



The imperialist United States has done a lot of destructive work in the past decade. The things that they have been doing during this period of time spells out their true identity...pigs.

The imperialist is a very conniving animal, who covers up his dirt by using different disguises: such as poverty programs, vista, the peace corps, and the U.N.This aggression on the entire working population is in its' last days; the u.s. imperialists are making their grand finale. Before we go into what the imperialists "think" they have planned for their grand exit, let's talk about what they've been doing to the people, especially black people for the past ten years.

In the early sixties Black people were beaten, hosed, cattle prodded dog bitten, and murdered, just because we wanted to attend the institutions of mis-education. After this came the period of wanting to sit on the master's lap and eat the scraps from his table, in other words "equal job opportunities".

The domestic imperialists (capitalists) were grinning in the faces of the poor people and gave us a "snow" job, on these issues. The black people of the country dug where they (the capitalists) were coming from, and for the first time in the history of this decadent ameriKKKa Black people rebelled all over the country but we were like children in the dark because we didn't really know who the true enemy was. Even though we burnt and looted the stores of the capitalist in our communities, we thought that our enemy was anyone with white skin. But we soon found out that sometimes your worst enemy has the same color skin as you.

After the riots the capitalists could see that if they didn't do something to pacify (calm) us their game of exploiting Black people would be over. So what did they conjure up? The poverty programs!! This is when we started to realize that all of our enemies weren't of a different color. These programs were made to keep the slaves quiet and racism high. How did they do this? First they got some uncle tom nigger (who told the people he wasn't a tom) to be the head of these and tell them that the government is "bad" when they don't give them these petty jobs, and good when they do. In reality the government is just throwing the people crumbs from the table so they won't ask for the cake. Second: the area most concentrated with these poverty programs is where? In the black community. Why? Because the pigs keep the element of racism going by ignoring the fact that poor white people exist and just bring the poverty programs into the Black community. This makes poor white people bitter toward poor Blacks because since they too are "underprivileged" they feel that they should get some kind of help from these conniving pigs.

In short, the uprisings were sold out by opportunists and bootlickers who were helping the pig power structure in its attempts to keep all poor people apart.

Huey P. Newton and Bobby Seale organized the Black Panther Party for Self Defense. They saw the need for Black people to become aware of what this system was doing do us in our communities through their gestapo pig forces. They also saw that if the ten point program of the Black Panther Party which deals with our basic human rights, was not acquired through legal means, then we would have to fight for what is rightfully ours.


From the time the Black Panther Party started to this day, this imperialist citadel (stronghold) of the u.s. has slandered, incarcerated (jailed) and murdered Panther members and people who follow the Panther ideology.

Lil' Bobby Hutton who was the first member of the party was also the first member murdered by these buffoon fools. Bobby was murdered in April of 1968, and from that time right up to December of 1969 there have been 28 Panthers killed and over 100 incarcerated (jailed). Why? Because the Black Panther Party teaches the people through their theory and practice how to get their basic needs and who their true enemy is -- the u.s. imperialists and all their running dogs.

As I said earlier the imperialists are on their way out but before they are totally wiped out they will become outrageous in their attempts to survive, even throwing people in jails and con-

Historically, the courts have been the instrument through which the power structure has punished those people who get out of line and stray off that red, white, and blue path




To be a revolutionary is to work actively to bring about the revolution; to understand that a firm

clearly and distinctly draw lines of demarcation between the people and the pigs and must not waver, because during this period the people are confused due to the misinformation fed to them through all the media which is controlled by the power structure. Most of all a true revolutionary does not expect any justice from the existing system. A revolutionary knows the only justice will come in the streets and not in a fascist court. To be revolutionary is to be out of line -out of step with the existing order of things. Therefore, for more than anything else the full wrath of the machinery of repression will be used against the revolutionaries.

What's Happening In The Projects

As more and more people are beginning to realize, the Black Panther Party's true actions are serving the people and trying to meet the basic needs of the people. One of the ways we do this is by "section work". Many of you already have had the experience of having one or two Panthers knock on your. door and talk to you about what the Party is doing here in New Haven. We hope that many more will have this experience.

During the course of the last three weeks we have been doing work in the Ashmun Street projects. And we have come across some facts of how the pig power structure is oppressing the people in the projects. The two main culprits of this latest move are Ed White, a house nigger, and Pig Chief Ahern.

First we find that Ahern (who is running hard for J Edgar Hoover's position as FBI chief) has set up a little pig department inside of the projects. These pigs are Black, they don't wear uniforms as yet, but they do carry guns. They haven't been sucessful at doing anything but generally keeping the people looking over their shoulders and terrorizing the 12 year-old junkies in the projects. I should say right here that if Ahern and his gang really want to stop crime in New Haven, they should leave the people alone and go after the real criminal; the Mafia who sells dope to little kids. Then they should move on the real robbers.

The point is this: the people in the Elm Haven projects are being robbed and terrorized by the pigs of the power structure, For Thanksgiving, or an early Xmas present, pig chief Ahern gave the people of the projects a special police force which does not wear uniforms, carries guns, can arrest people and passes on information to the regular pigs so they can bust people, making pig terrorism of the people that much easier.

L.A. 18 PRELIMS---A MOCKERY OF

JUSTICE

I'm tired...sick and tired of seeing my people being oppressed and exploited all over the world in general, and here in Babylon in particular. ameriKKKa is supposed to be the epitome of freedom, equality, and justice for all its citizens, yet I sat in a courtroom for 2 1/2 weeks and witnessed myself and my beautiful revolutionary comrades being railroaded down the "Hall of Injustice."

We chose to defend our lives and homes instead of being murdered cold-bloodedly by the fascist dogs who claim they are here to "protect and serve". Yet we are all facing life imprisonment if convicted because we stood up and were men. In this racist, decadent country, there is no justice for the poor oppressed people. If you try to throw off the yoke of oppression which is strangling you, you are either murdered or incar-

cerated for the rest of your life. The pigs have forced their yokes on Black people in Babylon, and since the Black Panther Party is "of the people, by the people, and for the people", the pigs have resorted to legalized murder in an attempt to squash and destroy our efforts to educate the people and to set the correct examples for them to follow. The pigs know they won't have all the power if the people achieve through liberation and they will resort to "any means necessary" to prevent the people from attaining power.

