

DOPE IN A **PHILADEL PHIA** BLACK COMMUNITY

Historically, Black people have been in a position where their conditions were forced upon them by outside forces. Along with bad housing, police brutality, etc. we have been dehumanized to a point where some of us would just like to get out of it. Dope has always been and still is a problem in our communities. It is worse now than it ever was before.

I was walking through the Richard Allen Projects around 12th and Fairmount talking to the people about the dope problem when I spotted this pig giving a little girl a sugar cube. I remembered this kind of cube from before, so ! went up to the little girl (she was about 9 years old) and asked her what did she have, and she related to me that it was candy, but I knew these were the same cubes that the pigs start our children out on, because it is sugar with a few particles of heroine on it. I turned around to see if the pig was still in sight, but like all pigs do, he skyed up and left his lackey to finish the job for him. We know that the only way

that we are going to rid our communities of the plague (dope) is to deal with capitalism. Because we understand that the government is running hand in hand with the mafia in flooding our communities with this plague in the pursuit of profits, regardless of how many Black children die of an overdose.

We say to the pigs and their lackeys that we will not stand by any longer and see our youths' minds being stolen from their very being. We say we are conscious of our situation, we are determined to change it, and we are unafraid, It had best be understood now that we will not stand by and let a bunch of profiteering fools (with their get-rich-quick schemes) continue to implement this dehumanizing form of genocide in our communities. The pig news media, whom we all know works in the interest of this system. wrote up tales that Jasper Bell had yelled halt to the brother. but the truth is that Jasper Bell murdered Alvin Battles. To prove how little the pigs care about a Black person being ripped off, Jasper Bell was cut loose, and is free to walk the streets again and continue to exploit the peo-

The pigs could care less if niggers kill niggers, especially the youth, because the youth makes the revolution. This is all part of the pigs' strategy--divide and conquer. As long as we have bootlickers such as Jasper Bell running amuck, this type of genocide of our people will continue. So as the racist pig must go, so must the bootlicking capitalist go. To the people of the Black community. bootlickers like Jasper Bell are enemies of the people and must be dealt with as one.

WRETCHED CONDITIONS IN THE "LAND OF PLENTY"



MRS. LEODA OF PHILADELPHIA

The Black person living in Philly in particular and in fascist Babylon in general lives in danger. We are

forced to live in indecent housing. One clear example of the fascism perpetuated by greedy slumlords is the condition that Mrs. Leoda of 2740 Eyre Street is made to exist in. Two months ago, she moved into the house at the above address, it had been fixed up enough to make it look passable to the average eye. Two months later, her basement flooded with

about 4 feet of foul stagnant water. This water sends an extremely terrible odor through her whole house, an odor so foul that she can't even sleep at night with the doors closed. Jefferson Realty (2906 Ridge Ave.) refused to send anyone to her home to deal with the problem, she then called City Hall, who sent a man out to put pipes under the sink, which did no good, Now, this sink (in the kitchen) has a gigantic hole in it, through which water goes into the

basement, even though the man from City Hall was supposed to have "fixed" it - can you dig it?

Other outrageous conditions in this obscene building that the fascist slumlord has the nerve to rent to anybody are: Holes in the walls and ceilings, and the usual rats and roaches. To add insult to injury, the slumlord threatened to call the pigs on Mrs. Leoda if she continues to refuse to pay the \$75 extortion fee that he charges her. Mrs. Leoda, whoreceives only \$40 every 2 weeks from DPA to exist on says that she will continue to hold back the \$75.00.



FASCIST PIGS BEAT BROTHER

In the city of 'Brotherly Love' as in the rest of decadent America, fascism does not only wear the uniform of a pig on the beat or the conservative business suit of avaricious businessmen or the black robes of a 'judge'. It also comes in the everyday clothes of ordinary young white racists.

Brother Glen Teet of 5222 Heaston Street received an expression of "Brotherly Love" --Philly style from 30 young fascist-in-training on September 9th. On that date, he was helping some people move on 50th Street when these 30 white racist boys jumped on him. The brother put up a good struggle, but being outnumbered by the young pigs, he was overcome. The outcome of this unprovoked brutal attack on an unarmed brother was a vicious wound in Brother Glen's head which led to a brain operation and a stay in Black Panther Party the hospital.

It is very apparent that Black people have no rights that racist whites feel bound to respect. The present Constitution is completely incapable of protecting our rights when we, Black people, weren't even thought about when it was written. That is why we need a Constitution that will make it clear to the world that Blacks and other oppressed people have rights and what these rights are.

We will not let these rights, including the basic right to life, be denied us by anyone! The situation is so foul that the only way we can protect our rights is with the gun. We WILL protect our rights and use the gun.

FASCIST BROOKLINE PIGS SHOT AND KILLED 14 YEAR OLD BROTHER

The fascist pigs of Brookline Smith, But this is one act that truly exposes the animal nature of these 'enforcers of the law' because Leon Smith was a white youth and he was killed in Newton, Mass., which is a high-class neighborhood pig sty to put into practice "law and order."

