RENEGADE PHILOSOPHY

EDITORIAL STATEMENT BY BIG MAN. CO-EDITOR

In dealing with the question of renegades, the Black Panther Party checks out Chairman Mao and China's arc renegade Liu-Shao-Chi.

Former members of the Black Panther Party who have been classified as renegades choose to draw their terminology as to what renegade really means from Webster's abridged dictionary of course this is extreme narrowmind-

The Black Panther Party draws its conclusions from suc cessfully practiced theories and examples. We learn from Chairman Mao that, kneeling before the enemy for allowing him a despicable life, a renegade is a criminal to history, a mangy dog that wags its tail in asking pardon from the enemy at the cost of betraying the revolution and the comrades. In depicting a renegade from the proletarian stand, one must expose his base and vile soul, condemn his crimes of betray ing the people and the revolution and repudiate the decadent renegade philosophy which puts survival above everything

When he kills people, a pirate excuses himself with the logic of a pirate; a renegade also has his theory for defending himself. China's prime example of a renegade says, "a man representing the proletariat . . . really wanted to make revolution at the beginning, but he became a renegade afterwards

According to this logic, a renegade who once "represented the proletariat" only "became a renegade afterwards," so he naturally has both "merits" and "faults" and therefore is a forgivable man whose "merits offset his faults" or he even is "hero" who has more merits than faults. Mao says, class society everyone lives as a member of a particular class and every kind of thinking, without exception, is stamped with the brands of a class." In the eyes of the proletariat, renegades never have been true revolutionaries, but worms and opportunists who sneaked into the revolutionary ranks.

Falling at the enemy's feet and betraying the revolution, one's comrades and brothers, and own soul, all to save one's own life, these are crimes that can never be forgiven. Yet a renegade takes a stand and tries to sell his betrayal of the masses as being justified. He espouses his acts as a philosophy of survival. In his eyes, oneself is everything and one's life is EVERYTHING.TheParty'sinterests,revolutionaryprincipleand national dignity could all be sold provided "his own life and health could be protected.

Renegades fail to understand that "wherever there is struggle there is sacrifice and when we die for the people it is a worthy death." Beginning Friday (March 21) at 6 p.m., a demonstration will be held in solidarity with striking workers at the Chevron Chemical Company in Richmond. Chevron Chemical is a "wholly owned sub-sidiary" of Standard Oil, and part of the same giant complex as the Richmond refinery. The solidarity demonstration is being held in memory of Richard Jones, an oil worker who was murdered by Standard Oil during the 8 week strike against the refinery. On January 5 while picketing a standard Oil Bulk Station near Martinez, Jones was run over by a Standard Oil tanker, waved on by a Supervisor who saw Jones fall under the truck, but ordered the driver to go ahead anyway. On February 20, Jones

The workers at the Standard Oil refinery have since won their strike. But their union brothers at the Chevron Chemical plants are still out on strike. The comare still out on strike. The company — Standard Oil, negotiating through its pupper corporation, Chevron Chemical — is trying to force the Chevron workers to go back to work without the union shop agreement they have had for 20 years. Without this union shop the company can divide the workers and reduce them to serfs at the complete mercy of the modern-day plantation owners who run the giant imperialist monopolies like Stan-

Standard Oil, with its billionaire bosses, is one of the most vicious tentacles of the octopus of U.S. imperialism that extends its racist oppression and exploitation throughout the world. Standard is controlled by the Rockefeller family -- which rules a vast financial enpire that concentrated its super-exploitation in Africa, South Africa

in particular.

The Rockefellers use their biggest bank, Chase-Manhattan, to manipulate the economy and the manipulate the economy and the politics of the racist dictatorship of South Africa, where black workers in the Standard Oil plants and other large companies controlled by Rockefeller money are forced to work like slaves for less than a dollar a day. The gold, oil, copper and other valuable resources of Africa, are stolen by the Rockefellers, and their imperators. the Rockefellers, and their im-perialist henchmen, from under the feet of the oppressed people who are forced to live at near-starva-

tion levels.
Standard Oil also steals oilfrom the Middle East, South America, Indonesia and South Vietnam. The Indonesia and South Vietnam. The Rockefellers and their cronies have been responsible for the criminal war of aggression and genocide against the people of Vietnam. In Indonesia, after Pres-ident Sukarno threatened to na-tionalize some of Standard's stolen oil. Standard simply got the head oil, Standard simply got the head of the C.I.A., John McCone (who then owned about one million dol-lars stock in Standard) to work with lars stock in Standard for work with right-wing Generals to overthrow Sukarno and give Standard back the Indonesian people's oil. This was in October 1965. Since then, the Fascist generals who ousted Sukarno in collaboration with the C.I.A. have executed over one half million Indonesian peasants, workers, students and Communist revolutionaries. And these milirevolutionaries. And these min-tary puppets have duffully re-turned the oil to Standard -- plus some new oil fields for ex-ploitation. (John McCone retired from the C,I,A, and was made a member of the Board of Directors of Standard Oil.)

In this country itself Standard is a vicious enemy of both third world peoples and the masses of working people. Standard and its

dummy Chevron Chemical not only make chemical defoliants used in Vietnam to wipe out the crops and lives of hundreds of thousands of poor farmers. They manufacture pesticides that are poisoning thou-sands of farm workers in this country -- who make miserable wages orking in the fields owned by Bank of America (whose President, Rudolf Peterson, is on Standard's Board of Directors). And Standard has given black workers in this country the South Africa treatment. Until very recently Standard hired almost no black people (except for the dirtiest, lowest-paying jobs); and then, in response to the revolutionary pressure of the masses of black people, Standard tried to bring in black workers to do the same work white guys were doing -- for lower wages than the white guys get! But the union fought this and Standard has been forced to up the number of black workers to about 15 percent and give them a shot at some of the better-paying jobs -- although many blacks are still trapped in the lousy jobs.

The brutality of Standard's bosses has not been reserved only for third world victims. In this present strike Standard has used both cops and company goons to harass and brutalize picketers, white as well as black. And as they showed by killing Richard Jones, Standard's bigshots are willing to go as far as nurder to break the back of the workers

and their union.

The beatings, gassings and arrests by the pigs has forced the white workers - many of whom thought the police were their friends -- to go through a lot of changes. Now that they have seen for themselves that the pigs are not there to protect and serve the people, but to force the people to submit to the will of the avaricious businessmen, many of the oil workers can understand the real issues of the black and third world liberation movements. The oil workers voted to support the Third World strike at S.F. State -- because they had felt the brutality of the pigs themselves and because they had felt the brutality of the pigs themselves and because students from State, including third world students, came out to join the oil workers picket lines and broke down much of the ignorance and isolation that existed between students, third world peoples and white workers.

This is not to say that there is no racism left in the oil workers, or white workers in general. But this experience does show that white working class guys can be won over to support the black and third world liberation movements. And this can best be done through direct contact and principled, uncompromising confrontation with the racism implanted in these workers by their bosses.

The solidarity demonstration this week-end will be a good chance to broaden the contact between the Chevron workers still on strike — including a number of black workers — and people from the black and third world communities. This kind of solidarity, despite all its difficulties, is exactly what Rockefeller and the other ruthless tyrants in the racist ruling class of this country fear most. But, whether you make the solidarity demonstration Friday and Saturday, please do not buy any products sold under the sign of Standard and Chevron — including Ortho products. By refusing to boy their blood-soaked products, you will strike a small, but direct blow against U.S. impressiblem.

BLACK MOTHER'S SON BILLY CLUBBED

The information was given to us by John Briggs the son of Mrs. Buckner, the sister beaten up at Kezar after a basketball game, His lawyer, Hiram Smith, toldhim not to talk to anyone about it but he gave us a few details of what happened. John Briggs was approached by a pig and pushed in the back. He turned around to tell the pig he would keep moving, and the pig pushed him again, and he turned around again, The pig hit him in the face, in the stomach, and across the eye with a billy club. At this time someone called his mother. His mother came on the set. She went to his aid, and they started beating her. The badge number of the pig who beat the brother was number 1212 a white pig of the Tac-Squad. This brother stated that the judge came down or called Park Station at about 12 Midnight. Brothers and Sisters were being released from prison by the judge with no charges, At the time Mrs. Buckner was being beat her son was handcuffed on the ground. The Brother was charged with disturbing the peace, and interfering with police and resisting arrest, His mother was charged with disstanting arrest, His mother was charged with assault and battery. Her bail was \$3,000,00.

While the brother was being held at Park Police Station he heard people being beaten in the back of the station, screams came from there while the beating went

After the game, Black Brothers swiftly crossed the gym and began to fight with the honkeys from the opposing side. This battle lasted, at the most, three minutes, because the pig broke it up.

As far as the Brothers and

As far as the Brothers and Sisters were concerned, it was all over, and everybody was ready to go home until the pigs brought out their best hogs and began to beat up Black people trying to get home. Brothers, who were trying to protect Sisters, got the shit beaten out of them by the pigs. The pigs dragged them out into the street for a display. Most of the Brothers, were jive time niggers, they moved out of the way while the pigs were hitting Sisters.

The pigs stood in front of the 7 Haight bus so the people couldn't get through. The pigs used famous quotes such as, "If you want to go home, get through us", and, "Joe, get your nigger knockers out", and, "Black motherfucker", and, "Plasy nigger, get out of my way".

One incident was when a Brother was hit in the mouth with a riot tick. From there he called his mother. When his mother arrived, she was arrested and her arm twisted.

Pigs also beat Black people going up Waller Street trying to get home. They also tried to run over several Black people with their cars.

