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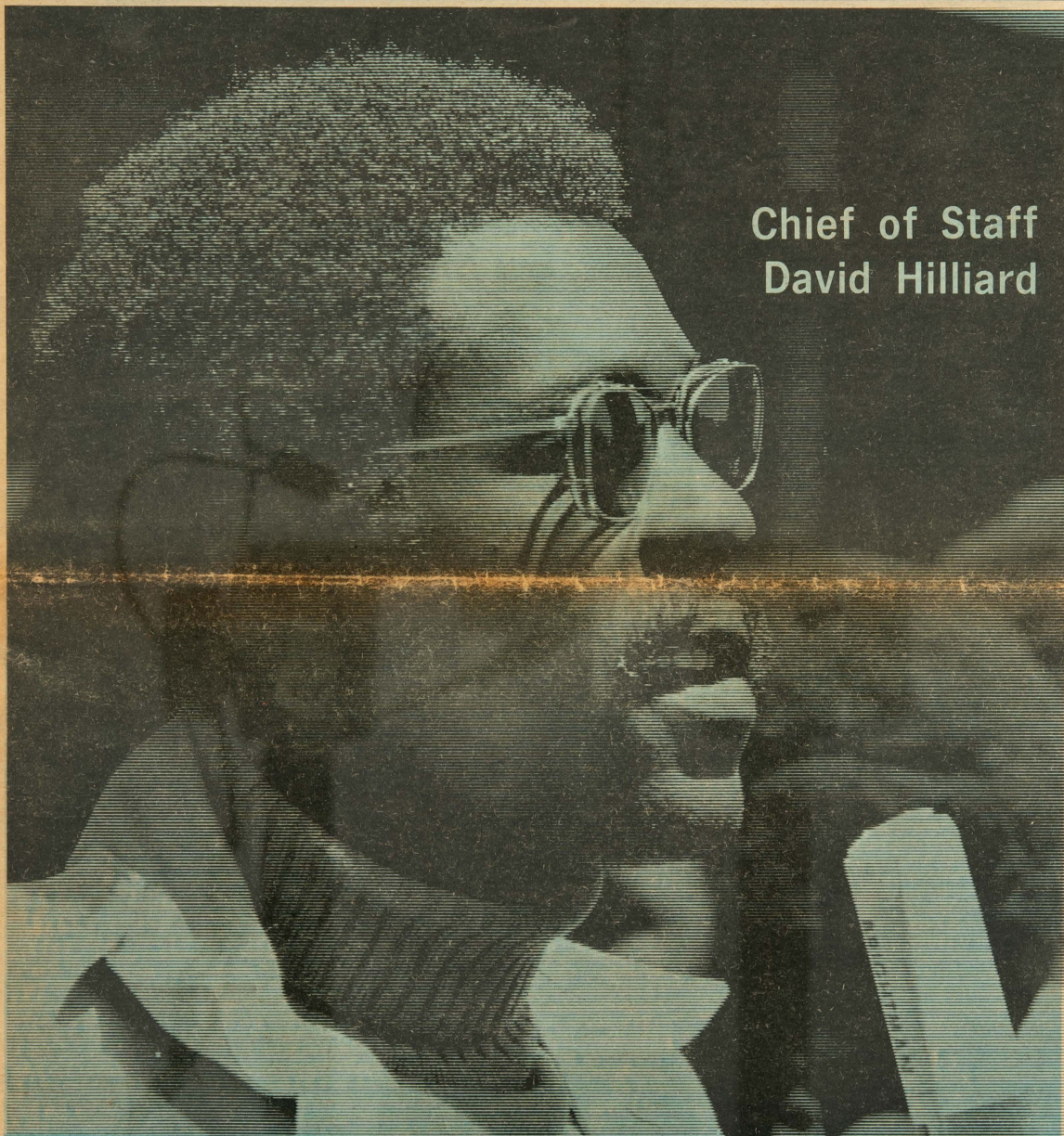

**NEXT VICTIM OF
FASCIST FRAMEUP?**

LETTER FROM CHAIRMAN BOBBY - NO.2

A revolutionary politician entrenched in the community is the key to Black people understanding the Party on a broad scale. Black people all over the Black community have heard of the Party's Ten Point Platform and Program. Black people have heard of the Free Breakfast for Children (before school) Program. I'm pretty sure they are aware that a petition for Community Control of Police is being circulated in the community. The people actually know, basically, what they want, even though it's all outlined in the Ten Point Program of "What We Want, and What We Believe."

Now where and how do we revolutionary politicians bring the people over? When? When we begin to do this, of course, is now. Where is, of course, down in the communities. How? This will be regulated to Community Centers and door-to-door contact with the people of the community on a day to day basis. What more do we need to be able to make the Party's political line clear and get Black people to move? We have to be able to show them the significance, the basic essence--the general besides the particulars--of any specific community program, remembering that we are not opportunistic and that we are not trying to trick the people in any shape, form, or fashion. We are, in fact, dedicated to the struggle to help them take state power, starting with the pig forces. One must be a real, honest revolutionary who can give depth in NOT long, confusing explanations or being overly doctrinaire with everything you read, but really show the masses the hows, whys, etc. of community control of police and the political significance as it's related to pigs attacking Panthers and making political prisoners of our members. This is the toughest job of all. We can't be negligent at any point and must relate listening closely to our comrades and take responsibility--not authority, but responsibility--to carry out the arduous task, thereby developing to be revolutionary politicians.

We must understand this: When the Party circulates and moves the people outside the Party to circulate the petition for Community Control of Police on a national scale (and now we have five cities started: Los Angeles, Oakland, Berkeley, Richmond, and San Francisco--automatically fascist. Alioto should pop into everyone's head), now that we've got this moving then we must see the essence of the revolutionary politics related to the petitions. The most beautiful idea David (Hilliard) made one day was this: David said, "We don't need to work on any time schedule for a ballot date and let PIGS say when we can vote for the control of the police." David went on. "We'll go out and get 100,000 signatures in every city and then that will be the voice of how we vote." Brothers, do you know what popped into my head then? This; I thought to myself, 'Yeah, because all we need is a majority of the people to vote it in, for one example, with a proposition on the ballot. But if in Berkeley where we need 13,000 to get the city council to put it on the ballot, instead of just getting 15%, 13,000 registered voters' signatures, we get 100,000. That would be way over the majority of voters in that city. I thought about Oakland where we would need 23,000 signatures for the ballot. "But if in Oakland," I thought to myself, "we set the goal at 175,000 or 200,000, then that would be way over the majority of voters needed to vote in Community Control of Police." I thought about the possibility of this going on in every city across the country, especially where Black people live and where we had a National Committee (to Combat Fascism) which might work hard for these kinds of goals. I thought and asked myself a question. 'How hard would the pigs come down on us then?' The answer to myself was, 'harder than they had been doing before.' Through all these thoughts David said, "When we get that many signatures, then they'll give up a special election automatically." Then the reason that the pigs would come down harder on us was clearer than ever. It was clear in the fashion of revolutionary politics--a revolutionary politics on a level where one can really see what the Community Control of Police petition really meant with the people destroying the fascist pig power structure.

Check this out, I thought. All those brothers and sisters who are registered voters and all those people not in the Black community but also the Brown people and many white working class and other poor people across this nation who are also all registered voters in the--check--IN THE DEMOCRATIC OR REPUBLICAN PARTY (to hell with Wallace's party!) This would become a revolutionary operation promulgated by the Black Panther Party that would be transferring, actually changing, for the first time those millions of brainwashed registered voters over to the REVOLUTIONARY CAMP. Nixon, Daley of Chicago,

Reagan, etc., etc., Republicans or Democrats, can't allow that petition because we would be pulling people in the millions--people who can also be moved to demand that Huey be set free, to demand that Charles, Ericka, and the Connecticut Panthers, the New York 21, and all political prisoners be set free.

The Democratic and Republican parties in the political machine are, as everyone knows, the parties of the fascist ruling class. Alioto is a Democrat; Nixon is a Republican. Hell, they ain't fighting each other; shit, they're both working together to keep the Black Panther Party from getting all of their brainwashed voters who have become at least aware of the fact that they don't want no more pig brutality and murder. We'll be beginning to transfer the masses of registered voters who are either in the Republican or Democratic party, both the parties of the present ruling class. Shit. That kind of blew my mind. I got flashbacks of Party materials I had been reading, trying to figure out what revolutionary principle that would be based on. It hit me later that the revolutionary people amass in one camp and the bourgeoisie ruling class and their running dogs amass in another. Win the masses, be concerned with their well-being, and they will surely take up with the struggle.






I think everyone remembers how I explain making one example of community control of police will cause everybody across the nation, especially in the thousands of cities where Black and/or Brown people are brutalized and murdered (people from all over will be here or finding out about the National Committees and the Black Panther Party) to try to move against the pigs. This will be, in essence, more people coming to work to get signatures in their respective cities. Signatures? Yes, sig-

natures of registered voters. That will be on a broad scale. Millions more will be siding with the revolutionary camp. One can see clearly how it's necessary to do this every day--extra legal work. We can see the necessity to work hard to organize the people to go out with the petition. It is necessary to study, but be as consistent as possible with the correct Party line and also, and especially, the programs and functions of the Party in the community.

I was trying to run that down so Party members have a broader perspective of the revolutionary politics. Some people don't understand how to relate the petition to revolutionary politics where the masses participate or begin to participate in attacking the armed bodies of the state because, while we're working with the Community Control of Police (petition), we will also be getting the community to work with the Party on the Breakfast for Children. And our goal, of course, is to see to it that 20,000 children are fed in the bay area alone. And if other Party chapters and branches work across the country, over 100,000 children can receive free breakfasts every morning. One hundred thousand children everyday, regardless if it's in the Party or anyone else giving free breakfast, shows the people that the Party is concerned with their well-being and NOT the ruling class who are fascists and liars. Free clothing (new clothing from the businessmen of clothing stores). Liberation Schools, and Free Health Clinics throughout the communities across this country are the basic necessities to get the people to be aware and conscious of the need for change; and the Black Panther Party, along with the Party's organizing bureaus (N.C.C.F.) can promulgate and move this struggle to a higher level.

'SEIZE THE TIME'

What is there to talk about? It's been three years now since Huey Newton founded the Black Panther Party and many things have happened.

In the past three years many of the things that have happened here in Babylon (America) have been the routine fluctuations of a decadent, racist, capitalist society. These routine happenings have been punctuated by some events that are not so routine but yet are the natural products of a cesspool society.

On the other hand, Huey Newton has been shot and jailed and Black and White communities have responded with indignation, rage, shock, rallies, funds, and demonstrations. Meanwhile, in the mother country, mini-skirts got shorter, and hair got longer. In the colony the quality of red-devils went down and the price of weed went up.

Little Bobby Hutton, the first to join, became the first to die. The Black Community was indignant, the liberal White Community was shocked. The community again responds with demonstrations and funds. During this time the pigs have stepped up their attacks against the Party, and the Party has grown. In the mother country the "hippies" have turned to "yippies," and the "liberals" have become "radicals". The Black Colony is filled with "hippies" (Black hippies) in Afro-garb, Swahili names, and cultural fixations.

Eldridge Cleaver was wounded when Li'l Bobby was murdered, then jailed and beaten. In the mother country people were devoting their lives to "rock music" and "light-shows". "Underground" papers were springing up everywhere with politics and pulchritude on the front page and want ads for the hard-up as a filler. People were "doing their thing" and "finding themselves". The Black Colony was seething with talk of guerrilla warfare, and saturated with poverty programs. In the Black Colonies the "advances" made by the psychedelic Whites have produced many new "cheap highs."

Eldridge Cleaver chooses self-exile rather than a return to prison and sure death. A few are concerned and many are still "doing their thing". The repression on the Party increases again and niggers in the colony sing of "cloud nine" while White boys in Babylon build bigger and better amplifiers for guitars.

Charles Bursley and Warren Wells become political prisoners as a result of the April 6th shoot-out. Luncy Carter and John Huggins have already been buried. Mother country radicals engage in heated ideological debates, they champion the cause of the Vietnamese Freedom Fighters, and squeeze more politics into their "Underground" papers. In the Colonies "Black militants" scream for Afro-American Studies and hope for the promised Black Capitalism.

A wave of raids, shoot-outs, and frame-ups has swept the nation with Panthers as the main target. White James Rector, a bystander, is killed in the struggle at Peoples' Park. Two more Panthers are killed by "niggers" just trying to be "Black". Rock-light shows become bigger and better, and a new trip pops up in the mo-

ther country as people delve into the occult for solutions to problems. Meanwhile in the colony young, would be pimps, drive Volkswagens as they dream of Eldorado, and the quality drops on the Bennies.

The Black Panther Party weathers the storm, purges its ranks, and grows nationally and internationally. The Black Panther Party calls for a United Front Against Fascism, and the fascist repression intensifies. Chicago, two raids, a couple of shoot-outs many frame-ups; New York frame-ups (14 in jail, many others underground -- two million dollars in ransom).

Chairman Bobby Seale is kidnapped by F.B.I. pigs in the final attempt to finish the Black Panther Party. The use of a Black pig agent in the frame-up catches

many people by surprise, but Mod-Squad is still a popular show in the colony. The Berkeley Tribe reveals a Berkeley plot to finish off the rest of the Central Committee and Central Staff. The pig media blocks it from public view, while the "Underground" newspapers that comment on it treat it as the story of a near-serious auto accident.

This has been a quick run-down on the three years that the Black Panther Party has existed/survived. Most of the details, and much of the repression has necessarily been omitted. This brings us to the present.

With Bobby in jail facing a multitude of phony charges in New Haven and Chicago, the man most wanted by the powers that run this country is Chief of Staff, David Hilliard. In the near fu-

ture the pigs will attempt to jail and/or kill David Hilliard. The Chief of Staff will be tried for a second time on charges stemming from the April 6th shoot-out. (His first trial on these charges of attempted murder resulted in a dismissal, but the D.A. appealed the dismissal).

As yet another leader of the people stands between the people and the wrath of the fascist power structure. How much more apathy shall we witness from the "militants", radicals", and "revolutionaries". How much psychedelic escapism, idealistic-tripping, greedy political scheming, and opportunism shall we witness.

Perhaps there are groups waiting eagerly to wear the mantle of the "New Vanguard". Maybe there are those that feel their ide-

ological - rhetorical well - being threatened and see the fascist pigs as saviours. The cases of David Hilliard and Bobby Seale will tell. It's hard to see who's for real just by coming to funerals. The Party has had over twenty funerals with thousands of mourners but that entails no commitment, not like a gun or a petition, and not like a gun and a petition.

So what's there to talk about?

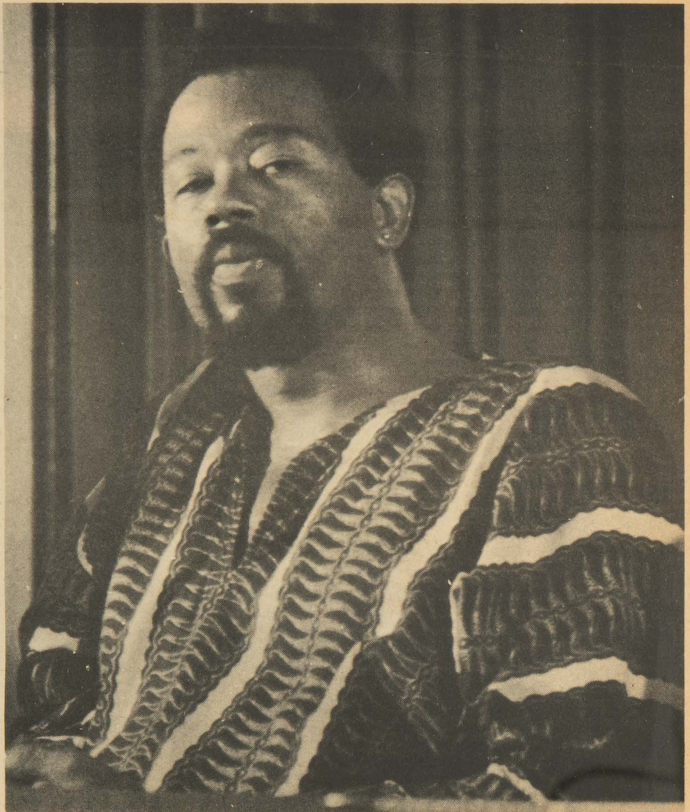

PRESS RELEASE FROM ELDRIDGE CLEAVER MINISTER OF INFORMATION BLACK PANTHER PARTY, ALGERIA

Regarding the massive repression of the Black Panther Party culminating with the arrest and seizure of Chairman Bobby Seale, Bobby Seale, Chairman of the Black Panther Party was arrested by a massive squad of FBI agents on August 19th outside of the State Church in Berkeley, while returning from a wedding of friends. He is being held in the City Jail of San Francisco without bail. The FBI has charged Chairman Bobby Seale with murder, conspiracy to commit murder, kidnap, and conspiracy to commit kidnap.

Through news released to me by David Hilliard, Chief of Staff of the Black Panther Party, it is crystal clear that the arrest of Chairman Bobby Seale is part and parcel of the intensified campaign of repression launched by President Nixon against the Black Panther Party.

Nixon has released his repressive forces against the Party. Starting with the frameup of Huey P. Newton, Minister of Defense of the Black Panther Party in October 1967, in his being railroaded into prison the obvious pattern indicates that the order has been given to destroy the Party. Thus we have seen a massive roundup of members of the Black Panther Party throughout the length and breadth of the USA. Most recently 21 members of the Party were arbitrarily arrested on conspiracy charges and held for bails of \$100,000 and \$200,000. Sixteen members of the Party were similarly arrested in Chicago and held for excessive bail sums. Seven members have been held on charges to commit murder without any bail in Connecticut. Two members in Denver have been held on charges of inter-state flight to avoid prosecution and the bails set at \$200,000.

It is clear that this massive campaign has been unleashed by the Nixon administration. The Mayor of San Francisco, Mussolini Alioto has taken a leading role in traveling throughout the USA and denouncing the Black Panther Party and thereby spear-heading the creation of an atmosphere of hysteria and confusion. Mayor of San Francisco, Mussolini Alioto after failing to obtain a local Grand Jury investigation into the Black Panther Party obtained a Federal Grand Jury investigation in San Francisco which resulted in nothing but a smear campaign against the Black Panther Party. It is in San Francisco State that this fascist pig is Mayor and where Chairman Bobby Seale is now being held.

On the National level the McClellan Committee launched a series of circus like hearings during which a parade of police agents came forth to testify to sensational charges against the Party. And now at the close of the McClellan Committee hearing the FBI is conducting another wave of arrests of Black Panther Party members. Even a special task force made up of FBI Agents from different departments has been created to conduct a special investigation. It is clear from these arrests that the target continues to be the top leadership and Central Staff of the Black Panther Party. The arrest of Chairman Bobby Seale is the most blatant move to date by the forces of fascism in their current campaign of repression. Legal procedures and regards for the rights of the accused have been thrown out of the window and the other tactics of the fascist repression being employed are reminiscent of the tactics used by Hitler in Nazi Germany.

Having tried and failed numerous times to frame Chairman Bobby Seale in the San Francisco Bay Area which they were unable to do because of the overwhelming support given him by the people, the fascists began to fabricate ways to arrest him outside of the Bay Area. They indicted him in Chicago on a conspiracy charge to disrupt the Democratic Convention along with members of SDS, the Democratic Youth National Party and other Peace Groups who organized the demonstration against the Democratic National Party Convention. Now these pigs have charged Chairman Bobby Seale with murder, conspiracy to commit murder, kidnap, and conspiracy to commit kidnap.