Fascism reared its beastly head in the courtroom, that mockery of justice, where the preliminary hearing for the LA 18 was held, All but 3 Panthers are still in jail, being held without bail or else their bail is between \$50,000 and \$100,000. Most of the political prisoners have been sick because of the unhealthy conditions of their cells. They cannot see their own doctors, even with a court order from the judge, because the pigs in the Sheriff Department don't want the people to know how the political prisoners

are being ill-treated. All of the DA's evidence consisted of the pigs' version of what happened on December 8. It was clearly obvious to everyone in the courtroom that the pigs were lying because their testimonies, in many cases, contradicted each other. Some of the pigs were staunch shouthern crackers who couldn't even pronounce "negro" correctly. The pigs testified that they had several briefings prior to their a ds on December 8. There were between 100-200 pigs at these briefings and even some federal agents were present. The pigs planned how they would conduct their raids, how many men would participate, who would participate, and what types of weapons would be used in the raids. They even secured a search warrant saying that the pigs could come to our home in the middle of the night, break down our door without knocking or announ-

cing themselves, and shoot us if they felt it necessary! The pigs are the ones guilty of conspiracy to commit murder against Panthers, but we still face possible death or life imprisonment because this pig power structure condones and applauds the brutish, murderous acts of its lackeys and chumps -- the pigs who ride around and harass and brutalize the people.

As I sat in the courtroom, I observed "constitutional fascism" in action. The judge was clearly prejudiced against us. In fact, in many instances he told the pigs on the stand that they didn't have to answer certain questions. In addition, the judge denied all motions the defense attorneys put forth. Even when the defense had the "solid" backing of the constitution in making their motions, pig Judge Brown chose to defy this country's laws rather than to give us our basic human rights as guaranteed in the constitution. The pigs illegally seized several articles not named in the search warrant and the judge, in so many words said that the pigs had a good reason to ILLEGALLY seize these other items. The witnesses, court recorder, judge, and DA'swere all working together to make sure that we Panthers didn't receive a just and fair hearing.

The pigs in the eyes of other pigs were victorious because they succeeded in denying Black people in general, and Black Panthers in particular, a fair trial. But the LA 18 were the victors on December 8, and we're still the victors on January 23. We stood up in defense of our lives, in defense of our homes, and in undying love for the people. The people saved us -- like Huey said, "the people's spirit is greater than the man's technology." This theory again was put into practice that last day of preliminaries when Judge Hitler Harvey Brown said "all defendants are are bound over to Superior Court -- I have sufficient evidence to believe they are guilty." Even when the judge refused to set bail for anyone except 17 year old Bernard Smith whose bail was set at \$50,000 (despite the fact that no incriminating evidence had been presented against the Panthers other than the fact that we are Panthers and defended our lives.) The only thing the political prisoners had to say was "All Power to the People." Right on!!

FREE LANCE BELL

One of the outstanding characteristics of the pigs is that they cannot accept defeat. They must always have a scapegoat, someone they can take their frenzled anger out on. This has been happening in the Black colony since the existence of niggers in Babylon.

A case of this madness resulted from the November 13th raid on the Black colony, in this attack Jake Winters, a proven revolutionary, was killed defending the Black colony. But before he

died he left two pigs killed--nine wounded, Another brother, Lance Bell was a witness to the foul deeds of these maniacs. Now the forces of reaction are trying to silence him. They are trying to sentence him to the electric chair. They have charged him with two counts of murder. But in an inquest into the incident by a coroner's jury on December 24, it was found that the two pigs that were killed were killed by the shotgun of Jake Winters. All the evidence shows

that Lance was just passing through the area, heard shots, saw the gestapo forces firing at a Black brother, and went to check it out. This was when he was captured by the pigs. Now they are making an all out effort to kill Lance.

This is part of the government conspiracy to commit GENOCIDE against the Black Panther Party in particular and Black people and all other decent progressive people in general, if the people allow the government to kill Lance.

this will set a precedent which the pigs will use to justify the mass murder of Black people. The power structure is systematically trying to destroy the youth in the Black colony. They ve murdered Fred Hampton, Deputy Chairman of the Black Panther Party, Illinois Chapter and Mark Clark, Defense Captain of Peoria because they were moving to educate the people to the true nature of this racist, capitalistic society. ILLINOIS CHAPTER

NATIONAL SALVATION

The Black Panther Party is a political organization that serves as a standard bearer for Black and all oppressed people in this country.

On the theory and practice of self defense, it should very well be most clear that Black People in this country have been victims of a systematic form of genocide since the time of slavery. Based on the treacherous and rugged road on which our history had to develop, there should be no doubt on anybody's mind about the necessity of defending their lives against vile and inhuman elements.

Back during the early ages when men had to defend themselves from the natural enemies of their environment, such as floods-stormsearthquakes-huge animals-etc., it was a common thing for men to work together to prepare shelters and the necessities for the salvation of their family (see Education and Revolution, Eldridge Cleaver). As society began to develop and mankind, through production, became less inclined to the natural materialistic needs of life and more geared toward the idealistic wants of the individual or family. thence causing antagonism between different cults. War was then introduced and man was then forced to defend himself from interlopers. The earliest known writings of war were written by Sun-Tzu. He wrote the "Thirteen Chapters on War" during the time when warring was first introduced on a large scale (warring years or warring states-360-460 B.C.).

Sun-Tzu expounded on the importance of defensive strategy and perseverance. He stated that,"In order for one to defend himself, properly, in war, he must learn ways to offend his enemy." So, therefore, the shield (defense was then accompanied by the sword (offense). As society advanced, and wars became more intense, the concept of the shield and the sword was reiterated and innovated to the knight in shining armor, on to what we have today that is commonly known as the "tank".

The whole concept of defense and offense has nowescalated to a level of major operations involving thousands of personnel, both defensive and offensive. Based on the theory of the age-old aggressive interloper, we see that those types of offensive operations are all geared toward imperialist aggression and exploitation of harmless, innocent peace-loving people. So we can safely say that these types of offenders are Jingoists, or warmongers, i.e. the U.S. involvement in Korea, Viet Nam, Palestine, Africa, etc.

