have the gall to try to pull it off.
But the fact that they are going full speed ahead with their disgraceful conspiracy should make it clear to the American people, once and for all, that a desperate hour is upon us and we have no time to loose if we are to salvage the situation. Because one thing must be made absolutely clear to America: no matter what the White people of America are prepared to accept. Black people do not accept this ultimate attempt to bind and gag Bobby Seale with death because of the fearless leadership that he has given to our people.

Black people will never accept this premeditated decision of the fascist power structure to murder Chairman Bobby Seale in the Electric Chair, So that the question is nowposed, pure and simple: Is America going to have a Class War or a Race War? The fascists have already declared war upon the people. Will the people as a whole rise up to meet this challenge with a righteous People's War against these fascist pigs. or will Black people have to go it alone, thus transforming a dream of interracial solidarity into the nightmare of a Race War?

Our brothers are being murdered in their sleep by the shock troopers of the power structure; our offices are being subjected to all-out military attack; our lawyers are being sentenced to prison along with us; and the fascist Nixon Administration has unleashed the political police of the F.B.I. and thrown away all pretenses of justice and equality under the law. Lip-service to the Constitution of the United States of America has been replaced by outright fascist terror and naked repression. Hundreds of our Party members have been jacked-up on highly political charges. Scores of our Party members languish in jails and prisons, subjected to scandalously high bails that are tantamount to RANSOM. Throughout the length and breath of this depraved land, the situation is the same. It is nothing but an attempt to sabotage the 400 year struggle of our people for freedom and liberation.

Our Minister of Defense, Huey P. Newton, teaches us that in order to have security from the unceasing aggressions of the enemy, we must always be in a position to inflict a political consequence upon the aggressor for each act of aggression. This attempt to murder Chairman Bobby Seale coldbloodedly in the Electric Chair is an open provocation and the ultimate aggression against Black people. 

HUEYS 7 4: 1/10); 1

As time goes by, I think it will become very clear to people in general that the coming of Huey Newton and the founding of the Black Panther Party by him and Bobby Seale was truly an historic event. Because you almost have to start dealing with religious categories to talk about the importance of what they did. It must always be kept in mind that of Hugy and Bobby, Huey is/was the dynamo. the source, the prime mover. And it wis he who set the standard by which Black men from that point on will be measured by themselves, by Black men and by Black women. In this sense. it doesn't really matter how White people judge Huey or whether or not they understand why he is so important to us. The important thing is the profound effect that he has had in elevating the consciousness of Black people inside the United States. It is very clear also that Huey's influence has spread beyond Black people, and that there are many young White people who relate charismatically to Huev Newton. But Huey has charisma for the average young Black cat and definitely has charisma for young Black women. Huzy was able to influence people who have never been influenced in the history of the United States. Huey was able to take the dispossessed and forgotten element--we call them the "brothers and sisters off the block" those who live in the urban ghettos and who are not represented by any organization, any political machinery. Huey was able to take winos and dope fiends, thieves, pimps and to politicize them and give them the motivation and the discipline to participate in organized political activity. This was a fantastic achievement. The closest that anyone ever came to that in the past was Elijah Muhammed and the Black Muslim Movement. Through the voice of Malcolm X, the Black Muslims were able to reach some of the same people. The people whom Huey Newton was able to reach are the people who listened to Malcolm X. The people who would listen to Malcolm X but who wouldn't join his organization but who listened to him sympathetically. Huey was able to strike a fire in their hearts and to infuse them with an enthusiasm that was miraculous. But you could understand that and how that could be done when you see Huey in action on the scene of oppression, when you see a scene go down, the type of scene that Black people have been subjected to for centuries. I'm speak-

ing of confrontations that speak of death. Scenes where some Black berson has just been brutalized by a cob or as in Richmond, California, April, 1967, when the police killed, in the most vicious manner, Denzil Dowell, a young Black man; and whose mother was upset and demanding an investiga-

