and faced expulsion when their sexual preferences have become known. In addition, the general oppressive nature of the ruling class in regard to sexual minorities becomes increasingly apparent even as a militant civil rights movement among homosexuals begins to develop.

"In the San Francisco - Bay Area alone: in the last several months, one homosexual was shot to death by the police in a so-called 'vice' entrapment situation in a park in Berkeley. Another man, a Black professor (who, it so happened, was heterosexual) was so badly beaten by the police when they 'suspected' him of being homosexual, that he afterwards died of a heart attack.

"Examples of a newly militant consciousness on the part of the homosexual community also come to mind, however. In New York City homosexuals finally raised the banner on 'gay-power' in a near-riot situation that freed a gay bar and has virtually brought to a temporary halt police raids of gathering places. In San Francisco the militant Committee for Homosexual Freedom has conducted a successful, non-violent demonstration that caused the re-hiring of a fired homosexual blue-collar worker and the guarantee by the company to end discriminatory hiring practices. Throughout the country the homosexual and other sexual minorities are finally organizing and demanding an end to repressive laws and to the bourgeois-liberal establishment pseudo-scholarship of sociologists and other social-scientists. This protest is revolutionary and not merely in the interests of this oppressed group; for the pseudo-scholarship already referred to, in the hands of the oppressive ruling class, undergirds and gives strength to authoritarian bureaucratic structures seeking scapegoats by cries of 'immorality, vice, sickness, deviance' in an effort to detract public attention from the pressing societal ills of our time: neo-colonial oppression at home and imperialism abroad.

"It is well past time that we own up to our irresponsible neglect as social scientists and attempt to understand the homosexual and other sexual minorities in the light of a social concern for the right of free choice of all persons and an end to cultural oppression. This will require a willingness to suspend past 'scientific' prejudices, judgements and attitudes which most sociologists and laymen alike have held, a willingness to share new insights with others, and the courage to join in the on-going struggle for a society transformed by the struggle for the freedom and rights of all persons."

After the presentation, the resolution was passed by an overwhelming majority of the membership of the business meeting of the American Sociological Association, and thus constituted the first time in the history of American scholarship that such a professional association has taken a stand in favour of homosexual rights and the right of all persons to freedom of choice in sexual matters.

## People's Festival

No one is calling a People's Festival, so everyone is. Peter Ashe of the Park Commission denied the Festival a permit last Tuesday, after he had given verbal agreement to let it be held at Mission Delores Park.

This is an old and universal tactic employed by governments to avoid embarrassing situations for visiting or meeting big-wigs. It is also a violation of the 1st Amendment, but then the ordinance that requires permits for use of public property is unconstitutional to begin with.

At any rate, there will be a People's Festival, of, by, and for the people who make it. Everyone is called to bring his thing and celebrate. There will be free food, but everyone is asked to bring their own too. P. A. systems are taboo, but celebrations in the past have been able to do without them.

What is wanted in people, all kinds, from every community. Musical and theatrical groups, craftsmen, artists, and all manner of celebrants, filled with the spirit of life, are called to celebrate the fact of their existence.

The only cautionary note is to not linger when the festival breaks up, a favorite time for the cops to vamp. The Festival is to take place Saturday and Sunday, September 13 & 14, in the Panhandle, Golden Gate Park, San Francisco, from 11:00 AM on.

Now is the time for all good men to come to the...People's Festival.



# FOUR WEEKS IN THE MUSHROOM MOUNTAINS

I have just returned to Mexico City, weak with aemicob disentary, after living for a month in Pointe de Fierro, a small town in the state of Oaxaca, Mex., where heads come from all parts of the world to eat the psylosibin mushrooms which grow there.

Pointe de Fierro is a small community of about six families situated along the beautiful crystal Zapu River which flows through the tropical orchid covered hardwood forests of that mountain area. The town acts as a center where the Mazateca Indians sell their coffee. Corn is also grown in this region, but mostly for domestic consumption.

A new source of income for the Indians, which has developed into "big business" in the last few years, is the sale of the psylosibin mushrooms which grow only in that area. Every morning the Indians bring mushrooms from the steep mountain jungles into the small towns where Mexican, American and Canadian heads come to stay in small inexpensive houses for a few days and eat the mushrooms.

The mushrooms are wrapped in banana leaves to keep them from drying out and they sell for about 50 cents a trip, the price varying depending upon the type of the mushrooms, their freshness, and one's ability to bargain in Spanish. Spanish is spoken only as a trade language by the Indian, Mazatec is used as the common tongue at other times.

We arrived at Pointe de Fierro in the early morning after a four hour bus ride along the unpaved road from Teotitlan. Mexican hippies at Pointe showed us how to distinguish between the different kinds of mushrooms and how to choose the best ones. Looking at mushrooms is a great pastime of both Indians and hippies alike. Even the oldest Indians who have been eating mushrooms since they were children rarely fail to walk across the road for a small peek while a transaction is in progress.

In this area two varieties of mushrooms are most popular, the derumbes and the pajaritos. The derumbes look like sturdy little penises with white stems and dark brown heads. Their size can vary from an inch long to four or five inches. The entire plant is eaten, head, stem, and root as well as the rich black dirt surrounding the root. Good fresh mushrooms smell and taste very metallic as if there were extra electricity inside of them.

The pajaritos are more fragile than the derumbes and have a more traditional umbrella shape. When fresh they are a light tan color with streaks of purple in the heads. After being picked, both varieties become darker in color and in up to three days the metallic aroma and taste vanish as the psylosibin decomposes. I have been told that the mushrooms have been preserved much longer by keeping them submerged in honey.

We rented a house for the first time for fifty cents, and bought our mushrooms from a man who later we learned was one of the "Maestros" of that town. That evening I ate my first mushroom, and discovered some of the secrets that

Lewis Carrol must have found when he visited those mountains before he wrote the eternal question asked to Alice by the Caterpillar with the hooks . . . "Who are you?"

My trip that evening was one of adventurous joy as I wandered along the river -- the living mark of beauty and fantasy of the area.