My name is Anitla Wadley and I go to Woodrow Wilson High School and I am in the low 12 and on Monday I went to the game and I just bought some new clothes, my boyfriend gave me some money, and during the game I saw him. After the game one of my girl-friends was arguing with a police-man, so I grabbed her and told her to come on, don't argue with him, so one of them grabbed me and tore my blouse and I have it on right now he ripped it and I got mad and I went hysterical and I just started cussing the policeman out so I had a hassle with one of them and three of them helped jump on me, so what happened was they sent me to Emer-gency Hospital, and they gave me gency Hospital, and they gave me three sedative shots but they didn't work. They handcuffed me to the bed, strapped my stomach and my feet. It all started again so they sent me to St. Mary's Hospital to the psycho-ward without my mother's consent or anyone's. And another thing, about 2 weeks ago I thought I was pregnant I was not a strain of the stra thought I was pregnant I went to the doctor and checked and he said my wounds were open but it is possible that I might be and he gave me some medicine to slow period down as a result of my being hit in my stomach at the game. I am bleeding again and I don't know if I am hemorrhaging or not and I would like to sue San Francisco Police for this.

attainment of the immediate aims, for the enforcement of the momentary interests of the working class; but in the movement of the present, they also represent and take care of the future of that movement." - Marx, Engels in the COMMUNIST MANIFESTO.

In my last article I pointed out at there has never been an organization in the U.S., to my knowledge, including the one founded on ganization in the vortex of the degre, including the one founded on the theory of the above decree, that has been able to carry forth this dual-principled program. Each one has either lost sight of its revolutionary perspective and fallen into the pit of reformism or has been verbally revolutionary and the decrease and the decrease of the decrease tionary only, not caring to deal with the daily demands of the people, thereby isolating themselves from the people.

I believe that the Panthers can fulfill that double role; indeed, they have proven it in several ways since their inception a scant 3 since their inception a scant 3 years ago. When Huey and Bobby carried on their armed patrols; when the Panthers marched into the State Legislature, armed, they showed the people not only their willingness to practice their theory, but they shot the old divinerish to favore more than the control of the co holes. (No pun intended, But there it is.) The government was vul-nerable; it could be beaten. Now, we all knew it. They proved also, the legality of carrying weapons: a lesson not only for immediate self-defense, but opening the door or preparation for the final con-frontation. Self-defense is no longer a vague hope to be hidden in closets and discussed in hushed tones. It has become, with Huey's tones. It has become, with Huey's tutoring, a reality, a visible presence, a practice. A practice that is becoming increasingly wide-spread; there are now armed patrols in several cities across the country and people are advocating it now who said nary a word before, let alone, "Arm Yourselves!"

When the Panthers knocked on doors talking to people about the political candidacies of Huey, Bobby, Eldridge and Kathleen, they

most important organizing tenet: talk with the people, know the peo-ple and their needs and discuss what action is necessary to satisfy spoke of the electoral struggle, they referred constantly - and applied it to the Panther Program.
The Panther Program IS the demands of the people; a written expression of both the immediate and long-range needs while recogand long-range needs while recognizing, as stated clearly in Point #7 that all of these cannot be satisfied under the present system of economic exploitation. If full employment cannot be guaranteed and it most definitely cannot if super profits are to be maintained-then the people must take over the basic means of production and run the businesses and industries by themselves, for themselves. Self-determination for the Black Colony determination for the Black Colony will never be given by the colonial rulers; it will have to be taken. Here is a perfect example of fulfilling the 2 basic components - reform and revolution: We want freedom. There are lots of daily freedoms that are partially attainable under capitalism; more jobs, better housing, less taysing, more better housing, less taysing, more better housing, less taxation, more representation, even community control of police and schools are possibilities; freedoms that will cost the profit-mongers less to give than to withhold - with the proper threats and perhaps a little PHYSICAL pressure. But the ultimate freedom, self-determination is unthinkable without revolt. The breakfast program is anbetter housing, less taxation, mor

The breakfast program is another example of meeting immediate needs within a revolutionary perspective. It is, of couse, a humanitarian thing to do; no child should be hungry, ever. But it is the Panthers, a political party with revolutionary orientation that has initiated and is carrying through the program. Why should they bother with hungry kids? Because kids are the only insurance we have of a new and different tomorrow and no premium is too high to pay. Educational skills are important; reading and writing are good things to know and when that time comes, as it inevitably will, when they learn that what they are



vill have the tools with which to fight for something meaningful, for control of the schools, of who teaches and what is taught; for the

teaches and what is taught; for the implementation of Point #5.

Finally, to answer the other question posed at the beginning of this 2-part article, how have the people accepted the Panther program? I think this is most clearly demonstrated by 3 living examples. First, to be expected, is the program of the Black Student Union. is simply the Panther platform applied to the specific needs of the school population. Apparently, the BPP program applies not only to the people in the community,

to the people in the community, but also to young people enmeshed in the phony, lying educational system dying society offers.

Secondly, the program of the Brown Berets, written to meet the needs of the Spanish-speaking community is similar in many ways to the Panther program. Let's look at some of their demands. Point #4: "We demand that the true history of the Mexican-American be taught in all schools in the 5 Southwest States." #5 demands that "all police officers in Mexican-American communities must live in the community and speak Spanish." (Community control of police). #9: "We demand that all Mexican-Americans be tried by mexican-Americans be tried by juries consisting of only Mexican-Americans." (A peer jury as de-manded in BPP Point #9) #10: "We demand the right to keep and hear arms to defend our communities against racist police, as guar-

arteed under the Second Amend-ment of the U.S. Constitution." Obviously, the original 10-point BPP platform, written for the Black community, expresses also the demands of other Third World peoples. The Brown Beret motto, incidentally, is TO SERVE - TO OBSERVE - TO PROTECT, first practiced in the north by Huey P. Newton, in 1966.

But what of the Mothercountry poor, exploited by the same profit-hungry capitalists? What of the white working class - that essential ally for a revolutionary victory? Late class community of Cleveland, Ohio. The first section under the heading WHAT WE WANT has

10-points, among which are:
2) We want freedom from robbery and control by the corpora-

ing people to control, the basic means of production such as in-dustry and agriculture. (Point #2, BPP platform.)

6) We want an education for our people that exposes the true nature of this corrupt, racist, rich man's society. We want an education that teaches us the true history of the people. (Point #5, BPP platform)
7) We want compensation for

poor people and the victims of racism. (Point #3, BPP Platform.)

8) We want an immediate end to 8) we want an immediate end to police brutality and murder of black, white and brown working people. We want the courts and prison system to protect the working people rather than the property of the rich. (Point #7, BPP plat-

9) We want an end to the Draft. We want a working people's militia formed to defend our country, based on the Constitutional right to bear arms. (Point #6, BPP)

10) As a first step, we want a truce signed between black, white and brown working people, in the community and on the job, as we recognize that fighting among ourselves only serves the rich. (I include this last point, not because of similarity, but rather because demands a necessity - and holds a beautiful promise.)

The second section entitled WHAT WE BELIEVE, explains the first 10 points and at the beginning of the 10th point, there is a quote: "When in the course of human events, it becomes neces-sary for one people to dissolve the political bonds . . . "

The program is based entirely

on the class structure of this society and the need for a blackwhite working class coalition, which is correct for a white community as the exploitation of white workers is purely a class factor, but it is obviously patterned the BPP Platform.

It is clear that the Panthers are implementing their program around the fulfillment of the im-mediate needs of the Black Community - and plan to continue with programs like free health clinics, liberation schools to fill the educational chasm created by the public schools and community control of various aspects of its life. The program is being tested - and it's working. And it is obvious from the above that the program is a universal one, applicable to all working people.

Whatever the Panthers have done has been done in a revolutionary manner; in all areas of struggle they have maintained and ver-balized their understanding of the necessity to qualitatively alter this decaying, most corrupt of all economic systems.

economic systems.

What is the probability of the BPP falling into the reformist trap or being left out on the purely revolutionary limb? I cannot envision the present leadership leading us into the boiling pot of reformism. Reformism is a result of either the inability or unwillingness to recognize the primary enmy. - Monomody Canitalism' or penmy. - Monomody Canitalism' or penmy. - Monomody Canitalism' or enemy - Monopoly Capitalism' or to compromise that knowledge. The Danthers KNOW the with their total commitment to the people, cannot compromise at this time. The danger lies in the pos-sibility of the struggle going on indefinitely with the present leadership forced into inactivity by imprisonment or physical harm (Reason #1 why they must be protected) and the younger, not yet politically mature being sucked into the system via the Poverty Program or some other lying promise. Neither can I forsee an isolationist revolutionary demise of the Party - for 3 reasons:
a) The community activities being carried on today are an evident attempt to meet the immediate demands of the Black community: successfully - judging from the Breakfast Program; educationally, in terms of the political campaigns. b) There is an enormous revolutionary potential within the Black working class which will intensify, working class which will intensity, thereby bringing the people ever-closer to the Party and c) The Panthers, having come from the poor, identify with the people more than with dedentic theory. Isolation is the result of intellectual rather than emotional involvement.

That is why I'm convinced that

the Black Panther Party has the program that will not only healthe wounds and fractures in the Colony, but will ultimately lead us all out of the horror that is capitalism into the promise that is Socialism.





PEOPLE'S TRIBUNAL

LOS ANGELES, Calif.(LNS)-More than 200 people gathered at a recreation center in the black community of Los Angeles March 1 where the Black Alternative, a ne black community group here, held a community tribunal against various leaders of the Black Congress.

The Black Alternative is a loose coalition of various black militant groups in L.A., ranging from the Black Panther Party to SNCC. The Black Alternative was organized about two months ago under the leadership of Margaret Wright, a well-known leader in the black community here.

The black community tribunal charged the leaders of the Black Congress (which itself is a supposed unbrella organization claiming membership of some 50 black "grass roots" organizations in "grass roots" organizations in L.A.) with committing "crimes against the interests of the black community."

Specifically, the charges were that the leaders in question -- Walt Bremond, Ron Karenga, and Roygene Robinson -- were "derelict

in their duty to the black com-munity, showed cowardice in the face of the enemy, refused to be held accountable for the money which they received and finally created turmoil and hysteria in the black community which led directly to the deaths of John Huggins and "Bunchy" Carter of the Black Panther Party."