Leon Smith was allegedly being chased for driving a stolen car in Brookline and the chase started when Leon and two other youths crashed into a parked car in Brookline. The other two youths were caught but the fascists began to chase Leon into Newton and when the chase ended Leon was in a twocar garage in Newton dead. The Brookline pig department has refused to give out any information. But it is plain to see that it was murder because Leon had no way of defending himself from these pigs and the pigs whose job is to "protect and serve" showed that

He told my caseworker that he wanted retroactive rent from May because that was when I became a new tenant. I was evicted on August 28, he lied, but I had to pay all of September rent and I moved back in on the 17th of September. I called my lawyer and told him about the deal that had gone down, and he said to forget

My family has been harassed. humiliated and degraded, thrown outdoors. My rights as a tenant have been messed over, and my lawyer tells me to forget it.

The negro pig who caused me to be evicted still insists on harassing me. When I went to get my keys to the apartment, he claimed he had lost them, and has not as yet given them to me.

We have to begin to deal with the avaricious slumlords and their lackey supers by any means necessary.

testified that Hawley was a very respectable man and upheldhis job as an undercover agent with digwas really like.

DeGrant testifed that he was approximately six (6) feet from the defendant (James Jones) when he saw money being passed between Hawley and Jones. A patrolman Lucas testified that he was only two (2) feet from them. Detective DeGrant was supposedly in a panel truck that allegedly was parked in the same area at the same time every day in order to observe the happenings inside the store, but James Jones' mother left court and took pictures of the area and brought them back disproving detective DeGrant's story and that he had to be at least thirteen (13) feet or more and that he had to look through a store front glass which was obscured by written advertisement in order to see the transaction. Anyone who has ever been on Congress Avenue knows that it is impossible to maintain the same parking space day after day. Both men testified that James Jones passed the drugs to Hawley with his right hand. But as everyone around Congress and Redfield can remember James Jones was shot in his right arm and hand; therefore, he was forced to learn to use both hands and was quite accustomed to using either hand even six (6) months later. They also testified that he wore no jewelry. It was a matter of police record that he had two rings and a watch at the time of arrest. Detective DeGrant testified that James Jones was clean shaven at the time of the alleged transaction, but police mugshots proved that James Jones had a beard and a mustache.

Mr. Ramsey, James Jones' attorney, made a motion to place the coroner's report in order to prove that Lucas was lying, but the judge denied permission and sent the jury out so that they wouldn't be able to hear what was being said because that would put doubt in their minds about their testimonies.

Mr. DeGrant also testified that only about eight persons including himself knew that Hawley was an undercover agent. But it was common knowledge in the neighborhood that Hawley was an auxiliary (aid) policeman or something of the sort.

Detective DeGrant said that Hawley received 150 bags of heroin from James Jones for \$350.00 but even 5 year old children in the ghettos know that it costs at least six (6) dollars per bag or more. No pusher in his or her right mind would sell it so cheap and the con-

sequences being so great. The New Haven police force also employs another man who is known by his fellow Black men as "Buffalo". This man has had a federal case against him for planting drugs on a federal agent. How can the police department be allowed to uphold law and order, when their star arrester is a criminal himself. The police department doesn't want to admit that the inside has just as many stoolies as the outside. Just like they have people they can get information from, there are corrupt policemen that will release inside information to help protect those they are receiving graft from.

All these things go to prove that James Jones has been railroaded through the courts of Connecticut. There should be an investigation of the police department, because Hawley and Lucas are not the only policemen that take our brothers for a ride. Hawley and Lucus ran their numbers store for approximately one year. We, the people of the community would like to know what happened to the money that they collected for the numbers? Do the police think that they are entitled to keep the money? We think that it should be put into taxes and city funds. If it was, we would like to see

If James Jones is sent to jail, it should be on the consciences persons living in and of all around the area of Congress Avenue. If you can find it in your heart, sign the petition when someone brings it to your door or place of business. The only way we will be able to liberate ourselves is to stick together. James Jones is in-

We must expose these Black lackeys for what they are, they are tools of this racist structure and must be dealt with in the same manner.



This press conference is being called by the Toledo, N.C.C.F. to publicly denounce the vicious attack upon the Toledo N.C.C.F. Headquarters, as being unprovoked and highly fascist in nature. The local and national conspiracy to kill or jail members of so-called organizations has finally reached its deadly tentacles into our community with hopes to steal our quest for freedom, but this cannot and will not be done.

The incidents surrounding these vicious attacks are as follows: !. The passing of an ordinance sponsored by Mayor EnsignDeputy Chief Duck, Safety Director Quinn, and Chief Bosch which states that it is unlawful for any citizen to call a policeman apig or make oink ing sounds.



3. The climax of the incidents leading to the attack on the N.C.C.F. Headquarters was the fatal shooting of Policeman William Miscannon. This incident was used to attack the Headquarters and also as an excuse to send John Mc-Clellan to the electric chair, and to send Mike Cross to the penitentiary. In the news, patrolman Miscannon was portraved as a "good cop," but he was known for his racism and acts of brutality throughout the Black community. His partner in crime against the people, Walter Shaw, who in the eyes of the people is a lackey, a bootlicker, and a traitor who shot me, Larry Mc-Clellan, as I was trying to surrender with my hands up, and he was one of the many who shot Troy Montgomery, who was also surrendering with his hands up, and both were unarmed. Shaw also opened fire on Mike Cross as he tried to surrender, empty-handed, The news media failed to mention that Troy laid on the wet sidewalk with the rain falling on him for over two hours. After Troy was taken to the hospital he lay for another two hours before treatment began.