We must understand that the rudiments of survival-defense and the combination of offense for the purpose of defense - have been manipulated by the United States. And not only are they utilizing those selfish tactics in every corner of the earth, we have the very same interference right here within the confines of the Black communities. Now, relating to the ways and means that the war-like U.S. government perpetratesonslaughts on the Black, poor and oppressed people in this country and peoples of the world, we see that through a long process of atrocious sufferings the Black people in this country are now faced with the most wicked conglomeration of forces known to mankind. We find that the entire juggernaut is broken down into two integral parts: The Ultra Structure and the Infra Structure of the U.S.A. The Ultra Structure is headed by the Green Berets, CIA, Interpol, and MAC (Military Advisory Corps. It operated for the most part in foreign countries, planting war-

seeds in the soil of revolutionary peoples. Its home base is located in the Pentagon in Washing ton, D.C. and is coordinated by the C,I,D, (Central Intelligence Department); the vanguard of the Infra Structure is composed of three groups-1) The John Birch Society, which acts as the political arm of the constituent -2) The Minutemen-and 3) The Ku Klux Klan, which serves as the military-terrorist arm. Other smaller parties such as the N.R.A. (National Rifle Association), White Knights, ameriKKKan Nazi Party, Black Legion, etc. are detachments and supply bases of the leading bodies of the Infro Structure, which in turn serve the same purpose for the Ultra Structure. To cite one of the astronomical operations implemented by these fascists: In June of 1966, the propagandist of the Jingoist machine dropped some five million leaflets into Viet Nam, depicting the Black GI's as the most fierce and most effective fighters the U.S. had employed there, and that the Black man would be the decisive factor in the winning of the war. The result was an increase of Black ameriKKKan deaths, from 20% to some 48% killed in Viet Nam per year-Genocide.

On the same token, the CIA in Viet Nam has established an Infra Structure similar to their own here in ameriKKKa. It is headed by the Provincial Reconnaissance Units (pronounced "Prews") which terrorize villages and assassinates leaders of various hamlets, cities or provinces which oppose the present "puppet" regime. Trained by the Green Berets and financed by the C.I.D., they act in the same fascist manner as their ameri-KKKan advisors. Example operations of the C.I.D., are : Egypt, when Nasser was coming into power; the Congo, when Tsombe was educating the people; Cuba; Korea;

So we realize the need for self defense for our people is one of exigency when we see basically the same thing occuring in the colonies of Black ameriKKKa: The "constitutional fascism" manifested in the racist amerikkkan courts, i.e. Hoffman, Chavez, Brown etc.; and of course, the "Lawful fascism" manifested in theracist pig departorganizations, unions, groups, possess around the country The Patrolmen's Benevolent Association of New York (PBA). the Detroit Police Officers Association (DPOA), The Fraternal Order of Police of Cleveland(FOP), The National Policemen's Union (NPU) are but a few main pro-fascist pig political parties initiated by the U.S. Infra Structure. These type pig parties are mainly responsible for the birth of the main "killer squadrons" commonly known as the "The Tact Squads". "Metro Squads", "Goon Squads", "SWAT Teams", etc. as they are known in various cities. And everytime these barbaric pigs enter our communities, murdering our people and attacking our very homes and then being allowed to do it another day, it serves as a political education class for all the pigs in the country to follow and act in the same animalistic manner.

At the lower rung of the ladder of the Infra Structure there are the contemporary pawns and puppets. The most recent program to attempt to "quell" the intensifying revolutionary fervor of Blacks in this country was laid by the C.I.D. in Africa some 15 years ago. The program was to serve a dual purpose: 1) to impede or abolish the correct revolutionary theory in Africa, and to 2) instill a stiff reactionary outlook on world revoultion

DOWNFALL OF L.A.'S JEFFERSON HIGH SCHOOLS BSU---- UPRISING OF THE PEOPLE'S PARTY

The B.S.U. at Jeff came about as a result of a boycott of classes in September, 1968. The students at Jeff disagreed with the administration's way of running the students' lives. They had absolutely no voice in anything that happened at Jeff. They were not allowed to speak of the faults at Jeff, neither were they allowed to dress as they please or wear "naturals". They had no control over the pigs' coming on campus and harassing the students. But instead of negotiating with the students, the administration brought Black security pigs on campus to make sure the students stayed in their place.

The B.S.U. couldn't deal with any of these problems successfully because its members had personal hang-ups and weren't united. Thus, the organization eventually destroyed itself. For a year the students at Jeff have watched the Panthers work, and came to the conclusion that they dig on what the Panthers are doing, what they want, why they want it, and for whom they want it.

So, in 1969, the student body president, along with other revolutionary students organized the "People's Party" -- a Party that puts the Panther ideology into practice. The duty of this Party is to serve the people, to find out what the students at Jeff want, and see that the student council carries it out. They only take orders from the students, not the administration, which represents the pigs, The People's Party is also trying to get political education classes for the students. And since most

the membership is made up of the same type of people that the Party (Panther) consists of, they know what kind of problems the students have, and they feel the students will be able to talk to them better, and they will be able to relate to the students.


One problem of the students, for example, is going to class. The students don't go to class, because they don't like the subjects, or the teachers and can't voice what they believe in without getting suspended. And that's where the Party comes in. They negotiate with teachers and if that doesn't work, nobody goes to class.

To sum it up, the new organization at Jeff, the People's Party. is in existence for the same reason the Panther Party is -- to serve the people, or students -- only they can't move on the issues as strongly as the Panthers, because of their parents and other obstacles.

This organization is most likely to remain operating as long as the students support it, and right now it is being fully supported.

INTERVIEWER: Why did you decide to run in the Democratic Primary?

INTERVIEWER: If you blow heavy enough in this manner aren't you taking the chance that people will say 'then why should we vote?' In other words, why should people feel that they should vote for Ron Dellums?