Some 30 black community leaders were "subpoened" by the tribunal to testify against Bremond, Karenga and Robinson. Various members of the five-man tribunal board presented evidence themselves to show that Bremond, as director of the Black Congress, had collected within a five-month period, more than \$55,000, which was unaccounted for later. It was no accident, the tribunal hinted, that after this financial loss was discovered, Bremond held a press conference and then resigned as director of the Black Congress.

Tut Hayes, of the Afro-American Association, detailed several other charges against Bremond and the Black Congress. According to Hayes, the Black Congress, before its collapse, did not represent five groups, let alone the 50 it claimed to represent. According to him, Bremond and Karenga were the Black Congress.

Hayes also said that within a period of five months the Black Congress staff had received over \$15,000 in salaries. Hayes also charged that Bremond himself is solely interested in gaining perpower and wealth. And as sonal power and wealth. And as a consequence, Hayes held that Bremond was directly responsible for creating the bitter climate that led to the assassimations of Hug-gins and Carter at UCLA, (Also, the US organization, led by Karenga, is a principal in the Black Congress. US was deeply implicated in the murders of the two Panthers.)

After Hayes finished, Margaret Wright dealt with the charge that the Black Congress "showed cow-ardice in the face of the enemy." Mrs. Wright explained that the Black Congress has never stood up forcefully for the rights of black people in Los Angeles. She pointed out that the Black

Congress never offered to help the Black Student Unions in their struggles against the racist ad-ministrations on Southern California college or high school

She noted that this was particu-

larly noticeable during the recent black student action at San Fer-nando Valley State College. She further revealed that the Black Congress, after the assassination of Dr. King, attempted to collaborate with the cops to keep L.A. "cool," rather than trying to protect black people against the racist

attacks of the police.

Brother Crook, head of SNCC in L.A., was the last to testify.
He told of how the Black Congress received grants from both the Ford and the Rockefeller foundations. Crook described how the Black Congress took Rockefeller money and opened up a string of Standard and opened up a string of standard gas stations throughout the black community. Thus the Black Congress, according to him, was moving intentity on Nixon's "black capitalism" plan.

Crock also said that the Black

Congress gave tacit support to the entire slate of Democratic candidates during the 1968 presidential election. Crook finally pointed out that Bremond, in addition to being director of the Black Congress, also maintained positions on the "Urban Coalition," and the "Bro-therhood Crusade," (of which Bremond is president) intends to raise \$3 million ostensibly for programs as million ostensioly for programs in the black community. It was noted that the managing board of the "Brotherhood Crusade," with the exceptions of Karenga, Bremond and some other black people, is compased largely of white busi-

The tribunal closed by asking for a vote on the guilt or innocence of the accused leaders. The vote from the audience was on each charge unanimous. Bremond, in particular, along with Karenga and Robinson, stood convicted. Al-though it was stipulated beforehand that there would be no punishment, the black community, it was hoped, would make the final decision on what would ultimately be done with





Once Again - Police Brutality

The strategy employed here is "to unite to fight a common enemy," The Garment Contractors are pigs. They exploit the labor of 4,800 workers who slave in their sweatshops for seventy cents an hour. This is analogous to Mao's Red Army uniting with Chiang Kai-Shek's forces to oust Japanese Imperialists.

On Friday, March 15, the Red Guards attended a meeting with community elders from the Garment Contractors to discuss how to keep the white racist unions out of Chinatown, i.e., unions such as the Teamsters who are organizing the pigs and who use their goons to brutalize Board of Education meetings over dead issues like busing.

The Red Guard attended as security in case union goons were sent to break up the meeting at Powell and Pacific Streets, While the elders were discussing the formation of their own union in order to force the white racist unions away from Chinatown, work reached the meeting that pigs were harassing our security force posted outside, Apparently, a pig gave chase to a brother whom he thought was carrying a rifle (our right to bear arms is protected by the Second Amendment of the Constitution), but the brother got away. The pig then called for reinforcements from a gas station across the street, and re-crossed the street to tell the crowd, which was composed of Red Guards from the meeting, to disburse. The pig was met with verbal abuse when his reinforcements came. Plainclothed pig, David Utter, then told the Red Guard to "get off the street." The Guards told the pig that this was our community and that HE should get off OUR street, Besides, where do they expect street people to go, if we can't be on the streets?

By this time, there were three squad cars (12 pigs), three undercover cars (6 pigs), and one paddy wagon (2 pigs) on the scene. The Guard decided to return to the meeting at this time, but as they were entering the meeting hall, the elders had already adjourned the meeting and were in the process of leaving. After talking with the elders, the pigs started to retreat. As the last squad car was leaving, it was hit by two quart sized soda-pop bottles which did no damage to either car nor its occupants. The pigs then got out of the car, clubs in hand, approached the crowd of Guards and elders and started to swing at a brother - not the one who threw the bottle. One pig gave chase to the brother and was tripped flat on his face. By this time, reinforcements had arrived again. They started to beat the crowd, hitting six people, injuring one sister, swinging at women including one pregnant sister, and attacking a camera man as they were disbursing. None of the elders were hit although they were swung at by the pigs.

At this time, one pig started to swing his club at our Minister of Culture, Wing Quan. Wing grabbed the club and the pig oinked, "Get out of here." Wing started to leave but three other pigs approached him from behind and ordered him to "Stop." All four of the pigs then proceeded to club him viciously on the head until he fell to the ground. He was then arrested on charges of assault with a deadly weapon ja felony), resisting arrest and possession of a deadly weapon (a pocket knife which never left his pocket). He was held on \$3,375 bail - bond was posted by the Garment Contractors. Wing's injuries were minor scalp lacerations, He was released that same night.

The question which arises is: Were the pigs there by accident? Answer: No! The Red Guard and the elders were meeting to try to keep the Teamsters out of Chinatown at the same time that Teamsters are organizing a Policemen's Union. The pics were sent to break up

We will not fight and kill other people of color in the world who, like Yellow people, are being victimized by the white racist government of America. We will protect ourselves from the force and violence of the racist police and the racist military, by whatever

racist military, by whatever means necessary.

5. We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY AND MURDER OF Yellow People.

DER OF Yellow People.

We believe we can end police brutality in our Yellow community by organizing Yellow self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our Yellow community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We, therefore, believe that all Yellow people should arm themselves for self defense.

6. We want freedom for all Yellow men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails. We believe that all Yellow people

We believe that all Yellow people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

7. We want all yellow people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peer

group or people from their Yellow communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that Yellow people will recieve fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a man a right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the Yellow community from which the Yellow defendant came. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man of the Yellow community."

8. We want adequate and free medical facilities available for the people in the Yellow community. We know that Chinatown has the

We know that Chinatown has the highest density area next to Manhattan. It also has the highest TB and sickness rate in the naton.

9. We want full employment for our people.

our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white atherican businessmen will not give fullemployment, then, the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living. There are thousands of immigrants coming into Chinatown every year and it is almost impossible for them to find gainful employment.

10. We demand that the United States government recognize the People's Republic of China, We believe that MAO TSE-TUNG

Armymen and civilians in their hundreds of millions throughout China are enraged at the extremely grave and bleody incident created by the Soviet revisionist renegade clique which directed Soviet frontier troops flagrantly to intrude into Chinese territory on March 2. In Peking, the capital of our great motherland, one million armymen and civilians rallied and paraded yesterday, in strong protest against the towering crimes of the Soviet revisionist renegade clique.

China upholds revolutionary tradition, leads struggles of oppressed peoples; Soviet Revision-

pressed peoples; Soviet Revisionists sell out to U.S. Imperialism. On March 3, Russian troops carried out a provocative attack on Chinese border guards at Chenpao Island. The Chinese repelled the attack, wiping out many of the invading troops. In a radio broadcast the Chinese warned the ruling clique of the Soviet Union: "Should you dare to continue to instigate armed provocations, you will be resolutely, completely, cleanly and totally destroyed once and for all whether you come by Iand, by air or by sea and no matter how many of you come or with whom you come." The last part of the warning clearly refers to the conspiracy between the Soviet misleaders and the U.S. imperialists to harass, provoke, and attack the Chinese People's Republic.

The Chinese People's Republic guided by Chairman Mao-tse-tung and the Chinese Communist Party, is the leading force in the world-wide revolutionary struggle of oppressed nations and laboring masses against the imperialist ruling classes, headed by the U.S. imperialists, together with their bootlicking collaborators, the Soviet revisionists. The Chinese revolution is a thorn in the side of the revisionists - who have betrayed the Soviet working people by taking the country back to capitalism' and betrayed the oppressed peoples of the world by selling out to the Rockefellers, the Fords, the Duponts and the rest of the criminal gang that makes up the U.S. imperialist ruling class.

How did the Soviet Union, which was once a socialist country and an inspiration to millions of downtrodden people throughout the world, come to be the accomplices of the U.S. imperialists? The Soviet Union was not always ruled by a handful of revisionists (capitalists in workers clothing). Led by Lenin from 1917 to 1924, and by Stalin from 1924 to 1953, the Soviet Union was ITSELF hated bitterly, encircled and hounded by the imperialists.