Contrary to what the administration may believe, they have not stilled our efforts, we will intensify our struggle for total and un-





ONE PIG DEAD ONE PIG WOUNDED AT THE HANDS OF THE LUMPEN

Joseph P. Tracz Jr., 17934 Lakeshore, 27, one of the Cleveland's Police Department Tactical Squad's pigs was known to have an outstanding record for getting lumpens felony charges. His pig partner Frederick Fulton, 29, 18026 Olymid Road, was known to have a contract on his head, put there by the lumpen in the area.

Point No. 7 of our Ten Point Platform and Program states: "We want an immediate end to Police Brutality and Murder of Black people. We believe we can end police brutality in our Black community by organizing Black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our Black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all Black people should arm themselves for self-defense."

At 2:00 am Fulton and Tracz forced a gold Buick 225 over to the curb

on E. 106th and Saint Claire Avenues. Fulton ran over to the driver's side and was greeted by a barrage of bullets. He was hit in the mouth, chest and the groin. (He is now in intensive care division of some hospital.)

Tracz jumped out with his gun in his hand and ran up on the passengers said where he was greeted by a second barage of bullets. he was hit in the arm, leg and the foot. After a scuffle with this pig, the lumpen (in the correct manner) knocked the pig down, took his gun and fired into the pig, bang, bang, dead pig!

The lumpen escaped unharmed.

This and other revolutionary acts will continue to happen until community control of police is implemented throughout racist, fascist Babylon.

RUCHELL MAGEE'S DEMAND FOR JUSTICE

Ruchell Magee political prisoner of San Quentin, has filed a complaint in Federal court asking for the immediate arrest and prosecution of San Quentin's Warden (overseer) Louis S. Nelson for "conspiracy to kill and injure four humans", (in relationship to the incident that took place at Marin County on August 7th, in which Ruchell was wounded, Jonathan Jackson, William Christmas, and James McClain was murdered.) Ruchell bases this complaint on the fact that this sadistic pig ordered his fascist dogs to open fire upon them. He wasn't the least bit concerned with the lives of the Judge nor the three jurors, but as all fascist only inmates, and particularly interested in killing those brothers and sisters in the many prisons and jails who have a strong political consciousness. And who not only talk about the problem, but move to solve them. Ruchell also has filed a complaint in federal court demanding removal of his case from San Quentin's makeshift court, Ruchell also demanded that since the state has refused him permission to file civil or criminal actions in California, that he should not be prosecuted by the state.

Ruchell who was born in New Orleans, Louisiana, was first railroaded to San Quentin in 1965 The majority of Ruchell's life has been spent in prisons. He also spent several years in Angola State Prison in Louisiana, Ruchell has reached a high political conclousness, that cannot be destroyed. He realized that the corrupt murderous madness American society is in a state of crisis, because the people have been oppressed, exploited, and murdered for so long, that they are moving to take their destiny into their hands.

The same monster waging oppression upon communities in the United States has oppressed the people of the world, and so it is now surrounded by global revolution, waged by oppressed people of the world, the revolution of the oppressed has its own laws, the laws or freedom, that are accorded by the people who create it, who inspire each other to take



up arms in defense of the freedom of all people Liberation does not come as a gift it is seized by the masses of the people, with their own hands. And they themselves by seizing it are transformed from oppressive colonization to the ultimate supremacy of

"Where oppression is maintained from violence from above, it is only possible to eliminate it with violence from below." This system is the prison of the oppressed people of America as well as oppressed people of the world. And we the people of fascist America take the stand to fight that enemy to destroy the most deadly enemy of the world. We demand the immediate release of all of our warriors of the people's liberation Army. But yet we understand that demands have been made by the oppressed people ever since the existance of oppression. PRESS STATEMENT TO THE PRESS ON ELMER PRATT, DEPUTY MINISTER OF DEFENSE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA CHAPTER BLACK PANTHER PARTY

September 24, 1970

In the past year and a half, the Deputy Minister of Defense of the Southern California Chapter of the Black Panther Party has been unjustly jailed approximately 37 times for everything from murder and conspiracy to commit murder to traffic violations. During the period of 1969 and 1970, he has been shot at, threatened and beaten by various individual police officers and precincts. Particularly his life was threatend by officers Vasquez, then of Newton St. Station; Panzica Fisher, and Hole of Metro Squad; and especially by 77th St. Station. But over this period of the severest, fascist personalized repression and attacks on Geronimo, the city had been able only to bring four felony cases even to their own courts.