DELLUMS: Because in 1970 (with the crisis between the classes, with the crisis of our cities, with the pollution -- not only of our minds. but of our air and water, the raping of our soil and the killing of our sons) people are rapidly becoming aware of the facts and in the 1970's there are going to be some unlikely people who become revolutionaries. PIGS KIDNAP 17 YEAR OLD YOUTH

On Jan. 4th my mother and sister went to see my brother Charles in the Carl Holton school for boys in Stockton. As you know Stockton is about 100 miles from here where we live in San Francisco. My mother was sick at the time and we told her not to go. After fixing a lot of food and other thingsfor him we drove all the way down there leaving early so that we would be able to stay there with him a little longer than usual. When we got there, we told the woman at the desk who we wanted to see. She told us to sit down and she would send for him. We waited for about 20 minutes. Then my mother went up to the desk to ask why was it taking

him so long to get there. She then hesitated and finally told us that he was not there, and that he had been taken to Los Angeles 3 weeks before. My mother then asked to see his counselor. They said he wasn't there and she talked to someone else. He toldher he knew nothing about it then he talked to someone who also said he had been sent to Los Angeles. They said he was sent there to testify against some people who he knew nothing about. Nowhe was supposed to be released on Jan. 5th, the next day.

When she called to Los Angeles they tell us that the people he is supposed to testify against got their court date put off until Jan 29th. This means that he will be held until then. Right nowhe is in Los Angeles county jail and none of his relatives living in Los Angeles are allowed to see him. They (his relatives) try to get in to see him to make sure he is receiving the money they give the pigs to give him for things he needs.

This fascist treatment coincides with point number 8 of the Black Panther Partys' platform and program. "we want freedom for all Black men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails."



The Fred Hampton Memorial People's Health Clinic is open, Mondays through Fridays, 7 p.m. to 10 p.m., at 10 N. Russell Street. It provides free medical care for the people; everyone is welcome.

We now have 27 doctors, plus nurses and medical students. Our X-ray diagnosis is done free for us and the lab work that we can't do in the clinic is sent out for free. We have specialty referrals to private offices on a free basis in surgery, internal medicine, dermatology, hematology, neurology, pediatrics and cancer therapy. We also have a small but growing lab of our own, and we have been offered a portable X-ray machine and its accessories.

It is so very clear how racist the pigs are; so very clear that their position is to serve only the interests of the rich, the so-called law abiding citizens. The interests of the rich are money and private property, and the poor are murdered everyday because those two things are more valuable to a sick lot like the pigs and avaricious businessmen - than life itself.

Saturday morning about 2:00 a.m., a brother (Jessie Brown) who lives in Richmond, was driving a U-Haul truck he had rented in order to move his furniture, The truck stalled at 6th and Bissell, and for about an hour he had been trying to get it started with help of people passing at different intervals. The problem seemed to be the battery, and no-one had jumper cables, During this time as he struggled to get it started, I observed the pigs circling, circling, circling, like vultures over a dying form of life on a desert. An hour and half had passed now, and someone passing by helped him push the truck across the intersection so it would not block traffic. The pigs could no longer stand it, so one car stopped. When he found Jessie to be hip to their tactics and methods of harassing people because they are fascist back, this pig called two more cars of his pig counterparts to help him 'defend the peace'. Being chicken - shit by nature, this pig as all others do, waited until his swine buddies arrived, and then proceeded to frisk Jessie at several different

Jessie's brother, Stanley, was sitting in the truck, and the pigs made him get out to be frisked also, It turned out that Stanley was in violation of a minor traffic ticket (illegal left turn) for which he was handcuffed behind his back and taken to the pig pen like a criminal - - when in fact the pig is the criminal that "masquerades as the victim of an unprovoked attack."

Stanley was bailed out the next day for \$60,00, I saw and heard all that went down on the corner of 6th and Bissell, Pigs are filthy swine.

I was notified by my attorney that pig Steve Ahern accused me of informing against my brothers and sisters. The detailed account he gave me was very cleaverly planned. This is another fascist attempt to try to cause inner-

When I was first picked up in Bridgeport I did not know why I was busted other than it was supposedly that I was involved in a hit and run car accident, I was kidnapped off of my job. When I got to the New Haven Police Department I was not allowed any calls, mainly for fear that I would notify the other Panthers. Throughout the interrogation they constantly tried to use their bribes like 'You're the first one here and if you tell us all you know we'll let you go and they'll never know you were here'. I specifically said that I didn't know anything and I was not trying to clear myself in order to avoid doing time.

I was constantly harassed, intimidated and they kept drawing their own conclusions by trying to put words in my mouth.

I took the 5th amendment this morning in court (Jan. 21) not because I feared that anything I said would result in any harm to me by my brothers and sisters but because I love and respect them and

already taken me away from the people for 8 months. They've taken my bond away and held me in contempt for 6 months. My parents aren't rich people and they have to work hard for the \$750 they put up. The fascist pigs stole \$750 from them. They took me away from my 2 month old baby, they're going to take me away from my sisters and place me in tripe isolation until I give in to them. But I'd rather rot in jail rather than to give the state's attorney a chance to try to gain some manhood (which he lacks) or inflate long as they remain to have faith in me, I'll remain strong.

Why did they choose me to do this to? Because they know they lack evidence to convict me, that I was foolish enough to give a statement which by now is totally rephrased to suit them with everything taken out of context.

The information that the pigs are using against me have been repeated numerous times by people who have testified before, it's their old fascist tactic to cover up the real truth. Two (2) days ago I was released from jail after 8 months as all of my brothers and sisters should have been. Yestrday state attorney Arnold (Hog) Markle panicked at the idea of a Panther sister out on the

the masses of the people, and would streets exposing to the people the never turn on them. They've lies of this alledged murder case and exposing the inhumane treatment given to political prisoners in Niantic, Litchfield, Denver County and numerous other detention camps.

Today (January 21) Markle planned to try to make me testify against my will in this Kangaroo trial. He knew that I would demand my constitutional rights to remain united with my brothers and sisters. His main purpose today was to get me back in jail for what is mistakenly called "contempt'.

He did not believe that my lawyer, Catherine Rouback could succeed in getting bail granted for me and setting precedent for bail in the State of Connecticut, Since I was out he wanted me back in and was willing to use any means necessary. In the long run the people will start realizing the truth and deal with it.

Panthers are jailed and murdered by these fascist dogs, as in the case of Fred Hampton and Mark Clark, and more will follow them, Markel and his lackeys' cannot fail my spirits and they definetly can't jail the revolution.