That evening I evaluated my life as having been a happy one and I knew that I would have to spend more time in the woods hiking and camping as I had done so regularly and with so much pleasure in my boyhood. I also saw how I had abandoned some important questions of life style during the time when I had sacrificed some of my humanity for the false prize of educational security. I saw also that first night, how the beauty and fascination of nature, which I love so much, had been obscured while studying physics many years ago in the grindmill atmosphere of the university.

Thinking became such a clear process, as natural and beautiful as running like a deer across the field when you can feel the strength of your body lifting its weight gracefully into the air. It's not a feeling as being high as much as totally spaced. Going up is smooth, and coming down never really happens. You keep bouncing or skimming freely a few inches above your starting point.

Three days later, I moved into a large house high in the mountains with a group of Mexican and Indian heads. Actually we had two houses. One was a dormitory and the other was a cooking house where the girls always kept a large pot of rice or beans on the fire. The guys gathered the wood.

The house had been rented for \$2.50 for the month from the Indian wholived with his wife and several children a little farther up the mountain. One night the man who owned the house took mushrooms with his family. It was evident that a family that had the advantages of taking mushrooms together knows a unity that has long been lost from city society, USA.

Mexican heads are on a Jesus Christ Trip. Taking mushrooms represents the death and rebirth. There were many religious books in our house on the life and teachings of Jesus Christ. There were also a few volumes of Eastern philosophy as well as a copy of Island, Aldous Huxley's novel about a utopian society which was inspired by his trip to the mushroom mountains. Some of the Mexican heads did yoga, but not as many as in the States.

Some of the Mexican friends that I met aggressively fashioned their life styles after that of Christ. In the evenings we played cards, chess, read books by candlelight, and had many good conversations. Mushroom raps are much more serious than typical grass raps. Holiness fills the air of a room of twenty people who have eaten the mushrooms.

Every trip was different. Some were hard, some were easy, depending upon what my mind finally decided to think about and how comfortable I felt in dealing with the subject. The round areas were the ones that dealt with the most ignored thoughts in my everyday life. The reward of these rough spots of course was the great pro-

gress made by the time the trip was over. The heavy part of the trip lasts about six hours, but you can easily extend the time with concentration or taking more mushrooms.

While in that area of Mexico I ran into the police only twice. On both occasions they were in the country illegally. In a brief conversation with one of the police officials, I was told that they didn't foreigners buying the mushrooms - although it wasn't illegal for them to do so.

During the year it rains in the mountains almost every day for at least a few hours, but during my last week, in early July, the heavy rainy season began and the precipitation never stopped. The river became a raging slimy serpent and we decided to return to Mexico City.

The people who took the mushrooms knew that they would some day return to those mountains so that they could bring the people they loved with them to share the same rewarding experience.

# YOU, ME, AND THE LAW

This is the second in a series of head trips, the result of which, I hope, will be to make us THINK. Humanity as a mass, has a bad habit of reacting, rather than acting. When the right buttons are pushed, we fly off in a given direction with little or no understanding of the forces that are driving us, or what the end result of that trip may be. The things that I am putting forth are not really revolutionary, they are pretty obvious when the situation is given any objective thought. What would be revolutionary is some objective thought given to them by the entire populace of our country. And so, toward The Revolution:

Let's start at the bottom, with the butt of humanity, the man charged with enforcing the unenforceable; the man who spends his whole life pulling his pud because he can't get no satisfaction; the man who devotes his whole life to castration; the castrated, I mean your buddy and mine, your friendly local flatfoot, The Man.

I prefer not to call cops "pigs", because the few good ones I've met in my life don't deserve the comparison, and the pigs (animals) don't deserve comparison to a bad cop. Further, the term "pig" is an obfuscation, an attempt on the part of our own leaders to cloud fact with an emotional issue; a favorite ploy common to the leadership syndrome.

The contention that the present police attitude is extremely dangerous to our society is unquestionably valid, but the fact remains: given the human animal in his present mental and emotional state, the police are a necessary, even desirable part of our society. What is UNnecessary, and UNdesirable is that they should control that society rather than protect it.

That cat that has an emotional orgasm all over your head, is the frustrated product of a frustrated society. Throwing sticks and bottles at him is NOT going to change that society. It IS, however, going to make him that much happier when he's turned loose on your head.

It has become a fad at big demonstrations to tease the cops and turn some of the demonstrators into fodder for the Police Brutality issue. It makes about as much sense as teasing a piranha with your finger. The monster on the other end of that three foot long club sticking out of your stomach is just as frustrated as you are man, probably more.

And he has all the weapons, and The Law's on his side; getting someone's head split open does not make a revolution. It's one thing to prove a point, but the assembly line production of unwilling martyrs smacks of Reaganism in the first degree. It's the mark of extreme frustration gratifying itself.

Our entire society has turned itself into a eunuch and has turned to mental masturbation as its only source of release. Our entire society has castrated itself with

laws; and those laws are, in reality, Clark Kent, the mildmannered frustration of man's inability to communicate properly with his fellow man.

Somehow, somewhere, sometime, somebody in our lineage felt put-upon, so he went to The Wheel and pitched a bitch. The Wheel, seeing that he had a legit complaint said "O.K. Nobody better never do that to nobody else no more." And Law was born.

Meanwhile, out in radioland, that cat that first did the deed to our hero, decided that all those negatives cancelled each other out, and he could actually do the same thing to somebody else and The Wheel couldn't touch him. And lawyers were born.

The next thing we know, there were so many people doing it to each other in so many different ways, that The Wheel had to make some more laws and get a couple of the boys to help him enforce them. And police were born.