The Russian Revolution, in October, 1917 overthrew the Russian capitalists and created the first state ruled by the working class, in alliance with the poor peasants. Under the leadership of Lenin and Stalin, the Soviet red army turned back invasions by 14 imperialist countries, including the U.S. The Soviet revolution established self-soviet revolution establishe

determination and autonomy for all the oppressed nationalities of old Tsarist Russia; overcame the treachery and defeatism of opportunists like Trotsky and Bukharin and built a mighty socialist

The success of the Soviet rev-

olution was a great inspiration not only to the working people of the advanced capitalists countries—including the U.S. -- but to the oppressed, colored peoples of the East. Marxism -- Leninism, the thoughts of Marx and Lenin, developed through years of revolutionary struggle, was the tool the Chinese people utilized in making their own revolution. With the political, moral and material help of the Communist International, led by the Soviet Union, the Chinese workers and peasants, the great majority of the people, carried on a long struggle, through many setbacks, until the final victory of their revolutionary war, and the establishment of the Chinese People's Republic in 1949. This entire struggle of the Chinese people, covering more than 20 years, was led by the Chinese Communist Party, headed by Chairman Mao, whose thought represents Marxism-Leninism at its highest stage in the present period. This explains the importance of the little red book of "Quotations of Maotes-tung", many of which are reprinted in the Black Panther.

During their struggle to overthrow the landlords and the big capitalists, and drive their imperialist masters out of China, the Chinese people's closest ally was the Soviet Union, ledby Stalin. As Mao himself wrote in December, 1939: "Stalin is the true friend of the cause of liberation of the Chinese people. No attempt to sow dissension, no lies and calumnies can affect the Chinese people's whole-hearted love and respect for Stalin and our genuine friendship for the Soviet Union." But soon after Stalin died in

But soon after Stalin died in 1953, the leadership of the Soviet Communist Party and government was usurped by a handful of traitors — revisionists like the notorious Liu Shao Chi, who today in China opposes the revolutionary leadership of Mao-tse-tung. While pretending to be communists, Khrushchov and his cronies began to reverse the Russian revolution, to convert the Russian Communist Party from the vanguard of the working people to the apparatus of a new privileged elite of capital-

ist exploiters. To do this, against the revolutionary will of the Soviet people, they cooperated with their buddies in the U.S.; the imperialist ruling class. From supporter of worldwide liberation movements, the Soviet government was turned into the concealed and even open opponent of wars of national liberation. The Soviet traitors developed the phony line that a single war of national liberation might be the spark that would set off a world war. But they were really concerned with preserving their privileged position and not getting their imperialist bosses mad at them. They wheeled and dealed with the imperialists, inside and outside the United Nations, to divide the world into Russian and American spheres of influence.

In opposition to all revolutionary struggle the Russian revisionists demanded pacifism on the part of the oppressed and exploited people who were directly under the boot of the imperialists. These renegades put forward the phony slogan of the "three peacefuls": "Peaceful transition" (from capitalism to so clalism): "peaceful coexistence" (between the oppressed peoples and their oppressors); and "peaceful cooperation" (between themselves and their imperialist crime partners).

The record of the crimes of the Soviet revisionists is too long to repeat here. But the following is a brief outline of their worst misdeadu.

July 1959: Without any prior notice, they cancelled hundreds of aid agreements with the Chinese People's Republic and withdrewall Soviet aid, technicians, and blueprints from China — leaving scores of factories and plants unfinished and causing temporary havoc to China's economy. This was the same thing the U.S. Imperialists were doing to the Cuban people, after the victory of the

Cuban revolution in 1959.

July 1960: Voted in the U.N. Security Council to send U.S. controlled U.N. troops to the Congo, which led to the overthrow of the popular Congolese government of Patrice Lumumba and maintained the Congo as a happy hunting ground for the U.S. imperialists and their accomplices.

1959 - 1962; Publicly supported the Indian government, a pawn of U.S. imperialism, in its border provocations against, and direct invasion of, China. The Soviet Union furnished India with airplanes and other military aid. 159-1961; Withdrew all aid from the People's Republic of Albania, cut off aid from that heroic European socialist country, and publicly called for a coup against Enver Hoxha, leader of the Albanian Communist Party. (The Soviet revisionists were embarrassed and angered when the Albanian People's Republic, a small East European state, heavily de-East European state, heavily de-East

pendent on Soviet aid, said the Albanian people would rather eat grass than turn revisionist).

1963: Signed a pact with the U.S. AND British to cease all at mospheric nuclear tests and tried to pressure all nations in the world to go along with the scheme to prevent China from developing an atom bomb and keep the monoply of nuclear weapons in the hands

of the two so-called "super-powers": the U.S. and Russia, with England, (Early development of a nuclear bomb requires atmos-pheric testing, Later developments of MORE and BIGGER bombs requires only UNDERGROUND testing, which was continued at a heavy pace by both the U.S. and the Soviet Union). The Chinese people declared that they would never be the first to use nuclear weapons, and proposed the destruction of ALL such weapons, but the U.S. imperialists and So viet revisionists refused and the Chinese had no choice but to develop these weapons, at great cost to themselves, for SELF-DEFENSE. (It hardly needs recalling that the U.S. imperialists are the only ones ever to USE these weapons --which they did twice against the Japanese people in 1945, AFTER the Japanese government had of-fered to surrender!) The Soviet government extended credit to, signed an aid agreement with, and established close diplomatic relations with the facists dictators of Indonesia, Su-harto and Nasution, only a few months after these fascist Generals overthrew the anti-imperialist government of Sukarno; murdered over a half a million In-donesian workers, peasants, students and communists; and turned over the oil fields and other valuable land and resources to the U.S. imperialists, especially Standard Oil.

1968: Carried out naked aggression against the people of Czecho-slovakia. In collaboration with their revisionist junior partners in that country the Soviet imperialists are converting Czecho-slovakia into an occupied neo-colony within the Soviet imperialist sphere of influence.

Soviet Revisionist Renegade Clique Directs Soviet Frontier Guards to Flagrantly Intrude Into China's Territory

ON March 2 the Soviet modern revisionist renegade intrude into the area of Chenpao Island, Heilungkiang Province, China, and outrageously open cannon and gun fire, killing and wounding many Chinese frontier guards. The Chinese frontier guards were compelled to fight back in self-defence. This extremely grave incident of armed provocations deliberately created by the Soviet revisionist renegade clique is another grave crime perpetrated by it against the Chinese people and once again reveals its fiendish features as social-

At about 09:00 hours on March 2, large numbers of fully armed soldiers, together with armoured vehicles, a lorry and a command car, sent by the Soviet frontier authorities, flagrantly intruded into the area of Chenpao Island which is indisputable Chinese territory, and carried out provocations against the Chinese frontier guards who were on normal patrol duty on the island. At that time, the Chinese frontier guards, showing very great restraint, repeatedly warned the intruding Soviet soldiers and ordered them to stop their provocations and withdraw from the Chinese territory. However, the intruding Soviet soldiers refused to heed these warnings and became even more truculent. At 09:17 hours, the intruding Soviet soldiers outrageously opened up with cannon and gun fire on the Chinese frontier guards. Having reached the end of their forbearance, the Chinese frontier guards were compelled to fight back in self-defence, giving the intruders, who were committing provocations, their deserved punishment and triumphantly safeguarding our country's

This extremely grave armed conflict singlehandedly created by the Soviet revisionist renegade clique is by no means an isolated incident. For a long time, the Soviet revisionist renegade clique, ignoring the repeated warnings of the Chinese Government, has time and again encroached upon China's territory and

her air space and created incidents of bloodshed on many occasions. During the ice-bound seasons in the more than two years between January 23, 1967 and March 2 this year, Soviet frontier guards intruded into the area of Chenpao Island on 16 occasions, and on several occasions wounded Chinese frontier guards who were on normal patrol duty, and looted arms and ammunition. Between the end of November 1967 and January 5, 1968, the Soviet revisionist renegade clique sent Soviet frontier guards on 18 occasions to intrude into the area of Chilichin Island, north of Chenpao Island, Heilungkiang Province, China, disrupting Chinese people's production and on many occasions killing and wounding Chinese people engaged in productive labour. Soviet frontier guards also intruded into the area of Kapotzu Island, south of Chenpao Island, Heilungkiang Province, China, on many occasions. And, on a still greater number of occasions, Soviet military planes intruded into China's air space over Heilungkiang Province.

The criminal activities of the Soviet revisionist renegade clique in deliberately encroaching upon China's territory and creating one incident of bloodshed after another have glaringly exposed the vicious features of the clique, which for a long time has collaborated with U.S. imperialism, frenziedly opposed China and practised social-imperialism and social-fascism. These grave crimes of the clique have aroused the utmost indignation of the Chinese armymen and civilians. The Chinese people sternly warn the Soviet revisionist renegade clique: The 700 million Chinese people, tempered in the great proletarian cultural revolution, are not to be trifled with. China's sacred territory brooks no violation. In its reports, TASS called the U.S. 6th Fleet, which the Turkish people wanted to get rid of, "guests from overseas," used "down with imperialism" as a substitute for the demonstrators' slogan of "down with U.S. imperialism," and did not say a word about the

reactionary Turkish authorities' atrocities in suppressing the masses. Even more shameless was that when the U.S. 6th Fleet was on its way out of the Turkish ports to the boos of the people, a Soviet revisionist destroyer crossing the Bosporus Strait on its way to the Mediterranean went to the trouble of flagging "salutes" to the fleeing U.S. warships. All this proves to the hilt that Soviet revisionism and U.S. imperialism are jackals of the same lair and that both are enemies of the Turkish people.

Our great leader Chairman Mao pointed out long ago: "All reactionaries are paper tigers. In appearance, the reactionaries are terrifying, but in reality they are not so powerful. From a long-term point of view, it is not the reactionaries but the people who are really powerful." The victory of the Turkish people's recent massive demonstration against U.S. imperialism once again proves that this thesis of Chairman Mao's is absolutely correct. So long as the Turkish people unite, dare to fight, defy difficulties and persist in struggle, they will surely win final victory in their anti-U.S.

