

## PIGS MANUFVER

On the night of April 2nd, Thursday night, the local gestapo forces of San Francisco, showed openly the training programs that they are now going through in preparation. for the completion of the National conspiracy to wipe out the ranks of the Vanguard Party. The pigs had our office at 1336 Fillmore sucrounded with patrol cars and fire trucks, also with an estimated 10 to 13 man foot patrols. The pigs stood directly in front of our office pointing at our door and roof.

When the Panthers Inside of our office saw what was taking place. they started calling the other Community Centers and houses. After a while, the pigs cut off the phones so we would be unable to communicate. These operations lasted for some two hours (from approximately 4-6 a,m.). We are very well aware a what the pigs' intentions are. The point of the pigs going through these maneuvers is to show and intimidate the people away from thinking that they can be beat or driven from our communities. Before our office in L.A. was attacked, for several weeks the pigs ran maneuvers around the office. We know that because we are working even harder now than the last time our office was attacked almost one year ago on April 28, 1969, that this has forced the pigs to make ready for another battle with us -- this time to wipe us out. But our effort for survival has made us develop skills that will enable each one of us to be a match for 100 enemy troops. We know that the only reason for patrolling the streets in such large numbers is to try to intimidate the people, to make us think of them as 'supermen'.

Historically the use of foot patrols is the sign of the coming of the sealing of the ghetto and making it into the concentration camp.

In accordance with the German fascists, which the pig of America have well exceeded in their fascist acts, they are starting to commit acts of sabotage and making it look like the acts of the revolutionary forces. We should look at these acts very closely and see if they are revolutionary or reactionary. Only gangsters under the influence of pigs like Alioto would set fires where there is a chance of little babies asleep--being burnedup; No true revolutionary would attack the symbols of fascism instead of the true fascists like Alloto and his bedmate, 'Big Red (Richard Youle) a member of the tac squad who has been running throughout the streets of the Black community killing and beating people everyday. All these deceiving acts are done to set the stage for the pigs to legitimize the planned genocide on Black people in general and the Black Panther Party in particular. The most profound example the pigs plan on setting in the history of Black people's fight for liberation is killing our Chairman, Bobby Seale, in the electric chair. But we have news for you. Before we stand by and let you kill Bobby we will cut out all the electricity in Bahylo... And we will destroy any obstacle that stands in our way so that means that if you are not fighting also then you are in the way - you are either a pig feeder or a pig killer. We bear in mind that if we lose one man in wiping out 100 enemy troops, this is no victory for us, because the life of each guerrilla is much more precious than 1000 enemy troops since he has been seasoned in the guerrilla struggle for many years and prepared politically for years and prepared politically and militarily. ## FOUR PIGS WERE OFFED THIS WEEK... A VICTORY FOR THE PEOPLE

Four pigs were offed this past week ... a victory for the people, a tactical example -- moves of oppressed people for their ultimate attainment of liberation. It would be a great event if we could attribute this act to some brother who righteously got down and went out to deal with the oppressor's troops in he community, this however, is not the

These four pigs were killed by two men trying to escape capure for another crime they had supposedly already committed; their reasoning was not to deal with the oppressor or the symbols of his 'presence' - it was a matter of survival. When I say survival, I'm not relating to the survival of a race or group of people as is the concern of revolutionaries, but I am referring in this case to individual survival.

What then is the reason for even dealing with the deaths of these four pigs since it cannot be labeled 'revolutionary' or as having been done in the 'service of the people' .... the reason is simple enough. The deaths of these four pigs and especially their dying in this manner should point out the fallacy of the 'superman' image of the pigs and the plausibility of dealing with them in such a manner in the interest of the masses and the liberation of the oppressed people of Babylon.

The pigs have always tried to maintain an image of being 'indestructable," In the past whenever there were shootouts or confrontations between the pigs and the people, there was never any pig killed, one never died even in the face of such over-whelming evidence that no one could have lived, The pigs have lived through the Watts

rebellion where Niggers ruled the streets for days; the pigs further say that they suffered very few casualities in the midst of the sniper fire in Detroit. In very altercation between pigs and the people, the pigs have always maintained that they held the upper-hand or control of the situation throughout the 'distarbance.'

There are brothers and sisters who have been involved in these so-called "disturbances", and they can testify that in many cases it would have been impossible for the pigs to have come out with so few casualities and/or deaths. This whole myth of indestructibility has been perpetuated to make the pigs look unbeatable, to discourage the people from righteously dealing with these scurvy punks as the snakes and cowards that they are. This superman image has been maintained at all costs but the image is slipping; as the people prepare to deal with their enemies, the 'supermen in blue' seem to be losing their ability to soar through the air.

There are four dead pigs, killed by two men with guns...the pigs can and will die but not from a wish and a pray. 

## THE NIGHT RIDERS ATTACK BLACK BROTHER









REGGIE: Could you state the policeman's names who was the one identified as the one who did the actual killing?

MRS. BROWN: Evans, you want his full name?

REGGIE: Could you repeat those names of the officers that did the actual killing?

MRS. BROWN Brinkley Evans.

REGGIE Who was the other officer with him?

BROWN: Thomas Lyons.

REG: Could you tell me how many times your son was shot and how badly he was beaten?