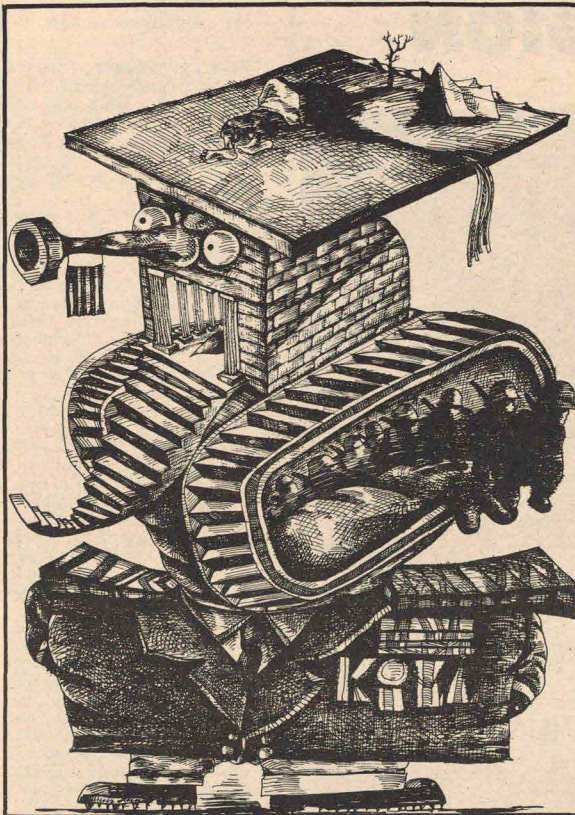
But since everybody was doing it to everybody else, and they all made conflicting claims, The Wheel had to sit and listen to both sides to determine which actually did it to whom, and how to handle the offenders of the laws he had put down. And judges were born.

Well, before you can say MAX-RAFFERTY IS AN ANA LRE-TENTIVE, The Wheel had to put some more of the boys on the force, hire a couple of cats with cool enough heads to listen to the conflicting claims and make decisions, and hire a bunch more to make new laws as fast as people found new ways around the old ones. And a legislature and a legal system were born.

Pretty soon some people discovered that by being in the group that makes the laws, they had almost as much power as The Wheel himself, and they started competing for those positions. And politicians were born. Before long, the boys were so numerous that The Wheel had to set up an organization of small wheels to handle them. And the small wheels observed that they had almost as much power as The Wheel himself, since they had the responsibility of enforcing his power. And power structure was born.

And The Wheel looked at what he had done and saw that it was bad, for he had given away a lot of his power, and not only were his people still squabbling among each other, but he had created a whole new group of squabblers over the power that he had delegated out. Still, he couldn't stop things anywhere, because if he tried, there would be no one to protect his power, as his power was now dependent upon the enforcement of all the laws he had made.

Anyhow, thus we see the rudimentary structures and entanglements of our own system of government. We have a legal structure and a power structure, each protecting, feeding, and thriving upon the other. The logical result of such a dualistic system is that, in time, they should merge, creating, if not openly, then at least



in essence, a single power unit which is self-protecting and self-perpetuating.

The drafters of our constitution were intelligent and thoughtful men. They foresaw this very complication and tried to cope with it through the division of power, long term appointive judgeships, and the Bill of Rights.

The mobilization of the entire structure as a unit would only take place if the entire structure itself was threatened. This, they felt, was an appropriate compromise between individual liberty, and the necessary ability of a government to protect itself under attack. What they failed to consider, however, was the general apathy of the American public in protecting those rights accorded to it. The inevitable result has been the passage and enforcement of any number of unconstitutional laws on local levels, and a general snowballing of the entire legal-power structure.

As the structure has snowballed, so has resistance, but now that resistance is interpreted as an attack on the structure itself, we are witnessing the planned mobilization of the structure as a unit to protect itself. As I said, WE the public bear the burden of responsibility for this situation.

We have allowed ourselves to be politically stampeded into a frenzy of tacit acceptance of law upon law upon law, governing our own personal existence, while huge businesses run rampant, comparatively unfettered over our land, our economics, and our very lives.

talked into a kind of bankruptcy of the imagination, where by our answer to every new social challenge is to pass a law against it, thereby obliterating all possible means of social control of the situation, and adding one more bullet to the gun that the power machine holds at our collective head.

We have allowed ourselves to be conned into looking at law as a kind of magic wand, which, when waved, will make all our troubles disappear-POOF! You're a mated.

The depth of the brainwash job that has been done upon us is almost unbelievable. We have more law and less order in this country than ever before, and yet there is still a highly organized bunch of nitwits among us who equate the two as synonymous, and cry for more. The power structure is more than happy to oblige. Good old Mr. Average Man, Mr. J.Q. Public (that's us, you and me, as well as them) cannot get through an entire day without making a criminal of himself several times over, and still we beg for more!

One of history's more obvious lessons is that you cannot legislate morality (using morality in the Popular sense). But why the hell should we, The Great American Public, be shackled by the dictate of history? We have the Magic Wand. (Boing your magic boinger, Froggy) Prostitution-POOF! Gambling - POOF! Drugs --POOF! Look Ma . . . no problems.

A kid spends his whole youth watching grown-ups pick and choose which laws they'll obey and which ones they'll break, and when he decides to do the same . . . he's a victim of the violence on television. Well . . . Let's pass a law POOF! No violence on Television, no juvenile crime.

Simple isn't it? Shit if those idiots had thought of this a few thousand years ago we wouldn't have all the problems we have today. Kids smoking grass? Easy, put 'em in jail for five years in-

stead of one . . . that'll teach the little bastards. Never did stuff like that when I was a kid. Prohibition? Aw well, that was different . . . stupid law. . . everybody knows a little nip now and then ain't gonna hurt nobody.

And so it goes, generation after generation, the kids grow up and become just as stupid as their parents. It has to stop somewhere or we will achieve the dubious distinction of being the first free society in history to legislate ourselves into slavery. Revolution? If you think you're going to take any thing away from the power structure in this country by force, baby, you'd better sit back down at the drawing board and check your figures again. . .

If we're ever going to achieve a revolution in this country and have anything left when it's over, we're going to have to start with a social revolution; a willingness of people to work and live together without the chains of law to keep us from tearing each other apart. And the removal of power from the power structure is going to have to be just as insidious as their takeover was. How? Start by writing letters, lots of them, every time the politicians try to pass or extend the limits of a law which impinges on personal freedom.