An agent provocateur named George Sams was sent into the San Francisco Bay Area from Detroit into the Black Panther Party by Stokely Carmichael last summer being used by the FBI to justify the arrest of Chairman Bobby Seale. This man George Sams was quickly discovered to be functioning in a hostile manner calculated to destroy the Black Panther Party and has been barred from ever entering any offices of the Party in the USA. The FBI has released to the press a statement given to them by George Sams. This press statement places Bobby Seale in Connecticut at the same time as the killing. The flagrant nature of this accusation against Chairman Bobby Seale becomes even more vicious when it is stated in the press statement issued by the FBI agent George Sams that Bobby Seale ordered the killing and that such a thing could not have happened without the unanimous consent of the Central Committee of the Black Panther Party.

During the Pan African Cultural Festival which occurred before the apprehension of Bobby Seale, the past and mutual problems the Party has had with the former Prime Minister Stokely Carmichael were discussed with him. One of the items was the problem created in the Party by the presence of George Sams and at that time Stokely admitted that he had made a

mistake by sending George Sams from Detroit to the San Francisco Bay Area and that he, Stokely had discovered that George Sams was a police agent. Asked why he had not relayed this information to the Black Panther Party, Stokely stated that he had been unable to contact anyone and that all letters he had sent to the Party, including the last ones mailed from Guinea in May 1969 had not been answered. He also stated that at the time of his letter of resignation from the Honorary Position of Prime Minister of the Black Panther Party why he had denounced the Party in the same vein and emphasis as the police agents were using to denounce the Party had nothing to do with the hearings because he did not even know that these hearings were taking place.

It is now clear that the arrest of the Chairman of the Black Panther Party by fascist FBI Agents was fabricated from a long awaited pretext for rounding up the entire Central Committee of the Black Panther Party.

FOR US THE PLOT TO DESTROY THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY IS CLEAR. WE CALL UPON THE PEOPLE OF THE WORLD TO POUR FORTH THEIR INDIGNATION AT THE FASCIST TIDE IN THE U.S.A.

WE CALL UPON THE PEOPLE TO ORGANIZE PROTESTS AGAINST THE ARREST OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY IN PARTICULAR AND AGAINST THE REPRESSION OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY IN GENERAL.

THE PEOPLES OF THE WORLD MUST THROW THEIR WEIGHT AGAINST THIS FASCISM AND HELP STEM THE TIDE BEFORE IT ENVELOPS THE WHOLE WORLD AND DROWNS OUT EVERY SPARK OF HUMANITY ON THE PLANET EARTH.

PANTHERS, PIGS AND FOOLS

Word has reached Black Panther Party National Headquarters that people posing as Black Panthers are popping up in cities across the nation. Two such incidents are particularly prevalent in the establishment media at present. One is Charlotte, North Carolina alleged "Black Panthers" have engaged in shoot-outs and so-called community programs. The Black Panther Party would like to inform all the people of Charlotte and the U.S. that no authorized legitimate representatives, members, Branches or Chapters of the Black Panther Party exist in the City of Charlotte. To the Black People of Charlotte we want to make it clear that the Black Panther Party seeks no monopoly on shoot-outs against Fascist, racist pigs, nor

do we claim the Breakfast Programs, or Free Health Clinics as our own. All these belong to the Party, and not the Black Panther Party. What must be understood is that only a pig or a fool would impersonate a Panther. A fool would do so only out of ignorance to the danger to himself, the Party and the people. A pig would do so for the sake of misrepresenting the Party, alienating the masses, infiltrating groups and organizations, provoking incidents, gathering information, and generally sabotaging the Peoples Struggle for Liberation.

We advise that the following Jack-n-Ape Negroes (that we must assume to be a conglomeration of Fools and Pigs) to cease representing themselves as mem-

bers of the Black Panther Party.
Grover Bennett - Co-Chairman Benjamin Harrison - So-Called Minister of Information and Education Ben Charis - "Party Chairman" (Sic) James Lovington - So-Called Minister of Defense Leonard Smith - Alleged Deputy Minister of Defense Veronia Huggins - So-Called Communications Secretary Bernita Culbreth - So-Called Corresponding Secretary Gene Gaither - Alleged Panther Jack Dixon - Alleged Panther James Michael Black 31, and James Edward Prother 17 Two alleged Panthers "arrested

in the August 16th shoot-out at Chicken-Ribs Restaurant are not members of the Black Panther Party. They are either fools and/or pigs.

NOTE: Ben Covington is the H.N.I.C. and most likely a Pig and to all who would aid, or abet this band of Jack-n-Apes, you should understand that as long as these people pose wrongfully as "Black Panthers" you are in fact "aiding the enemy".

WARNING

The actions of these Fools/Pigs can incur extreme anger from the people and such anger from the Masses has been known to cause extreme bodily harm. Add to this natural phenomenon a starved ego, an arrogant attitude, and terror-

izing the community by the alleged "Panthers" and one can see that anything could happen.

News reports of alleged "Panthers" in Oklahoma City have begun to drift in. The truth is that there is no authorized Branch or Chapter of the Black Panther Party in Oklahoma City, and any "Underground Panthers" would not announce their presence in the mass media. There is a Branch of the National Committee to Combat Fascism in Oklahoma City, and the two should not be confused. Anyone who fosters such confusion is either a fool and/or a pig.

ALL POWER TO THE PEOPLE

REAGAN CHEERS, "LOOK" ATTACKS - ALIOTO OINKS

It's been a very rough month for Mussolini Alioto Fascist Mayor of San Francisco. Recently Pig Alioto had been working to strengthen his Anti-Panther coalition with Sam Yorty, the Ambitious Fascist Mayor of Los Angeles. Pig Alioto's anti-Panther links with Yorty have been growing so until it reached the point that he was able to put in an appearance at the Happy Darkies (Watts Summer) Festival. Alioto has always voiced his love and understanding of "Millitants", and he put it into practice as he mixed with some of Watts "Blackest Millitants". The fact that Alioto, Yorty and Ron Karenga all see the Black Panther Party as a threat to their "status quo" is a very strong unifying cause. The Fascist Italian gangster, the Bootlicking Black Militant, and the All-American Anglo are feverishly conspiring to destroy the Black Panther Party. This gruesome three are not by any means the perpetrators of the nation-wide repression and persecution inflicted on the Black Panther Party. "Tricky Dick Nixon", "Pig Queeny Hoover", and "Rin-Tin-Reagan" will not be easily usurped no matter how ambitious the lesser Fascist may be.

THE BLUFF

A good indication of how big pigs (like Governor Reagan) keep little pigs (like Alioto) in line is the recent tussle over "Gun laws" (not pros and cons but jurisdiction). Although big pig Reagan is the Governor of the State of California and little pig Alioto's turf is limited to the San Francisco Bay Area, Alioto acted as if he was going to tell the Governor what he could do with his gun law, and just how far to jam it. It is the opinion of most people that pig-to-pig the Little Mafia can kick the hell

out of the big movie star, but luckily no-one had placed any bets because the next day all would learn why the little Italian Swine was acting in such an unruly manner toward his senior pigs.

THE SACRIFICE

Some one upstairs in the hierarchy had put some "Italian Ham" on the political chopping block. A soon to be published Look Magazine Article linking "legit" Alioto with some not-so-"legit" mafioso pigs, had been "leaked" to newspapers throughout the State by Governor Rin-Tin-Reagan. This blew all the quiet-but-frantic work that the little Italian pig maker had been doing underground to block or alter the Look articles publication. Like all die-hards Alioto's Response was "Fight to the finish". Salvatore Marino and his son Angelo Marino, Operators of California Cheese Company in San Jose, California.

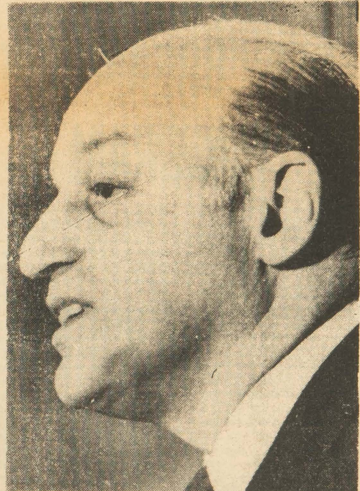

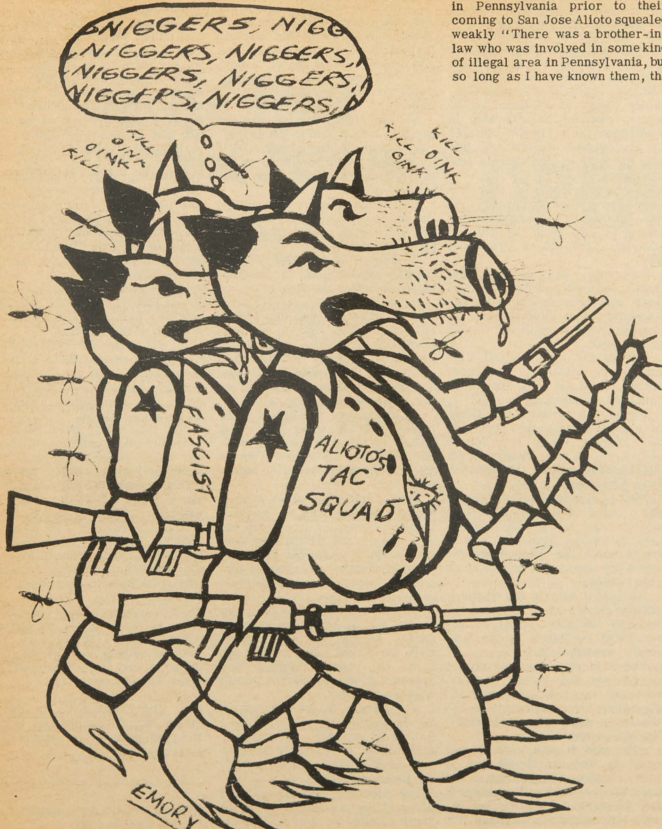

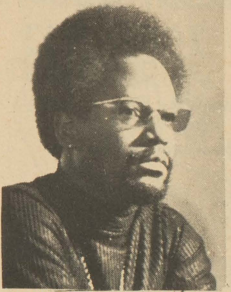
THE LAST STAND

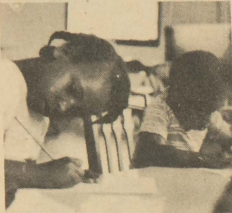

L.A. PIGS VAMP ON FREE BREAKFAST PROGRAM

The military take over of the Watts Free Breakfast Program, by the Los Angeles Police Department and its agents in September 28th, is the latest and most outlandish atrocity overtly committed by the fascist governments of the United States to date, within the confines of this country.

Children, ranging from about three to fourteen years, were at the location of the Panther Party's 'Watts' breakfast to simply eat the food that we provided for them. They are there in the main because this government has not provided them with even the basic necessities of life, food and shelter, as are the natural rights of human beings, and is the duty of the institutions by which they elect to be governed to provide. And so we, the Black Panther Party then have taken upon ourselves to struggle of not only preparing for the total liberation of all people, but the temporarily alleviation of some of the ills which the great masses of people suffer.

Now we, armed troops - armed with shotguns - illegally in a private building, where 40 to 50 children are trying to stave off the hunger they daily suffer, and force these children at gun point to leave the building with no breakfast; with the pretext of looking for suspects of an alleged killing or shooting in a house that is well-known to be the location of the breakfast is used to terrorize elementary-school age children; when even after the children have left hysterically, their food is thrown out by these same gestapo pigs; when, in essence, terror replaces logic, and the gun replaces justice and law, then we must refer to the very constitution upon which this so-called government was found;

...We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the

pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness... (and) when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same object, evinces a design to reduce them under absolute despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new guards for their future security.

Looking for suspects has been a common excuse and the basis for which terrorist acts have been committed and justified - it happens in Vietnam, when whole villages are wiped out, and it has happened across the country recently to the Black Panther Party, especially in the case of the alleged murder in Connecticut, for which our Chairman, Bobby Seale, is being held.

When we said this was fascism Intellectuals, phrase mongers and fascists said this country was not moving to that point. Well, we say that this single act was an introduction to the open tactics the power structure will use to quell any form of legitimate dissent of the people.

But, the people are not fooled for the people saw this act and realized they strongly need for Community Control of Police and complete control of their destinies. And we simple say again

A West Oak man, who narrowly missed death after being shot by a pig at point-blank range in his own home Sunday charged this week that the pig broke into his home and the shooting was unprovoked. Joseph W. Slater Sr., 46, of 1608 68th Ave., an employee at the Container Corp. of America for 20 years, claimed he was shot in retaliation for a lawsuit initiated by his attorney against two pigs and the City of Philadelphia last December.

The suit was started after two of Slater's children: Wayne 16, and Eleanor, 19, were severely beaten by pigs from the 35th Pig District, York Rd. & Champlot Ave.

Following that incident, Mr. Slater suffered a nervous breakdown and was in the Veterans Administration Hospital for six months. He was released May 22 of this year.

The family also contends that after their attorney, Cassandra Birnie, sued the pigs, they were harassed continuously by pigs.

Wayne was arrested four times in recent months on "trumped-up" charges, while Pvt. Joseph Slater Jr., 18, was arrested twice. All charges against the brothers have been dropped.

While being transferred Thursday from Einstein Northern Hospital to the VA Hospital, Slater and his wife, Mildred, who is White, gave the Free Press the following account as to what took place Sunday.

"At about 5:30 in the morning, Wayne became very sick and my husband called the police so that he could be taken to the hospital," explained Mrs. Slater.

She said that when an officer arrived at the house, Eleanor, who had not been told about the pig having been summoned, opened the front door and asked what the officer wanted.

"He said it was none of her business, and she should step aside," added Mrs. Slater. She said that she had no knowledge of the police being called, but before we could say anything, the policeman pushed her up against the front door, and her head went

right through a pane of glass." "Then he swung at her, and I ran over to pull her out of the way," "Get out of the house. These cops," as he stood with one hand on his belt and the other hand partly in a trouser pocket. Patrolman Sixberry then pointed the gun at Joe and said, "Whatever you got in your pocket, drop it," the father declared.

"I stepped a few feet in front of Sixberry and said, 'if you shoot him, you better kill me.'" "I yelled, 'Don't shoot!' Mrs. Slater added, "but the officer pointed the gun right at my husband and fired. Joe was turned around completely by the shot, and he hit the ground hard. Then we began to scream and cry out for someone to please get help."

An ambulance was called to the scene, and the elder Slater was rushed to Einstein Northern Hospital. Doctors there said it was a miracle that he survived the shooting.

"They said the bullet missed Slater's jugular vein by less than a quarter-inch as it entered his neck and missed his spine by even less when it came out his back. The bullet also came close to hitting his vocal cords and the main artery to his heart."

Wayne (who was not in the room during the shooting incident) his father, Joseph, Jr., and Eleanor were all placed under arrest and held on charges ranging from breach of the peace to assault with intent to kill.

A neighbor, Wilbert Thompson, 28, of Smedley St. near 67th Ave., was also arrested. According to Mrs. Slater, he was taken into custody after asking pigs not to handle Eleanor roughly.

Pig Inspector, Robert Wolfinger disputed the account given by the Slater family. He claimed that Pig Sixberry had been threatened by Joseph Jr., who allegedly said,

"I'm going to get my gun and blow you out of here?"

Wolfinger said that Joseph and his father then came at the pig even though he cocked his gun and warned them not to advance.

He claimed that the father continued to move forward despite a second warning, and then when Sixberry pushed him out of the way, his gun accidentally discharged, striking the elder Slater in the neck.

However, angry neighbors told the Free Press that they are "sick and tired of the racist, gun-happy cops in the 35th District" and that they have begun obtaining signatures on petitions that will be presented to pig officials, demanding that radical changes be made.

The Slater family told the Free Press that they will also ask their attorney to initiate legal action as a result of the shooting.

A physician at Einstein Northern, who requested that his name be withheld, said it was inconceivable to him that Slater could have been shot during a scuffle, as the pigs claimed.

"If this would have been the case, the man would have had powder burns on his neck, but he had none, only a clean hole," he said. "This means he was some distance from the officer when he was shot."

A police captain, who also requested anonymity, admitted (off the record) that a few officers at the 35th District were "racists who are a little too anxious to pull the trigger."

"You shouldn't judge all policemen by these few," he added, "there aren't many of them, but there's nothing we can do about them at this time. You probably know the reason why."

P.S. The situation is so bad in Philly that the people have to call the pigs in order to receive hospital service.

We will fight fascism by building a united front against it. It's one thing to be oppressed; but it's another thing to be repressed. **ALL POWER TO THE UNITED FRONT AGAINST FASCISM.**

Take the power from the paper pigs and give it back to the people.

Letter from Prison

To the Black Panther Party:

Let me start by introducing myself. My name is Richard Clark, and my age is 19. I am from Philadelphia but am now in the District of Columbia Jail waiting for trial. I would like to say at this time I am facing a court-martial from the military service for desertion because I escaped from the stockade. Why I am writing this letter is because I've been in the revolution for some time (since age 14) but was greatly disillusioned by my former brother by actions I would not like to relate to at this time.

While in here, I ran into another brother from the Panthers and he was also from Philly. What he told me of my former organization shattered my confidence in them but did not deter my obligation or responsibility to the Black people. I am a nationalist and revolutionist and consider myself capable of defending my people against the pig by any means possible. But I can not do this alone, so I'm asking membership in the Black Panther Party. If I am convicted of this felony, I will receive from the pigs' both civilian and military courts, a position which you might say puts me in front of the death squad. In the past, I have defended and watched over brothers who were marked by the pig for death and risked my own life. But my life meant nothing to me then nor does it now, because if that's what it takes to defend or save another Black brother so that he may still get the truth to the Black masses, then this is what I'll give gladly and with honor. But although I have served loyally, I am now deserted and need the help of a brother.

LETTER FROM A POLITICAL PRISONER

August 28, 1969

On Friday night, Aug. 15, 1969, the captives on two tiers within the walls of fascist Hudson County Tombs, broke the pig good squad out of a bad habit...The habit of viciously beating the captives at will...the pigs will.

The pigs wanted to bust some brothers up because the pigs felt the bloods were making too much noise...b---s---t. The brothers told the pigs to go to hell, they were not going for a bust...So the pigs reinforced themselves with more pigs, but the brothers still stood firm on their convictions, namely that they were men.

Besides the brutalization administered by the pigs, the living conditions are unbearable--one of the main problems that all of us face is overcrowdedness.

When the sadistic pigs showed up to crack skulls on the tier where we were---we told the pigs, "you are not going to brutalize our brothers or us, if you swing your clubs we just as well swing ours." So the pigs left, but they returned with tear gas. All the brothers were shouting, "ALL POWER TO THE PEOPLE" and "DOWN WITH THE PIGS." After they shot the tear gas on us some of the brothers became nervous, but we reminded them and ourselves of the brothers and sisters who have stood firm and have carried on the struggle for a long

time. Even while the gas grew strong we still chanted, "ALL POWER TO THE PEOPLE," and "DOWN WITH THE PIGS." All the Black Panther supporters and sympathizers all over the pig pen (Black, Brown and White).