Geronimo had previously--before joining the Black Panther Party-been in the Army as a paratrooper and in the special forces, training Green Berets, He had earned 13 medals from his period of service, including one bronze star and two purple hearts. In 1967 he was honorably discharged from the Army and turned his life and skills over to his people. He became the leader of the Southern California Chapter of our Party, after the assassination of the former Deputy Minister of Defense, Alprentice "Bunchy" Carter, on January 17, 1969.

Due to what the U.S. knew he could do with the very knowledge they had given him, and with his brilliant mind and devotion to his people, he suffered the severest attacks by the local and national police from that time on.

Because he knew from these previous, unsuccessful attempts to kill him that these court cases were merely excuses to legally jail him forever or execute him, Geronimo decided that in order to continue his hard work for the people, he

could not possibly relate to passively turning himself in to the police. So he refused to go to court, he refuses to be a willing victim to their conspiracy to commit mur-

Therefore on August 17, 1970, when he was suppose to appear for these cases, he did not. And no one has seen him since. The police cannot find him and they have been so upset by this that, they recently issued twenty-two subpoenas to members of this Chapter including Masai Hewitt, Minister of Education and Gwen Goodloe, Deputy Minister of Finance. to allegedly investigate his whereabouts. Then suddenly on the last day that Geronimo had to appear in court, September 21, 1970, while one court forfeited Geronimo's bail, the other dismissed these twenty-two subpoenas and the next day the police announced to the news media that they were suddenly looking for him.

We want the people to know that the police have always been looking for him; and, therefore, dismissing these subpoenas is an excuse for openly attacking our offices and homes as they did on last December 8th. For example: On September 17, over one hundred police units surrounded our offices and homes for several hours. And September 23, squads from the Los Angeles Police Department, the Metro Squad, the Sherrifs Department and other unidentified units were performing practice attack exercises in a vacant lot on Bliss and Oleander in Compton, several blocks from our Community Center in Compton.

What we want the people, particularly the Black community, to know is that we do not know where Elmer Pratt, Geronimo is and that we know that the so-called police search for him is an excuse to viciously attack the Black Panther Party and the Black Community.

A REPORT FROM TRACY PRISON, CALIFORNIA

September 19, 1970

The genocide, the dehumanizing and the barbaric conditions, past and presently existing at the many incarceration camps throughout Babylon are being manifested in a real-life way at Tracy Prison.

Tracy, like other pigpens, has the ever present gun towers, and adjustment centers (better described as the hole or the dun-

Tracy in relation to the murders and brutalities perpetrated in other pigpens, it was noticed that the information previously unknown and presently prevailing hasn't been publicized in the systematicallymonitored news media, or exposed to the people in our many communities throughout Babylon. This being clearly another concrete method to confuse and blindfold the people and create an illusion of no cruel and unusual punishment bein inflicted upon the prison population of Tracy.

Quite to the contrary however, just during the last two months, two brothers have died in perplexing surroundings. One in the hole with the pigs maintaining that he killed himself by cutting his wrists and bleeding to death. The other by hanging himself in his cell in the R.E.C. (receiving guidance center), the only information source acquired was by the pigs, leaving many and much explanations questionable and unanswered. The inmates are stripped naked and completely searched before they are placed in the hole. There is no other way knives can get in...unless the After studying the situation at pigs bring them in. Pigs beating of inmates who refuse to go to the hole for trumped-up frames and small petty, trivial charges are frequent, and gas is often pumped into the hole, in order for the pigs to conduct their tear-gas training. The administration makes no attempt to correct these planned genocidal actions and attacks, in fact, they are completely neglected and ignored.

The administration condones the Nazi's actions, for this enables the racial attitudes to outweigh the primary injustices of a fascist system. Racism is one of the contributing factors to our struggle, but we cannot fight racism with racism. We must fight racism with solidarity. Otherwise the administrations' job is safe and easy. The pigs can camouglage their basic operation of mass oppression by using the Nazis as a medium to divide and conquer. In relation to a long train of At shower time, ten Nazi's are abuses, a pig was nearly executed. He managed to oink away on all fours. The pigs used this excuse to round up the brothers who are the most instrumental in revolutionary theory, and those who are trying to formulate a Black Program which will be designed to prepare the brothers for the hostile environment and explosive conditions on the streets.

A few of the brothers now being held and interrogated are Johnny Holms, D. Bolton, Brother Ross, Brother Scott, and Brother Chino. The pigs planted a knife in Chicon's cell, trying to say he is the leader, while also giving him the most serious charge of attempted murder. No one has been able to see them, and don't know if they are receiving any legal defense. Some have been quietly transferred out to court and given new charges, while others are being shipped out to San Quentin, Soledad and Folsom.

The entire prison was locked down for two weeks, while the administration went about their plot of subjecting the brothers to cruel and unusual punishment ... to reaffirm their discipline.

It's important the people realize the struggle going on inside the decadent prison walls. As one brother in San Quentin recently observed -- as he walked from the "condemned row" down for a visit with his love ones--"A standing army"....Niggers, White people, Brown people, waiting to snatch a chance at freedom. We have to mobilize the people to form Political Prisoners Committees to insure these brothers of the due process always oinked by the pigs. It's time now to SEIZE THE TIME!