Her son had been murdered in the most blatant and vicious manner shot down in an alley with a shotgun by pigs. And this mother was very upset as we can understand and all she wanted was an investigation. She wanted something to be done about it and she went to the authorities and asked the authorities to have a Grand Jury investigation. The Coroner rushed through his investigation and called it justifiable homicide. And here was this mother with a huge family, I think about fourteen people in her family, a very poor woman, a woman wko was ill, a woman who had been more or less robbed by life years ago and whose only perspective was to see her children, all finally grow up and do the best that they could. And Denzil Dowell was kind of the jewel of the family. I'm not sure whether or not he was the baby of the family but his mother was very, very fond of him because he was the one in the family whom she could rely on, to whom she could turn and ask to do things, to run errands for her when other people didn't seem to be available. Denzil Dowell was her right hand and he had gone out of the house to do something for her and he never came back. Someone came to her house and told her that the police had just killed her son. She was in hysterics almost. She was hysterical for justice. She put out this call to all the Black organizations to come and talk to her, to have a meeting at her home so that something could be done about the murder of her son. She asked for the NAACP, the Urban League, and CORE, and some of the religious organizations just to come and discuss this with her because she was not well enough to go and visit all of them. And she asked them to send a representative and she didn't even know about the Black Panther Party. But at the moment, the time that was set aside for this meeting, we showed up, the Black Panther Party showed up, and none of

And it was around this incident, trying to do something for Mrs. Dowell, that I really became convinced that I had to join the Black Panther Party. That's the moment when it was clear to me that I was a Black Panther. I had been associating with the Panthers and I had been strongly attracted to the Panthers but out of this attempt to get this investigation, there were many times when I saw Huey step forward, under the guns of the police, in a very fearless manner, Not for money; not for any compensation of that type, but out of the desire to do something for his people. To see Huey Newton step forward confront murderous. brutal, vicious gestapo pigs and to see him do this fearlessly and to hear him articulate the grievances of his people and to hear him hurl forth an implacable demand for alleviation of these grievances, it was a thing that has to be seen in a certain perspective and in a certain context. If you can understand that then you can understand why and how Huey P. Newton was able to get other Black men and women to pick up the gun and stand with him in defense of our people.

When Huey was on the streets out of jail, he was always in a hurry. Huey walked fast, he talked fast, in everything he did there was a sense of urgency about it, because he knew that time was very short for him. He fully expected to be shot down some night, to be killed by pigs. During those days it was like walking on egg shells. egg shells that were filled with explosives. Tension, tension was extremely high within the group, and every moment was like the last moment. And no one would have been able to hold his cool unless Huey held his. I always got the impression that when there would be a group of Panthers together, they were ready to split and that they would all have gotten away from that scene, and gotten away from each other, but for Huey standing there firmly holding them together.

At this particular time that I was trying to talk about when we were in Richmond, we visited the scene where Denzil Dowell was shot down in this alley. And there were about thirteen or fourteen members of the Black Panther Party there all of whom were armed except myself, I didn't have a gun. And when the cops found out that we were there with guns, well just reacting as they have always reacted in the past, they dispatched their troops to the scene. And there were maybe fifteen or twenty people from the community, Black people who knew Denzil Dowell and who were concerned about Denzil Dowell, and Denzil Dowell's mother was there. You have to picture this elderly Black women. In describing Denzil Dowell's mother you have to picture an elderly stout woman; a woman recognized by other people in the community as being a mother, a grandmother; an elderly woman who had the appearance of being weary and tired; the type of woman you might see sitting in the front row or pew of the other organizations showed up, a Baptist church on any given Sunday. And she was surrounded by some of

DEMOCRACY FOR WHOM?

Under the United States Constitution, the highest law of the land, every citizen is guaranteed the cight to speak his mind, write and publish his thoughts and assemble on the street to protest against what he thinks is wrong. This is clearly written in the Constitution. However, there are always loopholes in the Consti-tution which empower the State with the authority to suppress these basic rights if and when it so desires. As we have witnessed many times, whenever a large body of men evoke their rights to freedom of speech, freedom of press and freedom of assembly, the State, if annoyed by the words or demands of this body of men, does not hesit-ate to dispatch its armed troops while at the same time declaring state of martial law. Of course, there is always an explanation, or justification for this overt act of repression; the "justification" always comes to us under the name of "law and order", the unwritten clause in the Constitution. This contradictory system of justice-the granting of certain civil liberties on the one hand and the denying of these liberties on the other -- is always the case of a state ruled by what is termed a "bourgeois democracy". Under a bourgeois democracy. Juneer a bourgeois democracy, a govern-ment by the wealthy, of the wealthy and for the wealthy; the state exists only for the benefit of the bourgeoisie, the owners of the means of production. It could be no other way. If the state were ruled by, say farmers, what we would have then is a government by, of and for the farmers. In other words, the state is merely an instrument employed by one class to suppress another. The state does cannot-exist in the interest of freedom but rather to keep down its adversaries. When class antagonisms disappear and when it is possible to speak of freedom, tate, of course, then ceases to exist.