BROWN Well I can only tell you, it was stated that he was shot twice but it was told that the undertaker stated that there were two more unexplained cuts on his body. So we don't know whether he was shot four times or not. And that's what we're waiting for the coroners report. He says twice, but on the first statements was given that he was shot in the leg while running. But then the coroners reported that he was shot seven inches below the knee from the front. The boy that was driving the car stated that if he ran (he jumped out of the car and ran), he said that Harold got out of the car with his hands up raised, and he looked back and he said he was standing with his hands up and he kept running. He said he heard a shot, he turned around and saw Harold on the ground. The he said he ran, and kept running. It was also stated that the lady across the street at 128, Miss Thomas, told us that when she got to the window she saw Harold trying to run up the street with a slight limp like something was wrong with his leg. She said that there was another shot and at this time he fell. It wheeled him around, he grabbed the back of his leg, and he was coming up on his elbow and knee when the policeman took aim and shot him in the chest. Now that's the statement that we

The distance from the accident and the distance from where he was shot is too short a distance to run, pull a knife, turn around and lunge. Because it's within two car lengths - they showed us. So a lot of them probably think that we aren't doing anything, but that's not true. I was just waiting for a report, I have a letter from the Commissioner for 2 weeks stating that have a report ready shortly after I sent him a certified special delivery letter asking for a report on the case in detail and he said that I would hear from Inspector Golden shortly. The next day I received a telephone call from a Lt, Mattews telling me that the report was not in complete, but that they should have something within two weeks and I would hear something from them.

That Sunday, the Inquirer brought that statement from Rizzo. Now this was on a Thursday that I was speaking to Lt. that they wouldn't have anything for two weeks. Two weeks was up Thursday past, I haven't received any word and yet he keeps making statements to the newspaper, but he hasn't even given us the courtesy of anything. Cause they didn't even come out an notify us that he was even shot or dead. The hospital called, you know that already. So there's a lot of unexplained things about it, we didn't even know that his nose was broken.

REG: His nose was broken?

BROWN: His nose was broken. That's the Coroner's report. His nose was broken We do know that he had at least a 3 inch gash on his head. The undertaker said that the impression looked like either the butt of a gun or a blackjack. The wound is unexplained and he might have received it in the car accident, which I can't see how that can be possible if the boy in the front seat didn't get any kind of injury, how's someone in the back seat gonna get a broken nose and gash over the forehead, plus bruises. His face was bruised so bad that the undertaker had to darken his complexion to try to hide the bruises and you still could see it. He had a cut on his lip and the flesh was blown away so badly on his leg that they had to make a cardboard...

we didn't receive his eye-glasses back. Out of his personal effects, we only received his wallet, four quarters, (which I can't say how much money he really had on him), and four identification cards and a Miraculous Medal which he wore around his neck. But he wore gold-rimmed glasses...you know, the Bill Cosby fashion. We didn't even receive those and I didn't even expect to get the clothes back until after this investigation. But then I understand that the coat that the cops have is not the coat that he left home with. It was stated that he has a pea type jacket. He left home wearing a full length black cashmere, and I bought that for him and I have proof. I can get proof that I bought the coat. He never owned a pea type jacket so I can't understand how this come about. I don't know about the other clothing, I don't know what kind of clothing they have otherwise.

REG: When we came up, we noticed that this thing at the door that said Cardinal Doughtery. Is that the school that he went to

BROWN: Yeah, he attended Cardinal Doughtery up until he started Germantown in September. We took him out of Catholic school because of the rising costs and we had two boys in there too and with the baby coming along. But he went to Cardinal Dougherty. He was fourth trumpet in the band and the lowest mark he got in conduct, I have his report card I could show you, was 85 and the only thing he ever had to bring it down like that was if you were late to school and had a detention, they took marks off of that and if your tie wasn't correctly pulled up they took off for that. And that was the extent of his punishment. We never had any trouble with him, conduct wise, at all, he was exceptionally quiet.

REG: Well in other words you're saying that he wouldn't be the type of person that would throw an 8-inch (Right! Mrs. Brown) knife at an officer with a .357 magnum on his hip.

BROWN: Because it would be foolish for someone to be shooting at you and you go and turn around and throw a knife at someone with a gun! You're gonna keep running if you got an opportunity to run. Which I don't believe he had the opportunity to run from someone. And then with the amount of drinks coroner stated. You jump out - run and you still got your recollections? That's a lot of unanswered questions.

REG: Well, do you have any faith in the police, really bringing these policemen to justice?

BROWN: Well, I'll say this. I have the faith in the D.A.'s office.

REG: Do you think that Spector will prosecute those police officers to the full extent of the law?

BROWN: Well, (pause) I hope so and I feel that he will. Presented with the right evidence he will.

REG: Well, I just want to ask this. It's a hypothetical question, if the D.A.'s office don't come up with the type of verdict that the people's so consciously aware that's needed to be brought about and that's first degree murder - would you be willing to deal in what we call the People's court where we can present the facts to the people in the street, the people in the community, and that the people can determine the innocence or the guilt of these police officers and would you support their verdict that the community turns back?

BROWN: Do you mean, in other words, the witnesses or the people who...are you speaking about witnesses?

REG: Right, we're speaking about facts,

BROWN: Oh, of course, the facts, yes. Definitely... if it has to go as far as it can, as far as it can go, to a hight court and in order to get the truth because I'm really not pleased at the idea that they not only after his death, just make him seem as if he were a hood - that was number one. Next, if you have a knife, in other words say he's violent.

REG: Mrs. Brown, since this incident has the D A.'s office contacted you and told you that the police officers were no longer working on the force? Were they suspended or do you have any kind of knowledge that they're still on the force or not?

BROWN: No, the D.A's office did not state that they were suspended, but so far in the papers, that they were not. But the D.A.'s did not have any knowledge of that because I met with him on Thursday to give them information and what they wanted and far as we know, they're still on the payroll.

REG: and the D.A.'s office is conducting this investigation with them still patrolling the streets?

BROWN: Well, I don't know if they're still patrolling the streets but they're conducting an investigation now. I understand that its customary to pull them off the street and put them in office duties while there's an investigation. Now, I don't know how long that goes I don't know but then it was also stated by different persons, I don't know if its true or not, that when an officer's involved in anything that's not cleared up immediately, he's automatically suspended, especially in a case of murder. I believe that if he shot him once in theleg, that he wouldn't have attempted to run unless he made a statement "Nigger run. I'm gonna kill you anyway." So what, what do you have to lose? Now, that's the only way or reason that I would believe that he would have ran because I don't believe he would have.

REG: And you did state that the coroner said that your son was shot in the leg from the front...