Such laws are the chief tools of the power structure in weeding out anyone who would dare to disagree with it. It may sound silly and ineffectual to write letters, but they do make a difference in terms of his own personal power that the man opposing him feels generally the same as he does. His personal power is dependent upon our votes. If he sees a real threat of losing too many votes by any particular action or inaction, he will definitely be moved.

Another point of attack which is sorely needed is a movement to erase all unconstitutional laws from the books. These number in the thousands on local levels, and are rarely contested because they are normally enforced against people without the means to carry them to the supreme court. Such a movement would probably have to be spearheaded by a lawyer, but somewhere there must be a good lawyer who is not so hung up on propagating his own income that he cannot see the writing on the wall.

It's a mistake to think that this has to be done on a national level to be effective; nationally we are still somewhat protected by our constitutional rights. The power structure is not yet strong enough to openly usurp the constitution. It is most important that we start cleaning house right down here on the local level where we have always been the most lax about our rights because we don't like our neighbor and a "that law will affect him, but won't bother me" attitude has always prevailed.

Ideally, we need only one basic law: No person shall, under any circumstances, exploit anyone or anything. If we define "exploitation" as value taken greater than value given, then we have covered the total area of necessary law, and it remains only to delineate degrees in exploitation. Criminals should be treated on the basis of what they are; mental aberrants of an anti-social nature, which is in many cases the result of being exploited. For thousands of years, society has treated the symptoms of it's sicknesses, while the diseases themselves have ravaged unchecked. A doctor who works on that level is guilty of malpractice, and society revokes his license. A society which operates on that level is guilty of no less, and in the end, will deal itself the same justice.

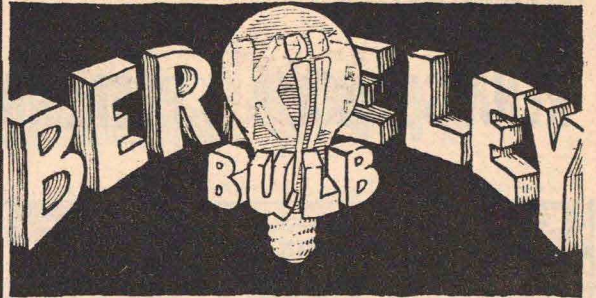

### JEALOUSY AND LOVE

Jealousy is a natural and very human feeling. There are three stages, or aspects to the development of the love impulse, including sexual feelings -- the IMPERSONAL, the PERSONAL, and the TRANSPERSONAL.

In the first stage, a person can enjoy affection, and even sex with lots of people -- because his own, and their personalities aren't yet fully differentiated. It's sort of a group psyche phenomenon. For example, when young children "play doctor" -- and experience the forbidden thrills of seeing and fondling each other's genitals -- they have little interest in the individual personalities of their co-conspirators. A penis is a penis; a vagina is a vagina. And these organs represent exciting glimpses into the realm of universal biological sexuality -- regardless of whose they are. It's just impersonal fun.

But, later on, as emotional development continues, a focusing process occurs -- and everybody is no longer equal to everybody else. One no longer experiences the same impersonal pleasure in fun-and-sex group games, or in the random sharing of affection. One person begins to be more fun to be with than all the rest. And certain conflicts -- both inner and outer -- also start to take place.

Love between two people is a painful, as well as a joyous, ecstatic experience. It's painful because it operates against the wish of the ego (the precious "ME") to be all-powerful and self-sufficient. In love, the "me" is actually incomplete without the other person. And the ego-centric "me" finds this very humiliating -- and fights against it in every way possible -- including subscribing to the conditioned mind's dictums that "Dependency is silly and childish", or that "Possessiveness is bad and neurotic" -- and all sorts of other superficial stereotypes.

Dependency and jealous (fear in the face of threatened loss of the love d one to somebody else) go right along with feelings of personal interest, affection, and desire. They, in themselves, are no problem. The real problem is what to DO with such feelings.

The worst thing is to try to suppress them. Then they come out in sneakier and more destructive ways -- like nagging at, or quarrelling with the partner over other, irrelevant things. Or, if you do succeed in suppressing such "uncomfortable" feelings altogether -- you'll find that your emotions of attraction and affection have also been suppressed and lost, right along with them. You can't have one set of feelings without the other -- and accept only the day without the dark.

The best way to deal with jealousy is to express it and share it with your partner. You can't successfully handle such powerful instinctive emotions all by yourself. The wish to do so is an example of the ego's old demand for self-sufficiency. It's embarrassing to have to admit openly that you're really hooked into a dependency involvement with someone else -- and need their help in coping with some of the painful passions that go with love. It always takes TWO people, though, to deal successfully with the storms of imagery and the cyclones of emotional energy released from the unconscious by the forces of love.

"But, I'd be scared to death to tell the person I'm interested in about such feelings. They'd think I was immature, and see that I was WEAK! Besides, they might feel they were being tied-down--that I was expecting them to COMMIT themselves!"

Yes -- the old mind-reading game! We react to a fantasy -- a mental anticipation of what we imagine the OTHER PERSON might think or feel -- instead of responding to what's inside of us.

It's true that the fancy word "commitment" has become a mental bugaboo these days. And if that word happens to pop into the other person's mind, he may have some trouble battling his way out of its clutches. But maybe you can help by pointing out that your own feelings of affection and jealousy are just FEELINGS--and have nothing at all to do with "promises" or abstractions like "commitment" or even images about what a "good relationship" is SUPPOSED to be.

The problem arises out of a confusion between the level of FEELING and the dimension of thoughts in the head. Ideas may come to mind like, "If you really love someone, then -- their feelings ought to be more important to you than your own--or, it should last forever -- or, it's your obligation to make the other person happy -- or, you ought to be able to TRUST the other person completely". And all sorts of other mental garbage -- conventional generalizations and philosophical theories -- that have nothing to do with feelings of love at all.