RULES OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY

NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS 1048 PERALTA STREET OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA

Every member of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY throughout this country of racist America must abide by these rules as functional members of this Party. CENTRAL COMMITTEE members, CENTRAL STAFFS, and LOCAL STAFFS, iccluding all captains subordinate to either national, state, and local leadership of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY will enforce these rules. Length of suspension or other disciplinary action necessary for violation of these rules will depend on national, state or state area, and local committees and staffs where said rule or rules of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY WERE VIOLATED.

Every member of the Party must know these verbatum by heart. And apply them daily. Each member must report any violation of these rules to their leadership or they are counterrevolutionary and are also subjected to suspension by the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.

THE RULES ARE:

- 1. No Party member can have narcotics or weed in his possession while doing Party work.
- 2. Any Party member found shooting narcotics will be expelled from this Party.
- 3. No Party member can be DRUNK while doing daily Party work.
- 4. No Party member will violate rules relating to office work, general meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY, and meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY ANYWHERE.
- 5. No Party member will USE, POINT, or FIRE a weapon of any kind unnecessarily or accidentally at anyone. 6. No Party member can join any other army force other than
- the BLACK LIBERATION ARMY. 7. No Party member can have a weapon in his possession
- while DRUNK or loaded off narcotics or weed. 8. No Party member will commit any crime against other Party members or Black people at all, and cannot steal or
- take from the people, not even a needle or a piece of thread. 9. When arrested BLACK PANTHER MEMBERS will give only name, address, and will sign nothing. Legal first aid must be understood by all Party members.
- 10. The Ten Point Platform and Program of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY must be known and understood by each Party
 - 11. Party Communications must be National and Local.
- 12. The 10-10-10-program should be known by all members and also understood by all members.
- 13. All Finance officers will operate under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Finance.
- 14. Each person will submit a report of daily work,
- 15. Each Sub-Section Leader, Section Leader, Lieutenant, and Captain most submit Daily reports of work.
- 16. All Panthers must learn to operate and service weapons correctly.
- 17. All Leadership personnel who expel a member must submit this information to the Editor of the Newspaper, so that it will be published in the paper and will be known by all Chapters and
- 18. Political Education Classes are mandatory for general membership.
- 19. Only office personnel assigned to respective offices each day should be there. All others are to sell papers and do Political work out in the community, including Captains, Section Leaders,
- 20. COMMUNICATIONS -- all Chapters must submit weekly reports in writing to the National Headquarters.
- 21. All Branches must implement First Aid and/or Medical Cadres.
- 22. All Chapters, Branches, and components of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY must submit a monthly Financial Report to the Ministry of Finance, and also the Central Committee.
- 23. Everyone in a leadership position must read no less than two hours per day to keep abreast of the changing political situation.
- 24. No Chapter or Branch shall accept grants, poverty funds, money or any other aid from any government agency without contacting the National Headquarters.
- 25. All Chapters must adhere to the policy and the ideology laid down by the CENTRAL COMMITTEE of the BLACK PANTHER
- 26. All Branches must submit weekly reports in writing to their respective Chapters.



SPEECH BY IRVING SARNOFF, SEPT. 3, 1970 IN LOS ANGELES AT RALLY TO PROTEST ARMED POLICE ASSAULT WHICH BROKE UP THE NATIONAL CHICANO MORATORIUM HELD ON AUGUST 29

"Es mejor morir de pie que vivir rodillas, "(it is better to die on your feet than life on your knees.) This was the remark of one of my fellow workers, as we talked about the murder of Ruben Salazar, one of the two victims who died as a result of the police assault on August 29.

We marched 20 to 30 thousand strong through the heart of the Chicano barrio in an atmosphere of love and comradeship--against the war, against oppression and poverty, and the genocide being inflicted against Chicano youth. Everyone felt good and proud in the response of the community and in our strength. And then love and happiness turned into fear and anger and hatred as the rally was turned into a battlefield--sheriffs gassing people, clubbing, routing and, killing.

I felt a great sense of frustration sitting in Belvedere Park, watching the fires still burning and the deputies, the sirens, and helicopters, and our people being hauled off and returning from the battle.

As I sat, I thought of a poem:
"The wheel of the law turns without pause

After the rain good weather

In the wink of an eye, the universe throws off its muddy clothes For ten thousand miles the landscape spreads out like a beautiful brocade

Light breezes. Smiling flowers, in Portland) the Peace Action
High in the trees, amongst the Sparkling leaves, all the birds sponsible for the National Chicano sing at once. Men and animals Moratorium 7 It was a typical racist rise up reborn.

What could be more natural? After sorrow, comes joy."

The author of the poem was Ho Chi Minh, and it is a fitting remembrance because today we mark the first anniversary of the death of Ho Chi Minh, It is symbolic also because there is a great similarity between the struggle of the Vietnamese people against colonialism and the struggle of the Chicano people. This similarity was evident as we marched and observed the foreign aggressors stationed on each intersection--block after block--for five miles. These were the same aggressors as those in Vietnam -the same attitude, And I thought as we marched that the demands of the movement, in terms of these aggressors, were also similar: Immediate, unconditional withdrawal, self-determination free of foreign control, removal of abcultural dignity.

have in mind the statement of Los Angeles Police Chief Davis who said (from 1,000 miles away in Portland) the Peace Action Council was an organizer and responsible for the National Chicano Moratorium? It was a typical racist statement that indicates the refusal to accept the ability and maturity of the leadership of the Chicano community.