BROWN: From the front! Seven inches below the knee!

REG: In other words, the police officer's saying that after he shot him in the front that your son turned around and ran...

BROWN: And lunged at him and threw a knife. Yes, and he shot him But, this I can't see. This doesn't even make sense, does it?

REG: No, it doesn't.

REG: Would you restate what the lady said when your son was laying on the ground?

# WE WILL NOT ALLOW OUR CHAIRMAN TO DIE IN THE ELECTRIC CHAIR

The ultimate in the ascending tide of fascism is the murder of the politically opposite forces.

The Nixon-Agnew-Mitchell regime has planned to murder Chairman Bobby Seale in the electric chair. This preplanned murder is an overt attempt of genocide against Glack communities. We will not sit by and let these racists make public sacrifices of our leaders. These fascists are making an example of Bobby Seale because of his political beliefs. This sacrifice is to serve as an example to all who voice opposition toward this racist government.

There have been 28 Party mem-

bers murdered since the Party was formed, 3 years ago. These systematic attacks upon Party members add to the death of over 50 thousand Black people in America. Black people are in the strategic position here in this country to deliver a poitical consequence, a political consequence that would be destructive to the racist capitalist class, Huey P. Newton said the slavery of Blacks in this country provides the oilfor the machinery of war that America uses to enslave the people's of the world. Without this oil the machinery cannot function. We are the driving shaft, Black people can destroy the machinery that's enslaving the world. America cannot stand to fight every country of color in the world and fight a civil war at the same time. The Black Panther Party teaches that society is divided into classes. but we will not take class to the point where it would be suicidal for Black people, We are drawing closer lines of demarcation as to who our real friends are. Those White people who call themselves our friends will be tested by their social practice. Those Whites who wish to carry on a class struggle with us will have to start making committments, committments to the destruction of this decadent system. These lascists have instituted more repressive measures to separate the Black Panther Party from the masses, In the Black Panther Party we have been forced to intensify the struggle for our survival and the survival of Black people, Those Whites who wish to continue in carrying on the struggle on a class level must also move to a highe level to secure the dignity of the oppressed people. When our leaders are assssinated or incarcerated, those Whites who want to become revolutionaries must take to the streets the same as Black and oppressed peoples to oppose this overt aggression, because if we allow our Chairman to go to the electric chair the pattern will be set for the execution of other persons whose political beliefs are contrary to the capitalist class.





We have had our rights trampled on in the past and now the pigsare trying to do it again. The latest plan by devilish assasin Hogan and 'justice' Murtaugh (the puppets of this White racist government), was hatched by telling us that there will be no more court until we sign a statement -- a death warrant--saying we will be quiet in court. But how can we be quiet when pigs are constantly oinking in our faces about some justice that never existed? The only way we can get a fair trial is if the people give it to us, and this can only happen if the people are educated through our actions. The pigs are looking for a quiet hanging and we will have no part of it

We didn't sign the statement because we knew we were right. We knew that when Murtaugh started making that noise about the American system of justice, the people would see that there are two systems of justice--one White and one Black. We knew that they would check out Dred Scott, the Black codes, the fugitive slave laws, the McCarran Act and see that there is only an American system of

He is going to:

1) Continue to demand a written statement, but the words will be hooked up so as to make the people believe he doesn't want us to do anything but only wants a speedy trial, (All we've been saying for a year is that we want a fair and speedy trial without any violations of our constitutional rights)

2) He is going to try and force us to trial by infering that we waive our constitutional rights by refusing to go to trial. (This would push Hogan into making a motion for a continuance of

trial). If we made noise during the kangaroo proceedings, they would drop the fixed statement on us, hold us in contempt and try us on the 12th floor while our lawyers, the judge, the jury, and the people are on the thirteenth floor. But we say asour Minister of Information, Eldridge Cleaver said, "We will obtain our liberation by any means necessary---and we don't mean bootlicking". Right On! 

There were three brothers driving up Orizaba Ave. and they were stopped by these punks, and given a ticket, and were The spirit of revolution is here; made to listen to one mealymouthed pig oink for five minutes. Then they were told that they could leave. Before they could get to the corner, they were stopped again and given another ticket. Then they were told that they could leave again. So the brother driving turned the corner and went down Farrallones Street. By the time he got to Farrallones and Plymouth Streets, two pig cars blocked them off and jumped out of their cars with their hands on their guns and flashed their flashlights all through the car and then told all three of the brothers who were in the car to get out. As soon as as the brothers got out of the car, the pigs immediately handcuffed them and put them in the pig's car. By this time approximately pigs on motorcycles had circled the car that these brothers were in and the people were checking out the actions of the pigs. The pigs claimed that the car might be a stolen car and the brother who was driving the car had informed them that the car belonged to his mother who lived only a few blocks away, but the pigs didn't investigate or even make any attempts to contact the brothers' mother. CHAPTER X

#### CONCLUSION

Once the ghetto is sealed off and, depending upon the violence being perpetrated by the guercillas, the following actions could be taken by the authorities:

(I) A curfew would be imposed in the enclosed isolated area. No one would be allowed out of or into the area after sundown.

(2) During the night the authorities would not only patrol the boundary lines but would also attempt to control the streets and if necessary, send out foot patrols through the entire area, If the guerrillas attempted to either break out of the area or to engage the authorities in open combat they would be readily suppressed.

(3) During a guerrilla uprising most civil liberties would have to he suspended, search and seizure operations would be instituted during the daylight hours, and anyone found armed or without proper identification would immediately be arrested. Most of the people of the ghetto would not be involved in the guerrilla operation and under conditions of police and military control, some would help in ferreting out the guerrillas. Their help would be invaluable.