We are taught at an early age that the term "democracy" means "rule of the people." But what we are not taught is that there are basically two kinds of democracy---bourgeoisie democracy and proletarian democracy. So no we are left with the question, democracy for whom? Let us take a closer look at this word democracy and apply it to our

democracy and apply it to our present-day society.
When the word democracy is used in our presence, many of us immediately think of an imposing building which we have been taught to call "the House of Congress, or in some cases, "the House of Parliament" Inside this huge building, we visualize two so-dalled onposing groups of men. called opposing groups of men, one group being the "majority power" and the other group jocking for position to become the majority power at the next general election machinery of a certain kind of democracy. It does not relate to the essense of what a true demodemocracy is simply a government by the people, of the people and for the people and the assurance that will be freely elected by the people. But then we are told that the two opposing groups of men in that congressional building are the elected representatives of the people; this would include also the President of the State, who is not a member of Congress but does have the power to veto any of the laws passed by Congress, and the power to declare or stop a war.

ho are these representatives of the people? Where do they come from? Who are the people? What people? These are fair questions and, they deserve fair answers.

In a society made up of classes, class struggles and class contradictions—that is, classes with an-tagonistic interests, political beliefs, etc. — the State, as is always the case, invariably serves the class that is in control of the means of production. Owing to this "type of democracy", the people or the Demos, would be none other or the Demos, would be none other than the economically dominate class, since all the benefits of democracy are not extended to everyone. So what we have here is a democracy for one class, which is made up of a fractional which is made up of a fractional part of the entire population. The representatives of the "people" people in this case being wealthy class, the owners of the of production -- are men themselves are from the wealthy class) who are elected to office simply to serve "the ruling class." Of course, the ex-ternal characteristics of the state -- constitutions, general elections, congress, party opposition, etc., -- may seem democratic but the state is nonetheless here to pro tect and serve the interests of the ruling class. Even the pro-claimed democratic rights and liberties are in the hands of the ruling class. This is a bourgeois democracy. Such is the type of democracy that exists here in America today. To quote Vladimir Lenin: "Bourgeois democracy, although a great historical advance in comparison with medievallsm, always remains, and under capita-lism is bound to remain, restricted, truncated, false and hypocritical, a paradise for the rich and a snare and a deception for the exploited, for the poor."

As long as class antagonisms exist, we can only speak of a "democracy of classes." We cannot speak of a "true" democracy (pure democracy) as long as classes exist. There can be no equality between the exploiting class and the class that is being exploited. It is ignorant and monstrous to speak of equality between the exploited and the exploiters.

us now examine another kind of democracy: Proletarian Democracy. In this type of demo-cracy the state still exists to put down its adversaries—the reactionary class, the former, owners of the means of production. However, since the means of produc-tion are now in the hands of the proletarian, the working class, the state now exists in the interests of the proletarian, whom, as I mentioned earlier in this work comprise the vast majority of the entire population. And the representatives of the people-- the people, or the demos, now being the proletarian class -- are, of course, elected to serve the proletarian, being that they (the rep-resentatives) are from the ma-jority class. "There is no longer a need for the "two-Party" system since there is now a unamity of interests and political bellefs. The state now becomes a system of government by" of and for the majority of the people-in other words, a socialistic society, a society where the people share equally in the things they commonly need and commonly use. The state will exist only so long as to eradicate all bourgeois and petty bourgeois tendencies. This is a

Proletarian democracy.