Now the pigs had never had this happen in here before so they didn't know exactly what to do. They had 150 pigs out in the halls with clubs and guns...But they had gotten the message that we (the people), even though armed only with brooms and mops were ready to fight to the death...So the warden came in and we negotiated a "settlement", but if you know this fascist city, history was made in this act against oppression.

The next day the warden admitted that our actions were justifiable and we were correct because, for one, the jail, is an overcrowded tomb...Again we let it be known to the warden that we were not going to allow ourselves to be attacked by pig guards.

Although we are inside the fascist prison walls, we must function, for as our Minister of Defense Huey P. Newton says, "The walls, the bars, the guns, the guards, can never encircle or hold down the ideas of the people. **ALL POWER TO THE PEOPLE**

"When dark clouds appeared in the sky, we pointed out that they were only temporary that the darkness would soon pass and the sun break through" (Mao). Having heard of the start of the Breakfast Program was the sun breaking through--it was without a doubt the most cherished news that I've received since being here. To know that you all are struggling in the interest of the people was the sun breaking through for me.

"We must persevere and work unceasingly, and we, too, will touch God's heart. Our God is none other than the masses of the Black People." "New things always have to experience difficulties and set back as they grow. It is sheer fantasy to imagine that the cause of socialism is all plain sailing and easy success, without difficulties and setbacks or the exertion of tremendous efforts." So the problems that you may be having should not sadden or dispirit you, for hard work is like a load placed before us, challenging us to shoulder it.

My particular situation here is still the same, a case of the court, (the criminal) trying to make me (the victim) look like the criminal, and the criminal the victim. The kangaroo courts and the breaking of the constitutions laws are a reality here in the "belly of the beast" as Chairman Bobby calls it, and I can bear witness to that. My bail of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is usually unheard of for the type charge (unlawful interstate transportation of a firearm by a felon, v.io. s922). So you can see that these fascist capitalists are not relating and have never related to that five a-s constitution where black people are concerned.

(A cloak of "legality" was given to the arbitrary arrests and the incarceration of victims in concentration camps. The term was "Schutzhaft" or "Protective Custody", page 374 "Rise and Fall of The Third Reich", which should be on everyone's reading list). The high and excessive bails put on black people are not only unconstitutional, but slick Dick's and Miss Hoover's way of im-

plementing punk a-s Mitchell's (Attorney General) protective custody jail to the horses brown and woe to those who CANNOT SWIM...

The bails set on members of the Vanguard throughout Babylon and the power structures refusal to set a bail for Brother Huey shows that capitalism really resembes "a dying person who is sinking fast, like the sun setting beyond the western hill."

In closing I would like those within the Vanguard to remember, "We must not become complacent over any success. We should check out complacency and constantly criticize our shortcomings, just as we should wash our faces or sweep the floor every day to remove the dirt and keep them clean."

Dear Chairman Bobby,
I used to have a typical black middle class misunderstanding of the Black Panther Party and what it stood for, but after stopping and listening instead of letting myself be told by the news media, I am now able to decide certain things for myself.

1. I have no intention of allowing my daughter to live in a society as exist today.
2. Most white people and their enforcement agencies intend to keep this society capitalistic with the Black man down.

PANTHER 21 HAVE BAIL HEARING

STOP THE GANG-UP!

BALTIMORE BUST

On August 13, 1969, the Panther 21 had a bail hearing in Federal Court in New York City. This was the 17th bail hearing the 13 brothers and sisters who are incarcerated have had since they were busted on April 2 of this year. Attorneys William Kuntzler and Jerry Lefcourt argued that the State's bail system was "unconstitutional" and that the bail on which the 21 were being held was excessive. District Judge Edmond L. Palmieri presided.

Attorney Lefcourt pointed out that the \$100,000.00 bail that the N.Y. Panthers are being held on was a "political bail". William Kuntzler picked up the argument blowing about the racist nature of the courts. Both lawyers were really "taking care of business." Kuntzler went on to point out how the pig power structure is out to destroy the Panthers, and how the press has conducted a vicious slander campaign against the Party. Lying D.A. Hogan and his lying assistant, pig Phillips equated the "so-called" conspiracy to bomb department stores to that of the Chicago bombing of department stores. But Kuntzler pointed out that the person responsible for heinous bombing was an insane white ex-marine. The N.Y. 21 are not insane; they are revolutionary freedom fighters and servants of the people. The "aura of fear around this case" was also mentioned. (When Panthers appear in court in fascist New York City, there's a pig-a-Panther). There

were 3 armed men in the court. "For what?" asked Kuntzler? "For two lawyers and your honor?" Kuntzler went on to point out that "it is white people that are doing all the shooting." And Martin Luther King was the example put forth.

The Panther lawyers were joined in court by Mrs. Elizabeth Dubois, who appeared "as friend of the court" on behalf of the NAACP Legal Defense and Education Fund. Mrs. Dubois argued that the bail system "discriminated against the Negro and the poor." Mrs. Dubois argued:

"If a person is able to supply \$100,000.00 he has a right to be set free, these defendants (N.Y. 21) do. Their ability to pay has nothing to do with their danger to the community."

Mrs. Dubois pointed out that the exorbitant bail of \$100,000.00 violated the "eight amendment of the jive constitution which protects the defendant against pretrial detention. Judge Palmieri said that to deal with the questions presented by the lawyers "would overturn some of our fundamental concepts." However, he did admit that "the poor (particularly poor blacks) are disadvantaged by the (bail) system." The \$100,000.00 bail is to insure that the incarcerated brothers and sisters will not be on the streets serving the people. Outrageous bail is simply a means of insuring pretrial detention for persons whom the (capitalist) system

thinks is dangerous." Mrs. Dubois closed her argument by saying, "those incarcerated before trial, have more chance of being convicted."

Up jumped lying D.A. Phillips and he was off and lying at full speed. Judge Palmieri asked whether it was true that some of the defendants had no prior records. Pig Phillips oinked that, "Each defendant is responsible for acts of all of the others in a conspiracy."

"Once you prove it beyond a reasonable doubt after trial in court," countered Judge Palmieri.

"If you assume these defendants are innocent for all purposes," oinked Phillips, "then there should not have been any indictment."

Right On, Pig Phillips. "It is necessary for me to point out," said Judge Palmieri, "that their guilt has not been proved" and he asked again about individual records. "You just can't deal with these defendants as a conglomerate."

Pig Phillips searched his records and started bad mouthing Curtiss Powell, saying that Curtiss Powell had a record of 3 arrests "Arrest, No convictions?" asked the judge and everyone in the court room, laughed and applauded. Moreover, the arrest—all petty offenses—were at least 8 to 10 years old."

See that Pig Phillips was totally outside, Judge Palmieri reserved his decision to study records.

Bobby Seale, Chairman of the Black Panther Party, was arrested the other evening by two dozen FBI agents, armed with shotguns as he was leaving the wedding of a friend. The agents said he was wanted for "illegal flight to avoid prosecution".

The charge was a phony because (a) he was not fleeing, and (b) he was not aware of any prosecution. Just the same, \$25,000 bail was slapped on him. No sooner was this bail posted than Seale was grabbed again—this time by San Francisco cops—on a new charge: kidnaping, murder and conspiracy to commit murder in the state of Connecticut.

At the request of District Attorney John J. Ferndon, a judge denied bail on the new charge. Ferndon said some police informer had implicated Seale in the Connecticut crime.

As Seale's attorney pointed out, not long ago San Francisco Police Officer Michael O'Brien (while off duty) shot and killed a Black truck driver named George Baskett. And O'Brien was granted bail (and other courtesies too), although several people who were not police informers testified that he killed Baskett in cold blood.

That is racism in one of its worst forms. One rule for Whites, another rule for Blacks.

LABOR'S EXPERIENCE

"Working people come in all colors and such racism is used to divide them along color lines to make them and their unions a softer setup for the boss.

Unions have had their share of "conspiracy" to prevent scabs from entering a plant and police frameups when the powers that be wanted to break a union or bust a strike.

Certainly their own experience and the phony FBI "gang buster" stage managing of Seale's arrest ought to make union men and women

Two sisters, Sherrie Brown and Sandra Wallace had noticed pig cars gathering about a block from the office. When they went down to investigate, they saw the people from the community gathering as the pigs slammed a brother against the pig car. The sisters began to tell the people about the fascist pig tactics and were joined by three more Panthers. As the Panthers talked to the people about the fascist pig repression, more pig cars arrived. The fascist swine grabbed brother John Clark and slammed him against a patrol car. Someone in the crowd threw an old shoe and connected on one of the swine. A couple of burley swine grabbed sister Sandy, called her a "b---ch", and raised their "law and order" sticks. But another pig called out that there were too many people around. The pigs decided to retreat, but not before arresting all the Panthers in sight. They were Sherrie Brown, John Clark, Steve McCutchen, and Malik Jones. They were arrested and charged with resisting arrest and hindering pigs in carrying out "law and order". They are currently in the pig pen, pending on \$500. bail each. Their trial is scheduled for September 12th. Sister Sandra Wallace was tried that same day on charges of assault on a pig and found guilty and fined \$120.00. The fine was payed and she was released.

suspicious of this whole deal. Especially since Seale's arrest is just the latest in a series of police raids, rousts and arrests, which add up to a massive attempt to smash the Black Panther Party and to intimidate Black people from organizing to defend their interests and improve their condition.

Legal Lynching and More of the Same



AHMED EVANS

The power structure is out to make an example of the five brothers they indicted who were alleged to be involved in a shoot-out with Cleveland pigs back in July of 1968. The fact that 14 pigs were wounded and three killed, has made it necessary for the power structure to set some examples for other Black people who might lean toward armed self-defense. The fact that the Black community suffered only half as many wounded and one dead served to up-tight the pigs' situation even more. It is common knowledge that the pigs ran amuck and somebody happened to be waiting and ready. It's also common knowledge that the pigs tried to shoot anybody not in uniform and then termed all their acts justifiable or blamed it on alleged "snipers".

Ahmed Evans was singled out as

a "ringer" and is sentenced to die in the electric chair on September 23, 1969. Brother Non-Du has been sentenced to 100 years with no chance for parole. Once again the pattern is set, the trend is clear. To add to this, the brother of Ahmed Evans, William Evans, has been found shot to death. The pigs' answer to this was "attempted armed robbery - justifiable homicide. Some people in the community believe the murder of William Evans was a "warning" from the pigs to Ahmed Evans' attorney and others connected with the "case."

THE CONTINUOUS REPRESSION LEADING UP TO THE ARREST OF CHAIRMAN BOBBY SEALE

The continuous chain of repression, the constant harassment, open fascist terrorist tactics can be seen clearly since the bust of the New York 21.

On April 2, 1969 at 5:30 a.m. over 400 plainclothes pigs vamped on 16 different houses and arbitrarily arrested (by any means necessary) 21 Panthers of the New York Chapter for a so-called plot to bomb tulips, pig stations, railroad tracks and all Department stores. The very same department stores that the Black people we serve shop in.

On April 26th, the pigs bombed the Des Moines Office destroying everything.

On May 22nd, the pigs arrested 8 Connecticut Panthers on trumped up charges of murdering a fellow Panther who they supposedly thought was a pig informer on the N.Y. 21, when in effect, the pigs murdered Alex Rackley.

On June 4th, the pigs raided the Chicago office stating they were looking for a fugitive that wasn't there upon investigation. They said something about the person being connected with the Connecticut case. The so-called person still wasn't there.

On June 5th, the pigs raided the Denver Office and arrested Landon Williams, and Rory Hithe on charges connected with the Connecticut case.

On June 6th, the pigs arrested Lonnie McCluskey in Salt Lake City, Utah on the same charges.

On August 18th, the pigs held

a ransom of \$20,000 on the Chief of Staff, David Hilliard.

On August 19th, the pigs kidnapped Chairman Bobby Seale on trumped up charges of being a fugitive from justice in connection with the Connecticut case, based on the testimony of some nigger pig who signed a statement saying Bobby ordered the murder while he was in the state for a speaking engagement.

Coincidence? Do you think so? The dates are concurrent, the places of arrest or kidnap (arrest without a warrant), run in a very smooth line from the East Coast to West Coast in order, ultimately, to arrest our Chairman Bobby Seale.

This has been a premeditated assault upon the Black Panther Party in an effort to destroy the Party that is working for the people, in an attempt to incarcerate all the leadership one by one, state by state.

BUT THEY FORGOT ONE THING ----- the Black Panther Party belongs to the people, and that as long as the people are oppressed and exploited, as long as there are Black people alive - there will always be a Black Panther Party.

OPEN LETTER

TO THE PEOPLE OF THE COMMUNITIES:

We must now begin to stand up and intensify our fight against this injustice that is brought down on us from "those" that are in power and ruling over us, the masses of the people. With all of this repression, we the members of the Black Panther Party as well as you the people can plainly see that this government does not work for the better interests of its people. It is because he is not only the Chairman of the Black Panther Party, he is the people's chairman; he is a leader for all of those who are moving against the suppression of the people's movement to free themselves by using their constitutional rights.

If there is to be any justice, then let those that rule over us and claim to show justice, be tried in the courts of the people as criminals from justice. (Those that have brutalized, exploited, murdered, raped and have intimidated the people). these fools. The social conditions which the people have been subjected to is against the laws of the land and are outright criminal. It is the duty of the poor to write and construct rules and laws that are in their better interests. This is one of the basic human rights of all men. One such example of this is the right for decentralization of any police department that does not serve us. "The slavery of Blacks in this country provides the oil for the machinery of war that America uses to enslave the people of the world. Without this oil the machinery cannot function. We are in the driving shaft. We are in such a strategic position in this machinery that once we become dislocated, the functioning of the remainder of the machinery breaks down."

SCANDINAVIAN SOLIDARITY WITH THE B.P.P.

Scandinavians received the news of the kidnapping of Bobby Seale, Chairman of the Black Panther Party with utter amazement. It took some time before they could really believe that the fascist pigs in America had overdone their act.

On August 25th a demonstration took place in Copenhagen, Denmark in front of the American Embassy led by the Black Panther Party Representative in Scandinavia, Connie Mathews. In pouring rain over 400 Danes turned out to protest the kidnapping of Chairman Bobby Seale, and the mass repression underway to annihilate the Black Panther Party. Most Danes, for the first time, faced reality as they remembered very clearly the visit of Chairman Bobby Seale to Scandinavia in March of this year when he ran down to them exactly what the Black Panther Party was trying to do. Added to this was the fact that one of their comrades, Jorgen Dragsdahl, had been arrested and imprisoned in California for raising his hands in court during the hearing of Chairman Bobby Seale.

A press release from Eldridge Cleaver, Minister of Information of the Black Panther Party was also read at the demonstration. Due to

the contents of this press release, one of the major newspapers in Denmark carried an Editorial the next day on the repression against the Black Panther Party and included the following extract from 'Esquire', "The ghetto settings and spies, secret codes and double agents. One would think the police were preparing themselves for a war or were about to start one!" This article appeared in Esquire one and a half years ago. It is

now diaphanous that Fascist America, under the direction of the Chief of Pigs, J. Edgar Hoover, has started a full scale war against the Black Panther Party.

It becomes crystal clear to Scandinavians that J. Edgar Hoover considers the Black Panther Party a threat because they are the first Black movement to put the Black American Struggle into a political context. In opposition to the Black Cultural Nationalists who condemn all Whites alike, the Black Panther Party does not primarily see the struggle as a racial conflict but as a conflict between the oppressors and the oppressed, capitalism and socialism. They express solidarity with the Third World and look upon their struggle as a link in the struggle of all oppressed people.

The Scandinavians are standing in solidarity with the Black Panther Party and are demanding consistently the release of Huey P. Newton, Bobby Seale, the right of Eldridge Cleaver to return to the U.S.A., the release of all political prisoners and an immediate end to the massive repression launched against the Black Panther Party.

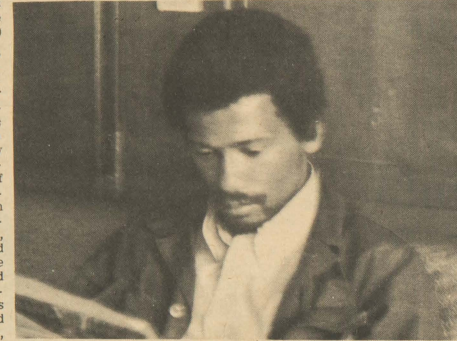
The people have always been awared that the courts, from federal on down to the municipal level, were just not the places to receive justice. Unless one checked out the court system, you

managed to smuggle out a letter to her mother who lives in New Orleans. Her mother contacted a lawyer in Jackson, and he managed to get them out after paying \$350 fines each.

Of the Pig Departments around the country, probably the most racist of all are the Mississippi Pigs. These racist swine have reputations of being Pigs by day and Klansmen by night. In view of this entire incident, at least two questions stand out above all others: (1) Why did the Pigs feel it was their duty to beat two helpless females, (2) Why were they not permitted to use the telephone.

FASCIST DUAL TACTICS

Some people who are quibbling about the correctness of the recently held U.F.A.F. Conference called by the Black Panther Party should consider the announcement by the fascist state's "Justice" department to intensify its harassment and attempted suppression of the Panthers.

The deliberate attack on the Party's Chicago office by the pigs set the stage for a new round of violent suppression and coming on the heels of this event, the announcement to "investigate" possible (sic) violations of the civil rights of Panthers is a mere smokescreen to conceal more "legal" repression.

Let no one be confused; didn't the Chicago pigs claim that "they were fired upon" by the Panthers? But this lie was exposed by Chairman Bobby when he pointed out

that "all windows and doors were covered" in order to foil just such sneak attacks by the pigs as this. In seeking to blame the Panthers for "firing first", the pigs are using the tactics of all reactionaries and are like the thief who yells "stop thief!"

Now the government comes forth behind this event and seemingly says it will look for violations of Panthers' "civil rights," (supposedly carried out by the pigs.) But what they are really doing is seeking to confuse public opinion by painting the false notion in people's minds that the government is willing to punish its own forces and extend justice and democracy to all, even Black Panthers, while at the same time, conspiring to begin a fresh round of "legal" repression. This is known as counter-revolutionary

dual tactics and is designed to disarm and mislead people away from the Party's correct call to fight against fascism.

We must expose these fascist dual tactics and not be hoodwinked by the seemingly "good intentions" of the ruling circles, or of their state apparatus. By the very contradictoriness of their own position, they are required to vary their tactics, seek to undermine the growing influence of the Black Panther Party, especially in the light of the U.F.A.F. Conference.

We are aghast upon reading the drafted plan for the annihilation of the Black Panther Party National Headquarters which has come from your office and the desk of Officer Plummer! We are even more shocked by your Department's spokesman, heard on KPFA tonight admitting that this sordid document issues from the Berkeley Police Department.

I wish to register my strongest protest against even the thought of such a plan, much less the actual

drafting of it! I can no longer consider of any value such proposals of police-community workshops and public meetings aimed at bettering relations between police and the people. Who can sit down and talk with the mentality represented in this plan. Rather, it fills me with disgust, and then with fear and anger. Rather than talking, I believe that my Church would do better to begin installing armor-plate on our own windows immediately. Let me put it more directly: do you have similar plans for the Free Church and other Movement headquarters? We are anxious to know.

I am encouraged by the fact that such a plan has found its way outside your department: to the press. One of the remaining hopes

of the people is the free press which can print plans from police departments, as well as lists of narcs and tactical squads. Perhaps free press, in the end, will be our only hope of community control of the police.