(4) If the guerrillas were able to hold out for a period of time then the population of the ghetto would be classified through an officer for the "control and organization of the inhabitants." This officer would distribute census cards which would bear a photograph of the individual, the letter of the district in which he lives, his house and street number, and a letter designating his home city. This classification would aid the authorities in knowing the exact location of any suspect and

## BLACK PEOPLE EVERYWHERE-NO CENSUS

The first census for the United States was taken in the year 1790. classifications were: "slaves" and "FREE MEN." "Free Men" meant "WHITE" The census counted the free White males and females, and most important, the free White males over or under 16 years of age (to determine eligibility for racist leadership). There was very little problem in counting niggers because niggers were slaves and the racist slave-owners counted niggers just like they counted their cattle.

For one-hundred years the classification on the census remained as "SLAVES" and "FREE WHITE MEN". The American Civil War (1861-1865) which supposedly meant the abolition (end) of slavery made very little difference to the way Black people were boxed-up and looked upon by the Federal census. Up until 1970 they have changed the classification of Black people by name only, as if we are fooled by the choice of NEGRO or BLACK as a selection on the census is merely an exemplification of racist attitudes by census makers and of our Black communities. takers.

## RESPECT FOR LAW

Bobby Seale, Chairman of the Black Panther Party, has set a new stage in legal defense activities. In the early days of the trial of the CHICAGO EIGHT he gave proof to all concerned that those in charge of what is called "due process of law" would have no easy time railroading him to prison. He had no intention of being, in any manner, shape or form, party to the government's conspiracyto continue to use the courts as a weapon with and through which to violate the constitutional rights of Americans regardless of creed or color or more particularly to fortify and consolidate its cold-blooded racist policies.

Bobby Seale was determined to take the offensive in the court. He had done nothing save demand his citizenship rights. Now his liberty was at stake. The constitutional rights of the American people to freedom of speech and assembly were in jeopardy. The court in which he sat was arena of fierce struggle, a battleground in the fight for democracy and against racism. Although the atmosphere was controlled by his persecutors Bobby was determined that the people's enemies were not going to dictate the course or character of struggle, His counsel, Charles

Garry of San Francisco, was ill. Bobby was determined to defend himself. He knew that leading military strategists have always held the best defense to be an offensive.

Most legal trials in which a Black man are involved are war. The name is changed. So are the tactics. But the best defense remains an offensive. All of which opens up the question of "respect for the law".

The court as an arena of war is most often chosen by the racist enemies of Blacks and labor because having more or less satisfactorily cloaked it with an air of sanctity and impartiality they have wards to labor and to those Whites thus concealed its class character. They have made of it an excellent institution in which to victimize those who would defend the people's dignity, rights, immunities and constitutional guarantees.

The Chicago Judge held Bobby in contempt of court. For vigorously fighting for his and the "inalienable rights of the people this Black man was sentensed to four years in prison. He is now a political prismer, a prisoner of a racist war. His very life is menaced, A conspiracy is afoot to try him in Connecticut for murder,

Battle flags of the racists fly in every courtroom, Across them is written: Down with the defenders

of human dignity and constitutional liberties. The lives of the intended victims can be saved. But only by people mobilized for struggle in the courts, in the streets and in the shops, mines and mills. Those who rely on the courts do not fully recognize their role.

High sounding words are dally mouthed about the sanctity of the law even while the President prepares to place another racist upon the Supreme Court. They are for the greater part addressed to the victims of the government's racist policies: to the Blacks, and afterwho are beginning to understand that an acceptance of the myths of racism leads to political and cultural victimization and early death,

Respect for the law is demanded by the court trying the Black Panthers in New York charged with bombing or conspiring to bomb public buildings and monuments. Their crime; a demand for respect for their rights as American citizens and human beings. That demand is ignored. The countering demand is RESPECT FOR THE LAW while the trial court prepares the conspiracy against them. The same situation holds true as conspiracies against the Black Panthers are launched from Coast to William L. Patterson

Coast, Respect the Law: What law? Was it disrespect for law that caused Bobby Seale to challenge and defy a court that violated his constitutional rights?

How can the Black man, woman or child have respect for law or a system that has no respect for him or her? Of course the questions do not stop there. How can a White worker, male or female, have respect for law or a system of laws that has no respect for the working class? For Black and White en masse there can only be a vowrelentlessly to fight laws geared to destroy their ability to protect their own rights, the integrity of the State and the moral stamina of the

Respect for law begins where the law has respect for the people and their rights. To an ever greater degree the law will be used as a weapon against the developing National Liberation Movement, When the law is used as a major weapon against racism and bigotry there will be no lack of respect for it. Black America will not allow itself to be treated as outside the pale of what has been defined as law and order. If such continues to be the case it must, in the interests of national unity and self-protection, be a law unto itself.

## SAVE THE ILLINOIS

Robert Bruce, Nathaniel Junior, William O'Nell, and Billy 'Che' Brooks are part of that 'notorious group of criminals', the Illinois Panther 16 gangsterlike, these persons conspired to kidnap, kidnapped, assaulted, attempted to murder, attempted to rob, robbed. etc., etc., -- all done in one night to one person, a Black woman."

If you thrilled at every word oggled from the mouth of Agnew, and hum at the sounds that shout from the Black community, and sigh with satisfaction at Amerpolicy, domestic and foreign, then you accept the preceeding paragraph. But if you realize America 'is paving the chaos in world history then you know the preceeding is absurd. Yes, it is absurdity. But this is one absurd ity that cannot-be chuckled off. No. there can be no laughing for a Black woman, herself oppressed, paid by the police to lie that crimes were committed against her in order to further the oppression of the Party. Nor can there be any laughing when we consider that one of the Illinois 16, Nathanial Jr., peers from behind bars in lieu of one million dollars bond -- the cost of his life.

And we most certainly feel an overwhelming anger when we realize that Fred Hampton, himself, of the Illinois 16 was murdered



#### JOHN McGRATH INTERVIEWS

#### ELDRIDGE CLEAVER

Minister of Information, Black Panther Party

Algiers, Algeria-February 1970



JOHN: We really don't want to interview you as a personality -but just to set the scene, how would you describe your present situation?