PRESS RELEASE JAN. 22, 1970

The Coalition for the Defense of the Panthers today denounced the officials prosecuting the New Haven Panther Case for their utter contempt of ameriKKKan principles of justice and of consitutional rights. They charged that the prosecution is conducting "a systematic program of harassment, intimidation, and pressure against the members of the Black Panther Party who have been arrested for the alleged slaying

of Alex Rackley."

"Yesterday, the Coalition continued "Frances Carter, whom the court had freed on bail, was again deprived of her right of free speech when the prosecution put her back in jail after she refused to testify. We can only conclude that the prosecution greatly fears the impact that Miss Carter's descriptions of her eightmonth imprisonment might have on the general public. She, along with fellow menbers of the Black Panther Party, has been held in virtual isolation; literature and mail have been censored; visiting privileges have been severely restricted." The Coalition further charged that the prisoners have been intimidated and harassed. The women have been denied adequate sleep, exercise, and prenatal care." It is certain that preparation of an adequate defense has been hampered by restrictions on the visiting privileges of counsel."

The Coalition asks "...how long could any human being tolerate such

conditions?"

The statement continued, "the effects of such pressures are clearly shown by the events of last week concerning Warren Kimbro,' In considering his change in plea, the Coalition emphasized that this does not represent an admission that he committed murder. "What it may represent is the result of a build-up of pressures over the past eight months in jail."

In addition, the Coalition has evidence that Mr. Kimbro has been subjected to extreme pressure by his eldest brother, a policeman,"This evidence was documented in a recent letter from Coalition spokesman, Dr. Robert Abramovitz to Attorney charles Garry who represents National Black Panther Party Chairman, Bobby Seale.

The Coalition for the Defense of the Panthers charged that the prosecution is attempting to use the ancient technique of conquering its victims by dividing them. In effect, it tells the prisoners that they will be better off if they plead guilty to a lesser charge, "It is the combination of this treatment,' the statement continued, "and the continued harassment and intimidation in jails, that leads to systematic denial of the rights every man is guaranteed by the first ten amendments to the constitution of the United States,

"How long can the public allow men and women to be degraded and humiliated because of their political beliefs? The blatant efforts on the part of the prosecuton to continually harass all of the prisoners and their unconscionable jailing of Miss Carter in order to prevent her from speaking our must not be allowed to continue. > After ten hours of deliberation, the jury could not reach a unanimous decision; and the judge declared a mistrial. Such a verdict is a partial victory in the racist court system, but we recognize that the pigs will use any means necessary to railroad Bob when his trial comes up again.

BOSTON FREE CLOTHING PROGRAM

The Free Clothing Program was started by the Black Panther Party because of the need for clothing in the Black communities. Following the guidance of our Minister of Defense, Huey P. Newton, who says that we must serve the people wholeheartedly and become "an oxen to be ridden by the people', the Free Clothing Program began on the West coast and has since been implemented by most chapters and branches of the Black Panther Party.

The Boston Chapter of the Black Panther Party started a Free Clothing Program in the Mission Hill District of Roxbury on January 9, 1970. After two months of hard work, the progr n was ready to open so that people from our community could come and get clothing for their famiaring the course of the day, people came to get dresses, shoes, hat coats and other necessities to end re the cold winter weather. The response of the people in the community was great enthusiasm; and we see the need to expand the Free Clothing Progam throughout the entire Black community.

The Black Panther Party is truly dedicated to meeting the needs and desires of the people. We recognize that the United States government spends billions of dollars a year on

space and war research; and is not interested in the welfare of the masses of people. AmeriKKKa, the richest and most highly developed country in the world does not see fit to provide its people with even the basic necessities of life (food, shelter, clothing etc.). Over the last four hundred years Black people have always been on the bottom of this society. This racist society could not care less about the welfare of Black people. So as long as Black people are being oppressed, we will continue to implement programs to serve the needs of the people.

These programs have a two-fold meaning: (1) meeting the basic material needs of our people and (2) raising the political consciousness of our people. (Ex. The Free Breakfast for School Children implemented by the Black Panther Party clearly indicates that such programs must be implemented by the people because the United States government has made no attempt to eradicate the hunger in ameriKKKa,) This is why the United States government is trying to destroy the Black Panther Party. We, in fact, expose the true nature of this racist decadent ameri-KKKan society, But Black people are learning by the correct examples set by the Black Panther Party; and the

ERITREA: WELL DEFINED OBJECTIVE

n the last few months US imperialism and Zionism have aimed their blows at the national liberation movement of Eritrea, in an effort to distort the nature and objectives of that revolutionary struggle.

Regarding these attacks the Syrian newspaper Revolution published a communique of the Eritrea Liberation Front (ELF) in which it rejects imperialist intrigue and points out that the revolution in Eritrea is not an Islamic revolt nor is it the result of the efforts of any power to rule the Middle East,

empire were two separate units. Thus, when in 1953 Eritrea and the Ethiopian empire entered into formal political ties, they took the form of a federation granted and guaranteed by the United Nations. After that, the Ethiopian empire began its partial annexation of Eritrea and in 1962 it considered itself strong enough to formally take over Eritrea. There can only be secession when there has been unity. In Eritrea's case there was no unity; thus there can be no secession. Eritrea's revolution is a struggle for national independence and liberation from Ethiopian colonialism.

The ELF says that the revolution in Eritrea is an independence struggle and asks how, with this in mind, their movement can be considered of a secessionist na-

Considering the revolution in Eritrea secessionist means accepting Eritrea as part of the Ethiopian empire, and that means being blind to historical facts. Eritrea was an Italian colony from 1890 until 1941. In 1890 the Ethiopian empire did not exist in its present form. It is important to understand that the evolution of Eritres and that of the Ethiopian empire were simultaneous historical phenomena. That is, when the Ethiopian empire was evolving in 1899, Eritrea was evolving simultaneously as a modern nation.

The other historical fact worth noting is that until 1953 Eritres and the Ethiopian The people of Eritrea fight against the Ethiopian occupation forces in the same way they fought against the British military occupation from 1947 until 1952.