NIXON GO HOME! WEST EUROPE THUNDERS:

Scarcely had new U.S. imperialist boss Richard Nixon warmed up to his presidential seat after a month in office than he crossed the Atlantic, taking with him a huge force of armed bodyguards plus two bullet-proof limousines, and got busy in Western Europe. That the American President had to journey here and there visiting "allies" in Western Europe at a time when inside the United States the struggle of the American people was mounting, the financial and monetary crisis was worsening and strife within the ruling circles was growing more acute makes it still clearer that U.S. imperialism, torn by crises at home and abroad, is in a worse than ever pre-

Nixon's 8-day (February 23 to March 2) itinerary took him to Belgium, Britain, West Germany, Italy and France. U.S. officialdom and press disclosed that the trip was designed to patch up the irreparable split in the imperialist bloc and make possible for the United States to hold its ground in Western Europe by coaxing and cajoling the West European "allies" which had become increasingly resentful of U.S. control. On the other hand, it was intended to pave the way for the next round of bigger scale global counter-revolutionary deals with the Soviet revisionists. It was generally the belief of the Western press that Nixon's tour of Western Europe was "prelude" to his "summit meeting"

with the Soviet revisionist chieftains.

Much as Nixon had done before leaving Washington to work on public opinion to put his visit in a favourable light, it was not bouquets with which the awakening people in Western Europe greeted the "arrival of the august person." They wel-comed the new U.S. imperialist boss with angry shouts of "Nixon, go home!"

Belgium. Belgium was the first stop in Nixon's tour. Before his arrival in Brussels, several hundred Belgian youths on the afternoon of February 23, waving flags of the South Vietnam National Front for Liberation and shouting "U.S. imperialism get out!" "Out with NATO!" and other slogans, held a rally and demonstra-tion in the heart of the capital to protest the visit. The Belgian authorities hurriedly cordoned off the entire airport area when Nixon arrived in the evening. But more than 500 youths broke through the cordon soon after he got off the plane. Climbing on to airport rooftops, they shouted in one voice: "Nixon, go

Britain. Nixon flew into London, the second leg of his "working" trip, on February 24 amid roaring protests by the British people. Several hundred protesters demonstrated in front of protesters demonstrated in front of the U.S. Embassy in Grosvenor Square. They shouted: "Nixon, go home!" "Yunkees, go home!" "Fascist Nixon!" "Down with U.S. imperialism!" "People's war in,

Nixon out!'
Placards carried by demonstrators read: "Nixon, go home!" "U.S. imperialism is a paper tiger!" "Defeat U.S. and Soviet imperialist plot against the people of the world!"
"Kosygin, Wilson, Nixon all the
same!" "U.S. aggressors, get out of
Vietnam!" "Victory to Afro-Asian liberation struggle!

Many demonstrators held aloft portraits of Chairman Mao and waved copies of the treasured red book Quotations From Chairman Mao Tse-tung. They repeatedly shouted: "Long live Chairman Mao!"

The protests and demonstrations alarmed Nixon. Large numbers of security forces were mobilized by U.S. and British police authorities to protect him. All buildings along the streets travelled by Nixon's car were under close guard by police and secret agents. The entire working staff in his hotel were replaced by detectives. Still, the Wilson government was apprehensive about Nixon's safety. Thus, according to the British press, it had a "nylon bullet-proof vest" especially made for the American President, just to make him feel a bit more "secure" during his 40-hour visit.

West Germany and West Berlin. Hurriediy leaving Britain on February 26, Nixon arrived by air in Bonn, West Germany, the same morning. People in Bonn tarred street walls in the American com-munity with anti-U.S. slogans before his arrival. One read: "Yankees, get out of Victnam!" Another had the letter "X" in Nixon's name written

as a "swastika," the Nazi emblem.

Nixon showed up in West Berlin
the next day. The demonstrators' hostility poured forth at once on Nixon's arrival there. Escorted by a large police force, he was denounced by a mass of angry demonstrators who threw stones, bags of paint, snow balls and fire-crackers at the motor-cade as he rode through the centre West Berlin in his bullet-proof limousine brought all the way from the United States. Waving red flags, the demonstrators shouted "U.S. fascist!" They burnt the U.S. flag and Nixon's portraits.

Marchers in the demonstration held high the red book Quotations From Chairman Mao Tse-tung and evinced their respect-for Chairman Mao with warm slogans.

Italy. Nixon landed in Rome on February 27. To ensure his "safety," the reactionary Italian authorities declared a ban on all mass demonstrations during Nixon's visit and moved tens of thousands of police and gendarmes from different parts of the country to the capital.

But the Italian people, who have a glorious tradition of struggle, defied the government ban and, undaunted by police suppression, took to the streets to voice their strong protest against the new U.S. imperialist chieftain. While Nixon was holding talks with Italian President Saragat in the presidential palace, about 10,000 people held a big demonstration near by. Among the demon-strators were workers, students and Africans and Arabs residing in Rome. The demonstrators gave vent to their indignation by shouting: hangman!" "Nixon, go "Nixon. home! "Nixon, you are a paper tiger!" and other slogans and held aloft placards reading "Get Italy out of NATO" and "Unite, carry the struggle everywhere against imperialism till victory!" as

they marched on to the presidential

Many demonstrators expressed their affection for the great leader Chairman Mao. They shouted with warm feeling: "Mao Tse-tung! Mao Tse-tung!" "Long live Mao Tse-tung!"

France. From Italy Nixon flew to France on February 28 to complete the last leg of his 5-nation West European tour. Shortly before European tour. Shortly before Nixon's arrival in Paris, group after group of Parisian youths attacked U.S. monopoly capital's business establishments in downtown Paris, smashing many office windows of the Pan-American Airways, the American Express and the Hilton Hotel. Pamphlets protesting his visit distributed by the demonstrators all along the route as Nixon rode from the airport to the centre of the French capital. Rotten eggs were flung at Nixen's motorcade. The demonstrating youths, holding aloft placards reading "Halt U.S. aggression," shouted in unison "Nixon, assassin!" Nixon, the God of Plague, was thoroughly denounced.
On March 1, tens of thousands of

workers and students from univer-sities and lycees, defying the government ban and armed police threats, organized a mammoth demonstration to strongly protest the "visit" by the U.S. imperialist boss, the largest since last year's May-June revolutionary storm. Singing The Internationale and shouting "Nixon, assassin," they marched in a long procession through downtown Paris carrying red flags. The demonstrators were in a militant mood, and they burnt a dozen or so U.S. flags and several effigies of Nixon to show their hatred for U.S. imperialism, the common enemy of the people all over the world. Slogans denouncing U.S. imperialism appeared in many streets of the capital.

Nixon's predecessors Eisenhower, Nixon's predecessors Ensembled. Kennedy and Johnson, had at one time or another made "inspection tours" of Western Europe in the capacity of "protector" or "super boss" of the Western world. But the pomp and bluster of former days is fast diminishing, and the comedown of one administration becomes worse than the other. Today, Nixon's trip is only a ghost of his predecessors' trips. For years the surging tide of the revolutionary struggles of the people the world over has not only accelerated the decline of U.S. imperialism, but has considerably hastened the disintegration of the imperialist bloc with the United States at the head.

SIRHAN -- A REVOLUTIONARY

Recently, Sirhan Sirhan has been able to make statements during his trial. Finally we are able to hear from him the thoughts that led to the revolutionary action he carried out.

On the stand he told about the outrages of being forced out of a comfortable home in Jerusalem in 1947 when the Zionists militarily occupied Palestine. The family fled from West Jerusalem into a partially wrecked 900 year old build-ing in the old walled city.

When he spoke of Jerusalem and his early childhood he recalled frequent bombings in the area of his home; huddling for heat around open brazier in the bombed-out building where seven or eight other families lived; hunger and severe thirst. People in his neighborhood died of starvation.

Mrs. Sirhan testified, "All our money gone; all our furniture gone; we didn't know where to lay our heads. We didn't have beds, we didn't even have a blanket for my baby ... we slept on the floor and that was made of tile. It was drafty. It was dark. We used to go thirsty for many days before we could get a drink of water." She told of "explosions that blew

victims to pieces, young men and women tortured and bloodied." Her on, Sirhan, was three years old then and after he saw one such incident, "he took a blanket and covered his face with it. He stayed in bed for two days. For two weeks he didn't want to take his little brother from near the house." han had fits of trembling after see-ing blood, his Mother said, and shook for two weeks after seeing a neighbor's body against a fence. "He became fearful of the Zionhis Mother was asked.

"Yes," replied Mrs. Sirhan. Even in the face of statements like these, the racist prosecution tried to show on cross-examination that any anti-Jewish sentiments Sirhan developed were the result of prejudices he drew from others or things he read. As for the atrocities Mrs. Sirhan de-scribed, the state suggested that little effort was made to spare Sir-

han the knowledge or sight of them! Testimonies like Sirhan's can be

of the power structure which document atorcities; from Vietnam to Palestine. Sirhan Sirhan is a revolutionary. He became one be-cause there was no other logical way to go in the face of the brutal occupation of his homeland.

6 Students Arrested in Bronx As 100 Battle With Pigs

NEW YORK (LNS) -- More than 100 protesters gathered March 3 at William H. Taft High School, in the Bronx, to picket the recent suspension of black high school dent Ron Dicks.

The picket line grew as students stayed out of school to join the protest. The demonstration drew students from Taft and other near-by high schools, as well as parents and SDS people from New York Un-

iversity, Fordham and Columbia.
About 11 a.m. cops charged the picket line, isolated black student leaders and an SDS organizer, and beat them. Two victims were hospitalized.

Nine people were arrested on charges of possession of a deadly weapon, assault with a deadly weapon, resisting arrest, obstruction of government services, har-rassment and possession of mari-

Ron's suspension, which initiated the protest, is the latest in a series of repressive actions taken against Taft students since end of the United Federation of Teachers strike last November.