It is interesting to note that under a bourgeois democracy, the term "free enterprise" is very misleading. The existing state would have us believe that capitalism is an economic system in which the means of production and distribution are privately owned, which in turns leads us to believe

that the owners of capital are separated from the state. This, the owners of capital are the state -in this case, the state being the bourgeoisie. In the development of capitalism, the vast majority of capital is accumulated by a small group of men who inevitably turn their capitalistic monopoly into the governing body of the state in question. When the working class seizes the means of production, all capital is then turned over to

all capital is then turned over to all the people. The existing state, through its political educators—high school government teachers, college po-litical science professors and the "popular" mass media—in-forms us that the right to dis-sent is an essential ingredient of a democracy. To take away the right of dissent -- freedom of speech, press and assembly --is to infringe upon one's basic freedoms as guaranteed by the Constitution. But, then, this is good only on paper. For we know that the basic rights of millions of Americans are being violated each and everyday, as exempli-fied by the "Bobby Seale Trial." American jurisprudence once again wiped its big ugly behind on the U.S. Constitution. Bobby's ludic-rous imitation of a trial was just another classic example of A-merican toilet room justice." in hog-tying Bobby to the chair and stuffing rags in his mouth and denying him the right to private counsel of his own choice, and of speech, the American judicial system merely revealed itself as the most decadent form of juris-prudence in existence. And to top it off, Bobby was sentenced to preson without the benefit of a jury trial. (The court sentenced Bobby to four years in federal prison on sixteen consecutive

counts of contempt of court.)

I could write several pages citing incidents where many Americans have been denied their constitutional rights, but to do this it would be a reiteration of what has already been said. What I am trying to point out, is that the existing state is simply an apparatus for making laws that are used as weapons against those who are subordinate to the ruling class. There can be no justice for the ''non-owners'' of the means of production. For a slave to expect justice from the slave master would be the same as expecting the robber to return the loot to the man he just robbed.

Now we are left with the ques-tions, "what must one do to secure one's rights, to protect one's right? The answer, I believe, lies in the sister document of the U.S. Consti-tution: The Declaration of Inde-pendence, "...We hold these truths to be self evident, that all men are created equal; that they are en-dowed by their creator with-certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the

secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent any form of government becomes destructive to these ends, it is the right of the PEOPLE to alter or to ABOLISH it, and to insti-tute a NEW government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such forms, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that governments long es-tablished should not be changed for light and transient causes; and, accordingly, all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms for which they are accustomed. But, when a long train of ABUSES and USURPATIONS, pursuing invari-ably the same object, evinces a design to reduce them under absolute depotism, it is their RIGHT, it is their DUTY, to THROW OFF such government, and to provide NEW GUARDS for their future se-curity," (Italics are mine).

That the American people have

been suffering a long train of abuses and usurpations for many

WOMENS INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE FOR PEACE AND FREEDOM STATEMENT OF REPRESSION

Men's International League for Peace and Freedom, meeting in Philadelphia on February 14-15, 1970, deplores the growing climate of repression in the United States. The pressing problems which face our society-racism and urban deay, polarization between persons of different political persuasions, growing disenchaniment by youth-will not be solved attempting to repress their manifestations. Spokesmen for the Administration are cultivating polarization by categorizing political dissenters as "ideological criminals" and inveiging against the media for recent wave of attacks against the Black Panther Party perpetrated by federal, state and local authorities evidences a lack of respect for the Constitutional rights of ALL members of society. More than 28 members of the Black Panther Party have been killed and much of their property destroyed by law enforcement agents.

Contributing to this atmosphere of repression, the Senate has passed, with little opposition, two measures which repeal sections of the Bill of Rights. 

And Wives Moaroe, Ga., July 26--Two young Negroes, one a veteran just re-turned from the war, and their wives were lined up last night near a secluded road and shot dead by an unmasked band of twenty White

The ghastly details of the multiple lynching were told today by Loy Harrison, a well-to-do White farmer who had just hired the Negroes to work on his farm. Harrison was bringing the Negroes to his farm when his car was waylaid by the mob eight miles fro Monroe, Questioning of one of the

Her the past year the Black citizenry of Cairo has been engaged in a political struggle, (our gaged in a political struggle, (our Minister of Defense, Huey P. New-ton, says that "War is politics with bloodshed, and politics is war without bloodshed" which has involved shooting skirmeses, economic boycotts, and some people's

We found that a state of war manifestes itself in the attacks on the Black community by the White Hats, a viglante group formed by the State's Attorney as an auxil-iary police force. The White Hats were an armed body who in fact turned out to be a higher manifestation of the Klu Klux Klan. "They were terrorists who had traded their white hoods for white hats".