The people of Eritres are not only fighting for national independence; on the contrary, they struggle for all the demoeratic rights provided by the Constitution of Eritrea. Article 16 says "The Constitution of Eritrea is based on the principle of democratic government." Article 17 of the Constitution guarantees all persons the right to "human rights and fundamental liberties." Article 18 states that the "governing bodies are established by the people and act in their interest." Article 25 and 26 say that "there must be freedom of movement, conscience, and religion." Article 30 stipulates that "every resident of

Eritrea will have the right to express his opinion in any way (press, word of mouth, etc.) and be informed of the opinions expressed by others." Article 33 says "everyone in Eritrea, regardless of nationality. race, sex, or religion, will have the right to work at equal pay for equal work, regular paid vacations, a guaranteed minimum wage, sick pay and workman's compensation, and a decent and healthy standard of living." Paragraph 2 of the same article says that "every resident of Eritrea will have the right to join trade unions to protect his interests." It is is clear, then. that the people of Eritrea fight for national independence in order to regain their sacred democratic rights.

But the reality is that the people of Ethiopia remain in the grip of an especially primitive type of feudalism. All the rights guaranteed in the Constitution of Eritrea are a remote dream to the people of the Ethiopian empire, Today the Ethiopian peoples are awakening from their listless passivity. A small but organized progressive force has come to the fore. What is surprising, however, is that even the socalled progressive force has entered into an unholy alliance with Haile Sclassie on the question of Eritrea. As a result we are forced to ask the following questions. Are the so-called Ethiopian progressive forces struggling against feudalism to win for the Ethiopian people what the Constitution of Eritrea provided for the people of Eritrea, i. e. basic civil and human rights, and true justice - economic, political, and social? If that is the case, how can they deny to the people of Eritrea what they want for the people of Ethiopia? The objective of a progressive must be to condemn repression wherever he finds it. But when a progressive adopts a double standard of progress he can only be a chauvinist where Asmara* is concerned, a shoan nationalist or simply a person who is ignorant of the

Haile Selassie has deliberately and sys tematically cast a veil over the contribution of the people of Eritrea to the great anticolonialist movement of our time. The anticolonialist movement of Eritrea which has its roots in the period from 1890 until 1941, was only able to gain strength from 1947 on when the international situation became favorable.

History shows that Eritrea and Libya were the first African countries that obtained their independence. Nor can we overlook Eritrea's contribution to Pan-Africanism, Not imaginary Pan-Africanism

but rather practical Pan-Africanism. The federation with Ethiopia was a genuine contribution to African unity. However, Ethiopian colonialism, with its usual brutality destroyed and abused the noble feelings of the people of Eritrea.

The revolution in Eritrea is part of the global anti-imperialist struggle.

The US that has made a political, economic, and military neocolony out of the Ethiopian empire supports the annexation of Eritrea. Thus it is clear that the people of Eritrea who struggle against Ethiopian colonialism are also indirectly fighting against the power of the United States. An article published in US News and World Report serves to illustrate what we mean. "The importance of Kagnew Station "." the article says, "goes a good way toward explaining the heavy commitment of the US toward maintaining the military strength of Ethiopia."

The article quotes a US official: "Our aid, plainly and simply, pays the rent on Kagnew Station." The article goes on to say: "Ethiopia receives more than half of all US military aid to nations on the con-

tinent of Africa. The cost of this program now has climbed over the 100-million-dollar mark, and the US Military Assistance Advisory Group of some 110 officers and men in Ethiopia is the biggest in Africa. In addition, Ethiopia has received 150 million dollars in economic assistance."

The revolution in Eritres is neither an Islamic uprising nor the product of the maneuvering of a powerful nation seeking to dominate the Middle East. As the Eritrean revolution achieves new and bigger victories it will prove that it is advancing the struggle in the Middle East as well as Africa's struggle against imperialism. But perhaps the greatest impact of the Eritrean revolution will be on the tottering Ethiopian empire. The nationalities under the rule of the Ethiopian empire -following the example of the Eritrean people- will succeed in crushing feudalism and US imperialism. The prerequisite for unity in the African Horn is to crush the feudalimperialist shoan and the great alliance between regional feudalism and US imperialism.



G.I. To Continue Anti-War Struggle After Discharge

lano of Ft. McClellan, Alabama, was notified November 28, 1969 that he would be given an undesirable discharge from the Army for "unsuitability due to apathy, defective attitudes and inability to expend effort constructively". Delano chose to fight the charges by facing a field board which would determine his "suitability" to remain a soldier, because he believed the charges against him were due to his opposition to the war in Vietnam and as such in violation of his First Amendment rights, On January 7, 1970, he was notified that proceedings against him were discontinued and that he would receive the honorable discharge he clearly deserves.

Delano is a leader of Ft. Mc-Clellan's Gis-WACs United Against the war in Vietnam, and an editor of their newspaper Left Face. Upon notification of the action against him last November, he contacted the GI Civil Liberties Defense Committee of New York. The Defense Committee requested legal help from attorney Peter Rindskopf of Atlanta, associate legal director of the Southern Legal Action Project SLAP). Rindskopf, immediately demanded that proceedings against Delano be dissolved, and that the field board hearing (AR 636-212) be cancelled.

Delano's original hearing was scheduled for January 6, and was postponed until January 12, but before the hearing could be held Convening Authority Colonel Ladson conceded to Rindskopf's de-

Vietnam veteran Sgt, Lewis De- mand and dissolved the proceedings. Delano's military attorney, Capt. Ganobcik, was informed of the decision January 7.

Delano, was served 12 months in Vietnam, had excellent conduct ratings until he became active in the GI anti-war movement last spring. Twenty-two years old, he has been awarded the National Defense Service Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal, the Vietnam Campaign Medal, Army Commendation Medal and the Bronze Star for "meritorious service". The GI Civil Liberties Defense Committee considers Delano's victory an important step forward for constitutional rights in the Armed Forces and a blow against the Army's attempt to punish Delano for his anti-war views.