At that time, the Taft UFT chair-man Rohsak told Ron that he would get rid of the Black Student Union leaders no matter what he had to

Ron was suspended for allegedly distributing the BSU newspaper in the school. As it really happened, Rohsak asked Ron for a copy of the paper. Ron refused. Rohsak insisted, so Ron gavehim a paper. Hence, his suspension for distributing literature on school

After the March 3 protest, par After the March 3 protest, parents and students met to discuss further political action. The meeting was interrupted three times by police visitors -- a cop on the beat, the bomb squad and the public relations officer of the local pre-


On March 4, parents and students picketed again, this time with no cop reaction. The stidents issued cop reaction. The stidents issued demands, including the removal of cops from, school grounds, reinstatement of suspended students and elimination of suspensions and expulsions altogether. Political activity continued throughout the

Despite popular protest against Ron's suspension, the local school voted eight to one against rescinding the suspension.

The Taft student body is about 55 per cent black and Puerto Rican and 45 per cent white working class. While black and white students at Taft have not been exactly close, there have been no actual battles between them like at other New York schools, despite the efforts of the administration to turn

efforts of the administration to turn the races against each other. "You should stay out of this," a teacher told a white student par-ticipating in the demonstrations. "It's a colored problem. You'll only get in trouble because of the militants."

At the same time, black students were told that they were being "used" by outside SDS agitators. One cop told an SDS organizer who was passing out leaflets, "Sorry we missed you today. Hope to see you tomorrow."



The only proper purpose of a government is to protect a man's rights, which means: to protect him from physical violence. 

The Black Man's Stake in Vietnam

The most critical tests facing and the Negro revolution at home. fact that the brains in Pentagon see fit to send 16 per cent black troops to Vietnam is indication that there is a one indication that there is a structural relationship between these these two arnas of con-flict. And the initial outrageous refusal of the Georgia Legislature to seat representative elect Julian Bond, because he denounced the aggressive U.S. role in Vietnam, shows too, the very intimate relationship between the way human beings are being treated in Viet-nam and the treatment they are receiving here in the United States.

We like today in a system that in the last stages of the protracted process of breakingup on a worldwide basis. The rulers per-ceive the greatest threat to be the national liberation movements around the world, particularly in Asia, Africa, and Latin America. In order for them to wage wars of suppression against these national liberation movements abroad, they must have peace and stability and unanimity of purpose at home. But at home there is a Trojan Horse, a Black Trojan Horse that has become aware of itself and is now struggling to get on its feet. It too, demands liber-

What is the purpose of the attention that the rulers are now focusing on the Trojan Horse? Is it out of a newfound love for the horse, or is it because the rulers need the horse to be quiet, to be still, and not cause the rulers, already with their backs to the wall, any trouble or embarrassment while they force the war in Vietnam? Indeed, the rulers have need of the horse's, power on the fields of battle. What the black man in America must keep constantly mind is that the doctrine of white supremacy, which is a part of the ideology of the world system the power structure is trying to preserve, lets the black man in for the greatest portion of the suffering and hate which white supremacy has dished out to the non-white people of the world for hundreds of years. The white-supremacyoriented white manfeels less con punction about massacring "niggers" than he does about massacring any other race of people on the earth. This historically indisputable fact, taken with the present persistent efforts of the United States to woo the Soviet Union into an alliance against China, spells DANGER to all the peoples of the world who have been victims of white supremacy. If this

sweethearting proves successful, if the United States is finally able to make a match with Russia, or if the U.S. can continue to frighten the Soviet Union into reneging on commitments to international socialist solidarity (about which the Soviets are always trumpet-ing, while still allowing the imperialist aggressors to daily bomb the Democratic Republic of North Vietnam), and if the U.S. is able to unleash its anxious fury and armed might against the riging non-white giant of China, which is the real target of U.S. strategy the world over -- if the U.S. is successful in these areas, then it will be the black man's turn again to face the lyncher and burner of the world: and face him alone.

Black Americans are too easily deceived by a few smiles and friendly gestures, by the passing of a few liberal-sounding laws which are left on the books to rot unenforced, and by the mushy speechmaking of a President who is a past master of talking out of the thousand sides of his mouth, Such poetry does not guarantee the safe future of the black people in Amerca. The black people must have a guarantee, they must be certain, they must be sure beyond doubt that the reign of terror ended and not just suspended, and that the future of their people is secure. And the only way they ensure this is to gain or ganizational unity and communiation with their brothers and allies around the world, on an international basis. They must have this power. There is no other way. Anything else is a sellout of the future of their people. The world of today was fashioned yesterday. What is involed here, what is being decided right now, is the shape of power in the world to-

The American racial problem can no longer be spoken of or solved in isolation. The realtionship between the genocide in Viet-nam and the smiles of the whiteman toward black Americans is a direct relationship. Once the white man solves his problem in the East he will then turn his fury again on the black people of America, his longtime punching bag. The black people have been tricked again and again, sold out at every turn by misleaders. After the Civil War, went through a period similar to the one we are now in. The Negro problem received a full hearing. Everybody knew that the black man had been denied justice. No one doubted that it was time for changes and that the black man should be made a first class

citizen. But Reconstruction ended. Blacks who had been elevated to high positions wee brusquely kicked out into the streets and herded along with the masses of blacks into the ghettos and black belts. The lyncher and the burner received virtual license to murder blacks at will. White Americans found a new level on which to cool the blacks out. And with the help of such tools as Booker T. Washington, the doctrine of segregation was clamped firmly onto the backs of the blacks. It has taken a hundred years to struggle up from that level of cool-out to the miserable position that black Americans find themselves in. Time is pass The historical opportunity which world events now present to black Americans is running out with every tick of the clock.

This is the last act of the show.

We are living in a time when the people of the world are making their final bid for full and complete freedom. Never before in history has this condition pre-vailed. Always before there have been more or less articulate and aware pockets of people, portions of classes, etc., but today's is an era of mass awareness, when the smallest man on the street is in rebellion against the system which has denied him life and which he come to understand robs him of his dignity and self-respect. Yet he is being told that it will take time to get programs started. pass legislation, to white people into accepting the physically impossible, to move as fast as the black man would live to move. Black men are deadly serious when they say FREEDOM NOW. Even if the white man wanted to eradicate all traces of evil over-night, he would not be able to do it because the economic and political system will not permit it. All talk about going too fast is treasonous to the black man's future.

What the white man must be brought to understand is that the black man in America today is fully aware of his position, and he do not intend to be tricked again into another hundred-year forfeit of freedom. Not for a single moment or for any price will the black men now rising up in America settle for anything less than their full proportionate share and participation in the sovereignty of America. The black man has already come to a realization that to be free it is necessary for him to throw his life -- every-thing -- on the line, because the oppressors refuse to understad that it is now impossible for them to come up with another trick to squelch the black revolution. The black man can't afford to take a chance. He can't afford to put things off. He must stop the whole NOW and get his business straight, because if he does not do it now, if he fails to grasp securely the reins of this historic opportunity, there may be notomorrow for him.

The black man's interest lies in seeing a free and independent Vietstrong Vietnam which is not the puttet of international white emacy. If the nations of Asia, Latin America, and Africa are strong and free, the black man in America will be safe and secure and free to live in dignity and selfrespect. It is a cold fact that while the nations of Africa, Asia, and Latin America were shackled in colonial bondage, the black Amerwas held tightly in the vise of oppression and not permitted to utter a sound of protest of any effect. But when these nations started bidding for their freedo it was then that black Americans able to seize the chance; it was then that the white man vielded what little he did -- out of sheer necessity. The only lasting salva-tion for the black American is to do all he can to see to it that the African, Asian, and Latin American nations are free and independent.

voice be heard on these issues. They must let the world know where they stand.



"Fully half" the U.S. troops in Vietnam are "against the war to some extent," the noted Chicago Daily News correspondent Georgie Ann Geyer concluded after cover ing the war for six months.
"Many of these men say the ex

perience of Vietnam has led them to a deep cynicism and skepticism about many of their country's mo-

tives and actions."

These highly significant observations about the attitudes and morale of U.S. soldiers in the war were covered in a five-article series in the Chicago Daily News beginning Jan. 13. The CDN press service is nationally syndicated.

In essence, Miss Geyer found that the same, but "much more heralded revolutions on the campus, in the ghetto and in American political and social struc-tures' are going on in the Army in tures' are going on in the Army in Vietnam. 'It has an Old Right, a New Left, a large middle ground, some aimless existentialists and a number of confused officers."

There is significant antiwar movement among the troops: "Side by side with the highly professional as a technical endeavor, is a large and vociferous group that frankly does not believe in the war and

does not believe in the war and says so with amazing candor."
This group, which includes "many of the best educated of the young officers," in particular questions "the rights and wrongs of the Vietnam war and American involvement in it."

The biggest factor that has turned GIs in Vietnam against the war, according to Miss Geyer, is that blatant corruption of the Saigon regime these soldiers are being asked to defend:

"It is certainly one of the first times in history that soldiers have admired the enemy more than they admire their allies."

Notable was this sentiment even among relatively high-ranking of-ficers. 'How can you have land reform when all the landowners are the officials in Saigon?" a lieutenant colonel asked Miss Gever.

ERGEANT Mobutu, the all-powerful ruler of the Kinshasa Republic of the Congo, thanks to the backing of the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency, has obviously succeeded in buttressing his power, during this first round helped along by succeeded in buttressing his power, during this first round helped along by sing weaknesses of the Congolese revolutionary movement and the support of those—some of them well-intentioned—who consider Mobutu a temporary solution to the Congolese problem which has cost so many tens of thousands of lives beginning long before February 13, 1961, the date of Patrice Lumumba's assassination by troops at the service of the United Nations, with the direct participation of Moise Tshombe and Joseph Mobutu.