We must, however, ask ourselves where was the White Peace movement on August 29 with only a tiny, insignificant number attending. Where was the White Peace movement three days prior when some 500 protested at the Nixon visit to the Los Angeles Music Center and over half of the 500 were Chicano Youth?

The August 29 march would have occurred without the few Anglos present because of the organizing efforts of the Chicano Moritorium for the previous six months and because of the response of the Chicano community.

as we marched that the demands of the movement, interms of these aggressors, were also similar: Immediate, unconditional withdrawal, self-determination free of foreign control, removal of absentee landlords and oppressors, cultural dignity.

The violence also would have occurred because the Anglo establishment felt a need to smash this largest working-class anti war action ever to take place. The violence would have occurred because the Anglo establishment is racist.

We live in a racist country run by whites intent on keeping Chicanos, Blacks, and Asians down at home and abroad.

What happened on August 29—
and in Vietnam is happening all
over America and will continue
and intensify unless our country
and our movement deal with the
question of racism. We must deal
with the kind of racism in our
movement where a narrow leftist
political tendency, i.e., Progressive Labor, arrogantly blast the
leadership of the Chicano and
Vietnamese people and try to tell
them how they should conduct their

We must deal with the kind of racism in our movement where our affluent friends refuse to allow and accept leadership from Chicanos and Blacks or accept it reluctantly with attitudes of paternalism. The slogan of self-determination is a mockery in the face of these attidues.

We must deal with the kind of movement racism that renders in-

sensitive to the violence that is committed outside the white community. East Los Angeles on August 29 was a heck of a lot worse than the Century Plaza police riot two years hence-hundreds more arrested, people killed, many more wounded, tear and nerve gas, police state and martial law in the barrio--but not hardly a peep out of the liberal community compared to the Century Plaza which involved mainly the White Peace Movement. Our movement racism has rendered us insensitive to the increased casualties of Vietnamese as the toll of American casualties decreases. And what can be said of the higher draft quotas of Chicanos and Blacks; the first draft resisters (Black youth from S,N,C,C,) all but forgotten, the hundreds of thousands languishing in jails across America whose main crime in life was not being born white. Where is our move-

Our movement needs to see racism as the chief ideological tool of imperialism used to justify exploitation and oppression of Blacks, Chicanos, Asians, Racism justifies a system of imperialism that murders and keeps millions in slavery in Asia, Africa and Latin America in order to enrich the few in Europe and North America.

Racism is thinking (openly or subtly) that says whites are "superior" and justifies the destruction of "inferior" people. It is the thinking of a Northern California judge who suggested killing a Chicano youth for a minor offense and suggested that Hitler was right in his genocidal solutions. It is the thinking of a Pasadena judge who tried to force sterilization upon a Chicano mother. It is the thinking of the Los Angeles Police Department

and Grand Jury when they exonerated the killers of Jerry Lee Aime--a Black youth, Vietnam veteran, "accidently" riddled with 25 bullets. It is the thinking of the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department when Ruben Salazar was murdered on August 29 in East Los Angeles.

These are no mistakes. These are no accidents.

It is genocide, because a nation that is run by racists is a nation that engages in genocide. Western nations are rich in our history of genocideal solutions: The history of the native Americans of North and South America, the German destruction of Jews and Gypsies, Vietnam, Hiroshima, South Africa, and the Indians of Brazil. "Final solutions" by genocidal racists.

The people of the world will not permit this to happen any more—the imperialist system that is sustained by racism will be destroyed first.


We must not allow a system to continue to exist that violently represses people who seek to end poverty and exploitation while it raises the salary of judges to \$40,000 per year and allows a poor mother on welfare to become so hungry and distraught that she throws her child on to a freeway.

Racism allows us to be indifferent and call for investigations by the very racists that create the problems; racists who pay \$1,000 per month to live in penthouses on Wilshire Boulevard and Beverly Hills.

The White Peace Movement must understand that: There will be no Peace if racism continues. We must understand our role in our communities. We must understand that our movement has allowed this slaughter to continue in relative silence—and until we deal with the racism and genocide of America the slaughter will continue at home and abroad.

What is needed is the dedication of our movement to end racism and thus create the unity of forces necessary to end war and poverty.

In every corner of Babylon, from the North to the South, from the East to the West, Law and Order officials supposedly in carrying out their job as the protectors of human rights, are, in fact, doing just the opposite. They protect a law or a set of laws that are and have never been beneficial to the masses. These individuals have been deemed as pigs by the people because of their piggish practice. And in light of a recent chain of events in Philly from racists attacking Black families to the simultaneous raids on 3 of our offices and now to another incident that happenedrecently, it clearly shows that the "City of Brotherly Love" (Phila,) is no exception.