ELDRUCE: People when they start talking about my present situation, they start with the word 'exile', you know. I don't like to use that term myself because it is static. We are in the process of establishing here an information centre: to deal with the struggle on an international level, make contacts, find out who our allies are, locate anarres of mutual support, it's a way of

continuing to work, I never would have left the United States if the decision hadn't been made for me. We were not prepared to deal with an insecure underground thing at that time. So while we're working on that, this is a way of biding time until we can return,

IOHN: What would you say the Black Panther Party's main successes were, so far?

ELDRIDGE: I think that the main success and the most important success has been in heightening the political consciousness of a lot of people. Once people are aware of a situation I dog't think the government could ever really change their minds back to where they were before. Also dispelling the alienation that existed between Black Revolutionaries and White Revolutionaries of the United States. At the time that the Party was started, there was like a big gulf that was sort of a beritage of the work of SNCC and Black Power and Stokely Carmichael.

JOHN: So in a way, you have created an awareness of the simurion, a political consciousness among American Black people and you have aligned or made some form of coalition with the Peace and Freedom Movement and other White movements. But so far as I can see, you haven't issued any call to the American Working Class as such. What is your opinion of the political role of the American Working class?

ELDRIDGE: You see our Party is drawn largely from the lumpen proletariat, We are members of the working class, but we have to make a distinction between the employed and the unemployed. There are large numbers of unemployed people in the United In the first place the American people are very corrupt, very deeply imbued with the whole greedy dog eat dog philosophy of individualism, and they don't give a damn about other people or each other, and as long as the government is able to provide enough jobs, as long as they're able to prop up the economy by manufacturing war materials, as long as they're able to keep a cheque coming to these people, it is almost impossible to do snything with them, We understand the described analysis that makes the working class key to the revolutionary process, but we also recognise the realities of thatsituation -the important thing now is to organise those who are objectively organisable and after that we can begin to crack that hard ace, Right now I feel, and it is the feeling of the Party, that we must make an approach to the working class as a category, but we feel that they're not about ready to come in.

JOHN: So that when you speak of "domestic imperialism" and "The Black Colony" and "liberating the colony," are you talking outside the Marxist framework of class struggle?

BLDRIDGE: 1 think it's strictly compatible wth the Marxist analysis except that we are in a situation where we have to apply these universal principles to our specific situation in a way that has never been done before. To just take the dry marxist analysis as it exists, is not functional for us. This has been the diabolical failure of the American Communist Party. They refuse to deal with the reality of the situation -they just talk about the working class, and Black people are members of the working class, and that's it. They don't confront the ethnic problem that exists, in the United States, the class struggle is hidden by the ethnic struggle, and the way that the people are manipulated by the government, by the ruling class, makes the ethnic struggle primary, They keep the ethnical contradictions very sharp manipulating racism and the whole history of racism, which is why the struggle of Black people in the United States has come to be looked upon as a race struggle as opposed to a class struggle. We rederstand that the class struggle is the key, but you cannot neglect the ethnic factor, if you do, you meet with disaster.

JOHN: On a question of timing, would you say that liberating the colony had to come before the revolution in America?

ELDRIDGE: No we think that they must be done at the same time. The key dynamic that gave rise to the developing Movement among Whites in the United States was started off as a support operation against the war in Vietnam and support for Black people struggling for their rights. If the struggle for Black people didn't exist, the present anti-war movement wouldn't be there. The two things are inter-related and they must go on at the same time; there's no question about that, I mean you cannot call a moratorium on one and say, well let's deal with the othe one first, We say that they must both work together, must have machinery to deal with both of them at the same time,

JOHN: The demands of the Panther Party are not particularly Socialist, In some ways they seen to accept the pattern of Society and demand more justice with that pattern, rather than overthrowing it, is this so?

ELDRIDGE: We often are confronted with this question, -many times as a criticism, but you must understand the situation that exists inside the United States and the people who drew up the programme, They understood the society from a Marxist point of view. The programme, if you notice, is drawn up on an either/or principle, it says either you will do this, or we will do this and behind that is the understanding that it's impossible for the government to deliver those demands, But in terms of relating to the people, the demands are very clear and they're very just and they speak to the grievances of the people, Now when the people see these just demands put forward and then they see the government unable or unwilling to meet these demands, then it becomes very reasonable to them to start dealing with the alternatives, We always go beyond the Ten Points, They are a working device that we can use to approach the people, and it's proving very effective, in spite of the criticisms that a lot of intellectuals make of it.

JOHN: I notice that in one of the latest issues of the Black Panther Paper, you did a breakdown of a strike in General Electric which gave a very good analysis of how the power structure worked in a specific case,

ELDRIDGE: This is because there have been some successes in approaching the working class over the last couple of years —we have got some Party members and some allies who are members of the labour unions and who devote all their time to trying to relate to workers. We have a wide readership among the working class, and by running these analysis we can help them make some ideological inroad. You can say definitely that this process will continue.

JOHN: When you talk about a united front against fascism you have identified America as a Fascist country, how do you think it compares with Nazi Germany?

ELDRIDGE: I think that in terms of the effects it's having on the world, it's far worse than Nazi Germany, Many people have come to identify fascism only when they see swastikas, you know, or something related to Mussolini, We think that the form of oppression and the totality of the oppression that is involved in the United States in enough, along with the economics that are involved, to identify America as fascism, Through some very devious mechanisms, of holding companies and interlocking directorates and so forth, the economy is centralised in the hands of very few people and very few corporations at the top, it has an apparent facade of competition and free enterprise, but it's not free enterprise, it hasn't been for quite a while; if it ever was, It's definitely a highly centralised mechanism that only gives the appearance of being decentralised.

JOHN: According to some Black Panther statements, America needs now a North American Liberation Front, Traditionally liberation fronts fight protracted wars: What would you say was your strategy for carrying out the war?