Cairo, Illinois, is situated in southern Illinois, Alexander County, lying on an agriculturally rich area around the Mississippi delta area around the Mississippi delta called "Little Egypt". Agricul-turally it is one of the richest areas in the United States. In defiance of the acts of ter-

rorism and exploitation, the peo-ple of Cairo have banded together as one into a unified political force, a structure called United Front. It consists of the NAACP, the Cool Gents, concerned clergy, Southern Illinois Cooperative As sociation, all civic groups, and all churches. Through their social practice the United Front has practice the United Front has found that their responsibilities and needs are one, in both, one can find the structural design aimed at meeting the needs of the people. 

The seven did not testify at the official inquest.

The most dramatic moment of the event came when Debra Johnson, Hamplon's girlfriend, who was nine months pregnant at the time of the raid, gave her testimony. "I came home that night after a political orientation class," said Miss Johnson. "Later on someone came in the room and started shaking the chairman. We woke up and saw shots being fired. He (Hampton) looked up and then he laid his head back down. I assume he w a s shot then. They kept shooting."

Greeting Comrades

Whenever we read the mass media news coverage of the cur-rent events locally and nationally, we have to read between the lines and distinguish the truth from the false-hood. The news is slanted so when the masses make revolutionary steps or actions against the oppressor it has to be recognized as strategic methods of resisting the pig power structure, and not as the news media would have us believing.

I say this mainly because while being incarcerated the racist pigs have denied us our legal reading rights. They try to pacify us by allowing us to read lies and ir-relevant propaganda about our communities, which has been pro-jected by the systematic mass news media. We want to read something that's relevant to us as poor oppressed people struggling in America. Tricky Pig Dickie Nixon's vacations or the imagionary moon and space car-toons aren't related to the people. We want something to read that exposes the true nature of this de-American society and something that's directed towards the freedom of all poor oppressed

a) There was no showing whatsoewer that d-fendant wielded a weapon or threatened anyone with it;

b) A different alleged victim than named in the complaint was produced, and even this individual denied having been assaulted.

"The examination must be completed at one session, unless the magistrate, for good cause shown by affidavit, postpones it. The postponement cannot be for more than two days at each time, nore more than six days in all, unless by consent or on the motion of the defendat."

The rights set forth in this and the other Penal Code Sections prescribing the procedures to be followed at preliminary examination are fundamental, and when denied, vitiate the legality of the commitment of the defendant. Peo. v. Bucher, 175 C.A. 2d 343 (1989) The court in Bucher affirmed the Superior Court's dismissal of an information pursuant to motion brought under Penal Code Section 995 squarely on the grounds that the defendant had not been legally committed due to violation of Section 801, The preliminary examination had been continued for only one day, upon the People's assertion, uncontinues for only one cay, upon the People's assertion, un-supported by affidavit, that the pro-secution had heen unable to serve a subponee on a material witness, The People made no such asser-tions in the instant case, The magistrate required no showing at

Notither witness HESS or witness BEAM were present on December 1, 1969, although the case had been set for preliminary on that day long in advance. B. DEFENDANT'S RIGHT TO CROSS-EXAMINE THE WITNESS HESS ATTHE CONTINUED PRE-LIMINARY HEARING WAS UN-DULY RESTRICTED AND DENIED SUBSTANTIVE DEFENDANT

The magistrate unduly and prejudicially restricted defendant's right to fully cross-examine witness HESS as to present employment, and thus as to bias and credibility (R.T. 29). Thus defendant was denied the opportunity to present all available evidence and defenses. Penal Code Section 865 requires that the defendant be permitted to cross-examine the witnesses in his behalf. Though there is discretton given the magistrate to supervise cross-examination designed to test credibility, nevertheless, this discretion must be exercised within the rule that such questioning "should be given wide latitude, particularly in cases in volving 'a witness against a defendant in a crimial prosecution'". The witness HESS herein was the only witness able to identify the defendant at all, and although remotely, he linked her with the incident involved which gave rise to the charges, it is to be noted, and it is significant in apprais-

These circumstances make even more significant the fact that the witness BEAM turned out not to remember anything about the day he was allegedly assaulted by the defendant, and that when finally produced be admitted that he was "supposed to have been beat up", for "why would I be here", R.T. 22, and the fact that Witness HESS was no longer employed in his capacity as security guardandwas protected from having to reveal to the defense his present employ-ment.

In the prosecution's case as to every element of the offense, that two other defendants are charged in the complaint, but they had not been served nor were they present (R.T. 2-3).