I think I speak for the Free Church community in saying that we are a Church which will support our brothers in the Black Panther Party with whatever resources we have. Documents such as this plan only confirm us in the belief that the Party is the cutting edge of the Black man's struggle (and our own) for liberation in this society.

PHILLY PIGS ON THE RAMPAGE

REPRESSION

The police, FBI, CIA and repressive agencies in general are on the prowl for Black militants. In the last few months Black Panther Party offices in such cities as Sacramento, Chicago, Denver, Washington and Salt Lake City have been attacked by the police. Searching without warrants, the making of false accusations, the setting of high balls, mass arrests and other actions have been taken against the Panthers - which led Gerald Lefcourt, their New York lawyer, to say, "They are certain the Government is trying to destroy them within a year."

The Black Panthers have been carrying out unity activities with other groups of liberals, leftists and radicals -- Black and White -- to form a coalition against repression. But this unity of Blacks and Whites against U.S. racial oppression has caused the Panthers to be attacked by other groups of Black self-styled nationalists. This clash among Black groups has exposed existing ideological differences.

NATIONALISM: REACTIONARY OR REVOLUTIONARY

The last few years have seen the development of a trend in U.S. Blacks toward studying and becoming acquainted with African culture. The Black man has become aware that the theory of racial inferiority was a myth which served to prop up the system of exploitation. Thus, the wearing of African clothes, the use of African names and languages -- all this has become popular in the United States, as has the wearing of natural hair styles and the emphasizing of other external characteristics aimed at making blacks more like the peoples they originated from.

But this trend toward idealizing Blackness has its negative side. Black leaders in the front ranks of the struggle against the American way of life and for the liberation of Black people have expressed their disagreement with this trend.

Huey Newton, founder of the Black Panther Party, now in jail has said, "There are two kinds of nationalism: the reactionary and the revolutionary. Revolutionary nationalism is based on a popular revolution whose objective is power for the people. To be a revolutionary nationalist, you must first of all be a socialist. The reactionary nationalist is not a socialist, and his final objective is oppressing the people."

Newton's point becomes even clearer when he says, "Cultural nationalism, or pork chop nationalism, as I sometimes call it, is the result of a false political perspective.... The objective of cultural nationalism is a return to African culture, by which these nationalists expect to regain their identity and freedom. In other words, they feel that African culture will bring them political freedom. Often cultural nationalists become reactionary nationalists."

BLACK CAPITALISM: NIXON'S PROGRAM

Side by side with this ideological struggle, an economic tendency called "Black capitalism" is developing. The idea of Black capitalism is to divide. It is a palliative aimed at neutralizing the Black masses and deceiving a minority which believes it can join the ranks of the capitalists as exploiters. Black capitalists will also exploit their own people. This Nixon strategy has met with some success as a political measure.

Negroes." This is proof that some have joined the ranks of the divisionists.

Black capitalism has not developed greatly from an economic point of view. Thomas Matthew, who organized the National Economic Growth and Reconstruction Organization (NEGRO), found it almost impossible to sell his own capitalist services to the Government. He could not get the Pentagon's orders and could not complete other contracts for chemical products. These were granted to monopoly enterprises such as Kodak and Minnesota Mining, instead.

The reason such monopolies as Shell and the Chase Manhattan Bank, to cite only two of them, join the Black-capitalism program is that they see a danger in the Black people's struggle and in their possible alliance with White radicals.

But a significant event has already taken place. In April -- during the Negro Economic Development Conference, in which the activities in connection with the Nixon plan were supposed to begin -- elements or groups that supported Black capitalism came out against the program. Brother Crook, one of the participants in the conference, later made the following statement: "Black capitalism cannot help the Black people, because it is based on the assumption that the exploitation of man by man is a natural thing. Since Negroes are the lowest rung in this country's social and economic scale, Black capitalism would mean that Negroes would have to exploit other Negroes."

It appears that the words of Black Panther leader Bobby Seale are already being proved true. In reference to Nixon's plan, he stated that Black capitalism "only leads to a strengthening of the capitalist system, a system which keeps Negroes in slavery."

In the face of the present situation of the Black movement in the United States and the attacks of all kinds which are leveled against it with a view to doing away with it completely, it is more necessary than ever to achieve the unity of the Blacks and to secure the support of the Whites in the struggle to eradicate capitalism, which is the real prerequisite for truly solving the problem of racism in the United States or anywhere else in the world.

Big businessmen take advantage of black cultural nationalism to grow even richer. American Greetings, Inc. has put out a line of greeting cards for Negroes.

For instance, an article published in Time magazine points out that there is a group of Black athletes who have become businessmen, taking advantage of concessions and loans offered them. Meredith Gourdin, and Olympic boxer jumper, has said, "Black athletes have a better chance to join capitalism than any other

First LEE BERRY, epileptic beaten by the pigs, then Joseph Brooks, epileptic murdered by the pigs, now CHARLES LEWIS . . .

Approximately 4:00 Tuesday morning, a brother named Charles Lewis who lives at 1814 31st St. was stricken with convulsions. The pigs were called by his relatives in order to have him taken to the nearest hospital. Approximately 45 to 55 minutes later a Black pig and a White pig arrived. Both pigs refused to carry Mr. Lewis, who was in convulsions, from his second floor apartment down to their wagon outside. Mrs. Mattie Knight, who is Mr. Lewis's sister-in-law told me that she begged them to carry him downstairs, but both pigs, especially the Black pig, were very nasty to her. Being that the pigs refused to carry Brother Lewis outside, some brothers, Tim Darrison and Kitchens Wilson carried him downstairs and outside to the pig wagon.

Mrs. Knight who relayed this story to me, is nearly sightless, and was unable to obtain the number of the two pigs though she desired to do so. The pig wagons that usually patrol the community are 2201 and 2202. In this area it usually takes the pigs a half hour to 45 minutes to respond to calls other than those reporting robberies. Mrs. Knight's niece died in January or February while waiting to be rushed to the hospital. In this case, the pigs had taken at least a half hour to respond to the emergency call.

Though these incidents do not involve actual beatings on the part of the pigs, they do illustrate the

brutal nature of the pigs toward the Black Colony. The fascist pigs are right there on the spot in protection of the interests and the property of the avaricious, greedy businessman, but take their time when called to rush someone to the hospital. The pigs (human property of the power of finance capital) are controlled by a system which places a higher value on property than on human lives! This is why the BLACK PANTHER PARTY is circulating a petition for COMMUNITY CONTROL OF THE FASCIST PIG POLICE. The pigs on 31st St. must serve the people on 31st St. Not the avaricious businessmen living out on the Main Line! The pigs will not stop busting your heads and letting you die while waiting to be rushed to the hospital as long as they don't live in your community and are not controlled by you.

HANDICAPPED YOUTH MURDERED IN COLD BLOOD

Patrolman William Bishwanger shot and killed 15 year old Joseph Brooks on Wednesday August 27. Brooks, a mentally retarded youth was on vacation from the Ebensburgh State Hospital. Brooks was told by Bishwanger to drop a knife he was holding. When Brooks refused Bishwanger shot him in the face. Joseph Brooks died fifteen minutes later.

By force of the people's petition we will move for complete implementation of the end to POLICE BRUTALITY & MURDER. We want no more "Joe Brooks" a 15 year old victim of epilepsy, and retardation. Shot down by a fascist pig just doing his job. Well, his job is shooting, brutalizing, torturing, and killing niggers.

The outright racist action employed against Joseph Brooks is neither strange nor new to Blacks, Puerto Ricans, and other oppressed people in the confines of this capitalist system. BOSTON PIGS RAMPAGE

Boston August 29, 1969

On returning from a film rally sponsored by the Black Panther Party, the fascist Boston Pig Department moved on a Panther car with guns drawn, for a "motor violation." After seeing the community respond to their restop-like tactics, they immediately called an "Officer-In-Trouble" call, which brought 10-12 car loads of pigs with guns drawn within 2 minutes.

The Defense Captain, Doug Miranda, and myself were immediately whisked away and were

not advised of our rights nor put under arrest. After arriving at the pig station, Doug was put under arrest for a "motor vehicle violation" and I was suspected of being a fugitive.

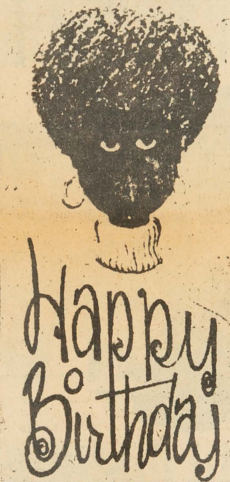
These incidents prove several things: (1) The pigs are only in our community to brutalize and murder Black people. (2) They realize the power of the people and the Black Panther Party's role in the education of our people to the true nature of the decadent American society and (3) The system's at-

Editorial Note:

Within the Movement, debate rages over organizational and political strategy for the women's liberation movement. This debate rarely includes the ideas of black women. So we rapped with six women, members of the Black Panther Party, about some of the issues raised by the women's liberation movement and their own experience with women's liberation inside the Black Panther Party. (Technical note: A large space between paragraphs means that a different sister is speaking.)

MOVEMENT: How has the position of women within the Black Panther Party changed? How have the women in the Party dealt with male chauvinism within the Party?

PANTHER WOMEN: I've only been in the Party about ten months and when I got in the Party the thing about Pantherettes was squashed, we sort of grew out of it. Then there's Ericka Huggins. The brothers had to look on Ericka with a new light because she had been thru a lot of things that some Brothers hadn't even been thru. The sisters looked up to her and we all saw what we had to do. The sisters have to pick up guns just like brothers. There are a lot of things the sisters can do to change society.

We realize that we have a role to play and we're tired of sitting home and being misused and unless we stand up, male chauvinism will still show itself and be something that's just passed over. Unless we speak against it and teach the brothers what's correct and point out what's wrong, then it'll still be here.

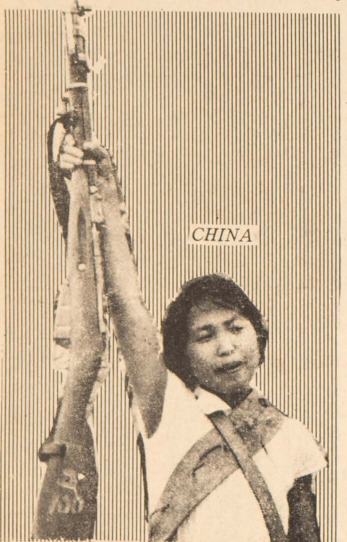
There used to be a difference in the roles (of men and women) in the party because sisters were relegated to certain duties. This was due to the backwardness and lack of political perspective on the part of both sisters and brothers. Like sisters would just naturally do the office-type jobs, the clerical-type jobs. They were the ones that handled the mailing list. You know all those things that go into details. They were naturally given to the sisters and because of this, because the sisters accepted it so willingly because they had been doing this before, this is the type of responsibilities they've had before, it was very easy for male chauvinism to continue on. The only examples we had of sisters taking responsibility were probably in Kathleen or one or two people who exercised responsibility in other areas of Party work.

We've recognized in the past 4 or 5 months that sisters have to take a more responsible role. They have to extend their responsibility and it shouldn't be just to detail work, to things women normally do. This, I think, has been manifested in the fact that a lot of sisters have been writing more articles, they're attending more to the political aspects of the Party, they're speaking out in public more and we've even done outreach work in the community, extensive outreach work in that we've taken the initiative to start our own schools--both brothers and sisters now work in the liberation schools. It's been proven that positions aren't relegated to sex, it depends on your political awareness.

I can remember that when I came into the Party over a year ago at that time David Hilliard was National Headquarters Captain, and there was another sister in the Party who was the National Captain for women and even though most of the people related to David Hilliard as being National HQ Captain, most of the women related to this other sister for directives because she was the National Captain for women. Under her were sergeants and lieutenants who were all sisters and in their ranks were other sisters. There was almost a separation between the brothers and the sisters.

REORGANIZATION

When that was abolished, when there were no longer any separate positions for sisters and brothers, when we all had to relate to the brothers or sisters who were in the specific positions, there wasn't just a reaction on the part of certain brothers cause they didn't like having to relate to certain sisters, who were in leadership positions. There was also a reaction on the part of some sisters, who because they had to relate to some brothers, because they did not have ranks above certain brothers, they wanted to quit the Party. So it wasn't just a matter of brothers being

male chauvinistic in not wanting to relate to sisters as leaders over them--but it was also the sisters, because of conditioning, wanted to continue to submit to other sisters, rather than to leaders of the Party per se, regardless of sex.

And I can see since the time I joined the Party that the Party has undergone radical change in the direction of women leadership and emancipation of women. Even though Ericka Huggins provides us with a very good example, it's not so much Ericka and the realization that Ericka poses a strike example, it's the fact that the political consciousness and the political level of members of the Party have risen very much since I joined the Party and because of the fact that we're moving toward a proletarian revolution and because we have come to realize that male chauvinism and all its manifestations are bourgeois and that's one of the things we're fighting against. We realize that in a proletarian revolution, the emancipation of women is primary. We realize that the success of the revolution depends upon the women. For this reason, we know that it's necessary that the women must be emancipated.

IMPORTANCE OF WOMEN'S LIBERATION

MOVEMENT: Could you explain what you mean when you say that the success of the revolution depends upon women. Movement organizations have always been dominated by men, the way civil rights organizations used to be dominated by white people.

PANTHER WOMEN: I don't know, that sounds illogical to me because you can't solve the problem apart from the problem. You can't be liberated from male chauvinism if you don't even deal with it--if you run away from it. And I think forming any separate organization with that in mind is negating or contradicting what you're setting out to do. I think any type of inside organization that deals with women's liberation should take into consideration that women's liberation is important, but what is primary is the People's liberation. If they want a women's club, those have existed for centuries--they should form that, instead of calling themselves revolutionaries.

MOVEMENT: The one of the arguments that's been made is that the movement has failed to attract a lot of women because of male chauvinism within the movement and because of the intimidation that's found in a lot of political organizations. We fail to attract the other half because men dominate. Women have to get together to talk about their special problems in order to involve more women in the struggle.

PANTHER WOMEN: I think our judgment of caucuses, just like independent groups, is going to be to depend on whether or not they forward the revolutionary movement in the end. I mean if their purpose for caucusing among themselves is to make a more efficient organization and if they, in fact, are able to do that thru their practice, then Right On. But if they fall into a trap of just getting by themselves and just complaining about the situation and are unable to put forth a positive program, then that form is not viable. Again, their practice is going to have to tell--whether or not they further the revolutionary organization PERIOD.

ROLE FOR ADVANCED WOMEN

Also for a person to use the argument that the struggle does not ATTRACT women to the organization, I think, is coming from a subjective point of view. Because if they understand that it's not a women's or a man's struggle, it's not an attraction for a man or a woman, but we're here for the liberation of oppressed people, regardless of whether male chauvinism exists, the women would still come into the Party or movement because they agree or are willing to support the revolutionary principles that exist. If they find male chauvinism, they should be willing to fight it on the basis of principle and unity. And to say, "they're not attracted to it"--there's no advertisement for getting rid of oppression. It's an attraction based on principles, not based on some subjective wishes or wants. So I say that women who say that they don't want to come into the struggle because they're not ATTRACTED to the struggle aren't really interested in the first place.

MOVEMENT: No, they say the movement doesn't deal with their special oppression.

PANTHER WOMEN: Well, that may be true, but still, if you're interested in the struggle of oppressed people, you can come into an organization and bring that question in yourself, instead of staying away from it. You can fight on the basis of unity within an organization, not on the basis of, "well, they're not dealing with the women's question and they're not dealing with the special oppression of women, so therefore I'm not going to participate". They're still being subjective.

Well, I think that's one place where women who are already advanced are going to have to take a strong stand. The fact is because of objective conditions in this society women are more backward, because of their positions in their home or in school, even working women who are more exposed to what's happening in the world, are still relegated at home and to the family jobs to the children, etc, etc, and their perspective in terms of the world is more limited. So it's very important that women who are more advanced, who already understand revolutionary principles, go to them and explain it to them and struggle with them. We have to recognize that women are backward politically and we have to struggle with them. And that can be a special role that revolutionary women can play.

ON THE EMANCIPATION OF WOMEN

PANTHER WOMEN: It's because of the fact that women are the other half. A revolution cannot be successful simply with the efforts of the men, because a woman plays such an integral role in society even though she is relegated to smaller, seemingly insignificant positions.

I think conditions outside the Party have forced us to realize that we have to get rid of male chauvinism. As Panthers, we cannot separate ourselves and divide ourselves and work as Pantherettes, and on the other hand have brothers work as Panthers and expect to present a United Front against Fascism or against the enemy or against outside forces. There has to be unity within the Party. We can't be divided on the basis of sex and we can't be divided on the basis of principles or anything.

Ericka became a good example because the pigs realized she was a revolutionary. Maybe we didn't realize that, in the sense that we thought about it all the time or brought her up as an example of a strong woman. But, I think the pigs realize that and this outside condition has forced us to realize that we can't operate as two halves, separate, apart from each other--we have to be unified.

VIETNAMESE WOMEN LEAD

MOVEMENT: You once said that the Vietnamese women were your example. Could you explain more concretely what that means in terms of the struggle of women in the United States?

PANTHER WOMEN: We feel that the example given us by the Vietnamese women is a prime example of the role women can play in the revolution. The Vietnamese women are out there fighting with their brothers, fighting against American imperialism, with its advanced technology. They can shoot. They're out there with their babies on their backs, as the case may be, and they're participating in the revolution wholeheartedly just as the Vietnamese men are participating in the revolution. In the national liberation struggle is just as much dependent upon the women continuing struggle as it is dependent on the Vietnamese men. So there we see in Vietnam where the struggle today is the sharpest in terms of struggling against US imperialism, the women in fact, play the role of the other half--not the weaker half, not the stronger half, but the other half of the

"SISTERS"

Vietnamese men. We hold them up as our example and we hope that the revolutionary women in the U.S. can follow that example and live up to the goal that they have set.

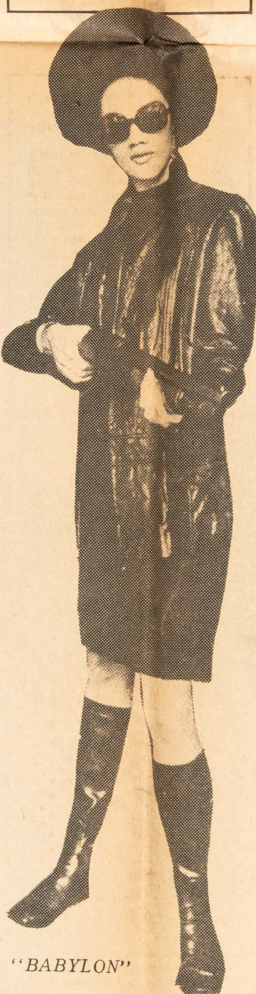
Right now the issue of male chauvinism is rather sharp and kind of out of place. We're starting to talk about it and everybody is sensitive about it--but once women find their place in terms of their roles as revolutionaries and use the example of the Vietnamese women, then I don't think it will be such a sharp issue. I think we'll begin to function and make it very natural

for a woman to behave as a revolutionary and not as a subordinate or as a submissive half.