ELDRIDGE: You see, usually people speak about liberation fronts when they're dealing with a Colonialist regime, in the US the primary struggle is a revolutionary struggle, but at the same time we have to deal with specific conditions of oppression of Black people, Black people were taken to the United States as part of the process of the expansion of European politics into the rest of the world. So many of the forms of oppression that were developed in that process were developed and inflicted upon Black people inside the United States, Not all. We don't have the classical form of colony, but many of the forms are there, We have to apply the analysis of Imperialism and Colonialism where the Black community is controlled from the White community. But the large thing is that it has to be a revolution that will be won through a process of war, We don't think we're going to be able to vote the capitalist economy out of existence, and we don't think we're going to be able to vote the ruling class out of existence, We think that people are going to have to organise and take up arms and fight a war to overthrow the system. We talk about the North American Liberation Front, I prefer the term The New World Liberation Front,

What is happening now is that small groups of people are arming themselves and they're beginning to carry out activities against the system. I think that that process will increase and out of it, just as in other countries, a people's army will develop. This is what we constantly try to bring about, in terms of time, who can say how long it will take? I know that I can't. These things have a way of exploding and processes that we think will take ten years telescope into two weeks; so there's a way of speeding up time through action.

JOHN: Do you see it in relation to the economic processes?

ELDRIDGE: Yes, if the economy, because of the international situation, experiences CONTINUED ON PAGE 12

ELDRINGE: Educated people have been the Black masses out, because they were specifically educated in order to perform certain functions for the slave master, and they have performed these functions well. So there is a lot of suspicion and hostility among the Black masses towards the educated people. But in the Party there is a great need for intellectual power to constantly refresh the analysis of our situation. People have to learn to really appreciate and dig a cat that functions in that manner, and we've got over some of these suspicions simply because we've got good benefits out of some of the work being done by so-called intellectuals.

We find that the pigs have been very helpful in this regard, because you find that the people that they have been murdering have the brains, like Malcolm X, even Martin Luther King, Fred Hampton was a very intelligent man. The disaster that has happened to certain brains of the Party have made people understand that the pigs were doing this because they were trying to hurt us in turning out the lights. People have an appreciation for talent, We know that we need it.

JOHN: Do you think the effects on the individual of racialism, Imperialism and class exploitation all take place on the same level?

FLDRDGE: In the first place we're talking about a totality that can't really be separated but in terms of pain, certain things are more easily remedied than others. Like you can destroy the basis of economic exploitation, and some of those sufferings can be wiped out, but certain other forms of pain, like the suffering that people do for racism, can warp you phsycologically so that maybe nothing can be done to alleviate that. But at the same time they're inseparable because the racism is just a tactic employed to bolster up the economic exploitation. It's like this, you could have a ball and chain around your ankle you know, but when you examine your body to see where the physical damage is done it's not the big ball but the clasp around your ankle that will leave the mark on you and the big ball might be imperialism and all the economic exploitations and the clasp may be the racism you see, that's the thing that marks you-but its really the ball that's holding you down.

JOHN: How much do you feel the movement can rely on the help of Communist Parties in America or Moscow or China or Cuba?

ELDRIDGE: We don't. Because we find that they are lagging behind our activities. We're inclined to have rather disatrous relations with the Communist Party in the United States.

The reason they have started relating to us is because the people were relating to us, and they were out of it. We consciously barred them from participating in certain of our activities and we even at one point barred them from passing out leaflets in the Black community-Black communists and White communists. We had to come down on them very hard, we had to expose them in our newspaper, write articles attacking them and their activities before they started changing their behaviour. You see some cooperation between the CPA and the Black Panther Party now, but this is something that we've gained through some very bitter conflict. Myself I'm not inclined to be liberal with them or to even forgive and forget, because even though they are functioning in a harmonious way on certain problems, they have an ingrained ideological bias that keeps them lagging behind. As far as I'm concerned, the marxism that they use is not an indigenous marxism, it's something that is unrelated to the problems that exist in the United States. The Movement as a whole, is beginning to relate to Marxism-Leninism in the United States. They haven't structured it, developed Marxist-Leninist traditional type parties, but



two Metropolitan Pigs (police) decided to stop in front of the National Committee to Combat Fascism (NCCF) Community Center, 2327-18th St., N.W., Washington, D.C., to harass members of the Community Center and also community people who were engaging in a conversation about the Free Breakfast Program for Children, The boot-licking nigger pig by the name of E.E. Hemly, badge number 1872, and his White counterpart, K.P. Parkus, badge number 3099, started to harass people from the community center by oinking that he wanted some identification from all of the people that were standing outside. The pig went on to "oink" in the people's faces about how we had no right to talk or give information to the people. He started to tell the people shutup and because he was Black he thought that he was allowed to use the language of the ghetto people

## YOUNG LORDS BARRED FROM G.I.S

Carlos Rodriguez -- Torres, the last of the Ft. Dix 38 to be tried by general court-martial for the June 5th stockade rebellion, was sentenced to four years at hard labor, a bad conduct discharge and loss of pay after being convicted of arson.

On June 5 the prisoners in the Dix stockade rebelled gainst the racism, the brutality and the concentration camp-like over crowding of inmates. Thirty-eight men were given general courtsmartial. Three, including Carlos, were ASU members.

Rodriguez, the only Puerto Rican given a general court-martial,

was obviously the victim of racism. Rodriguez' attorney, Henry di Suvero, termed the sentence 'a result of racism that permeates the military.' He pointed out that two of the three other men, all White, convicted of both arson and riot received 3-year sentences and the third man received no sentence.

The racist nature of the all fascist court-martial board of six highranking officers and the prosecution was clear from the opening of the trial. During the questioning of the potential board members one admitted that while in Korea for a year he could not tell one Korean from another. The prosecution had difficulty throughout the trial keeping the names of Black witnesses straight.