Love is simply love -- a movement within the heart and from the soul. Enjoy it -- without mind-reading the other person, or crystal balling the future. It's specific shape, color, or duration, and its ultimate meaning for a particular relationship can only be discovered by living it through, and by finding out for yourself what it moves you and the other person to do. It may

The Third Annual Renaissance Pleasure Faire and Ha' Penny Market is a conducive place to go to get stoned. The smell of the country, the non-mechanical sounds, and the idyllic setting provide the pleasure in the Pleasure Faire. The Faire is a Renaissance Market place, rustic booths set up by the crafts and trades-people themselves under a cover of oaks and laurels.

Way away from the beaten track, located near the Bay in the Wood in San Rafael, there are no sounds of 20th century civilization, and in the Faire there are no water fountains, electric lights, telephone poles, or P.A. systems. The only modern intrusion are the cameras some Faire-goers bring, and the equipment carried by the few Marin County Sheriffs keeping tabs on the place.

The Faire is ostensibly a money-making thing, put on by the Renaissance Centre to acquire land, build, grant scholarships, etc. all for the promoting of Renaissance culture. The Centre hopes to build a permanent Renaissance Village-Centre, with a Guildhall, Theatres, an Inn, Craft shops, classrooms, a research library, and a market.

There is a \$3 admission charge to the Faire, and once inside there is almost continuous entertainment in the form of Renaissance drama, music, dancing, games, and pageants. There is good food at reasonable prices. The Market is just that, a small village with craftsmen and tradespeople grouped together along the paths. There are jewelers, woodcarvers, potters, weavers, spinners, flag-makers, mapmakers, stained glass craftsmen, ironmongers, candle-makers, flower sellers, sellers of spices & herbs, alchemists, print-makers, foodmongers, leather-workers, wandering merchants, a gypsy, and an organ grinder.

The wares are all handmade and very nice, but it is sort of like Nephenthe revisited. Don't come looking for bargains, but it is nice to look.

To get to the Faire you can take either the Golden Gate or Richmond San Rafael Bridge, then take Highway 101 North to the San Rafael Civic Center exit, then go east on San Pedro Road, which you follow for quite a distance, making a horseshoe curving back up north along the Bay. There is a shuttle bus to carry Faire-goers who park in the southern parking lot to the Faire. The public is encouraged to come in Renaissance apparel. If it is hot where you live in the Bay Area, it will be hot at the Faire, so dress appropriately. The Faire runs every Saturday and Sunday from 11:00 AM to 6:30 PM through September.

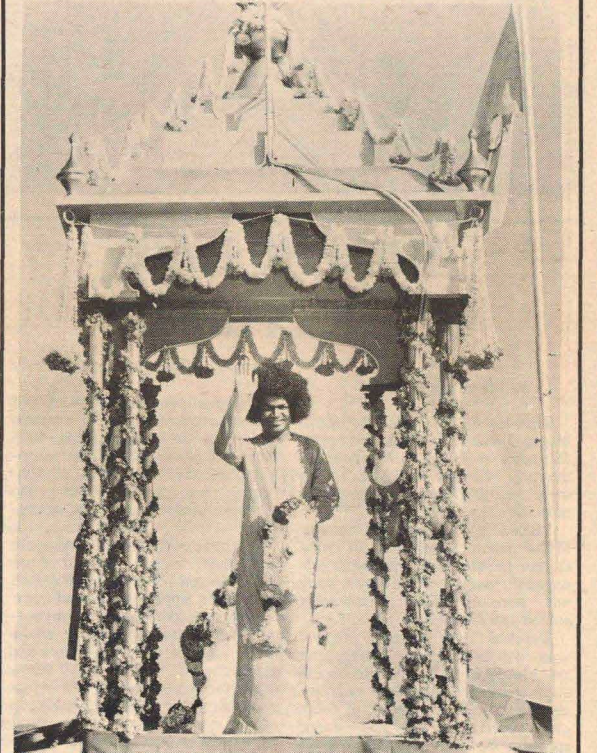

elderly lady yogi from Mexico told the story of Sai Baba. Sai Baba is a miracle-worker. He can create or destroy entire universes at will. This is an ability of any atma on the fourth plane, the fourth plane being one of seven planes of consciousness leading to god-consciousness. Jesus Christ, some have said, was based on the fourth plane: "if you have faith you can move the mountain to the sea". Sai Baba produces candies and cosmic dust from thin air and distributes them to his devotees. He also heals, produces gems, clothing and happiness. At Sai Baba's birth, it is said that tamboras played by themselves which freaked his parents good. They figured this was an omen that their son was possessed by evil spirits, and they consulted various doctors, priests, faith healers, and astrologers in search of a cure. But nothing stopped Sai Baba's growth into a wonder man. Sai Baba's first miracles consisted of writing plays and composing music at the age of seven. Then he began to fall unconscious and recite the text of Vedas. # YOGA AND ORGASM

The breathing practices of Yoga must be pursued with care. The individual is cautioned to proceed slowly and to never strain himself. With the induction of proper respiration the tensions in the muscles begin to dissolve, energy is freed, and plasmatic waves begin to flow over the organism. But for reasons already described the organism is likely to react to these pre-orgastic sensations with anxiety and redouble his armoring. This produces clonisms described both by Reich and in the literature on Yoga.