On Saturday, September 12th, around 9:30 p.m. the "Gladiators" notorcycle club gave a dance for all motorcycle clubs at their pullding (which is in the vicinity of Germantown and Allegheny Aves.) The
pigs, caused a hassle in which one
pigs vamped on the people causing
a hassle in which one pig was bear
in the head by another pig. This
event ended the dance, but the pigs
were not satisfied.

On Sunday, September 13th, at

approximately 2:30 in the afternoon, Jim Palmer, of 5124 Irving St., was coming out of a bar in the 3200 block of Germantown Ave. It is known that Uptight (his nickname) is a member of the Scorpion Motorcycle Club and that he was at the dance the night before. As he was leaving the bar, pigs stormed into the area and told the brother to leave. Not wanting to cause any trouble, the brother did as he was told. That's when one of the pigs hollered "Get him", Bozo's flunkies then rushed the brother and started

clubbing him all about the head, arms and back. The brother, trying to defend himself, was met with harder blows, and knocked to the ground. The pigs beat the brother with their baseball bats while he was on the ground.

Once the pigs finished beating

him, they put their slimy hooves on the brother and dragged him on the ground all the way to the pig wagon where they then picked him up and threw him in the wagon on top of other people who had been busted also. (This act could have resulted in further injury to the brother and possible injury to the people already in the wagon.) The brother was then taken down to the 25th pig district at 2nd and Westmoreland Sts. Upon arrival at the pig sty, the brother was charged with disorderly conduct,, breech of the peace and resisting arrest. The pigs there, greedy and low-down, true to form stole \$60 from the brother and also broke his watch.

Point #7 of the 10-point Platform and Program states that; We want an immediate end to police brutality and murder of Black people.

We believe we can end police brutality in our Black community by organizing Black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our Black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The 2nd Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all Black people should arm themselves for self-defense.

COMMUNITY REBELS AGAINST LIVING WITH POSSUMS RUNNING LOOSE IN THEIR HOUSE

In racist America there is a tendency to attribute a great deal of respect to men like Lyndon Johnson, Nelson Rockefeller, Richard Nixon and Carbondale's John Lannin (a slumlord), When a man becomes rich and at the same time prominent in a competative dogeat-dog society like Babylon, it is assumed that his wealth was achieved within the framework of the United States constitution and within the confines of the law. But we should also remember that Hitler seized power, and never functioned outside of the context of the law - because he made the laws. Laws are arranged in favor of those in power, by those in power, and these laws protect slumlords. A clear example is Lannin, the scum landlord,

Lannin's buildings are drafty, the walls, floors, and ceilings have large holes in them. Lannin's houses provide a good home for unwanted and disease carrying rats, possums and snakes. The Black Panther Party Community Information Center believes that if insects, rodents and snakes are compatible playmates for little Black children, Lannin's secretary shouldn't have objected to the action of people of the community when they attempted to bring their plight to the landlord, by dumping a possum on her desk, a possum that had been killed running around in one of the buildings he owns. Instead of yelling and running and making petty threats, the secretary should have thanked us for bringing it exclusively to her. Instead of going into hysteria, the secretary should have hopped into her car and sped over to 204 East Oak and hunted for the mother possum (it was a baby that was killed, the mother and more siblings are still running loose).

For some reason the secretary didn't appreciate the ghetto's gift, and threatened to call the pigs, she seemed to think that it was such a shame that this possum should be placed on her desk, how does she think we feel, having to live with them?

Black people are tired of slums, tired of poverty, tired of hunger, and tired of paying rent and not receiving adequate housing. Point #4 of the Black Panther Party 10point Platform and Program states "We want decent housing fit for shelter of human beings", and we are saying to Lannin, one day soon it won't only be a few people from the community that will be throwing possums on your desk, but the WHOLE Black community, and we will say to you, "try to collect some rent, scum landlord. Yesterday our community was invaded by Ahern's racist Pigs. The reason given by the pigs is that they came to recapture stolen goods from a house in the community and as always the victims were Black People. The Pigs came without a warrant, so this make the whole nature of their business illegall

It was about 3:30 P.M. when the pigs came to do their dirty work, and at this time of the day most Black People are at work, which was the case in this situation.

The sister who owns the apartment, was not at home. Certain items were taken from her house. You see, no one was there to see if items were stolen or which items were stolen, (as the pigs claim) or what things belonged to the sister. They also tried to intimidate people from the community to get them to pass out any information about the stolen goods. The people began to tell those pigs that they had no right going in the sister's house while she wasn't home, but these foul

deprayed creatures went on with their dirty work. So we can began to see very clear now what our Minister Of Defense, Huey Newton pointed out to us, and that is that the pigs are not in our communities to protect our people or their properties, but are here to protect the greedy businessman and recover their goods.

This action of violating people's rights by invading people's privacy and many other acts of aggression upon our people are only one of many reasons why the Black Panther Party and Black people are taking the position and saying that the present Constitution is not and has not been functional for our people, so we say that it has to to abolished along with this racist government, and that we along with Black people call for a Revolutionary People's Constitutional Convention where the people will devise a new Constitution that will beneifit all of humanity. FASCISM RACISM RUNNING RAMPANT IN EASTON, PENNSYLVANIA



Front of Easton Pig Department

On the evening of September 18, 1970, Williams Mitchell and Tyrone Andrews went into the Deluxe Restaurant located in the well known area of Easton called "The Circle". They asked the waitress if they could use the bathroom. But due to the racism that exists in Easton the waitress shouted at them and made racial slurs as they were leaving, causing the brothers to respond with a display of unfriendly words, then left.