Leopoldville has adopted the name of Kinshasa, and Lumumba, martyr of the African Revolution, has been declared a national hero of the Congo by no less a person than Mobutu, one of his murderes, and the congoles and the congoles of political activities in neighborhoods, plantations and factories peopled or staffed by the Congolese masses, and it certainly must be admitted that he has succeeded in confusing a considerable segment of the people, abstred by the lack of real, effective, practical and steady opposition on the part of the revolutionary movement.

thousands of Congolese patriots, organized into guerrilla units, fought against Tshombe's rule. At that time the second zone of operations, the Eastern Front, was commanded by Laurent Kavila, aided by Massengo as Chief and the Congoles of the Congoles of

The first soc of operations was the only one to stand up after 1966. Only a few months ago, however, its commander in chief. Pier-i Mulélé legendary guerrilla, failing to recall the experience of Lumunba, the martyr, placci his confidence in forces which were not exactly those of the people in arms and naively delivered himself up to Mobutu, influenced perhaps by lack of support, the growing division in the ranks of the Congolese revolutionary strungle he had sustained. It is for the revolutionary cause in particular and the Congolese cause in general — which must unite us. Two years later, how a direct order to do so from a high-ranking U.S. official when the ruler was on a stopover in Morocco on his way back to Leopoldville.

Clearly Perre Mulélé, who had diminished the grandeur of his revolutionary stature in returning to Leopoldville, was then abandoning the necessary path, the only one which can first curb and then destroy forever, not only Mobuttu but everything his rule of puppets and brass hats represents. The war cannot be waged against the figure of Mobutu. Certain revolutionaries, once more indulging

in "naiveté," even tried to make contact with the mercenary forces of Katanga (which, in 1967, were fighting against Mobutu), failing to understand that even if this government got backing and suceeeded in staying in power with the aid of the U.S. Government and the direct participation of the Yankee Green Berets, the Katanga mercenaries also represented imperialism, and that the objective of both the mercenaries and Mobutu was the same — namely, to guarantee the exploitation of the country's vast wealth by imperialism, the true and fundamental enemy of the Congolese people and of humanity in general.

It is impossible to combat or destroy the strongholds of imperialism in the Congo while so-called revolutionaries such as Zenon Matimba — who returned to Leopoldville with Mulélé and chose to ignore the fate of the latter — continue to encourage divisionism within the movement itself, splits based on questions of international politics and completely unrelated to the advancement of the Congolese people's liberation struggle, or while there are theoreticians such as Nima, who committed himself to leadership of the revolutionary movement and then, after only three days on the march to lend moral and not the time by Mulélé combatante of the Front (headed at the time by Mulélé combatante of the Front (headed at the time by Mulélé programs worked out by Botcheley and Kasimbura (both of whom have been reported dead on the Eastern Front as a result of internal strife), which are based fundamentally on the organization of a political party to head up the struggle they themselves were unable to wage, will not be conducive to success. Seeds of hatred and divisionism have been planted, and the fruit they have borne has been only the strengthening of Mobutu's position. And those responsible can be found in the ranks of the revolutionary movement itself.

Today, eight years after the death of Lumumba, there is only one way to defend the principles for which he died in the cause of African liberation.

Placing our faith in Mobutu, abandoning the revolutionaries of the Congo because of internal differences, because of political weaknesses and indecision, will never get us onto the road of the Congolese Revolution.

Certain revolutionary groups, not affiliated with any Congolese party or organization, are prepared to renew and advance the liberation struggle. The CNL, under the leadership of Gaston Soumialot, has once more stated that it is prepared to advance the armed struggle. Thus, most of the leaders of that organization have left Cairo. Moreover, rumors seem to indicate that Kavila has once again taken up the revolutionary struggle, after a visual capitals of East Africa. In addition, certain CNL spokesmen have stated that the Eastern Front has held on and that it is making progress in organization.

To those who are prepared, over and above all other considerations, to offer up their lives as a contribution to victory, we wish to stress our readiness to stand side by side with them, and we send them our encouragement and militant support, but we urge the fulfillment of one absolutely necessary condition — namely, that they stand up for, put into practice and prove their conscientious dedication to the revolutionary cause, that the writings and trips to African capitals cease, as well as the expressions of demoralization at the lack of support from those who historically should be lending it, and that they fully promote and utilize that great invincible force represented by their people. They must become sufficient unto themselves by facing up to these issues and growing greater in resisting difficulties. The memory of Lumumba is to be defended in direct and determined confrontation with imperialism in the fight unto victory or death.

What We Want What We Believe

1. We want freedom. We want power to determine the destiny of our Black Community.

We believe that black people will not be free until we are able to determine our destiny.

2. We want full employment for our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white American businessmen will not give full employment, then the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living.

3. We want an end to the robbery by the white man of our Black Community.

We believe that this racist government has robbed us and now we are demanding the overdue debt of forty acres and two mules. Forty acres and two mules was promised 100 years ago as restitution for slave labor and mass murder of black people. We will accept the payment in currency which will be distributed to our many communities. The Germans are now aiding the Jews in Israel for the genocide of the Jewish people. The Germans murdered six million Jews. The American racist has taken part in the slaughter of over fifty million black people; therefore, we feel that this is a modest demand that we make.

4. We want decent housing, fit for shelter of human beings.

We believe that if the white landlords will not give decent housing to our black community, then the housing and the land should be made into cooperatives so that our community, with government aid, can build and make decent housing for its people. 5. We want education for our people that exposes the true nature of this decadent American society. We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present-day society.

We believe in an educational system that will give to our people a knowledge of self. If a man does not have knowledge of himself and his position in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

6. We want all black men to be exempt from military service.

We believe that Black people should not be forced to fight in the military service to defend a racist government that does not protect us. We will not fight and kill other people of color in the world who, like black people, are being victimized by the white racist government of America. We will protect ourselves from the force and violence of the racist police and the racist military, by whatever means necessary.

. 7. We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY and MURDER of black people.

We believe we can end police brutality in our black community by organizing black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all black people should arm themselves for self-defense.

8. We want freedom for all black men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails.

We believe that all black people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

9. We want all black people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peer group or people from their black communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that black people will receive fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a man a right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the black community from which the black defendant came. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man" of the black community.

10. We want land, bread, housing, education, clothing, justice and peace. And as our major political objective, a United Nations-supervised plebiscite to be held throughout the black colony in which only black colonial subjects will be allowed to participate, for the purpose of determining the will of black people as to their national destiny.

When, in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume, among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We had these twice the test of goident that the laws are averaged expelled.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and, accordingly, all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But, when a long train of abuses and unsurpations, pursuing invariably the same object, evinces a design to reduce them under absolute despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new guards for their future security.

RULES OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY

CENTRAL HEADQUARTERS OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA..

Every member of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY throughout this Every member of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY throughout this country of racist America must abide by these rules as functional members of this party. CENTRAL COMMITTEE members, CENTRAL STAFFS, and LOCAL STAFFS, including all captains subordinate to either national, state, and local leadership of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY will enforce these rules. Length of suspension or other disciplinary action necessary for violation of these rules will depend on national decisions by national, state or state area, and local committees and stoffs where said rule or rules of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY. and staffs where said rule or rules of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY

Every member of the party must know these verbatum by heart. And apply them daily. Each member must report any violation of these rules to their leadership or they are counter-revolutionary and are also subjected to suspension by the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.

THE RULES ARE:

- 1. No party member can have narcotics or weed in his possession while doing party work.
- 2. Any party member found shooting narcotics will be expelled from
- 2. Any party member found shooting narcotics will be expelled from this party.
 3. No party member can be DRUNK while doing daily party work.
 4. No party member will violate rules relating to office work, general meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY, and meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY ANYWHERE.
 5. No party member will USE, POINT, or FIRE a weapon of any kind unnecessarily or accidentally at anyone.
 6. No party member can join any other army force other than the BLACK LIBERATION ARMY.

- No party member can have a weapon in his possession while DRUNK or loaded off narcotics or weed.
- 8. No party member will commit any crimes against other party members or BLACK people at all, and cannot steal or take from the people, not even a needle or a piece of thread.

 9. When arrested BLACK PANTHER MEMBERS will give only name, address, and will sign nothing. Legal first aid must be understood by all Perty prophers.

 10. The Ten Point Program and platform of the BLACK PANTHER

 Party Communications must be National and Local.

 19. Only office personnel assigned to respective offices each day should be there. All others are to sell papers and do Political work out in the community, including Captains, Section Leaders, etc.

SOUL ON ICE?

"IT IS ONLY A MATTER OF TIME UNTIL THE QUESTION OF THE PRISONER'S DEBT TO SOCIETY VERSUS SOCIETY'S DEBT TO THE

PRISONER IS INJECTED FORCEFULLY INTO NATIONAL AND STATE POLITICS, INTO THE CIVIL AND HUMAN RIGHTS STRUGGLE, AND INTO THE CONSCIOUSNESS OF THE BODY POLITIC. IT IS AN EXPLOSIVE ISSUE WHICH GOES TO THE VERY ROOT OF AMERICA'S SYSTEM OF JUSTICE, THE STRUCTURE OF CRIMINAL LAW, THE PREVAILING BELIEFS AND ATTITUDES TOWARD A CONVICTED FELON." (SOUL ON ICE, P.59)

Eldridge Cleaver made the decision to politically exile himself November 27th, on the basis that the Adult Authority made an outlaw decision, and that he has been denied his constitutional right to due process of law.

The revocation of Cleaver's parole was illegal, because no parole violation was committed.

The Adult Authority parole board has tried to maintain that Cleaver violated his parole by having a rifle in his possession, and by associating with individuals of bad reputation. This contention, we will show, is false. The Adult Authority version contradicts the Superior Court order itself:

"... Cleaver's only handling of a firearm (the rifle) was in obedience to a police command. He did not handle a hand gun at all. There was nothing one way or the other to show a conspiracy or a situation calling for the application of the doctrine of aiding and abetting. Hence, nothing supported either the possession of a firearm or the assault charge.

As to the charge of association with individuals of bad reputation, the report indicated that two or three of those named had "police records," but nothing to show whether any had been convicted of anything, or whether Cleaver knew of their arrest record." (Superior Court c.t. 137, 138, 140, 141)

Parolee Cleaver was denied due process of law by being denied opportunity to present his case.