SPECIAL ROLE OF BLACK WOMEN

MOVEMENT: Black women are considered to be the most oppressed group in the US, as blacks and as women. That special oppression gives them a special, even vanguard, role. Do you want to talk about that a little?

PANTHER WOMEN: I think, historically, even at this time, even for women in the Party, to say we want full share and full responsibility is kind of difficult and kind of touchy because of our society. Our men have been sort of castrated, you know. The responsibilities that they rightfully should have had before, were taken away from them--to take away their manhood. We've had to fight all this before. Our men are constantly thinking or saying that maybe if we assume a heavier role, a more responsible role, that this, in turn, will sort of take away their responsibility and it's such a touchy thing, that we have to be very sure that the roles are evenly divided.

It shouldn't have to be one certain role for a man and one certain role for a woman--we're all gonna participate in the struggle and whatever we can do best, we do it, whether it's at a higher level or not. This is very specific thing like male chauvinism, in combatting a specific thing like male chauvinism, because some brothers still have this fear of women dominating the whole political scene. It may not be voiced that often, but I think it's a very real fear, and we're going to have to be sensitive enough to recognize it. We're going to have to be sensitive enough to say that we're going to take more of a share of the political arena but, at the same time, we're going to have to keep these things in mind.

I think it's important that within the context of that struggle that black men understand that their manhood is not dependent on keeping their black women subordinate to them because this is what bourgeois ideology has been trying to put into the black man and that's part of the special oppression of black women. Black women as generally a part of the poor people of the US, the working class, are more oppressed, as being black, they're super-oppressed, and as being women they are sexually oppressed by men in general and by black men also.

So, in this context we see that black women are especially oppressed in this country and it's very important that black women understand and black men understand that black man's manhood is not dependent upon the subordination of black women, but rather his manhood is, in fact, dependent on his own strength and the strength he also gets from a revolutionary relationship. A relationship is more fruitful when, in fact, the woman is the other half and not the weaker half. They (the men) get more out of the relationship, just as the women.

UNITY IN STRUGGLE

MOVEMENT: What are your ideas on the strategy for women's liberation in terms of separate women's organizations, the priority of women's liberation in relation to other issues like imperialism and racism?

PANTHER WOMEN: I think it's important that the separate women's liberation groups not all be lumped into one category. Their effectiveness and their value is dependent upon to what extent their work is furthering revolutionary goals in this country. I think that there are all different kinds of organizations in existence now. There are some people who talk about the contradiction among men and women as one of the major contradictions in capitalist society and therefore they take that contradiction (and even if they don't talk about it, some of them put it into practice) and develop it into an antagonistic contradiction, when actually it is a contradiction among the people. It's not a contradiction between enemies.

An example of this is at the IAF Conference where occasions arose from time to time where women would want to have caucus and a man would come around and they would get very uptight that a man was there and were practically ready to jump on him, just because he happened to be listening around. I think that's an example of how the women's struggle is taken out of perspective--it is separated from class struggle. In this country, it's separated from national liberation struggles and it's given its own category of women against men. Sometimes people say, "it's within a revolutionary context", but in practice, if all their rhetoric and all their practice is anti-men, it is not a revolutionary program and, as a matter of fact, it hinders the revolutionary forces.

The contradiction between men and women is a contradiction that has to be worked out within the revolutionary forces. It is not at all comparable to the class contradictions. It's the class struggle that takes priority. To the extent that women's organizations don't address themselves to the class struggle or to national liberation struggles they are not really furthering the women's liberation movement, because in order for women to be truly emancipated in this country there's going to have to be a socialist revolution. And there's going to have to be ideological struggle for decades and probably for centuries before male chauvinism is overcome. If women don't understand this, they're not going to truly be able to overcome their special oppression.

Roberta is correct and even those women's organizations who do address themselves to the struggles that are at hand, the strategy of having autonomous women's liberation organizations is incorrect because, as Roberta says, it seems as if those organizations look upon women's liberation as a priority when in actuality the struggle towards socialist revolution is a priority. Women can only become emancipated, not through their own efforts as a particular group, but through their participation on an equal plane in the existing organizations which are comprised of men and women who are struggling for the same cause. It's not a separate struggle and women's liberation does not take priority, but in fact is part and parcel of the overall struggle.

FEMALE CHAUVINISM

Any organization that's being formed for women's liberation, like Rosemary said, has got to take into consideration that they can't operate separately and by themselves. They must also understand the definition of chauvinism. Chauvinism isn't just relegated to the male. Chauvinism is an undying or unreasoning or irrational love for one's sex and if a women's liberation organization gets uptight because a man comes around that's looking at things as a whole. It's not being realistic and looking as a revolutionary in terms of a man too functioning as a revolutionary and a woman functioning as a revolutionary. If they're not careful, they will go to an extreme and they will become female chauvinists. They will have an undying love for their sex and totally negate revolutionary struggle.

Unfortunately, if we don't be careful, I think that the women's liberation struggle can be co-opted by opportunists. It can become just like a style or a

fad and the whole revolutionary struggle will be set back because of this. This is one reason why the revolutionary practitioners, because of the repression we're suffering, can't take time out to go off by ourselves to solve some of our backwardness. This would be just another dividing tactic as far as I can see.

WOMEN'S LIBERATION IN PRACTICE

I think it's important to recognize the dangers that separate women's groups face immediately, just because they're women's groups and there's a good chance that they're going to get off base in terms of what the primary struggle is. However, I think we have to be very careful in terms of condemning forms that are used in the movement. I think that there is room for special organizing of women. There are positive things that these kinds of groups can do: for example, canneries, special plants where there's primarily women, electronics and this sort of thing in terms of working class organizing, in terms of organizing cooperative nurseries to liberate the energies of women.

But, they are always facing certain dangers in terms of turning in on themselves, in terms of becoming a very petit bourgeois little clique where they just talk about how they have to take care of the kids all the time or become a gripe session. So, I think, while we as Panthers, while we integrate the struggle of the brothers and sisters within the Party, we still will see how these separate women's liberation groups do thru their practice. And that's where our judgment of them will come in.

We have a phrase that says that the only culture worth keeping is a revolutionary culture. Now, our culture dictates that we become revolutionaries. Irrespective of what the brothers say, like Rosemary says, we should function in a position that furthers revolution and revolutionary culture. The women's liberation groups that are separating away from the men (I think Roberta said there's some room for them, and we can't vacillate on whether there is or not, we have to judge them on their practice) should take into consideration that we're here to liberate the people and like we said, it's a socialist liberation struggle and we can't operate as halves.

If women's liberation is going to exist, it should exist with the goal in mind to channel the energies they liberate into a united liberation of the men and women together--not as a bourgeois club, because this has happened many times. They've become extremist organizations of female superiority and have totally forgotten about the people's struggles and oppressed people and have, themselves become oppressors.

PANTHER PROGRAMS

MOVEMENT: Do the Panthers have any specific programs directed at women in the community to get them involved in the struggle.



VIETNAM

PANTHER WOMEN: The Black Panther Party does not have any program that is specifically addressed to women, per se. There is, on the National Committees to Combat Fascism, a committee on the national steering committee of women. But the primary function of this committee is to channel those women who are proponents of women's liberation into areas of work integrated into the liberation movement.

Even though the Panther Party doesn't have a women's program per se, (I don't know whether we will in the future or not) I think we realize that the best effort is thru practice and that our liberation is going to come thru the realization on the part of the brothers that they can't practice male chauvinism, but even more important, it comes from a conscious effort on the part of the sisters to educate themselves and not to accept menial positions or relegate themselves to submissive positions. The brothers can be non-chauvinistic as much as they want, but unless the sisters realize that they have to accept an equal position or act as a revolutionary, then this isn't going to do any good. So I think the best criterion for that is practice.

In addition to that--simply because of the fact that we are members of the Black Panther Party and are therefore in the vanguard, does not necessarily mean that we can deem ourselves champions of women's liberation. We believe that male chauvinism must be stomped out, because we have come to realize that it is bourgeois. Bourgeois ideas are those which are perpetuated upon us by the bourgeois class and is something we're fighting against. But because we've come to realize all these things just recently, we're very new at it. So that whether or not we will become champions of women's liberation, whether or not we'll be able to provide the example to lead other organizations towards women's liberation will come thru our practice.

WOMEN'S CAUCUSES

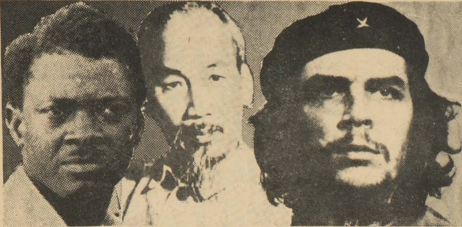
MOVEMENT: What do you think about all women's caucuses inside the organization? Some people say that within movement organizations there's male chauvinism and women must deal with it from a position of power, so they should organize their own caucuses. They also say there's a parallel between women's liberation and black liberation and just like black people had to get themselves together without whites first, so women have to get themselves together

THE POWER OF ARMS

From Tricontinental May - June 1969

After the Party was created in 1956, there was another important moment in 1959 when the Portuguese committed the Pijiguiti massacre, which caused indignation among the entire population of Guinea and Cape Verde. That was a crucial, decisive moment, because it showed that the Party was following a mistaken line and that it had no experience. At that moment the Party knew nothing of what was happening in the world and we had to advance empirically. It wasn't until 1961 that I got to know the works of Mao Tse Tung. The lack of experience made us think that we could fight in the cities with strikes and other things, but we were wrong and the reality of the moment showed us that it was not possible.

That same year, after Guinea achieved independence in 1958, small groups were created and then, in 1959, the Party succeeded in uniting each of them under its leadership. The result was a single organization requiring that each give up its group identity when it became part of this one organization. This showed the confidence our people had in the leadership of the Party. In September 1959, a little more than a month after the Pijiguiti massacre, we held a secret conference in Bissau which gave a complete new turn to the character of our struggle. Then we began to prepare ourselves for armed struggle and we decided to go into the countryside. The President of the Party, Rafael Barbosa, was the first to leave for the *mato* to mobilize the people and to form new party members. Our city people also went — workers, employees, etc.; they left their things and went to the *mato* to mobilize the population.

Another great moment is when the Party moved beyond supporting the struggle of the Angolans to direct action in our own land in August 1961. We began with some important sabotage; the Portuguese responded with massive repressions against our people, which made the contradictions between us and them greater and brought us inevitably to armed struggle.

The great wave of repression unleashed by the Portuguese — during which Comrade Rafael Barbosa was arrested — didn't succeed in destroying our will to free ourselves. On the contrary, it spurred our will to carry the fight onward and to show the Portuguese that nothing could stop us.

At the beginning of 1961 the Portuguese arrested 21 Party members — among whom were Fernando Fortes, Epifanio, and others — some of them leaders of the Party. The great campaign that took place forced the colonialists to give them trials and to free the majority of them. That gave us a great deal of prestige and helped to implant the idea of the struggle deeper in our people.

Consequently the Party decided to take advantage of the existence of independent countries, at least of one of the neighboring independent countries. If the internal factors are decisive, we cannot forget the external factors. The fact that the Republic of Guinea was next to us allowed our Party to decide to install there, temporarily, some of our

leaders in order to create the measures necessary to help the struggle. This enabled us to create a political school to prepare political activists. This was decisive for our struggle. In 1960 we created a political school in Conakry, under very poor conditions. Militants from the cities

— Party members — were the first to come to receive political instruction and to be trained in how to mobilize our people for the fight.

First some comrades from the city came to the school, then came peasants, youths (some even bringing their entire families) who were mobilized by Party members. Ten, twenty, twenty-five people would come for a period of one or two months. During that time they went through an intensive formative program and we spoke with them, and night would come and we couldn't speak any more because we were completely hoarse. Some of the cadres of the Party would explain the entire situation to them but we went further.

We performed in that school as in a theatre, imagining the mobilization of the people of a *tabanka*, but taking into account social characteristics, traditions, religion — the customs of our peasant population.

An aspect that I want to point out is the condition of our countryside. We speak of peasants, but the term "peasant" is very vague. The peasant who fought in Algeria or China is not the peasant of our country.

It so happens that in our country the Portuguese colonialist did not appropriate the land; he allowed us to cultivate the land; he didn't create agricultural companies like the European type like he did, for instance, in Angola; he didn't create *colonatos*, as he did in Angola, where he displaced masses of Africans in order to settle Europeans. We maintained a basic structure under colonialism: the land as cooperative property of the village, of the community. This is a very important characteristic of our peasant, who was not directly exploited by the colonizer but was exploited through trade, through the differences between the prices and the real value of the products. It is there where exploitation occurs. Not in work, as happens in Angola with the hired workers and company employees. This created a difficult aspect in our struggle: to show the peasant that he was being exploited in his own land.

Telling the people that "the land belongs to those who toil on it" was not sufficient to mobilize them, because we have more than enough land; there is all the land we need.

ZIONIST MENACE

Zionist aggression against the neighbouring Arab countries, and Israel's inhuman treatment of the Arab population of Palestine, millions of whom have been driven from their homes, continues to occupy a focal point of world anxiety. Behind Israel with her arrogant contempt for the Arab peoples and her dream of establishing a religious Jewish state from the Nile to the Euphrates, stands the world's most powerful and aggressive imperialist state, the U.S.A. Staunchly backing the Arab countries in their demands for the withdrawal of the invading Israeli troops and self-determination for the Palestinian people is the Socialist Soviet Union.

Thus, a prolongation and inten-

sification of the Middle Eastern crisis must lead to a grave danger that the two most powerful nuclear and military states will confront one another. No sane person could wish such an outcome, for reasons which are all too clear.

Yet, that is precisely what the leaders of Israel, aided and abetted by the West, are continuing to do. They refuse to withdraw to the borders they occupied before the aggression of June 1967, as demanded by the Security Council. They refuse to allow the return of the Arab refugees whom they expelled from Israel and from the occupied territories. They continuously conduct fresh aggressions against their neighbouring states.

Their pretext for so doing is that these states are allowing their territory to be used as bases for the operations of the guerrillas of the Palestinian Arab liberation

We had to find appropriate formulas to mobilize our peasant, instead of utilizing terms that our people couldn't yet understand. We could never mobilize our people merely on the basis of the struggle against colonialism. That produces nothing; to speak of the fight against imperialism is not convincing enough. In its place we use a direct language that all can understand:

Why are we going to fight? What are you? What is your father? What has happened to your father until now? What is happening? What is the situation? Did you pay the tax? Did your father pay the tax? What have you seen from that tax? How much do you get from your peanuts? Have you thought about what you will earn with your peanuts? How much sweat has it cost your family? Which of you were prisoners? Was it you who was a prisoner?

These were the mobilizing factors. You are going to work in road-building. Who gives you the tools? You bring the tools. Who provides the meal? You provide the meal. But — who walks in the street? Who has a car? And your daughter who was raped by that so-and-so — do you find that all right?

To interest certain elements we even used some concrete cases the people knew about: individuals who had been molested by Portuguese colonialism but didn't realize that Portuguese colonialism was at fault.

In our new mobilization we avoided all over-generalizations and platitudes. We went into detail and had our people, those preparing for this kind of work repeat what they were going to say many times. That is an aspect which we considered of great importance, in our specific case, because we started from the concrete reality of our people. We tried to avoid having the peasants suppose that we were outsiders come to teach them how to do things; we put ourselves in the position of people who came to learn with the peasant, and in the end the peasant was discovering for himself why things had gone so badly for him. He came to understand that there exists a tremendous amount of exploitation and that he is the one who pays everything, even the profits of the people living in the city. Experience shows us it is necessary that each people find its own formula to mobilize for the struggle.

movements, but who could deny the right of people who have been expelled from their motherland by force to return by all means including armed struggle? Or the duty of the fraternal Arab States to give them all assistance in their power?

Israel must quit the territories she has illegally annexed by her acts of aggression. She must readmit the Arab peoples she has inhumanly driven from their ancestral homelands. That is the plain message of the recent Cairo Conference in support of the Arab peoples.

WOMEN ARE GOOD CO-OP HEADS SAYS HO CHI MINH

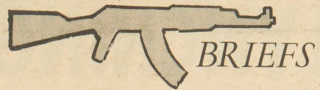
HANOI (LNS) -- In spite of the continuing attempt of the United States to wipe out that small country, North Vietnam continues its revolutionary struggles, including women's liberation. In a recent interview with Maria Rojas of Prensa Latina, the late revolutionary of the Democratic Republic of Vietnam, Ho Chi Minh reported "Women have made a good deal

of progress. They have taken on new leadership responsibilities. It is very common now to see women as heads of cooperatives, and, in my opinion, they're better than men, because when men achieve an exceptional workday they usually throw a little celebration party, and sometimes the production surplus is wasted. Women don't do that."

Vietnam

HANOI

On July 4, 1969, in the A So valley, southwest of Hue, 50 GIs and 10 puppet troops were killed or wounded in a clash between U.S. and puppet soldiers. In fact, U.S. planes had strafed and bombed by mistake a company of puppet Regiment 3 raiding near A Luoi; soldiers of a unit of puppet Regiment 5 coming to the rescue of Regiment 3, incensed by the rash attack of the Yankees, opened fire on a unit of U.S. motorized Division 5 moving behind them.

HANOI

HANOI (LNS) -- Twenty five GIs stationed at the port city of Vinh Lam staged a demonstration against the Vietnam war recently, according to a dispatch from Vietnam's Liberation Press Agency. The Vietnamese agency also said that GIs mutilated and killed two officers in the town of Thach Tru, in Quang Ngai province. South Vietnamese police reportedly indicated that the two officers were shot in an explicitly anti-war protest.

HANOI

HANOI (LNS) -- More than 100 Black GIs staged an anti-war protest July 30 in the port base of Qui Nhon, in Binh Hoa province, according to a report by the Liberation Press Agency of South Vietnam.

The report, as transmitted by Prensa Latina, said that the men marched from one end of the base to the other and also marched on the local airport. They reportedly "shouted slogans demanding peace, the end of the U.S. aggression in Vietnam and the immediate withdrawal of the U.S. troops."

At the airport, the Black GIs battled with cops who tried to stop the demonstration.

Vietnam

(Excerpts from Vietnam Courier, July 21, 1969 No. 226)

A group of journalists in Saigon took the decision to stage on July 13 last a hunger strike at the Press Centre as a protest against the brutalities and vexations inflicted by the U.S. -- puppet police and authorities on newsmen in the fulfillment of their duty, Western agencies reported.

This protest campaign began after the "rough tactics" resorted to by the police in a ceremony organized at Tan Son Nhat on the occasion of the "repatriation" of the first contingent of GIs under the plan for the deceptive withdrawal of 25,000 men of the U.S. expeditionary force decided by Nixon to hoodwink public opinion. According to an AFP correspondent, on that day, cameramen-reporters were expelled by force of arms from the stand while others were punched in the face.

Before the wrath of the newsmen, the U.S. -- puppets had given in by promising to punish the bullies.

However, these promises seem clearly inadequate to placate public opinion. The Thieu-Ky-Huong fascist clique, propped up by Washington, continues to encroach upon the freedom of the press and as it is known, within a year, over 30 newspapers have been closed down and many pressmen prosecuted, jailed or even killed by wicked thugs.

HANOI (LNS) -- A U.S. spy plane was shot down Aug. 14 in Ha Tay province in the Democratic Republic of Vietnam, Prensa Latina reported. The plane was number 3316 -- that is, 3,316 U.S. planes have been shot down over North Vietnamese territory since the beginning of the war.