This is the fourth time the brass has retreated faced by soldiers who refuse to accept penalties and harassments for their anti-war activity. Pvt. Steve Dash of Ft. Jackson, S.C., member of GIs United Against the War in Vietnam, was honorably discharged last September after a summer field board hearing was held to determine his "fitness". A/I C Larry Friedberg of Wright Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio, was threatened with a general discharge for character and behavior disorder (read anti-war views and activity) but was granted an honorable on December 17, 2 1/2 years early, after insisting upon his rights. Pfc. Thomas Hathcock, like Delano a member of Ft, Mc-Clellan's GIs-WACs United Against the War in Vietnam, was notified August 4, 1969, that he



would receive an "undesirable" discharge unless he chose to rebut it with a hearing or in writing. Attorney Dorian Bowman of New York, associate of GI CLDC's counsel Leonard Boudin, composed the rebuttal letter and so far the Army has taken no further action against Hathcock. ON G.I. NEWSPAPER **FIGHT**

On January 2, 1970, Chief Judge Algernon Butler of North Carolina's federal district court denied a motion for preliminary injuction which sought immediate on post distribution rights for the GI anti-war newspaper, Bragg Briefs. The motion was argued before Judge Butler last November 12. by noted constitutional attorney, Leonard B. Boudin of New York.

This federal court action was taken by attorneys Leonard Boudin, Laughlin McDonald of Chapel Hill, N.C., and Howard Moore of Atlanta, Ga., in association with the GI Civil Liberties Defense Committee on behalf of members of GIs United Against the War in Vietnam at Ft. Bragg.

In his decision, Judge Butler reviewed the facts of the case without discussing the points of law in favor of or against either First Amendment rights for soldiers or, specifically, the problem of freedom of the press for soldiers. He accepted Ft. Bragg Commanding General Tolson's contention that permission to distribute the publications would constitute a clear danger to the loyalty, discipline and morale of the military men under Tolson's command. In addition, Butler stated that the plaintiffs did not clearly establish the fact that they are being denied a constitutional

The flames of liberation struggle are fierce particularly in Asia, Africa and Latin America, Imperialism is meeting with a determined resistance of the peoples and dealt most severe blows in these areas. The peoples who have risen in the struggle are winning fresh victories in their revolutionary cause of smashing the old world of imperialism and colonialism and creating a new world.

The growth of the revolutionary forces of the world headed by socialism and the collapse of the colonial system have markedly weakened the forces of imperialism. The internal contradictions of imperialism have become more acute and the discord among the imperialist powers has been aggravated. The imperialists are suffering telling blows from within and without and are getting still deeper into hot water.

The revolutionary movement cannot be free from vicissitudes in the course of its development, but the general situation is developing in favour of socialism and the revolutionary forces and to the disadvantage of imperialism and the reactionary forces. Victory of socialism and downfall of imperialism are the main trend of our times that no force can check.

But imperialism does not recede from the arena of history of its own will. The aggressive nature of imperialism cannot change and imperialism still remains a dangerous force. The imperialists desperately try to find a way out of their doom in aggression and war.

The aggressive manoeuvrings of the imperialists led by U.S. imperialism have become more undisguised in recent years. The U.S. imperialists are perpetrating acts of aggression against the socialist countries and the independent national states, brutally suppressing the national-liberation movements of the Asian, African and Latin-American peoples and disturbing peace in all parts of

the world. Today, the U.S imperialists direct the spearhead of aggression to Asia, The U.S. imperialists have brought more and more armed forces into South Viet Nam in flagrant violation of the 1954 Geneva Agreements, carried out the scorched - earth operations of "burn all, kill all and destroy all" and have already extended their bombing of the Democratic Republic of Viet Nam to the Hanoi and Haiphong areas. This shows that the U.S. imperialist policy of "escalation of war" in Viet Nam has entered a new, serious phase. The U.S. imperialists are now running amuck to spread the war flames to vast areas of Asia.

The U.S. aggressors, occupying the southern half of our country, mad on war preparations; they also occupy Tiawan, a territory of the People's Republic of China, and incessantly commit provocative acts against People's China,

The U.S. imperialists have revived Japanese militarism to use it as a "shock brigade" in their Asian aggression, They have aligned the forces of Japanese militarism with the South Korean puppets and are scheming to rig up a "Northeast Asia military alliance" with this alignment as the backbone.

The basic strategy of the U.S. imperialists in their Asian aggression is to blockade and attack the Asian socialist countries, stem the rapid growth of the revolutionary forces and prop up their colonial rule in Asia by concentrating more and more US military force in this region and mobilizing the forces of Japanese mili-

A fierce struggle is going on tarism and their satellite coungressors aggravates the situation in all parts of Asia to the exversal peace.

The intensified aggressive manoeuvrings of the imperialists led by U.S. imperialism are no signs of their mightiness; they indicate, on the contrary, that they have been placed in a more difficult desperate ensituation. The made by U.S. imdeavours perialism in Asia, Africa and Latin America only testify that the forces of socialism are growing, the anti-imperialist revolutionary movement is unfolded intensively and the imperialist foothold is shaken to its very foundations in these areas.

No amount of manoeuvres on the part of the imperialists can check the mounting liberation struggle of the peoples or halt the triumphant onward march of socialism. The imperialists will surely be kicked out of Asia, Africa and Latin America and eventually be defeated by the revolutionary struggle of the peoples. Ultimate triumph of socialism and complete downfall of imperialism are inevitable. This is an inexorable law of historical development.

All events taking place in the international arena substantiate still more clearly that U.S. imperialism is the main force of aggendarme, the bulwark of modern colonialism and the most heinous enemy of the peoples of the whole lations with big countries, direct

U.S. imperialism is target No. 1 in the struggle of the world peoples. It is the primary task of the socialist countries and the Communist and Workers' parties to enlist and concentrate the broad anti-imperialist forces in the struggle against U.S. imperialism. Only by fighting resolutely against U.S. imperialism can world peace be safeguarded and the revolutionary struggle of the peoples be crowned with victory.

At the present period the attitude towards US imperialism is a major yardstick to verify the position of the Communist and Workers' parties. The Communists should always hold fast to the principled position of opposing imperialism. U.S. imperialism above all. Particularly today when the U.S. imperialists are expanding aggression in Viet Nam, all the socialist countries should take a still more frigid and tougher attitude towards U.S. imperialism. We should never tolerate renunciation of principle and compromise with U.S. imperialism in international affairs.