"In the armored human organism, the orgone energy is bound up in the chronic muscular spasms. After the loosening of the armor ring, the body orgone does not

is produced; in the middle stage the tremor of the body; and in the last stage, levitation in the air." (Sivananda)

"When what is called 'forced breathing' results in tremors, dizziness, numbness, tingling, etc., it is time to stop. . . ." (Wood)

"In Adhara perspiration is produced, in Madhyama tremor, and Uttama done for 100 times is said to result in levitation. . ." (Woodruffe)

Through the practice of Pranayama and meditation, the cells and tissues are vivified. They are charged with new Prana. New Pranic currents are generated. These give rise to jerks in the beginning. They will disappear soon." (Sivananda)

important centre of the nerves, connected with the sympathetic nervous system. . . . It plays a much more important part than is generally recognized. It takes an important part in the control of emotions and of various bodily functions. . . . It is one of the most vital parts of the body. . . . It is the store-house of Prana. It is the power-house. It is the most important of all the ADHARAS (supports) of the body that are sixteen in number. . . . The solar plexus is literally the sun of the nervous system. When this sun is shining harmoniously, the whole of the physical system is harmonious." (Sivananda)

It is through abdominal tensions that people control their emotions. By tensing the muscles in the abdomen, the breath is held. When

ganism, energy is created through the combustion of food-stuffs. In this process, heat and kinetic energy are created. Bio-electricity, also, is created in this process of combustion. If respiration is reduced, less oxygen is introduced; only as much as is needed for the maintenance of life. If a smaller amount of energy is created in the organism, the vegetated impulses are less intense and consequently easier to master. The inhibition of respiration, as it is found regularly in neurotics, has biologically speaking, the function of reducing the production of energy in the organism and thus of reducing the production of anxiety." (Reich)

Through holding the breath it is possible to control emotions. But when this practice has been continued over a long period, then

gic techniques, the individual feels for the first time repressed sensations of his own body which often rise into consciousness as visual phenomena, as in the psychedelic experience. The person afraid, who is not prepared for this phenomenon, frequently reacts with panic, redoubling his armoring. He believes he is going insane. Reich's patients frequently experienced such "psychotic episodes" with visual, auditory, tactile phenomena, etc. But what is being experienced is the microcosm of the human body, i.e., the subtle body or the cosmic tree. The Yogis use the experiences to gain knowledge and powers. Yet in most Yogic systems the practitioner is advised to ignore these phenomena and concentrate on bringing KUNDALINI all the way to the SAH-ASRARA CHAKRA. IN THE TIBETAN BOOK OF THE DEAD, used as a guide to the psychedelic experience, the practitioner is similarly told to ignore all "hallucinations" and to proceed toward the clear white light, toward total dissolution, total orgasm.

The similarities between Hatha and Laya Yoga and Reichian therapy are remarkable. Reich had obviously developed a theory of the human organism identical with that developed over thousands of years in the East. The point for point similarity between Yoga and Reichian therapy should indicate that the theories are true, for there is no way to account for the systematic similarities if we consider the techniques to be erroneous.

The techniques of Hatha and Laya Yoga and Reichian therapy all involve physical procedures. It is well known that Nirvana, or Satori, or whatever one chooses to call the dissolution of the psyche, can be achieved by techniques involving purely mental techniques as in Raja Yoga and Zen Buddhism. The physical and mental techniques are at first glance incommensurable. But once the relationships between the two are understood, the reason for them both reaching the same objective necessarily follows. As Reich always insisted, body and mind, psyche and soma, are one. The separation between them is a dualistic illusion.

The identity of psyche and soma is well known to the Yogi.

"It is part of the yoga psychology to say that ALL our ideas are accompanied by feelings and emotions, however slight. These in turn normally affect our breathing as a result of their calling for some action—such as flight or fight in the case of fear—but one of the aims of yoga practice is to stop this effect while sitting in meditation and to be able to control it at other times." (Wood)

"There is no RAJA (mind yoga) without HATHA (body yoga) . . ." (Wood)

"The practice of relaxing the muscles of the body will bring rest to the body and to the mind also. . . . Relaxation of the muscles reacts on the mind and brings repose to the mind. Relaxation of the mind brings rest to the body also.

"Body and mind are intimately connected. Body is a mold prepared by the mind for its enjoyment. (Enjoyment, in India connotes both the experiencing of pain and pleasure. A synonym might be the sensing, the experiencing of this world.)" (Sivananda)

Mind and body, character structure and character armoring are identical. If one is dissolved, the other is dissolved also. One can either work on the muscular armoring or the psychic (character) armoring. To integrate psyche is to integrate soma. While Reichian techniques are directed primarily toward the muscular armor, both Jungian and Freudian techniques are directed toward the character armoring. Because both the latter employ systems which utilize the universal archetypes of the psyche, albeit at different levels, they may both be equally successful or unsuccessful as the case may be.



immediately begin to stream freely. What appears at first is clonisms, together with pricking and crawling sensations. This indicates that the armoring is loosened and that energy becomes free. Genuine sensations of waves of plasmatic excitation do not appear until a number of armor segments have been dissolved, such as blocks in the musculature of the eyes, mouth, neck, and diaphragm.

"Then we can clearly see wavelike contractions in the loosened parts of the body, moving up towards the head and down toward the genitals. Very often, the organism reacts to these first streamings and convulsions with renewed armoring. Spasms of the deep throat musculature, reverse peristalsis of the esophagus, diaphragmatic tics and other phenomena clearly show the struggle going on between streaming impulse and armor block. Since more energy was liberated than the patient is able to discharge, and since there are still numerous spasms which prevent plasmatic streaming, acute anxiety develops. These manifestations confirm the orgonebiophysical concept of the antithesis of pleasure and anxiety." (Reich)

"In the early stage, perspiration

One of the main purposes of posture exercises in Yoga is to develop a sitting position in which one is perfectly relaxed, the spine straight, so that one can maintain equilibrium when the body begins to experience spasms in the initial stages of pranayama.

The yogi concentrates his life force, his PRANA, and controls it by yogic breathing. Reich devised a physical device called an orgone box to concentrate the orgone energy. The patient was to sit in that box and so absorb the concentrated orgone energy.

The major resistance to dissolution of tensions is centered in the muscular tensions of the solar plexus. This is recognized both in Reichian therapy and in Yoga.

"So important has the treatment of the abdominal tensions become in our work that today it seems incomprehensible to me how it was possible to bring about even partial cures in neuroses without knowing the symptomatology of the solar plexus." (Reich)

The emphasis in Yoga on the solar plexus is similar to that given by Reich.