The witness HESS was quick to impute motives and intend to the defendant without any evidence therefor, and he demonstrated great bias in his testimony. But clearly defendant could have had any number of reasons, including the need to rest herself, while she waited patiently for the police - making no attempt whatsoever to leave the scene - (R. T. 36). Thus his credibility and bias was the critical lissue for the magistrate, in the absence of any other evidence that an offense had been committed at all, or that the defendant had anything to do with it. This case, is, in pertinent respect, analagous to that of Priestly v. Superior Court, 50 Cal. 2d 812 (1959) where writ of prohibition was granted when the only incriminating evidence was based on informer's testimony and defendant has and credibility effectively denied defendant her substantive right to cross-examine the only witness with incriminating evidence.

Witness ANN GOFORTH saw 3-4

Wilness ANN GOFORTH saw 3-4 girls, unidentified, and undistingishable from each other to her view, with one hitting a man with a 2" X 4" / At the time she observed this, the male had a belt in his hand.

Wilness HESS saw the defendant with ber hand on a 2" X 4", one end of it on the ground; and at the time he observed the incident, another girl had the belt (R T 24, Clearly he cam -upon the scene at a different time than did Miss GOFORTH. Neither witness knew whether or not this man had attacked the girls first, (R.T. 12) although HESS told the police at the time that this man was drunk and disorderly. This is clearly insufficient evidence to hold the defendant to answer for assaut, either on the theory that she threatened the victim with the 2" X4" (which she was never seen using or brandishing) or on the theory that she actually hit the victim with force likely to produce serious bodily injury, for there is no evidence she touched the victim at all.

There is finally the question of whether the man produced in court

at all.

There is finally the question of whether the man produced in courl was really the victim, or if he was present, whether he had no seriously assaulted the girls, whethe he had received the rather minor injuries described by witness HESS during his assault on the girls or at a prior time.

D. THE NAME OF THE PARTY ALLEGED TO HAVE BEEN ASSAULTED IS A MATERIAL ELEMENT OF THE OFFENSE, DEFENDANT IS REQUIRED TO PREPARE A DEFENSE AGAINST CRIMES CHARGED IN THE COMPLAINT AND NO OTHER.

The defendant has been illegally committed and must, therefore, be discharged on the ground that the party named to have been assaulted in the complaint, DONALD M. DEAN, is at variance with the witness presented by the prosection, a DONALD MILLER BEAM, This variance is fatal in Peo, v. Christian, 101 Cal, 471, 473 (1894), the court held that "The name of the party assaulted is a material element of the offense, and common justice." The defendant has been illegally

aulte of is a material element of the offense, and common justice to the defendant demands that he be notified of the particular offense of which he stands committed". The defendant in Christian was charged in the compilaint with assault upon the person of one George Mugin. The District Attorney filed an information charging defendant with assault upon George Massino. The Supreme Court held that in framing of the information the prosecution is restricted to the charges of the complaint; and additions from outside sources were not authorized.

charges of the complaint; and additions from outside sources were not authorized.

The defendant in preparation for a preliminary examination must be informed as to all charges against him. He is required to defend himself only against those crimes charged. Nor can he be required to have prepared a defense for other crimes which he has not been heretofore charged. 101 Cal. at 476 and see also Peo. v. Howard, III Cal. 655, 699-61, (1896). Defendant SAULS herein is charged in the complaint and the information with an assault on DONALD DEAN, but was presented at the preliminary examination with a man by the name of BEAM. The latter was identified, not by himself, but by a witness, as having been a participant in a fight (R T 34). Defendant has not been notified of the particular offense which she is charged, and if the District Attorney seeks to change the information there will be a substantial alteration of the complaint the right to fair notice. Defendant and conducted substantial investigation and ascertained that a DON ALD DEAN has been listed as the complainant by the police, although he did not sign a complaint against defendant(or against anyone else), and that he had given the police an incorrect address.

The Person-identifieds DONALD BEAM at the preliminary examination appeared to be under the psychological control of the District Attorney, and not to know what he was doing at the hearing, except that be was "supposed" to have been at the scene of the alleged offense, even if DONALD BEAM were the person purported to be identified in the complaint, the variance is fatal because the individual named did not reside at the address listed on the police report and could not, despite due diligence, be found or interviewed by defendant's investigator prior to his production at the continued preliminary hearing.

