

DISCUSSING IT ISN'T GOING TO BRING HIM BACK

"My brother's life is taken, I don't know what can be done. The Bible says God giveth and God taketh away. He took my brother for reasons unknown to us but discussing it isn't going to bring him back."

This was the voice of Meredith Hunter's seventeen year old sister, Gwen, speaking in the softly-lit, pleasant living room of their home here in Berkeley where Meredith had spent all of his life.

She is 17 years old, she says. Going to Berkeley High. She is beautiful,

'Cause he had a lot of feeling and when he was with me he showed it to me 'cause we talked a lot and he really felt really storng feelings that I didn't even know he felt until he told me about them,"

Murdock's girl thought he had this insight into people that was just remarkable. He could sit there and of course he read this book one time called The Games People Play and he loved this book so much and he was always telling me do you see those two people over there and I'd say yes, and he'd say what are they doing? And I'd say what are they doing? And I'd say this, you know that was obvious but he'd point out something that was entirely not obvious.

"His whole leaning, the way he was doing, he had beautiful insight into people. He knew exactly how to handle, he could get me to feel any way he wanted me to feel cause he knew exactly how to go about this.

"The Hell's Angels are white men. The difference between them and other white men, those white men identify themselves by jackets that says Hell's Angels. The police not gonna do nothing. The whatever those things are, the Rolling Stones hired the Hell's Angels to act as policemen and patrol around the concert and they weren't police, they committed murders. They're not gonna be stopped. The police never do nothing to them and they're not gonna start to do nothing to 'em, just another black man dead to them."

I DON'T CARE IF THEYNEVER HAVE 'EM AGAIN

"Could you tell us some of his friends that we might speak to? Names and, did he have a fella at school or a group of fellas at school that he liked and spent time with?"

"Yeah he did, but I don't think it would be best if you speak to 'em cause at this time there's violence in their mind and if you would speak to them they would speak to them they would speak violence about it, causes trouble and it broadcasts as trouble."

"We'd like to know what they think. You know, if they think that way that's the way they think.

"No, but it shouldn't be broadcast, it causes trouble.

MURDOCK WASN'T ON THE STAGE

"Have you any idea what started the fight?" we asked his girl friend.

"No. Well, the Angels had been trying to get people off the stage that were on the stage and that had caused a couple of fights, but Murdock wasn't on the stage and he wasn't, like most of the newspapers said he was wielding his gun and all this on the stage, but he wasn't on the stage and he didn't pull his gun out at all until after the fight started and everything."




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Bedtime Story

ELDRIDGE CLEAVER wants back, but on his terms. Here is how he tells it, verbatim:

ELDRIDGE CLEAVER wants back, but on his terms. Here is how he tells it, verbatim:

I have a right to it, and I want it. When they refused me this passport they violated my rights again. They told me that they would give me a piece of paper that I could use to get back into the United States, where I would be arrested as soon as I got there. And they even wanted to pay my way back, and get me a ticket, I don't need them to book me no flights. All I want is a proper document of identification like everyone else is entitled to.

It proves that they're racist, because there's a White lady here who also wanted a passport. They gave her a passport real quick, her name is Elaine Kline. They gave her a passport immediately. When all the Black people went up there, they refused them. And took them on a trip about the only thing they could give them is a docement to return to the United States, and then they would be arrested, And I accuse this man his name is Conrad Drascher. He's a righteous racist, and the man didn't respect our rights at all.

The entire International Staff of the Black Panther Party applied for American passports; to which we are entitled by law and by constitutional rights and all of that. And the staff of the American Council here in Algiers checked with the State Department in the United States, and the State Department refused us the passports. And told us that the only thing that they would give us is a document that would allow us to return to the United States for the purpose of being arrested.

We have no intention of being arrested either in Babylon or anywhere else in the world. This is what this whole thing is about. We're trying to get people out of this type of custody. So that we're not going to accept any document that purs us in the custody of the Babylonian pigs. But we do want the passports. We think we have a right to them. Because we're very concerned about what's happening to our brothers and sisters in Babylon, and we definitely intend to do something about it.

We don't intend to broadcast out travel plans by having news conferences, etc., with people who not only will print. But will rush a copy of it to J. Edgar Hoover. And that's all that I have to say about that.

GARRY WANTS HIM BACK -- BUT FREE

Pressure on Black Panther leader Eldridge Cleaver to return to America has dramatically risen since the murders of several important Party leaders in police actions against the Chicago and Los Angeles headquarters.

Charles Garry, lawyer for the Panthers, announced Wednesday that Information Minister Cleaver, now in the 13th month of exile, "doesn't intend to return to the United States."

"I'd like him to come back," Garry admitted, "but as a free man, not a slave, He'd have to spend the rest of his life in prison."

Cleaver has demanded a passport from the US Consul in Algiers, it was reported. 'I have a right to it, and I demand it," he said.

Instead of a passport which would allow him to travel even more extensively, US authorities have offered him a "certificate of identity." This paper would permit Cleaver to return to the United States. He would not be able to leave at will, however.

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

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
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

WELLFAIR

Recent steps taken by The Alameda County Welfare Department to reduce welfare roles are meeting with unexpected opposition.

The cuts as usual are being made in the county's General Assistance Program. Some of the changes being made are:

(1) Cutting down on funds used for restaurant meals by requiring that a person live in a hotel or licensed boarding house to be eligible. Many who are now living in situations where there are cooking facilities but are not permitted use of those facilities will be losing their restaurant meal money.

(2) Beginning with new applications for general assistance all persons who give an address between Dwight Way and Sacramento Street will be refused aid at the Berkely office and referred to the Cakland office at 401 Broadway in Oakland.

Actions to counter these moves

Actions to counter these moves by the county are being planned jointly by Women's Liberation Front and Telegraph Ave Libera-tion Front.

Women's Lib is calling a meeting to organize an action which will ask the Berkeley City Council to intervene in the county's attempt to transfer a large number of the Berkeley cases to the Oakland office.

The meeting is scheduled for 1 p.m. Monday, December 22 at Sherwood Forest (Unitas Bldg) Bancroft and Dana in Berkeley. Tele Ave Lib Front is planning to organise a welfare rights group for the street community and south campus area and will be on hand at the Women's Lib meeting to provide info.

Welfare recipients who are being affected by the recent changes are urged to attend this meeting.

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
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
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