"Solar plexus is often called the ABDOMINAL BRAIN. It is an

the breath is held emotions are suppressed.

"The way in which our children accomplish this "blocking off of sensations in the belly" by way of respiration and abdominal pressure is typical and universal. This technique of emotional control, a kind of universal Yoga method, is something which vegetotherapy has difficulty in combatting.

How can the mechanism of holding the breath suppress or eliminate affects? That was a question of decisive importance. For it had become clear that the inhibition of respiration was THE physiological mechanism of the suppression and regression of emotion, and consequently, THE BASIC MECHANISM OF THE NEUROSIS in general. Simple consideration said: The biological function of respiration is that of introducing oxygen and of eliminating carbon dioxide from the organism. The oxygen of the introduced air accomplishes the combustion of the digested food in the organism. Chemically speaking, combustion is everything that consists in the formation of compounds of body substance with oxygen. In combustion, energy is created. # STRIP THE RIPPERS...

A few days ago, while perusing some of the daily social vomit which goes under the general heading of news in this society, I came across an interesting letter in, of all places, The Berkeley Daily Gazette. I felt that the letter, written by R.A. Berman of Palo Alto, contained a suggestion of enough significance that it warranted some further dissemination, and maybe a better chance of being read by more of the people it was directed to than it would have, were it limited to the Gazette. To these ends:

R.A. BERMAN, 360 Cowper No. 2 Palo Alto, writes "to students and faculties of the universities":

To those of you who are groping for moral support from the outside community, and particularly to those of the silent majority deeply troubled by the present state of things and yearning for real change by non-violent means, I propose a truly revolutionary inter-departmental, inter-university project patterned after the Geo-Physical Year. The objective: To discover what the tax structure of the nation really is, and how it works, from top to bottom, federal, state, and local.

Don't be turned off by the seemingly dry outer shell. Try rapping on it and you will find out why taxation is equated with death as the foe of life. It has become the instrument of all instruments to destroy the possibility of existence without wars, poverty, and ignorance. Once you dig into it, you will discover that the results of this all-youth, all-university project could provide the leverage for alterations in the social order similar to the energy potentials in nuclear power. It needs to be carried out with the urgency of the Manhattan Project.

To begin with, you will find that the tax structure impinges directly on education at every level. At this moment, while elementary education in many school districts is deteriorating rapidly because of the tax bind, and ever-increasing property taxes are forcing many elderly homeowners out of their homesteads, or on to welfare rolls, Standard Oil Co. is offering educational material to public schools free of charge.

Slums stand on a mire of tax laws that make them profitable. The disproportionate cost of housing to low and middle-income families grows out of a tax system warped and bent out of all rationality and the ravaging of our environment is accelerated by tax bounties paid to 'developers' of land in the city and countryside.

The war machine is fed on taxes taken out of low and moderate income pockets and fattened by the special privileges it dictates to the tax-law writers -- from whom it claims obedience in return for having 'paid for' their election, with tax-exempt money.

Contempt for the institution of public law is built into present tax laws federal, state, and local, because they set a premium on avoidance, and a profit on deviousness.

Right now, while you are in the process of demonstrating to yourselves and to others that you have the moral courage to challenge the old order of things you can, by pooling your brainpower, do what never has been done, and what never will be done by the Congress, state legislatures, foundations, institutes, or associations. You can lay open the guts of the medieval monstrosity that is eating the heart out of the vast majority of the American people, and spewing over it death and the destruction of its beautiful dream.

Instead of trying to horn in on the old set-up, which will lead to nothing but another groove on the old record, organizing this new kind of student-faculty task force across departments and across the land could show the administrators and trustees -- and the public how everything that is good about the university can be put to use in the same kind of exciting learning-discovery way on the now-life-related subject of taxation as it is in the physical sciences.

Most universities should be able to participate in this project within their present systems and budgets. No outside sponsorship would be needed, or acceptable. Virtually every liberal arts-humanities department could participate: history, mathematics, philosophy, law, economics, political science, sociology, even English Lit., theology, and journalism.

The research materials are all unclassified -- reference works, public documents and records.

Junior, Senior and Graduate students and Faculty would work in teams and inter-Departmental groups. Some of the scientists who took part in the Geo-Physical Year might help with the planning and organization of the project, and other scientists may well advise on research method. It will be an enormously complex task, and the key to its success will lie in adapting to it the disciplined research methods of the physical sciences.

Brain-storming sessions starting now could sift ideas and shape plans for the various segments of the project to be done in each university, etc. I suggest a definite time limit of two years; otherwise the project's effectiveness will be vitiated. The spin-off will provide ideas and material for years of study and hundreds of dissertations.

You who want to participate in the decision making processes, here is a positive way to do it -- BUT NOT AN EASY one. You would be educating yourselves in the habit of research while learning how to read the fine print and unravel the skeins of wool and steel that have been wrapped around every tax package a gullible public has had strapped to its back century after century. You would be arming yourselves with the means of doing something constructively new when you vote and get into the legislatures.

Going to work on the tax system with a scalpel-equivalent computer-brainpower combination universities across the country means

a confrontation with the life source of the existing power structure, political-military-industrial, on a totally non-violent basis. But it will undoubtedly meet with much greater resistance than anything thrown at campus dissidents so far.

You will be told that it takes tax experts, lawyers, and experienced legislatures to understand tax laws. Rubbish --- the same old fable of the emperor's new clothes. Using your own eyes and brains, and computers now, before you too are caught up in the same sense-dulling routine of paying the price on the label without knowledge of the contents, you will find out that the jargon is a deliberate cover-up.

Revolution touched off by people over-burdened by taxes have accomplished little more than a change in the cast of characters because the peasants have never understood how the system works. Those who do, use the jargon to keep the trade secret, and keep the tax-paying public admiring and paying for the cloth that generally serves its makers more handsomely than it does those who buy it. Campus revolts will follow the same pattern unless and until you get to work on deciphering the old codes.