E. THERE WAS NO EVIDENCE THAT THE DEFENDANT IN-TENDED OR ATTEMPTED AN ASSAULT



CONCLUSION
The magistrate denied the defendant due process of law by erroneously granting a continuance involation of the statute; prejudically limiting cross-examination. There is a fatal variance between the alleged victim charged and the alleged victim charged and the alleged victim produced at the hearing - at which time even this alleged victim denied having been assaulted. No one saw the defendant hit anyone, use any force, or threaten anyone with a deadly weapon. The information should be dismissed.

TRIAL OF BARRY FARMER, JAMES CHERRY & CLYDE BURTON

On February 20th, 1970 the pigs of the atlantic city police force attempted to railroad three of the people's warriors in a racist court.

We arrived in court at about 9:15 after serving the children of our community their free breakfast before school, as we sat in the court-room, we saw one person after another being railroaded through the halls of injustice, it was plain to see that the courtroom was really a mockery of justice.

Clyde Burton, James Cherry, and Egarry Farmer were arressed on the fabricated charge of creating disorder in a public building when Clyde's brother, Eric Burton, was arrested, beaten, and kidnapped off the streets. They saved the case until almost everyone else hadgone. This showed that they had every intention of railroading the brothers. But about 50 beautiful brothers and sisters stayed to support them and show how determined they were to see Clyde, James, and Barry free.

The case started with one pig's story which was contradictory to a second pig's story; the pigs were worried and confused. So they called a time out, to get their lies together. But it was too late, because the people saw the contradictions and were determined to see justice done.

Even after the pigs were clearly proven to be liars, Judge (Pig) Perone charged Clyde Burton, James Cherry, and Barry Farmer with "'defacing public property", because they had written ALL POWER TO THE PEOPLE on the jail cells. Contradictions rose and the people were getting mad and let the pigs know that they were wrong. Reinforcements were brought in and pretty soon the court was half filled with pigs.

The whole thing was a beautiful splitical education class and clearity pointed out the contradictions between justice and injustice. When shobby Seale layed down that right educations example he showed clearly that there will be no justice for Black people in the fascist courts of Babylon, as long as this oppressive system of capitalism and ragism continues to stand...

What We Want What We Believe



Huey P. Newton Minister of Defense Black Panther Party

 We want freedom. We want power to determine the destiny of our Black-Community.

We believe that black people will not be free until we are able to determine our destiny.

2. We want full employment for our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white American businessmen will not give full employment, then the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living.

3. We want an end to the robbery by the CAPITALIST of our Black

We believe that this racist government has robbed us and now we are demanding the overdue debt of forty acres and two mules. Forty acres and two mules was promised 100 years ago as restitution for slave labor and mass murder of black people. We will accept the payment in currency which will be distributed to our many communities. The Germans are now aiding the Jews in Israel for the genocide of the Jewish people. The Germans murdered six million Jews. The American racist has taken part in the slaughter of over fifty million black people; therefore, we feel that this is a modest demand that we make.

4. We want decent housing. fit for shelter of human beings.

We believe that if the white landlords will not give decent housing to our black community, then the housing and the land should be made into cooperatives so that our community, with government aid, can build and make decent housing for its people.

We want education for our people that exposes the true nature of this decadent American society. We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present-day society.

We believe in an educational system that will give to our people a knowledge of self. If a man does not have knowledge of himself and his position in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

6. We want all black men to be exempt from military service.

We believe that Black people, should not be forced to fight in the military service to defend a racist government that does not protect us. We will not fight and kill other people of color in the world who, like black people, are being victimized by the white racist government of America. We will protect ourselves from the force and violence of the racist police and the racist military, by whatever means necessary.

We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY and MURDER of black people.

We believe we can end police brutality in our black community by organizing black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all black people should arm themselves for self-defense.

8. We want freedom for all black men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails.

We believe that all black people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

9. We want all black people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peer group or people from their black communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that black people will receive fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a man'n right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the black community from which the black defendant came. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man" of the black community.

10. We want land, bread, housing, education, clothing, justice and peace. And as our major political objective, a United Nations-supervised pleblacite to be held throughout the black colony in which only black colonial subjects will be allowed to participate, for the purpose of determining the will of black people as to their national destiny.

When, in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume, among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal;

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the people to after or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes: and, accordingly, all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But, when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same object, evinces a design to reduce them under absolute despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new guards for their future security.