Another officer on the board said that "I would trust the word of an officer over the word of an enlisted man because enlisted men tend to stick to their own kind and lie for one another, whereas

officers are more independant." Carlos became the object of this racist prosecution when he refused a deal offered by CID (the Army's Criminal Investigating Division) to make statements against

other accused, even though Carlos

did not know the other accused and Carlos would be assured of only a 3-month sentence. His refusal to submit to the bribery attempts of illegitmate authoritymakes Carlos as a man of dignity who joins the legion of political prisoners who will not compromise.

On Monday, March 9th, Carlos went on trial again on additional charges of assault and AWOL Thirteen men and women members of the Young Lords Organization, Puerto Rican freedom fighters, along with members of the American Servicemen's Union attended the trial with some other supporters of Carlos. On the two assault charges, Carlos was sentenced to six-months hard labor. When the Colonel-Judge asked Carlos what kind of work he had done in Puerto Rico before entering the Army, Carlos Rodriguez Torres replied, "I am a proletarian, I work at any job I can get.'

At the close of the first day of this trial, about 50 MP's tried to eject the Lords from the base and a battle broke out in front of the court building, on the street and finally inside the MP bus. Fifteen were arrested and given bar notices, forbidding them to reenter Ft. Dix under penalty of a six months jail sentence and a \$500,00 fine, Those arrested refused to accept the bar notices or to sign them

ASU Chairman Andy Strapp, who was arrested and barred with the Lords, stated that the four year sentence of Carlos Rodriguez and the banning of the Young Lords, "reaffirms the racist character of the Brass. The ASU must step up its resistance to this oppression. The physical struggle against this illegal barring was a beginning."


Dear friends,

The massacres of civilians in Pleiku, Kontum, Kong H'ring, Ayun and other places have laid bare the real nature of Mr. Nixon's policy of "Vietnamization" of the war.

However, Mr. Nixon's perfidy and brutality can never shake our people's determination. German, Dr. Julius Mader, has set the number of Palestinian prisoners at 17, 316 during the second half of the current year. Of these 4,000 are alleged to be Freedom Fighters. The rest are civilians arrested arbitrarily for happening to be in areas of explosions, or demonstrators, or strikers against Israeli occupation of their country.

Contact with detainees is absolutely forbidden. Even families and lawyers are prohibited from communicating with prisoners. Little is told by the Israelis about the life these Palestinians lead or the hygenic circumstances under which they live.

The agony of these prisoners is not limited to the miserable life they lead. The suffering and pain inflicted on Palestinian prisoners is a landmark in human brutality.

A three-month pregnant Palestinian woman, Mrs. Abla Shafic Taha, was arrested while on her way home to Jerusalem and was put in a cell reserved for Israeli prostitutes who hit her violently in the presence of an Israeli guard. > - Prisoners are offered three meals a day. At breakfast, they are given two pieces of bread,

one hard boiled egg, half a teaspoon of jam and four olives. Eggs are sometimes substituted by some olive oil. At lunch, the prisoners are supplied with two pieces of bread and thin soup with one piece of boiled vegetable. A slice of radish is offered with either lunch or supper. Supper is made up of two pleces of bread, boiled spaghetti or a piece of dry fish. The latter is scarcely served. Each prisoner is allotted four cigarettes a day. - Families are never notified of the prisoner's whereabouts.

Asqualan Prison

A recently opened prison in Asqalan has features similar to those of the Nablus prison, According to the Israeli Ittihad newspaper (Haifa, 12/9/69) the following are the characteristics of this prison:

- Prisoners are beaten immediately upon arrival; a welcome ceremony.

- Prisoners spend most of their time in cells.

- The guards are allowed to beat the prisoners at their discretion.

- The warden is to be ad-

dressed 'your honor' whenever spoken to by prisoners. Any deviance from this rule is harshly punished.

- The prisoner should not raise his head when talking to Israeli guards but should keep his eyes on the ground.

- Prisoners are alloted beds made up of stone and one blanket which they are not allowed to use during the daytime.

- No printed matter of whatever sort is allowed to the prisoners.

- Application of Nitric Acid to the lips and other sensitive or-

- Twisting of genitals.

The following is a resume of the experience of several Palestinians who were lucky enough to survive their detention. Many of them however were released because of physical disenablement caused bytorture inside the prison and which have dimmed their chances of sur-

The Nablus Prison

The following are some of the features of the Nablus prison, one of the largest prisons in occupied territory:

- Prison rooms or wards are 18 ft. by 36 ft. in which 60-90 prisoners are held. Each room has one wash basin and toilet that are not partitioned from the rest of the room.

- Once every 24 hours, prisoners are allowed an open-air break of five minutes.

- Only after the interference of the Red Cross delegation did the prison authorities provide every two prisoners with a tin of water to wash with once every two weeks.

- Prisoners are checked three times a day starting 3:30 a.m. after which they have to fold their blankets and sit up for the rest of the day. The last check up is carried at 8:00 p.m. before which no prisoners is allowed to rest.

- Israeli civilians and army personnell, including children, are allowed into prison quarters to look at the Palestinian prisoners. Prisoners are ordered to stand up for every Israeli visitor. Not only do they have to stand up, but they also have to bow their heads and fold their hands behind their backs. Any disobediance to this rule is punishable by flogging.

- No medical doctor attends to the prisoners while in jail.

BROWN: She said he made a statement, but that she could not understand him, but he said something to the officer when he was lying on the ground. So he was coming up on his hand and his knee, saying something to the officer, but she couldn't understand him. The witnesses say that he took careful aim.

REG: While your son was on his knee ...

BROWN: Trying to get up on his elbow, the witnesses all state that he was or like, you know like when he hit him, he was coming up like this, I believe that he was saying "Don't shoot me", or something. I really believe it, because I know my son, He wasn't a violent type. And even if he would have been drinking that would have made him that much, he would have been less violent. She said that when they shot him in the chest he fell flat and he didn't move. And they all ran up and started to kicking him and beating him with their "bullies."