South Africa

The Vorster regime is pressing ahead with legislation to give sweeping authoritarian powers to the Bureau of State Security, already dubbed BOSS by South Africans.

The powers vested in BOSS are similar in many respects to powers vested in the S.S. by Hitler soon after he took power in Germany. Once BOSS becomes legalized, nothing this sinister fascist organization disapproves of can be published or raised in court.

The press cannot publish or communicate any information relating to military, police or security matters "deemed prejudicial to the safety of the State." In other words any person tortured in detention can be denied the right to seek redress in court if the Prime Minister or any official authorised by him issues a certificate proving no evidence being led on his detention.

In other words anything the BOSS does not want publicised or brought to court can now be legally and effectively hushed up.

Isreal

The United States has delivered 50 Phantom Fighter-Bombers to Zionist Israel. The move is calculated to insure American type "peace" in the Middle East -- just as the United States has done in Vietnam.

Israel's Prime Minister, Gold Meir is expected to visit the United States soon and ask for 25 more Phantom's and an additional 80 Skyhawks. As part of the kick-back, Israel will have to buy the Napalm, (to bomb Arab civilians with) from the United States. The United States is the only country in the world that produces Napalm.

Chili

SANTIAGO DE CHILE (LNS) -- Cops broke into the office of Hsinhua (the New China News Agency) in the capital of Chile, and later detained the Hsinhua Bureau Chief, Jorge Palacios. Chilean authorities accused Palacios of violations of "national security" laws for his ties to the Left Revolutionary Movement, known as the MIR.

Brazil

SAO PAULO, Brazil (LNS) -- Three Sao Paulo TV stations were destroyed by fire between July 13 and 17, signs of the pro-Chinese organization led by M. Carlos Marigheta and the former Army captain Carlos Lamarca who deserted January 28 with a truckload of weapons.

SAO PAULO, Brazil (LNS) -- Sao Paulo saw its 28th bank robbery of the year Aug. 6, as urban guerrillas stepped up their activities against the military regime. A trio of armed men liberated \$5,000 and took off in a car. Prensa Latina reported that there have been 61 political bank robberies in 1969, involving a total of \$717,800.

LYNCHING

It is well known that the black race is the most oppressed and most exploited of the human family. It is well known that the spread of capitalism and the discovery of the New World had as an immediate result the rebirth of slavery which was, for centuries, a scourge for the Negroes and a bitter disgrace for mankind. What everyone does not perhaps know, is that after sixty-five years of so-called emancipation, American Negroes still endure atrocious moral and material sufferings, of which the most cruel and horrible is the custom of lynching.

The word "lynching" comes from Lynch. Lynch was the name of a planter in Virginia, a landlord and judge. Availing the control of the whole district into his lord and judge. Availing himself of the troubles of the War of Independence, he took the control of the whole district into his hands. He inflicted the most savage punishment, without trial or process of law, on Loyalists and Tories. Thanks to the slave-traders, the Ku Klux Klan, and other secret societies, the illegal and barbarous practice of lynching is spreading and continuing widely in the States of the American Union. It has become more inhuman since the emancipation of the Blacks, and is especially directed at the latter.

Imagine a furious horde. Fists clenched, eyes bloodshot, mouths foaming, yells, insults, curses... This horde is transported with the

wild delight of a crime to be committed without risk. They are armed with sticks, torches, revolvers, ropes, knives, scissors, vitriol, daggers; in a word, with all that can be used to kill or wound.

Imagine in this human sea a flotsam of black flesh pushed about, beaten, trampled underfoot, torn, slashed, insulted, tossed hither and thither, bloodstained, dead.

The horde are the lynchers. The human rag is the Black victim.

In a wave of hatred and bestiality, the lynchers drag the Black to a wood or a public place. They tie him to a tree, pour kerosene over him, cover him with inflammable materials. While waiting for the fire to be kindled, they smash his teeth, one by one. Then they gauge out his eyes. Little tufts of crinkly hair are torn from his head, carrying away with them bits of skin, baring a bloody skull. Little pieces of flesh come off his body, already contused from the blows.

The Black can no longer shout: his tongue has been swollen by a red hot iron. His whole body ripples, trembling, like a half-crushed snake. A slash with a knife: one of his ears falls to the ground... Oh! How black he is! How awful! And the ladies tear at his face... "Light up," shouts someone, "Just enough to cook him slowly," adds another.

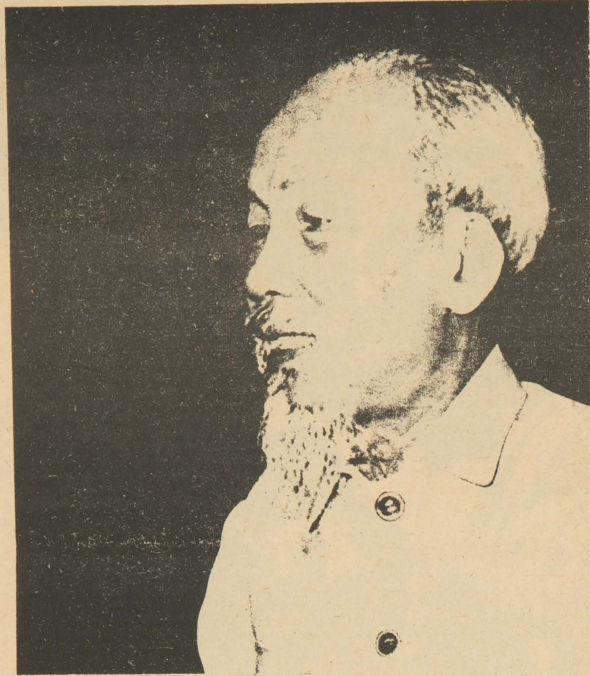
The Black is roasted, browned, burned. But he deserves to die

twice instead of once. He is therefore hanged, or more exactly, what is left of his corpse is hanged. And all those who were not able to help with the cooking applaud now.

Hurray!
When everybody has had enough, the corpse is brought down. The

rope is cut into small pieces which will be sold for three or five dollars each. Souvenirs and lucky charms quarreled over by ladies. "Popular justice," as they say over there, has been done. Calmed down, the crowd congratulate the "organizers," then stream away slowly and cheerfully, as if after

a feast, make appointments with one another for the next time. While on the ground, stinking of fat and smoke, a black head, mutilated, roasted, deformed, grins horribly and seems to ask the setting sun, "Is this civilization?"

What would we expect is this: One thing is that the revolutionary Party members must CATCH the tricks of the power structure and many things along with its operations of pacification, for example, The fascists begin to pacify when they see the ranks of their armed bodies or other, which use to be brainwashed, getting hip by resisting, be it in the military or otherwise. By now, all the Party members should be hip to the use of cultural nationalism by the pigs as a means to maintain their exploitative, oppressive war machine. Party members must have a political perspective on all fronts to the extent that they can damn near or automatically point out tricks, facts, and lies to the members of the masses in THE MILITARY and those not in it. Check specifically in the establishment news media who in the Party is writing an article about the use of cultural nationalism and outright Black racist statements by a fascist named General Chapman of the Babylonian Marine Corps? This, of course, with the run of the news items in the regular media, isn't the only developing situation especially related to the need to teach the correct methods and ideas to the masses via the Black Panther Party newspaper and door to door, face to face community work.

As we know, the Party paper sets the correct line or as definitely suppose to give, the correct political line. Now everyone in the Party naturally receives nationally the Party newspaper. From there, the correct political perspective is transferred, by Party members and the Black Panther Party newspapers, to 85 to 100 thousand people around the country, and from there hopefully it might get to a few more million in the Black communities, the white radical left, etc., etc. Who in the Party.....? Maybe we should centralize with Big Man or we should let those important situations which develop that must be countered, when it's a means especially to try and rebrainwash those who resist and other potential supporters, are written. These articles should relate to the Party's correct line. The Party should let anyone else who is writing should let the Editor know so Big Man knows it's going to be covered.

Party members are suppose to read the news everyday. I know there is a lot of work; but read and actually assign yourselves a task, say maybe two hours a night or early in the morning, and write articles dealing with specific situations that develop. I know some brothers and sisters in the Party already write articles. But even Brother Andrew one night, with all the work he has to do, he sat up one night and pounded out something. Some of what he had to say was all fucked up. But that was because the Party had to get the Editor on his job. What Andrew was doing was writing an article about how the Panthers had gone up to the campus and taught Reagan's National Guard from Party materials. And it was a timely developed situation of fascism in Berkeley which was fresh in the establishment press. Don't misunderstand, We don't necessarily count on the establishment press for news. But

the Party knows that the mass media lies and misleads the people. The only thing the Party has is a national organ which needs to be built up to a million circulation nationally in Babylon and abroad. I'm sure when our Minister of Defense, Huey, set the rule that everyone read the news daily and also do two hours daily reading of Party materials, etc., he didn't tell members to do this just so you would have some kind of "personal" information. No, Huey saw the need to see to it that Party members become equipped with correct revolutionary thought and from the work habits necessary to maintain a political party to lead the movement in this country. (The strongest instrument of the proletariat must be at the forefront to deal with the immediate situations and long range struggle). Every Party member has been studying to some extent. Now it's time to further develop what Party members are suppose to know correctly to be functional. All the revolutionary politicians must be able to (or develop to) write and speak to the people, starting now.

Another thing is that everyone should write to the Minister and tell him what you think. Help him understand about his latest articles. Tell him if the articles enlighten us. Tell him that, Huey has always been a brother who loves to explain what he means if any Party member has questions. "Prison—Where is the Victory?" and the one in the Ebony (Black racist) magazine. The articles naturally give righteous political perspective, and we need more from the Minister. Ask Huey to write more. Huey will love that. And I'll bet he responds. David, brother! What Party members editing and printing Huey's taped statement dealing with the peace forces of the movement, yet? You know Party members heard it on tape. But I'm sure you know that it must be printed so we Party members can study it.

Another Black talking fascist like Alioto and Nixon has made himself known to the exploited peoples of America. His name is Leonard F. Chapman, a general working for the oppressive ruling class circles in the U.S. Marine Corps. It's really gotten back. And the oppressed people should hope that it gets even worse, when the top brass of the military has to try and sell to G.I.'s cultural nationalism which is a Black racist's narrow-minded form of thinking that supports this oppressive, capitalistic system. This General Chapman has jumped up and hollered a program out that's similar to the same crap the Nixon attempted to trick Black people with, which was Black capitalism. Everyone nowadays is rather hip to give promises that the government has made. Reagan's attempt to trick capitalistic fools of the Black community.

We are well aware of how at one time to be "proud of being Black" was scorned by the power structure. Then along came Malcolm X. And he was not only proud of being Black, but he was more progressive than that. He was or became a revolutionary proletarian who refused to be a Black racist. Listen to his record, "The Last Message." Reading Malcolm's last words one notices how Malcolm began to teach Black people to defend themselves and protect themselves from anyone who attacks. Malcolm also in his last days moved to build the Organization of Afro-American Unity, a needed political organization which was primarily in dealing with everyday needs of Black people, such as decent housing, better education, clothing, food, etc.

Huey P. Newton, the Minister of Defense, has pointed out how when progressive, revolutionary organization comes along sincerely serving to teach its people, the "ruling class, the governor will finance cultural nationalism because all they (the cultural nationalists) do is bark and holler about being Black. The reason they will be financed is because they are not true revolutionaries." The man (the fascist governor) will allow the

Black racist, cultural nationalists to put on their plays, and the poverty programs will give them grants to play bongos on Black cultural programs. The governor will do this in hopes that they will forget about the need to fight the hunger and pig brutality rampant in our communities. They will finance them when an organization like the Black Panther Party comes along that will defend itself against aggression and teach the people to defend themselves. Huey said, "The power structure looks at the cultural nationalists as a bunch of barking dogs and looks at the Black Panther Party," (especially when 30 million Black people listen to the Party), they look at it like, "a political force destructive to oppressive capitalism which the ruling class maintains. So, what they do is throw a few crumbs to the cultural nationalists to keep them barking. A barking dog doesn't bite, but they move to kill true revolutionaries like Malcolm X," and Huey P. Newton, Eldridge, and many other members of the Black Panther Party. They move to put many of us in prisons on trumped up charges. But as the Party strengthens with correct ideas and methods amongst the people, the pigs begin to use these cultural, Black racist, pork chop nationalists as murderers in the same manner as Blacks were used to murder Malcolm X, and in the same manner as Black racists have been used as provocateur agents against the Party and are still being used.

CONCERNING THE G.I.'S:

Basically, getting down to the nitty gritty, there is the need on the part of the power structure to move to use "niggers" progressive revolutionaries as much as he can to try and make it look like "Black people are just fighting amongst themselves." He'll imply or say this on his news broadcast. Not so! Not at all. Now in the military, there has been some riots between Black and white soldiers from here to Germany to Vietnam, and especially in Vietnam where Black soldiers see they have no business fighting a war for the fascist ruling class power structure. If Black soldiers can't get along with white ones, well it breaks down the fighting capacity on the part of the U.S. military. But look: there is another factor. So many Black G.I.'s won't fall into a trap with this Black racism that this fascist demagogic General Chapman wants and needs.

What about all the G.I.'s, be they Black or white, who are refusing to fight in the war, who are seeking sanctuary in churches, going AWOL, hiding in other countries, and also there are those who are drafted who actually refuse to go. I even saw a front page headline one day when it said over 100,000 A.W.O.L.'s. I don't remember the exact figure, but this is important to notice. A large portion of G.I.'s in the U.S. military don't want any part of this war. They want out. G.I.'s even have underground newspapers. The Black Panther Party gets many letters expressing complete dissent from American G.I.'s. All in all, there is great dissent among American G.I.'s, both Black and white, brown and red.

General Chapman's Black Fascist program—a real summation of what he did; Chapman has told Black G.I.'s that they can have some "soul music" in the juke box and wear natural "Afro" hair if they stop being discontent by raising the clenched fist, which Chapman wrongly described saying and implying that it was a "Black Power salute", only, No. Not the case, the latter. The clenched fist

is a "Power to the People" salute. But there is a two-fold purpose here on the part of the power structure in doing this. One is to try and co-op the clenched fist salute and tell brothers in the military that it means "Black Power" which has already been co-opted by the Nixon regime to mean Black capitalism which really breeds more Black racism. Two, to limit the clenched fist salute to only Black people by trying to get it identified with Afro hair cuts and "soul music" in a juke box so it won't spread beyond Black soldiers to show G.I.'s who are beginning to show great dissent by relating to revolutionary ideology such as "Power to the People".

Once a white G.I. gets the correct meaning to the saying, "Power to the People," he is going to remember that old phrasing they taught him in school which is the same in essence to "Power to the People." That old saying is, "Government of the people, by the people, and for the people." Now, when it's placed in a proper perspective one can see that this capitalist government is not of, by, and for the people. How can it be when 30 million Black people don't have human rights, which we have been demanding for 400 years. It can't be a government by the people when fascist cops brutalize and murder Black and white people who circulated petitions to keep Eldridge out of prison. When young white G.I.'s denounce the military for the aggressive war on Vietnam and also see the racism within the military against Black soldiers, then it's time to get a demagogic (lying, misleading) fascist general like Leonard Chapman to come out and say some crap like there has been some "racial strife" and we're going to give you Black boys some "soul music" and let you "wear Afro hair cuts." Then he acts like it is the end of all "racial strife", where Black G.I.'s are suppose to forget about the poverty and brutality they receive in the wretched ghettos, and white G.I.'s are suppose to say to themselves, "Is that what the Black G.I.'s wanted? Soul music and Afro hair cuts?" No. Look at it in a broader perspective. The next thing the dogs will be lying about to the G.I.'s is about Ho Chi Minh's death, if they ain't already doing it. They will be telling Black G.I.'s that the Black Panther Party doesn't exist anymore, which is a lie, as everyone who reads this article in the Black Panther Party Newspaper testifies to, and especially all you brothers in the military who are reading this issue. Brothers, don't forget to give this paper to the white, red, brown and other Black G.I.'s who need to read this information. Buy 5 more copies and maybe take out some subscriptions for some people you know who should read the Black Panther Party Newspaper. Don't use your military address. Have it sent home then repackaged and sent to you, so you can make sure you receive it.

A picture of Chapman, the demagogic, fascist general, is in the paper and under his name in the San Francisco Chronicle he is quoted as saying, "Total impartiality." This is meant to mean from the article that "officers" are to use "total impartiality in dealing with Marines of all races, colors and creeds." "To dispel the racial problems that currently exist." Sounds just like Tricky Dick Nixon to me, Chapman went on about "violence" among Marines "cannot be tolerated." But I remember when "Lynching" Baines Johnson would react to Black rebellions in the

black community. Just before he would send in paratroopers to kill Black people, Lyndon Johnson would say, "We cannot, and will not tolerate it." This same general, Chapman, works with and for Nixon, and did the same for Lying Baines Johnson who kept the war going for the four years he was a rotten President. Lyndon Baines Johnson is a greedy, exploiting, avaricious businessman and was a demagogic, lying politician. General Chapman is a running dog for the ruling circles. In fact, being a general puts him in the category of being a member of the actual ruling class circles which oppresses and exploits us, the masses of the laboring people, unemployed or employed.

I was in the military once and because I opposed racism in the top brass, a Lt. Colonel, I was placed in the stockade for six months and kicked out with what they call a "bad conduct discharge". I was told that when I got out, (I had served a full 4 years, lacking one month to go), they said I wouldn't be able to get a job and that I should accept the fact that it was my fault that I received a 39-17 B.C.D category discharge. I told the fool that there wasn't any jobs out there for Black people before I came in the service and asked him what the hell he meant by thinking that I was supposed to be upset by him saying that. Then he said I was "being smart." I sure was. I was smart enough to know that there weren't any jobs for the masses of Black people. But just to prove I was a good worker, I got a whole lot of jobs. They would fire when they found out I had a B.C.D., I didn't care because the work I was doing was aiding their war machine. I began to realize this when I met Huey P. Newton. I became more aware by studying and reading and trying to help organize resistance of some kind against the oppression that the ruling class circles maintained upon the heads of the laboring masses (be they employed or unemployed) G.I.'s, Black, Brown, Red, White, any color, are workers. But they work most directly with the fascist aggressive war machine of America named by Eldridge Cleaver as "Babylon."

So, for those Black G.I.'s who need an understanding of how this capitalist system works against Black and all poor, oppressed people, not only at home but also genocide abroad, I would like to point out number 6 of the Black Panther Party's Program:

"We want all black men to be exempt from military service.

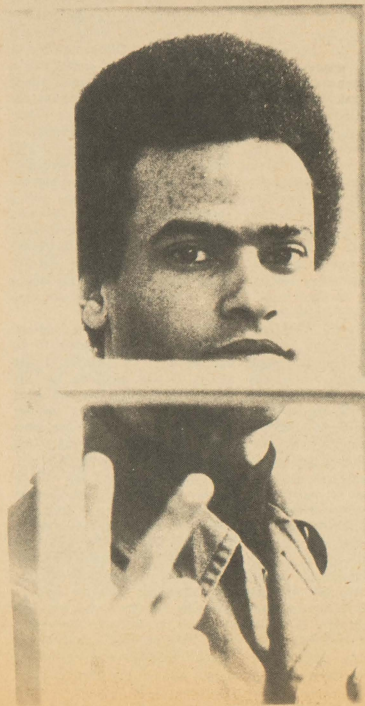

HUEY'S APPEAL



EDITOR'S NOTE:

The following article is taken from the appeal prepared by the attorneys defending Huey P. Newton, Minister of Defense of the Black Panther Party. Huey's attorneys have moved to have the case reviewed by the Court of Appeals of the State of California. The Black Panther News Paper will print the appeal in part—every week to give the people all the facts as to why Huey P. Newton should be set free immediately.