The socialist countries, even if they maintain diplomatic relations with the imperialist states, should not dissolve their anti-imperialist struggle therein or weaken it for that reason. The socialist countries should adhere to class principle in diplomacy, too, and should bring pressure to bear upon U.S. imperialism and expose and condemn its policy of aggression and

It is also wrong only to shout against U.S. imperialism without taking concrete actions to stop U.S. imperialist aggression. Particularly, one should not cause difficulties to the anti-imperialist anese and West German militarism forces taking practical measures in unity for dealing blows at the U.S. imperialist aggressors, If such an act is committed, U.S. imperialists' aggression cannot be prevented. On the contrary, it will make the U.S. imperialists more arrogant and outrageous, and eventually encourage their acts of ag-

It is a principle of the foreign policy of the socialist countries to struggle against the imperialist policy of aggression and war for world peace and security. While fighting to prevent war, however, the Communists should never fear it, but should thoroughly annihilate the aggressors when the imperialists make armed attack on us. 

RULES OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS BERKELEY, CALIFORNIA

Every member of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY throughout this country of racist America must abide by these rules as functional members of this party. CENTRAL COMMITTEE members, CENTRAL STAFFS, and LOCAL STAFFS, including all captains subordinate to either national, state, and local leadership of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY will enforce these rules. Length of suspension or other disciplinary action necessary for violation of these rules will depend on national decisions by national, state or state area, and local committees and staffs where said rule or rules of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY WERE VIOLATED.

Every member of the party must know these verbatum by heart, and apply them daily. Each member must report any violation of these rules to their leadership or they are counter-revolutionary and are also subjected to suspension by the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.

THE RULES ARE:

- 1. No party member can have narcotics or weed in his possession while doing party work.
- Any party member found shooting narcotics will be expelled from this party.
- 3. No party member can be DRUNK while doing daily party work.

 4. No party member will violate rules relating to office work, general meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY, and meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY ANYWHERE.
- 5. No party member will USE, POINT, or FIRE a weapon of any kind unnecessarily or accidentally at anyone.
- 6. No party member can join any other army force other than the BLACK LIBERATION ARMY.
- 7. No party member can have a weapon in his possession while DRUNK or loaded off narcotics or weed.
- 8. No party member will commit any crimes against other party members or BLACK people at all, and cannot steal or take from the people, not even a needle or a piece of thread.

 9. When arrested BLACK PANTHER MEMBERS will give only
- name, address, and will sign nothing. Legal first aid must be understood by all Party members.
- 10. The Ten Point Program and platform of the BLACK PANTHER
 PARTY must be known and understood by each Party member.

 11. Parts Communications must be National and Local.
- Party Communications must be National and Local.
 The 10-10-10-program should be known by all members and also understood by all members.
- 13. All Finance officers will operate under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Finance.

 14. Each person will submit a report of daily work.
- Each Sub-Section Leader Section Leader, Lieutenant, and Captain must submit Daily reports of work.
 All Panthers must learn to operate and service weapons correctly.
- 17. All Leadership personnel who expel a member must submit this information to the Editor of the Newspaper, so that it will be published in the paper and will be known by all chapters and branches.
- 18. Political Education Classes are mandatory for general membership.
- 19. Only office personnel assigned to respective offices each day should be there. All others are to sell papers and do Political work out in the community, including Captains, Section Leaders, etc.
- 20. COMMUNICATIONS all chapters must submit weekly reports in writing to the National Headquarters.
- 21. All Branches must implement First Aid and/or Medical Cadres.
 22. All Chapters. Branches, and components of the BLACK PAN111ER PARTY must submit a monthly Financial Report to the Minis-
- try of Finance, and also the Central Committee.
 23. Everyone in a leadership position must read no less than two hours per day to keep abreast of the changing political situation.
- 24. No chapter or branch shall accept grants, poverty funds, money or any other aid from any government agency without contacting the National Headquarters.
- 25. All chapters must adhere to the policy and the ideology laid down by the CENTRAL COMMITTEE of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.
- 26. All Branches must submit weekly reports in writing to their respective Chapters.

Black Panther Party Platform and Program

What We Want What We Believe



Minister of Defense, Black Panther Party

1. We want freedom. We want power to determine the destiny of our Black Community.

We believe that black people will not be free until we are able to determine our destiny.

2. We want full employment for our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white American businessmen will not give full employment, then the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living.

3. We want an end to the robbery by the CAPITALIST of our Black Community.

We believe that this racist government has robbed us and now we are demanding the overdue debt of forty acres and two mules. Forty acres and two mules was promised 100 years ago as restitution for slave labor and mass murder of black people. We will accept the payment in currency which will be distributed to our many communities. The Germans are now aiding the Jews in Israel for the genocide of the Jewish people. The Germans murdered six million Jews. The American racist has taken part in the slaughter of over fifty million black people; therefore, we feel that this is a modest demand that we make.

4. We want decent housing, fit for shelter of human beings.

We believe that if the white landlords will not give decent housing to our black community, then the housing and the land should be made into cooperatives so that our community, with government aid, can build and make decent housing for its people.

5. We want education for our people that exposes the true nature of this decadent American society. We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present-day society.

We believe in an educational system that will give to our people a knowledge of self. If a man does not have knowledge of himself and his position in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

6. We want all black men to be exempt from military service.

We believe that Black people should not be forced to fight in the military service to defend a racist government that does not protect us. We will not fight and kill other people of color in the world who, like black people, are being victimized by the white racist government of America. We will protect ourselves from the force and violence of the racist police and the racist military, by whatever means necessary.

7. We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY and MURDER of black people.

We believe we can end police brutality in our black community by organizing black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all black people should arm themselves for self-defense.

8. We want freedom for all black men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails.

We believe that all black people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

 We want all black people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peer group or people from their black communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that black people will receive fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a man a right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the black community from which the black defendant came. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man" of the black community.

10. We want land, bread, housing, education, clothing, justice and peace. And as our major political objective, a United Nations-supervised plebiscite to be held throughout the black colony in which only black colonial subjects will be allowed to participate, for the purpose of determining the will of black people as to their national destiny.

When, in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume, among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal: that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed: that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and bappiness. Prudence, indeed, will dietate that governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and, accordingly, all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But, when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same object, evinces a design to reduce them under absolute despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new guards for their future security.