The parents of many of you are just as angry and feel just as frustrated by the established systems of taxation as you are by the war, the draft, and university inadequacies. You are both jabbing at different heads of the same dragon -- while it laughs at all of us on its way to many banks and executive suites. No speeches, leaflets, or demonstrations can prove

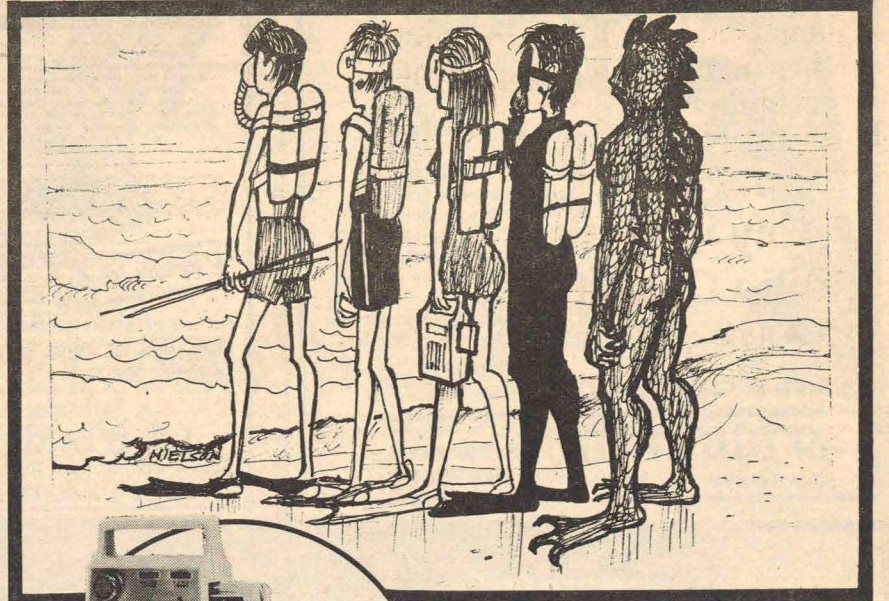
this, but the arithmetic can, and that can be produced only by a total, synchronized effort of the university communities searching in unison for the truth.

Grasping a new idea isn't as easy as sitting or rock-throwing and name-calling, but the excitement of it is far longer lasting. What is more, you will have support and understanding by the million-fold as soon as you start marching on all fronts against the tax dragon. Dragons have always been slain by a seemingly frail adversary armed with a small weapon. The combined force of student brainpower wielding the computer can slit the tax dragon wide open, and set us all free.

be long, it may be short, it may be wide, it may be narrow. But you can't decide this in advance with your head -- you'll only distort its natural development. So, stop trying.

There is such a thing as a transpersonal stage in the development of love (agape, caritas), in which feelings of caring and affection spread out more widely from the center of a two-some relationship. But the more genuine manifestations of this dimension evolve as a result of fully and deeply experiencing the problems as well as the pleasures of the personal realm. The stage of the personal can't be skipped over -- merely because it involves difficulties and discomfort.

Those who think they're at the transpersonal level -- but who

haven't yet been able to work out a satisfying personal relationship are usually only giving expression to amorphous, undifferentiated elements from the impersonal level.

If the fears that your partner will feel "tied down" or too "committed" by your interest and need for him or her -- are true -- that is, IF they are not yet ready to get really emotionally involved with you -- it's far better to find it out now. It's easier to deal with a real "rejection" (if that's what your mind chooses to call it) than to go on living in a world of fantasied hopes, bugged by imaginary demons of loss and despair. If the other person is not yet ready or able to be really "there" with you, you'll find that your own feelings will soon change -- and that your instincts will find someone else more suitable. It's usually the THOUGHTS in

our head that keep us tied to a relationship that's no longer really fulfilling -- ideas about FAILURE, and inadequacy, or fantasies of being alone and never again being able to find someone to love.

Take a chance! Share your feelings of jealousy with your partner. He or she might be having some of the same feelings that you are -- somewhere underneath. Men aren't really so different from women -- they like to feel needed and wanted, too. They can even feel pleased by a woman's jealousy.

But, expressing jealousy does NOT mean to scold, criticize, and bully the other person. A guy whose old lady seems to be getting too turned on by the flattering attention of another cat is NOT expressing his jealousy if he says to her, "You're making a damn fool out of yourself," or "The trouble with you is that you've got a neurotic need for attention -- like a spoiled brat," or "If you do that again, I'll knock your teeth in." NO -- he's hiding his real feelings to avoid exposing his inner fear and pain, by coming on strong and judgemental. And he's also not giving any expression at all to his underlying feelings of desire and need.

For instance, he could express his jealousy more honestly and effectively by enticing his woman away from the rival and saying, "Watching you with that guy just now gave me a stab of pain. I guess I'm jealous. But it sure made me realize what a groovy chick you are, and how much I dig you."

Get it? There are hundreds of ways to express that bitter-sweet mixture of pain and desire, fear and love known as jealousy -- without falling into the trap of accusations, or the play for power. When it comes to winning and holding on to someone you care about -- the power of need and desire is greater than any other. So, don't turn your back on jealousy. It's a valid ingredient in that complex of feelings called love.

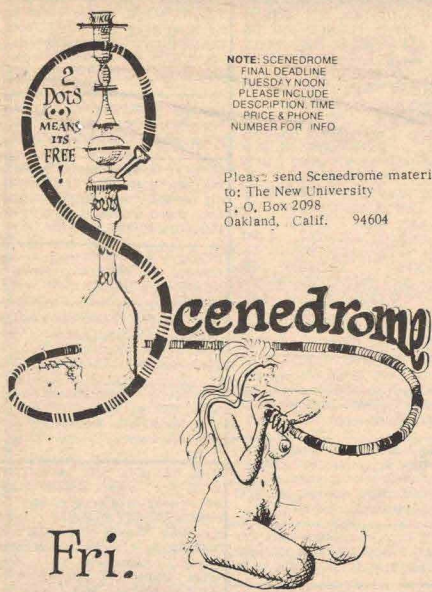