Why was Cleaver returned to prison as a parole violator if documented evidence to the contrary had been presented in his defense? To answer that question, one must examine the Adult Authority. This board has the right to arbitrarily revoke or suspend parole on any individual. At the same time, the Adult Authority maintains—falsely—that Cleaver has the opportunity to defend himself at a hearing. This is how it works:

"A parolee is served with violation charges, is interviewed, is given a hearing (before the Adult Authority itself, the charging party) at which the parolee may 'plead' to the parole violation charges, and is afforded an opportunity to present his defense."

"At the 'hearing' a parolee is denied the right to counsel, may not have an independent and impartial officer to conduct the hearing and make decision." (Petition for Hearing in the Supreme Court, p. 17)

Not only does the Adult Authority hold secret hearings, but it also refuses to notify persons under its jurisdiction of its procedures, or of its variable definitions of what constitutes a parole violation. This secrecy and vagueness is in direct violation of federal law which requires agencies to publish their procedures "for guidance of the public."

"Petitioner (Cleaver) is immediately and seriously prejudiced by the Adult Authority's unlawful refusal to publish its regulations, since he is to be imprisoned by virtue of an action which the Adult Authority still seeks to garb in this 'veil of secrecy.' (Petition for Hearing in the Supreme Court, p. 12)

Yes, the Adult Authority acted unjustly and illegally. Its decision was an outlaw decision. Cleaver had no chance of obtaining "justiee" from these Star Chamber proceedings. Why then wouldn't the U.S. Supreme Court hear Cleaver's case? There are, we believe, three reasons why the case wasn't accepted. The first is that any fair minded court would obviously have released Cleaver, thereby setting a precedent. The second is that thousands of cases of alleged parole violation from all over California and other states would be subject to reversal. Thirdly, the illegal functioning of the Adult Authority would come under attack. The U.S. Supreme Court just couldn't afford to consider the Cleaver case during this turbulent period.

Eldridge Cleaver is a victim of naked, shameless political persecution. As Judge Sherwin puts it:

"... The uncontradicted evidence presented to this court indicated that the petitioner had been a model parolee. The peril to his parole status stemmed from no failure of personal rehabilitation, but from his undue eloquence in pursuing political goals, goals which were offensive to many of

his contemporaries. Not only was there absence of cause for the cancellation of parole, it was the product of a type of pressure unbecoming, to say the least, to the law enforcement paraphernalia of this state."

Cleaver is in political exile because a man of his convictions cannot get justice here. Indeed, if we are to give more than lip service to the concepts of freedom and justice we must support him. The work to get him discharged from parole must continue. An intense publicity campaign is necessary now to bring to the public the legal defense and arguments which were carried to the courts with no satisfaction. We must all work together to focus attention of this case. This is not an issue of one man's freedom, but a broad struggle which affirms the right of all of us to speak out politically in this country. If Cleaver is not allowed his freedom, it is just a matter of time until all our freedoms are further reduced. His is not a personal struggle but a political one.

BLACK PEOPLE: KEEP YOUR GUNS

CALIFORNIA AND FEDERAL GUN LAWS

This article is to serve as a guide for the members of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY and is not to be construed as a substitute for competent legal counsel.

12001 -- A concealable firearm is any firearm having a barrel less than 12 inches in length.

12025 -- Any person caught with a concealable firearm CONCEALED on their person or within any vehicle is guilty of a misdemeanor.

12026 -- No license is required for any citizen 18 years or over to keep a legal weapon in their

home or place of business. Come weapons require federal resistration.)

12027 -- Persons exempt from Section 12025 includes members of any club or organization organized for the purpose of practicing shooting at targets upon established target ranges, whether pubc or private, while such members are using firearms upon such target ranges, or while going to and

\(\frac{1}{2}\text{od} = 0.5 \) Except as provided in subdivision (b), every person who carries a loaded firearm on his person or in a vehicle while in any public place or on any public street in any incorporated city or in any public place or on any public place or on any public street in a prohibited area of unincorporated territory is guilty of a misdemeanor.

(b) Persons who are using target ranges for the purpose of practice shooting with a firearm, or who are members of shooting clubs while hunting on the premises for such clubs.

(c) In order to determine whether or not a firearm is loaded, pigs are authorized to examine any firearm carried by anyone on his person or in a vehicle while in any public place. Refusal to allow a pig to inspect a firearm constitutes probable cause for arrest.

(h) Nothing in this section is intended to preclude the carrying of any loaded firearm, under circumstances where it would be otherwise be lawful, by a person who reasonably believes that the person or property of himself or another is in immediate danger and that the carrying of such a weapon is necessary for the preservation of such person or property.

(j) Nothing in this section shall prevent any person from having a loaded weapon, if it is other-

(j) Nothing in this section shall prevent any person from having a loaded weapon, if it is otherwise lawful, at his place of residence, including any temporary residence or campsite. 1252 -- Every person who furnishes any firearm, air gun, or gas-operated gun, designed to fire a bullet, pellet or metal projectile, to any minor under the age of 18 years, without the expressed or implied permission of the parent or legal guardian of the manor, is guilty of a misdemeanor. 12560 -- Any felon who owns, has in his possession or under his custode or control any firearm is punishable by imprisonment in the State Prison not exceeding 15 years, or in a county jail not exceeding one year and/or by a fine not exceeding \$500.

(i) Title X of the Civil Rights Act provides that anyone who demonstrates, manufacturers, transports, or teaches the use of firearms, explosives, or incendiary devices for use in riots or civil disorders may be imprisoned for up to 5 years and fined \$10,000.

(2) Title VII of the Crime Control Act states that felons, veterans discharged other than honorably, mental incompetent, aliens illegally in the United States, or former U.S. citizens who have renounced their citizenship, who possess, receive, or transport interstate any firearm may be punished by a fixed \$10.000. fine of \$10,000.

(3) The National Firearm Act requires that a \$200tax be paid on each transfer of any fully automatic farearm, rifles with barrels under 16 inches, shogguns with barrels under 18 inches, any rifle or shotgun under 26 inches overall, or silencers. The Act also requires that the \$200 tax be paid on the making of any firearm that meets the specifications listed above.

THE FOLLOWING LAWS BECAME EFFECTIVE ON DECEMBER 16, 1968

(1) Only a licensed manufacturer or dealer may ship or transport interstate any firearm (other

than a rifle or a shotgun) or any ammunition to anyone but a licensed dealer or manufacturer. (Licensed importers may also ship and receive all firearms and ammunition interstate.)

(2) No one but a licensed dealer, manufacturer, or importer may receive in his state of residence any firearm (other than a rifle or shotgun) that has been obtained by him outside his state of residence

(3) Only a licensed dealer, manufacturer, or importer may give, trade, transfer, transport, or deliver any firearm (other than a rifle or shotgun to anyone living in another state.)

(4) To receive or transport into any state a firearm that cannot be legally purchased in that state

a federal offense,

(5) Only a licensed dealer, importer, or manufacturer may ship or transport in interstate commerce

, automatic weapon or any sawed-off shotgun or rifle.
This article is not intended as a substitute for competent legal counsel.

POCKET LAWYER OF LEGAL FIRST AID

This pocket lawyer is provided as a means of keeping black people up to date on their rights. We are always the first to be arrested and the racist police forces are constantly trying to pre-tend that rights are extended equally to all people. Cut this out, brothers and sisters, and carry it with you. Until we arm ourselves to righteously take care of our own, the pocket lawyer is what's happening.

1. If you are stopped and/or arrested by the police, you may remain silent; you do not have to answer any questions about alleged crimes, you should provide your name and address only if requested (although it is not absolutely clear that you must do so.) But then do so, and at all time remember the fifth amendment.

2. If a police officer is not in uniform, ask him to show his identification. He has no authority over you unless he properly identifies himself. Beware of persons posing as police officers. Always get his badge number and his name.

3. Police have no right to search your car or your home unless they have a search warrant, probable cause or your consent. They may conduct no exploratory search, that is, one for evidence of crime generally or for evidence of a crime unconnected with the one you are being questioned about. (Thus, a stop for an auto violation does not give the right to search the auto.) You are not required to consent to a search; therefore, you should not consent and should state clearly and unequivocally that you do not consent, in front of witnesses if possible. If you do not consent, the police will have the burden in court of showing probably cause. Arrest may be corrected later.

4. You may not resist arrest forcibly or by going limp, even if you are innocent. To do so is a separate crime of which you can be convicted even if you are acquitted of the original charge. Do not resist arrest under any circumstances.

5. If you are stopped and/or arrested, the police may search you by patting you on the outside of your clothing. You can be stripped of your personal possessions. Do not carry anything that includes the name of your employer or friends.

7. Do not engage in "friendly" conversation with officers on the way to or at the station. Once you are arrested, there is little likelihood that anything you say will get you released.

8. As soon as you have been booked, you have the right to complete at least two phone calls — one to a relative, friend or attorney, the other to a bail bondsman. If you can, call the Black Panther Party, 845-0103 (845-0104), and the Party will post bail if possible

9. You must be allowed to hire and see an attorney immediately 10. You do not have to give any statement to the police, nor do you have to sign any statement you might give them, and therefore you should not sign anything. Take the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments, because you cannot be forced to testify against

11. You must be allowed to post bail in most cases, but you must be able to pay the bail bondsmen's fee. If you cannot pay the fee, you may ask the judge to release you from custody without bail or to lower your bail, but he does not have to do so.


12. The police must bring you into court or release you within 48 hours after your arrest (unless the time ends on a week-end or a holiday, and they must bring you before a judge the first day court

13. If you do not have the money to hire an attorney, immedi-

ately ask the police to get you an attorney without charge.

14. If you have the money to hire a private attorney, but do not know of one, call the National Lawyers' Guild or the Alameda County Bar Association (or the Bar Association of your county) and furnish you with the name of an attorney who practices criminal