Prejudice operates to incline the jury to believe ill of the defendant and to disbelieve his testimony and those of black witnesses for the defense, especially when their testimony conflicts with that of white prosecution witnesses. (See Myrdal, supra, at 550-52; Broeder, supra, 1965 Duke L.J. 60 Harv. L.R.; (29) Tucker, "Racial Discrimination in Jury Selection in Virginia," 52 Va. L. Rev. 736, 742-44 (1966).

FOOTNOTE

(28) The United States Supreme Court, federal and state cases prohibiting exclusion of a racially or significantly identifiable group from jury panels do not rest upon an explicit finding that white persons are racist or prejudiced against Negroes. Now, following the official findings of the Kerner Report by the President's official National Advisory Commission, even more stringent controls of the discriminatory result are required. If 7 out of 10 white persons or any percentage even approaching that figure were racially biased against the defendant, a fair trial could not be had as the result of any selection process which systematically, through a series of steps, from use of voters' roll through peremptory challenge, substantially underrepresented black people on the actual jury.

(29) Where jury deliberations have become known, overt prejudice toward blacks has been revealed (1965 Duke L.J. 21-24).

END FOOTNOTE

Challenges for cause cannot keep juries free from unconscious prejudice or from prejudice which the venireman, through embarrassment or otherwise, is unwilling to admit publicly on voir dire. Irvin v. Dowd, 366 U.S. 717, 728, 81 S. Ct. 1639 (1961). (30) See also Broeder, "Voir Dire Examination: An Empirical Study," 38 So. Cal. L. Rev. 503, 523 (1965), concurring with uncontroverted testimony given in the instant case by Professor Nevitt Sanford, Ph.D., and Bernard Diamond, M.D., on unconscious racism and difficulty of ascertaining both unconscious and willfully withheld attitudes of racism through ordinary techniques of voir dire (R.T. 227-28, 308-09).

The law contemplates that in finding facts, individual jurors will make like inferences and reach like conclusions in like situations, regardless of who the parties are. This cannot be the case if there is prejudice in one-population

group against another, and the fact finding process is hampered further if members of the prejudiced group have an excessive impact through over-representation on juries. (Broeder, supra, 1965 Duke L.J. at 22-24; Tucker, supra, at 742-45; and note, for example, that the authors of the 1890 Mississippi Constitution believed Negroes to be "given rather to furtive offenses than to the more robust crimes of the whites." (Ratliff v. Beale, 74 Miss. 247, 266, 20 So. 865, 868 (1896).

The prosecution herein made no attempt to refute or dispute the findings of the Kerner Report, or of the sociologists who testified herein or submitted the brief amici curiae, or, indeed, to deny that group prejudice exists to some degree in the great majority of white citizens against black people. Since jury discrimination tends to exclude Negroes and other disfavored groups, the result is to increase the amount of prejudice against such groups on juries so that the prejudice is even more concentrated on juries than in the general population. Exclusion of jurors opposed to capital punishment further concentrates on the jury persons who are racially prejudiced (R.T. 183-85).

The fair trial thus depends not upon whether Negroes are excluded by way of original selection from the voter lists, or by way of the jury commissioner's excuses for employers' convenience, (31) or because as wage-earners they cannot afford to serve, or because they are challenged peremptorily, but upon whether Negroes actually serve on the trial jury itself in reasonably proportional percentages of their representation in the adult population.

FOOTNOTE

(30) "No doubt each juror was sincere when he said that he would be fair and impartial to petitioner, but psychological impact requiring such a declaration before one's fellows is often its father." (Opinion of the Court, per Mr. Justice Clark, 81 S.Ct. at 1645).

(31) In *People v. Tripp*, Superior Court of San Diego County, No. Cr. 14790, the panel was quashed because the practice of excusing employees for trivial excuse and for the convenience of the employer was found to result in substantial underrepresentation of Negroes on the master panel.

END FOOTNOTE

Under prevailing law, it is immaterial whether exclusion results from a state law or from the discriminatory application of statutory selection criteria which are on their face non-discriminatory. "Along and unbroken line of our decisions since (Strauder v. West Virginia, 100 U.S. 303 (1880)) has reiterated this principle, regardless of whether the discrimination was embodied in statute or was apparent from the administrative practices of state jury selection officials, and regardless of whether the system for depriving defendants of their rights was 'ingenious or ingenious.'" (*Patton v. Mississippi*, 332 U.S. 463, 465-66, 68 S.Ct. 184, 186 (1947).

Where there is striking disparity between the proportion of Negroes chosen for jury duty and the proportion of Negroes in the eligible population, the burden is on the state to rebut the presumption that discrimination has been the cause. *Hernandez v. Texas*, 347 U.S. 475, 74 S.Ct. 667 (1954); *Patton v. Mississippi*, supra; *Smith v. Texas*, 311 U.S. 128, 130-31, 61 S.Ct. 164 (1940); *Norris v. Alabama*, 294 U.S. 587, 55 S.Ct. 575 (1935); *Neal v. Delaware*, 103 U.S. 370, 26 L.Ed. 567 (1880); *Davis v. Davis*, 361 F.2d 770, 773 (5th Cir. 1966). *State v. Anderson*, 205 La. 710, 18 So. 2d 33 (1944); *Bass v. State*, 254 Miss. 723, 182 So. 2d 591 (1966).

Defendant Newton urged the court that upon the showing of disproportion here the burden be shifted to the state (R.T. 327). Not only the motion to quash the venire, and the motion for mistrial after the jury was impaneled, but relief requiring the prosecution to rebut the presumption was also denied (R.T. 344).

Denial of said motions was error, under prevailing decisions and the policy of the United States as set forth in the Federal Jury Selection Act, which requires supplementation of voters' rolls where necessary to enforce rights and to effectuate the policy of the Act not to exclude persons on account of race, color or economic status. (32)

FOOTNOTE

(32) The Act provides (28 U.S.C.A. 1861): "It is the policy of the United States that all litigants in Federal courts entitled to trial by jury shall have the right to grand and petit juries selected at random from a fair cross section of the community in the district or division wherein the court convenes. It is further the policy of the United States that all citizens shall have the opportunity to be considered for service on grand and petit juries in the district courts of the United States, and shall have an obligation to serve as jurors when summoned for that purpose."

28 U.S.C.A. 1862 provides: "No citizen shall be excluded from service as a grand or petit juror in the district courts of the United States on account of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, or economic status."

The Act requires that there be: "... some other source or sources of names in addition to voter lists where necessary to foster the policy and protect the rights secured by sections 1861 and 1862 of this title." (28 U.S.C.A. 1863 (b) (2)).

The prosecution's reliance upon the Act as a justification for exclusive use of the voters' rolls (R.T. 239-40), was thus misplaced. Rather, the Act itself provides that wherever necessary to effectuate the rights and policies of the Act, supplemental sources must be used, and sets forth specific examples appropriate to such areas as the District of Columbia (suggesting the city directory) and the districts of Puerto Rico and the Canal Zone.

The Act's policy of ensuring that each county, parish, or similar political subdivision within the district or division is substantially proportionally represented in the master jury wheel would, if correctly applied here, prohibit the practices herein whereby the identifiable black community of West Oakland is lost in a county having vast areas of white suburbs. (See map in sub-section 1, e, this section). These white suburbs of Alameda County share no cultural or racial affinity with West Oakland. From the defendant's district, 47.5% of the adults were excluded from

potential jury service simply by use of voters' registration rolls. Such a result is prohibited by the policy of the Federal Jury Selection Act and by the Constitution.

END FOOTNOTE

In *Anderson v. Alabama*, 366 U.S. 208, 81 S.Ct. 1050 (1966), supra, the Court summarily reversed a state court finding of no discrimination where 10% of the veniremen were Negro in a county where more than half of those eligible were Negro. In *Whitus v. Georgia*, 385 U.S. 545 (1967) the Court reversed a conviction where 42% of the eligible population, 27% of the taxpayers from whom jury lists were drawn, and 9% of the lists themselves were Negro, finding these figures under the circumstances in question to constitute a prima facie case of discrimination.

In *Mitchell v. Johnson*, 250 F.Supp. 117 (Ala. 1966), the court held that the "wide disproportion" of a jury list 35.7% Negro in a county whose population was 82% Negro required the state to explain its origin as non-discriminatory (which the state failed to do). The Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit has described disproportionate representation giving rise to prima facie cases of discrimination in terms of "significant discrepancy" and "very decided variations" (*Davis v. Davis*, supra; *Labat v. Bennett*, 365 F.2d 698, 712 (5th Cir. 1966), cert den 386 U.S. 991, 87 S.Ct. 1303 (1967); *United States ex rel. Seals v. Wiman*, 304 F.2d 53, 67 (5th Cir. 1962).

Voter lists which are themselves a product of discrimination may not constitutionally be used as sole sources of jurors. *United States ex rel. Goldsby v. Harpole*, 263 F.2d 71, 78 (5th Cir. 1959); *White v. Crook*, 251 F. Supp. 401, 404-05 (Ala. 1966); *Harper v. State*, 251 Miss. 699, 171 So. 2d 129 (1965). The use of voter registration lists has been upheld in Boston and New York because those not registered were not shown to constitute a racial, economic, political or other identifiable group. *United States v. Bowe*, 360 F.2d 1, 7 (2d Cir. 1966); *Gorin v. United States*; 313 F.2d 641 (1st Cir. 1963); *United States v. Greenberg*, 200 F.Supp. 382 (S.D.N.Y. 1961).

In *Bowe*, no evidence was adduced and no hearing held on the allegation that the petit jury array systematically excluded Negroes. The original motion to quash the indictment on the ground that the grand jury was improperly selected for systematic racial exclusion was not supported by any evidence or affidavit. A renewed motion to quash the indictment was supported only by an affidavit by one of the attorneys, based on "discussions with former jurors, the deputy clerk in charge of juries, and information supplied by political figures and the United States census bureau." (360 F.2d at 6). The affidavit filed in support of the second motion contained only conclusory allegations and stated the attorney's opinion that Negroes, Puerto Ricans and blue collar workers were grossly underrepresented on the federal jury panels. On appeal, appellants did not attack the formal method of selecting grand jury members from voter registration lists and conceded the constitutionality of that source.

In *Greenberg*, the United States Court of Appeals for the First Circuit held that voting lists could be used as a basis for jury selection unless it appeared that in the community there was systematic and intentional exclusion from those lists of a particular economic, social, religious, racial, geographical or political group. Considering the problem in 1963, the court rejected the argument that eligible persons who did not register to vote constituted a "political group in the community. The decision was prior to the enactment of the Federal Jury Selection Act and prior to the findings of the Kerner Report. No evidence was presented to the Gorin court concerning the racial or other characteristics of those persons not registered to vote. The court pointed out that the group (of those not registered) "has no distinct or definable outlines" and noted that there was no showing of exclusion of any enumerated class.

In *Greenberg*, the District Court for the Southern District of New York held that appellant had not sustained his burden of showing that primary (not exclusive) reliance on lists of registered voters was not reasonably designed to produce a fair cross-section of the community. Some names were also obtained, in *Greenberg*, from city directories and real estate listings. The defendant there urged that the 30% of the population not registered to vote constituted, a fortiori, a cognizable class called "the politically dormant." The court held that in making a challenge to the "required and accepted standards" for jury selection, a party must introduce or offer "distinct evidence" in support of his challenge (id., at 387). This defendant Newton did. *Greenberg* was likewise pre-Kerner Report and prior to the Federal Jury Selection Act which changed the "required and accepted standards."

In none of these cases was there a showing of exclusion of a cognizable class by use of the voter registration lists. The uncontroverted testimony in this case established that Negroes of defendant's ghetto area were under-represented by as much as 29.5%, and Negroes were under-represented county-wide by as much as 17.3%. No such showing, or any showing, was made in the Boston or New York cases.

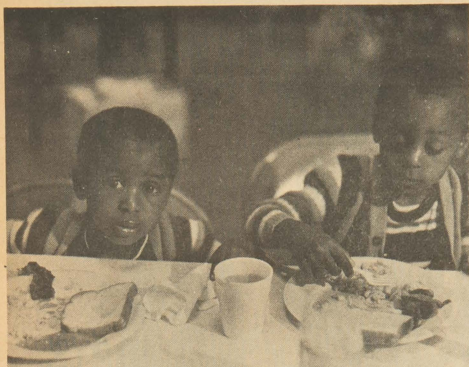
As in *United States v. Harpole*, supra, defendant Newton did show a wide discrepancy between Negroes eligible to vote and Negroes registered to vote, which was held to raise a presumption against the state in *Harpole*. The existence of an identifiable minority is considered a question of fact. *Hernandez v. Texas*, 347 U.S. 475, 74 S.Ct. 667, supra. The poor have been judicially declared to be a cognizable class. *Griffin v. Illinois*, 351 U.S. 12, 76 S.Ct. 585 (1956). (32)

(32) So have members of the Catholic faith, *Juarez v. State*, 102 Texas Cr. 277, S.W. 1091 (1925), and those who do not believe in a Supreme Being, *Schowgroug v. State*, 240 Md. 122, 213 A. 2d 475 (1965) neither of which groups are more culturally identifiable, distinct or significant than the black urban poor of West Oakland and other northern ghettos today.

FREE FOOD OR FAIRY TALES???

The Black Panther Party, in establishing and expanding the Peoples Free Breakfast Programs across this country has encountered many harassments, attempts at sabotage, and co-option. But never before has the program been hassled and possibly held up by a "Play-House-School" exclusively for four year olds.

Fathers, who've worked all summer implementing the first Liberation School in Berkeley, are now faced with an unheard-of attempt to place a "Play-House-School" program over the Free Breakfast Program, where children of all ages can enjoy one hot, nutritious meal to start off their school day.

The basic contradiction lies in an attitude, purely selfish, liberal attitude held by a few individuals who are running the "Play-House-School" program. Upon hearing of the end of our summer program, the Liberation School, a rumor was started that the Liberation School and the Breakfast Program were one and the same, and the program ended with the closing of the Liberation School. This was done to create misunderstanding between Panthers and the Board of Trustees of the Good Shepherd Church. One of these "super-liberals", Teddy Knight, a former worker for the government, even went so far as to take cold sandwiches, cocoa, and donuts to a bus-stop a few blocks away under the guise of continuing the "Breakfast Program". Since when has cold sandwiches replaced hot grits, eggs, bacon, toast, and hot chocolate? This opportunist move was done without the approval of the Board of Trustees of the Church who had voiced their desire to "see what the Panthes planned to do first".

The Head Start/or Coordinator of the School, a liberal in the true sense of the word, was unmovable, refusing to entertain the possibility of the two programs running concurrently. Her main objections was that "her school was to take children away from sium conditions and environment", and "mixing children of all ages would mean ALL the children of the neighborhood coming in." She voiced a fear of the neighborhood children tearing up and destroying her make-believe flowers, pictures, and toys. Hungry children cannot eat fake flowers, pictures, or toys. Her attitude is a good example of the privileged class coming into an oppressed area to "spread a bit of sunshine" with their presence, their unreal, make-believe programs, that continue only to fill our youth with false values, and delusions of material things which they'll never be able to possess in this Capitalistic Society.

Since members of the Trustee Board refuse to accept their responsibility to the community, and are content to avoid the issue with delaying tactics, and not face the serious problem of feeding hungry children, and thereby providing the solution to a real need in the community, a definite stand must be taken.

We understand the necessity of feeding hungry children throughout our neighborhoods and thereby meeting the real needs of the community, and not perpetuating our oppression with ideals and illusions of materialistic bulls--t.

The people of the West Berkeley Community want a Free Breakfast Program. The needs and desires of the community should take precedence over White Liberal Ego Trips bent on setting up make-



believe and false programs and projects which continue to place our youth behind and out of contact with reality.

While there is no comparison of the two programs, they can still complement each other. A Free Breakfast is the perfect way to start off any program, whether it's educational or enjoyment. So

we want the support and active assistance of the People to put forth a Peoples Program. We want all persons living in the West Berkeley Area to come and take part in a basic program to fulfill a basic need. The Breakfast Program at the Church of the Good Shepherd needs your support and help!

BLACK MARINES APPEAL HARSH SENTENCES FOR SPEAKING OUT AGAINST WAR

Two black marines from Brooklyn, Lance Corporal William Harvey, Jr. and Pfc. George Daniels, were sentenced to six and 10 years hard labor respectively for making statements against the war in Vietnam to fellow Marines. Their courtmartial which attracted almost no publicity at the time, took place at Camp Pendleton, California on July 7, 1967. Harvey and Daniels were 18 and 19 years old at the time and have already served a year and a half of their sentence. Their appeal which was argued before the Military Board of Review at Washington, D.C. on March 6, 1969, has brought the case to public attention.

The two marines were court-martialed for statements made to about 20 fellow marines in informal bull sessions which took place after noon and evening chow on July 27, 1967, at Camp Pendleton. The soldiers discussed the fact that the war in Vietnam was a white man's war and that black people should not have to fight in it and that they would have to

come back from Vietnam and fight the white man at home. They decided to request Captain's Mast, the Marine procedure for requesting to see the Commanding Officer to present their grievances and protest their grievances and protest being sent to Vietnam.

On July 28, 14 men in a unit being trained for combat in Vietnam although not on orders to go, requested to see the CO. They were unsuccessful but at the time a sergeant spoke to the men and took statements from Harvey and Daniels. None of the Marines disobeyed an order or refused to be shipped out to Vietnam. Twenty days later the Marines were arrested and charged with promoting disloyalty among the troops. Three months later on November 27, 1967 they were both convicted at a court martial where they were represented by Marine lawyers. Daniels was found guilty of violating a provision of the Smith Act of 1940 which makes it a crime for any person to attempt "to cause insubordination, dis-

loyalty, mutiny or refusal of duty" by a serviceman. Harvey was acquitted of this charge but was convicted of violating the general article of the Uniform Code of Military Justice which punishes "all disorder and neglects to the prejudice of good order and discipline." Specifically, he was found guilty of "making disloyal statements with intent to promote disloyalty among the troops."

Their lawyer, Ed Sherman, pointed out that this was the first case where servicemen were court-martialed for statements against the war when no action or refusal of orders resulted from the statements. He said, "There was no mutiny, nobody disobeyed orders -- there was no disobedience at any time, yet both of these men were given the maximum possible under the law."

The Naval Board of Review reduced Daniels' sentence from ten to four years in a decision handed down on March 6, 1969. Harvey's decision is now pending.

The laws which these marines

were charged with violating are clearly not constitutional and a violation of their first amendment right to talk to other servicemen and convince them of their point of view. Sherman is also introducing the argument that the element of racism entered into the unduly harsh sentences that were given. Capt. Lester G. Fant III, who argued for the Marine Corps, said Daniels and Harvey had created "an extra - ordinarily dangerous situation" by urging the black marines to "stick together" in their refusal to go to Vietnam. Captain Fant compared this to a "wildcat strike" in civilian life. It is obvious that the brass, like the politicians and the union bureaucrats get particularly uptight when black people get themselves together, especially over such an explosive issue as Vietnam.