### RULES OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY

#### NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS BERKELEY, CALIFORNIA

Every member of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY throughout this country of racist America must abide by these rules as functional members of this party. CENTRAL COMMITTEE members. CENTRAL STAFFS, and LOCAL STAFFS, including all captains subordinate to either national, state, and local leadership of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY will enforce these rules. Length of suspension or other disciplinary action necessary for violation of these rules will depend on national decisions by national, state or state area, and local committees and staffs where said rule or rules of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY WERE VIOLATED.

Every member of the party must know these verbatum by heart. And apply them daily. Each member must report any violation of these rules to their leadership or they are counter-revolutionary and are also subjected to suspension by the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.

#### THE RULES ARE:

- No party member can have narcotics or weed in his possession while doing party work.
- 2. Any party member found shooting narcotics will be expelled from this party.
- 3. No party member can be DRUNK while doing daily party work.
- 4. No party member will violate rules relating to office work, general meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY, and meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY ANYWHERE.
- 5. No party member will USE, POINT, or FIRE a weapon of any kind unnecessarily or accidentally at anyone.
- No party member can join any other army force other than the BLACK LIBERATION ARMY.

  - 11. Party Communications must be National and Local.
- 12. The 10-10-10-program should be known by all members and also understood by all members.
- 13. All Finance officers will operate under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Finance.
- 14. Each person will submit a report of dails work.
- 15. Each Sub-Section Leader Section Leader, Lieutenant, and Captain must submit Daily reports of work.
- 16. All Panthers must learn to operate and service weapons correctly.
  17. All Leadership personnel who expel a member must submit this information to the Editor of the Newspaper, so that it will be published.

- 25. All chapters must adhere to the policy and the ideology laid down by the CENTRAL COMMITTEE of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.
- 26. All Branches must submit weekly reports in writing to their respective Chapters.



# October 1966 Black Panther Party Platform and Program

## What We Want What We Believe

1. We want freedom. We want power to determine the destiny of our Black Community.

We believe that black people will not be free until we are able to determine our destiny.

2. We want full employment for our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white American businessmen will not give full employment, then the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living.

#### 3. We want an end to the robbery by the CAPITALIST of our Black Community.

We believe that this racist government has robbed us and now we are demanding the overdue debt of forty acres and two mules. Forty acres and two mules was promised 100 years ago as restitution for slave labor and mass murder of black people. We will accept the payment in currency which will be distributed to our many communities. The Germans are now aiding the Jews in Israel for the genocide of the Jewish people. The Germans murdered six million Jews. The American racist has taken part in the slaughter of over fifty million black people; therefore, we feel that this is a modest demand that we make.

#### 4. We want decent housing, fit for shelter of human beings.

We believe that if the white landlords will not give decent housing to our black community, then the housing and the land should be made into cooperatives so that our community, with government aid, can build and make decent housing for its people.

5. We want education for our people that exposes the true nature of this decadent American society. We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present-day society.

We believe in an educational system that will give to our people a knowledge of self. If a man does not have knowledge of himself and his position in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

#### 6. We want all black men to be exempt from military service.

We believe that Black people, should not be forced to fight in the military service to defend a racist government that does not protect us. We will not fight and kill other people of color in the world who, like black people, are being victimized by the white racist government of America. We will protect ourselves from the force and violence of the racist police and the racist military, by whatever means necessary.

#### We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY and MURDER of black people.

We believe we can end police brutality in our black community by organizing black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all black people should arm themselves for self-defense.

8. We want freedom for all black men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails.

We believe that all black people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

9. We want all black people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peer group or people from their black communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that black people will receive fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a many right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the black community from which the black defendant came. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man" of the black community.

10. We want land, bread, housing, education, clothing, justice and peace. And as our major political objective, a United Nations-supervised plebiscite to be held throughout the black colony in which only black colonial subjects will be allowed to participate, for the purpose of determining the will of black people as to their national destiny.

When, in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume, among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and, accordingly, all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But, when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same object, evinces a design to reduce them under absolute despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new guards for their future security.



BRITAIN:

AFTER LOSING WORLD WAR II, GREAT BRITAIN ECONOMICALLY AND IN EVERY WAY WAS IN A COMPLETE MESS. IN THE FORM OF WAR LOANS THE U.S. DECIDED TO AID BRITAIN TO HELP REBUILD HER ECONOMY. BRITAIN HAS BEEN UNABLE TO REPAY MOST OF THESE LOANS AS DURING THIS PERIOD THE COUNTRIES IN THE SO-CALLED BRITISH EMPIRE STARTED AND HAVE SINCE GAINED THEIR INDEPENDENCE, RESULTING IN BRITAIN'S SOURCE OF CHEAP RAW MATERIAL AND EXPLOITATION BEING CUT OFF. RESULT, U.S. CONTROLS OR HAS SHARES IN MOST BRITISH FIRMS AND BRITAIN DEPENDS ON U.S. FOR DEFENCE, ETC.

WEST GERMANY:

AFTER WORLD WAR II, GERMANY WAS COMPLETELY MESSED UP. THE SO CALLED ALLIES, GREAT BRITAIN ANDU.S., AFTER GERMANY WAS DIVIDED INTO EAST AND WEST, TOOK OVER WEST GERMANY, U.S. STARTED POUR-ING CAPITAL INTO GERMANY AND NEARLY ALL TROOPS STATIONED IN GERMANY ARE AMERICAN AND BRITISH, ABOUT 70% OF THE MAIN GERMAN FIRMS HAVE AMERICAN CAPITAL INVESTED.

FRANCE:

BECAUSE OF FINANCIAL INTERESTS AND THEDECLINE OF THE FRANC, FRANCE IS TIED TO U.S. ECONOMICALLY, ALSO, WITH POMPIDOU AS PRE-SIDENT, THE SITUATION HAS WORSENED, POMPIDOU IS CONNECTED WITH THE ROTHSCHILDS THE WORLD'S LARGEST GOLD AND DIAMOND DEALERS WHICH ARE TIED UP WITH U.S. AND SOUTH AFRICAN CAPITAL.