DESERTER TELLS: 'WHY I LEFT THE ARMY'

First I would like to say that I am an Afro-American. I want to let you, the reader, know, blacks in the army have more reason to leave than whites. Like most of you, I joined the army. I joined because I had come to a point in my life where I was faced with a problem of what I wanted to be. In high school I spent most of my time in sports and really did not feel ready for college or anything like that.

So I made the decision of going to the army. As soon as I entered basic training I could sense the racism inside of this army. But at this time I said to myself that it was harassment, which is just a word to take the fear of racism. After basic and something called on the job training, I was sent to my duty station in the States. I stayed there a year before I had to re-enlist in order to get out of going to Vietnam.

At this point I just didn't want to die. Because of this I began to think about what was really going on over there. Being in the service, I never found the information I wanted, and became confused. In Europe I decided to drop out, for more and more my eyes were being opened. Stationed in Germany I began to look at what I was really in. I watched people being put in jail and all kinds of restrictions being placed on

them for little or no reason at all.

Then I decided to fight these Army Pigs back. I tried first by quitting the job they gave me. Then every chance I got to disagree with some of their policies they were told me nounderground papers like The Black Panther, so I read them. I wore my hair the way I wanted. They tried to stop me from wearing my hair long, but every time they told me to cut it, I simply tamed it, which made them even madder.

But there was a Revolution that I knew little or nothing about. A Black Revolution. Here I was stuck in the enemy's army. That's right in the enemy's army, if you don't think they are your enemy, look what's going on today. Those pigs are killing blacks like hell. In the army they put you in jail or kill you, or even kill you in jail. But mostly they send you to Vietnam, dead up on the front lines to die for the Pig or the black that's killing our brothers. To die for the businessman that is starving our kids. And when we get ready to take what belongs to us, whose side are you going to be on? The time is now to prepare ourselves. They are ready to try and force us but we need unity, we need you.

'If Blacks don't work, nobody works'

NEW YORK (LNS) -- Blacks have recently stopped construction on a total of \$930 million worth of projects in Pittsburgh, Chicago, and Amherst, N.Y. in an all-out militant effort to get into the building trades unions. They are threatening more demonstrations in Milwaukee, Cleveland, and Boston.

The A.F.L.-C.I.O., were very

uptight about the Blacks' unrealistic demands, has cited the progress it has made in getting Blacks into apprenticeship programs. Blacks reply that these efforts are mere tokenism, maintaining that even if a Black man goes through a complete apprenticeship program, he still is denied entrance to the unions. Black membership in the building trades unions averages about two percent.

DRAFT CASES SNAG U.S. COURTS

OAKLAND, Calif. (LNS) -- A hard rain is falling on the rocky world of Lewis B. Hershey. There is mushrooming discontent with the process whereby the Army kidnaps innocent young men, kicks them in the balls, cuts off their hair, and sends them to fight elephant grass and the local poplance in distant Southeast Asian jungles -- that's right, the draft. The hatred of the draft has generated a rash of challenges in the courts which threaten to cripple, if not destroy, the Selective Service System of America, Inc.

They've got a permanent FBI man stationed here at the Oakland Army Induction Center, who does nothing but deal with the average of ten refusals per day. Maybe he also gets some ghoulish thrill from watching the half-clotted unwilling induction meat inspection, but his job is to take care of those who refuse to step forward to take their vows. He pops up, raps down their rights in a routine mumble, fills out a few of his forms, and starts the ball of repression rolling.

Admittedly, Oakland is a heavier scene than most. In October 1967, West Coast activists mounted a militant Stop-the-Draft-Week attack on the Oakland Induction Center, marking the introduction of the new mobile, hit-and-run approach to mass demonstrations. And the Panthers have seen fit to set up their National Headquarters in Oakland, but Oakland's draft resistance in getting to be as American as apple pie.

Dig these statistics from Uncle Sam:

From July to December of 1967 there were 746 Federal indictments handed down all across the nation on charges of resisting the draft: failing to register, failing to take the oath, and the like.

In the next six-month period -- from January to June, 1968 -- the number had gone up to 1080 indictments. And in the last half of 1968, the number of indictments nationwide had jumped to 1492. Thus, in all of 1968, one percent of the quarter of a million men drafted by the Army, got their cases all the way into the belly of that sluggish monster known as the Federal Court System. When 2472 tiny time-capsules go off in the blood stream of the sorry behemoth, the poor thing knows it's a down.

On July 1, 1969, some 2958 criminal cases were pending in all Federal courts involving various violations of the draft laws -- mostly men refusing induction. That's 15 percent of all criminal cases on the Federal docket.

In Washington, Justice Department statisticians are gloomy. The backlog in the courts runs at least one year on draft cases even though by law they have the top priority of all criminal matters. In the attempt to reduce the backlog, the reluctant inductees are often offered a chance to repent just before the trials begin. But cases continue to pile up faster than the courts can handle them.

More than 5000 "delinquencies" are under investigation, and thousands more await discovery. If the trend continues, and the indictments produce more and more indictments each month, even the current stopgap measure of special judges in overworked districts to hear nothing but pre-trial arguments in draft cases may not be enough.

[THE BLACK-WHITE ENTANGLEMENT]

ON JANUARY 13, 1969, IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF California, Joseph Karesh presiding, Michael O'Brien went on trial for manslaughter in the death of George Baskett.

Shames

Two days later George Baskett's sixth child was born. It took only one day to choose a jury. Ehrlich used two peremptory challenges; one eliminated airlines supervisor George A. Buckner Jr., the only black called. No "personal reflection," said Ehrlich.

Similarly, any lawyer can insure an all white jury by use of his allotment of peremptory challenges, which the judge cannot review.

Ehrlich made it quite clear, when questioning jurors, what the trial was going to be about. A key issue, he said, would be "this black-white entanglement." Judge Karesh found nothing to criticize in that formulation.

Attention on the second day focused on Elizabeth Hawkins, a tall, striking woman who said flatly that she had watched Michael O'Brien deliberately murder George Baskett. The next day, Ehrlich moved in, contempt dripping from his tiny frame. He accused Mrs. Hawkins of having lied outright on three occasions.

But she refused to be Ehrlich's pigeon. After she insisted again that she had seen O'Brien kick the dying Baskett:

Ehrlich: "What kind of shoes did O'Brien have on?"

Mrs. Hawkins: "Sneakers, I think."

Ehrlich: "Then he couldn't have hurt Baskett much if he kicked him, could he?"

Mrs. Hawkins: "I have no idea—I have never been shot and then kicked."

Carl Hawkins followed his wife to the stand and corroborated her story, with additional details. During the early part of the incident, he said, his stepson, Richard Dickerson, had arrived and asked a neighbor, Mrs. Anne Thomas, what was going on.

"Your father's having trouble with the white man," she replied.

That, she testified, angered O'Brien further. "Shut up, you goddamn nigger bitch!" he yelled.

Mrs. Thomas promptly yelled back, "Ask God why he made me a nigger bitch and made you a honky."

Baskett had picked up a stick and tried to use it to knock the pistol from O'Brien's hand, but O'Brien ordered him to drop it and began to count.

"O'Brien," Hawkins testified, "extended his arm, braced his right arm with his left hand to steady the pistol, and fired one shot. I saw the flash of the gun."

Otis Baskett, the dead man's brother, appeared and told the same story.

Ehrlich tore into him, shouting that he was a "professional liar." Assistant District Attorney Walter Giubbini, who prosecuted the case, called the use of the phrase "disgusting," Karesh, however, let Ehrlich rant.

But the next witness—Special Officer Adkins—had seen none of this at all. What he had seen was a silent confrontation, no words at all, in which Baskett was beating O'Brien on the head. "O'Brien stumbled backwards, kind of shaking his head. Mr. Baskett was preparing to strike him again when the gun discharged." Later he said that O'Brien was "tensing up, trying to regain his balance," but that he was off balance and "backpedaling," leaning backward with his gun "straight out in his hand," when it went off.

On redirect examination Adkins admitted to consulting with Ehrlich about a week after the shooting. The police department had been "harassing" him to talk to the district attorney, he explained. Ehrlich interrupted to say that he had advised Adkins only to tell the truth.

Dickerson's turn came next, and his story varied from that of the other black witnesses only in the quotation from O'Brien which he remembered as, "Drop it—drop it, goddamn it, nigger, I'll kill you." Then the count.

The score, by witnesses, was: four who matched each other almost exactly, one who differed. Up to this point memory divided along racial lines.

[THE TRAITOR TO HIS RACE]

DAVID ANDERSON, THE EIGHTEEN-YEAR-OLD SON of an elementary school principal, testified that he was listening to a rock record "when I heard shots and a big commotion." He went up on his roof, which

commanded an excellent view of Brush Place, to see what was going on, and he told the court what he saw.

David Anderson is not only white, he's "clean": his father's professional job is in San Leandro, just south of Oakland across the bay, and the family lives in the pristine suburb of Castro Valley. Anderson had taken his apartment while going to college.

From the roof, he said, he saw three black men spread eagled against the wall and a white man with a gun; he identified the white man as O'Brien. Then, Anderson went on, a fourth black picked up a stick and swung it, hitting O'Brien either in the left side or on the left elbow. As Baskett backed away, crouching, O'Brien deliberately shot him.

Shortly thereafter, he went on, O'Brien held his gun on one of the men leaning against the wall, and deliberately kicked him in the seat of the pants. "Just give me an excuse—just give me a reason and I'll shoot you!" O'Brien was quoted as shouting. Then O'Brien moved back and yelled at the people looking out of the apartments to get their heads back in.

Ehrlich was faced with a calm and believable young witness, and one who was white—apparently beyond the reach of simple racism. But he knew his judge, and he knew his jurors. The key lay in Anderson's attendance at San Francisco State College, and the possibility of making the young man appear a traitor to his race.

Ehrlich immediately asked whether Anderson was participating in the strike there; Anderson answered that he was. There followed a barrage of questions about Black Panthers, hair, SDS, prejudice, and a number of other subjects, none of which were particularly relevant, though they seemed to fascinate the judge, and Giubbini gave up trying to stem the flow.

What Anderson actually said was fairly mild. He is not a member of Students for a Democratic Society, though he is in sympathy with some of its aims (which no one asked about). He thinks students and teachers have a right to strike. He hopes the strike will help to end institutional racism.

But this alone doesn't convey the effect. Ehrlich met Giubbini's objection to the whole line of questioning by saying that he was trying to prove bias, because "these people who are part of SDS think every white policeman is a pig." He asked Anderson: "If there is any feeling between white man and

black man, you are standing against the white man?"

Ehrlich kept Anderson on the stand for two more days, hammering at left-wing associations that weren't there and ideas that Anderson refused to agree with. He demanded that Anderson show his draft card and pretended surprise when Anderson produced one.

Having raised the specter of SDS, the bombastic attorney made another try, this time with the Black Panthers. He asked whether Anderson knew Richard E. Brown, a Panther who had given a lower apartment in the same building as his address when arrested five times between March and November, 1968. Anderson said he didn't know Brown, but that he had moved into the building in September and that no blacks lived there.

Finally, Ehrlich said that he "had been informed" that a police report, dated the night after the shooting, involved Anderson's apartment, and that the report said a black youth was living with Anderson and his white roommate, David Dixon, and that the apartment was decorated with "Free Huey," "Black Revolution" and Che Guevara posters. Anderson merely noted that his apartment is decorated with travel posters, not revolutionary posters, and that he and Dixon have no other roommate.

BY A STRANGE COINCIDENCE, the Tactical Squad was called out in the area of Rodgers Street "to protect fire engines against possible sniper fire" on the night following the Brush Place shooting. And a couple of the boys just happened to bust into the front of, and out the back of, 35 Rodgers Street, where that stupid white punk lived who had backed up the black people's story about what happened the night before.

When they busted in, one Tac Squad member testified, he saw somebody else going out the back; he trained his pistol on the man and told him to stop—then discovered that it was Richard Brown, who cried out, "We live here, we live here."

The cops were there, of course, without a warrant, without any cause to break into the apartment, and without permission. They didn't even call out that they were police.

John Coate is white, but he has long hair and is obviously another traitor to his race. Coate, it seems, was visiting David Anderson on the night of September 30, when the Tac Squad came, and he said there was no black man there and no revolutionary posters on the walls. Ehrlich decided Coate was biased against the police, too, and started on the same bit with questions about State; Coate replied that he believes in nonviolence and is opposed to both police and student violence on the campus. Anderson, he said, is "a rather conscientious person who cares about the world in which he lives."

And the jury apparently just plain didn't hear Anderson's father, the school principal, because he was there that night too, and while he left before the cops came, he left Coate and Anderson and Dixon alone. He also described the posters on the wall. He could describe them, he said, because he had provided them—they were travel posters.

At one point during the testimony, Ehrlich found reason to thunder an accusation which, in its wording, effectively let the jury know which side Anderson was supposed to be on "This is a white and black fight," Ehrlich shouted. "This man Anderson is an unmitigated liar. Any man who would sit there and lie a man's life away is not entitled to a fair trial—he should be taken out and shot."

For this bit of legal theory from the city's foremost criminal attorney, the judge had not a word of rebuke.

But that wasn't Ehrlich's most extravagant shot for the day. He made his position, his tactics and his opinion of the judge all very clear just a short time later, when a Tac Squad officer said that he believed Richard Brown was in the courtroom.

Ehrlich strode to the railing separating the spectators from the front of the court, leaped over, and bellowed, "What's your name? Stand up, boy!"

There were some audible gasps in the courtroom, but Ehrlich ignored them. The black youth, after a brief but obvious struggle for control, said quietly, "My name is not 'boy.' My name is Richard Brown."

Ehrlich walked back to the counsel table, threw himself into the chair, and said, "Why don't you lock him up?" That's a little obscure, but that's what he said.

Judge Karesh leaned solicitously forward and said, "I'm sure you didn't mean to offend anybody, Mr. Ehrlich."

Jake took the cue and leaped up again. Facing the jury, he thundered, "Some black people seem to think it disgraceful to be called 'boy.' My grandfather and father called me that. What's wrong with it? I don't understand this childish, infantile feeling. I have defended these people many times without fee. I have no hatred for these people, no feeling for them at all. But I won't take any backtalk out of them, either!"

Karesh finally decided that maybe it was time for the jury to leave. When they were gone, he repeated to Ehrlich, "I did not mean to imply earlier that you meant any offense to anyone."

Black Panther Party Platform and Program

What We Want What We Believe



FREE HUEY

Minister of Defense, Black Panther Party

1. We want freedom. We want power to determine the destiny of our Black Community.

We believe that black people will not be free until we are able to determine our destiny.

2. We want full employment for our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white American businessmen will not give full employment, then the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living.

3. We want an end to the robbery by the CAPITALIST of our Black Community.

We believe that this racist government has robbed us and now we are demanding the overdue debt of forty acres and two mules. Forty acres and two mules was promised 100 years ago as restitution for slave labor and mass murder of black people. We will accept the payment in currency which will be distributed to our many communities. The Germans are now aiding the Jews in Israel for the genocide of the Jewish people. The Germans murdered six million Jews. The American racist has taken part in the slaughter of over fifty million black people; therefore, we feel that this is a modest demand that we make.

4. We want decent housing, fit for shelter of human beings.

We believe that if the white landlords will not give decent housing to our black community, then the housing and the land should be made into cooperatives so that our community, with government aid, can build and make decent housing for its people.

5. We want education for our people that exposes the true nature of this decadent American society. We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present-day society.

We believe in an educational system that will give to our people a knowledge of self. If a man does not have knowledge of himself and his position in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

6. We want all black men to be exempt from military service.

We believe that Black people should not be forced to fight in the military service to defend a racist government that does not protect us. We will not fight and kill other people of color in the world who, like black people, are being victimized by the white racist government of America. We will protect ourselves from the force and violence of the racist police and the racist military, by whatever means necessary.

7. We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY and MURDER of black people.

We believe we can end police brutality in our black community by organizing black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all black people should arm themselves for self-defense.

8. We want freedom for all black men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails.

We believe that all black people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

9. We want all black people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peer group or people from their black communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that black people will receive fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a man a right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the black community from which the black defendant came. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man" of the black community.

10. We want land, bread, housing, education, clothing, justice and peace. And as our major political objective, a United Nations-supervised plebiscite to be held throughout the black colony in which only black colonial subjects will be allowed to participate, for the purpose of determining the will of black people as to their national destiny.

When, in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume, among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and, accordingly, all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But, when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same object, evinces a design to reduce them under absolute despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new guards for their future security.

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RULES OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY

CENTRAL HEADQUARTERS
OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA..

Every member of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY throughout this country of racist America must abide by these rules as functional members of this party. CENTRAL COMMITTEE members, CENTRAL STAFFS, and LOCAL STAFFS, including all captains subordinate to either national, state, and local leadership of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY will enforce these rules. Length of suspension or other disciplinary action necessary for violation of these rules will depend on national decisions by national, state or state area, and local committees and staffs where said rule or rules of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY WERE VIOLATED.

Every member of the party must know these verbatim by heart. And apply them daily. Each member must report any violation of these rules to their leadership or they are counter-revolutionary and are also subjected to suspension by the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.

THE RULES ARE:

1. No party member can have narcotics or weed in his possession while doing party work.
2. Any party member found shooting narcotics will be expelled from this party.
3. No party member can be DRUNK while doing daily party work.
4. No party member will violate rules relating to office work, general meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY, and meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY ANYWHERE.
5. No party member will USE, POINT, or FIRE a weapon of any kind unnecessarily or accidentally at anyone.
6. No party member can join any other army force other than the BLACK LIBERATION ARMY.
7. No party member can have a weapon in his possession while DRUNK or loaded off narcotics or weed.
8. No party member will commit any crimes against other party members or BLACK people at all, and cannot steal or take from the people, not even a needle or a piece of thread.
9. When arrested BLACK PANTHER MEMBERS will give only name, address, and will sign nothing. Legal first aid must be understood by all Party members.
10. The Ten Point Program and platform of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY must be known and understood by each Party member.
11. Party Communications must be National and Local.
12. The 10-10-10-program should be known by all members and also understood by all members.
13. All Finance officers will operate under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Finance.
14. Each person will submit a report of daily work.
15. Each Sub-Section Leader Section Leader, Lieutenant, and Captain must submit Daily reports of work.
16. All Panthers must learn to operate and service weapons correctly.
17. All Leadership personnel who expel a member must submit this information to the Editor of the Newspaper, so that it will be published in the paper and will be known by all chapters and branches.
18. Political Education Classes are mandatory for general membership.
19. Only office personnel assigned to respective offices each day should be there. All others are to sell papers and do Political work out in the community, including Captains, Section Leaders, etc.
20. COMMUNICATIONS — all chapters must submit weekly reports in writing to the National Headquarters.
21. All Branches must implement First Aid and/or Medical Cadres.
22. All Chapters, Branches, and components of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY must submit a monthly Financial Report to the Ministry of Finance, and also the Central Committee.
23. Everyone in a leadership position must read no less than two hours per day to keep abreast of the changing political situation.
24. No chapter or branch shall accept grants, poverty funds, money or any other aid from any government agency without contacting the National Headquarters.
25. All chapters must adhere to the policy and the ideology laid down by the CENTRAL COMMITTEE of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.
26. All Branches must submit weekly reports in writing to their respective Chapters.