Shortly afterwards, pigs arrived at the restaurant, the waitress told them that Mitchell and An-



drews had given her trouble and that they were going to the circle. (The circle is the place where everybody goes to hang out). The pigs, Stephen Vincent and Joseph Peaks, Goe Peaks is known to show animosity towards Black people) took off looking for the brothers.

Pig Vincent found Mitchell, grabbed him and took him back to the restaurant where he was identified by the waitress as the one who had given her trouble. Then the pigs took Mitchell outside and started beating him with their nightsticks.

This incident erupted on a night of window breaking and rock and bottle throwing which ended up with six brothers busted and five of them receving fines of \$61,00 a peice and charges of disorderly conduct and nuisance actions. One brother was released in the custody of his parents because he was a juvenile.

This wan just the beginning, because the pig mayor Fred L. Ashton proceeded to put his curfew into effect. Curfew was set for 11:00 p.m. and all places where people gather were ordered to close at that time.

These actions continued over the weekend where on the following day a group of about 50 youths went to the pig station and broke out windows; one brother was busted for supposedly attempting to take down the flag.

On that following Monday the pigs busted 16 people on what they termed disturbances in the downtown area of Easton. The pigs proved themselves to be true fascists when they protested because the Mayor lifted the curfew. They staged a walk-out and began picketing the pig station, they



stated that the only way they would go back to work was for the mayor to put the curfew back into effect. After viewing that display of madness, the mayor decided to put the curfew into effect again.

The people have clearly shown that they are tired of being subjected to the racist police oppression that exists in this country, the people are resisting on all levels and they know that the only way to exist is to re-

This year can also serve to be very beneficial for the urban guerrilla and very disasterous to the avaricious Michael D.





But we know the fate of revolutionaries is to be a poltical prisoner or face revolutionary suicide.


John's sentencing is scheduled for October 19th, where at that time the pigs will move to violate or take away his probation.

FACIST PIGS BRUTALIZE PANTHER IN COURTROOM



HAROLD HAMINSON -- POLITICAL PRISONER

On Wednesday, September 23, 1970, the pigs kidnapped and brutalized brother Harold Jamison in one of the many fascist courts that exist here in this country.

We were attending the hearing brother Robert "Points" Joyner, a brother the pigs are trying to railroad for executing a pig on August 29, 1970, Sgt. Frank Voncollin, Whose death resulted in the raid of the Panther offices here in Philly.

Harold Jamison was unloading a camera in the back of the courtroom, lolding it in the direction of the floor when he tripped the flash by mistake, the Assistant D.A. Phillips made a statement to the judge regarding the picture taking, which the judge insists can only be done by the press. The pigs rushed Harold out of the courtroom and took him in the back where he was clubbed, beaten, kicked and then dragged to a cell, thrown in and beaten even more.

After that, Judge Market ordered the courtroom cleared of everyone except Joyner's wife and the press.

When we got outside the pigs came out with their night sticks drawn and ordered the people to move away from the building. Inrailroading of Robert Joyner, We went to our office and received a call an hour later from Harold stating that he was at the hospital and had been brutalized by the pigs.

This brother - who had five

stitches on the right side of his head was charged with assault on a pig and later released on a \$500 ball. This attack on Jaimson was one of the many being perpetrated against people of the community and Party members by the gestapo.

This was another blatant attempt to apply pressure on the Party. In recent weeks the pigs have been harassing and arresting all people who are associated with the Party. They have been working day and night plotting to destroy the Party since the Party began. They have been trying desperately to drain the Party of funds by placing high ransoms on those comrades that have been captured. This open provocation is an attack on the Party and people in the community, being that they (the people) gave us their strong support when our offices were vamped on.

So now it should be clear what the pigs are trying to do. We have seen the workings of 'law and order' in the fascist Kangaroo courts that exist throughout Babylon. We have witnessed the way the pigs mete out justice. WHITE RACISTS ATTACK BROTHER

This decadent American society has bred racism to such an extent that it is unsafe for black people to go any distance from their homes, especially if they live close to a white neighborhood, Failure to be aware of the deeply rooted insanity of the white racists in this country can lead to the death of brothers and sisters or at least serious bodily harm. On August 24, 1970 Henry

De Loach of Dorchester, Mass. walked into a white neighborhood, which is only a few blocks from his house, looking for a store in which he could buy some type of soda to settle his stomach. Before he reached the store however, he was met by a group of approximately 10 white boys in their teens who acted in the true manner of a racist and made remarks of nigger as they passed. Henry being hip to these cowardly provocations, kept going in the direction of the store, only to meet an even larger group of white racists sitting on a wall drinking beer. As Henry walked pass the first group, one of them, yelled ahead, " Here comes one of those niggers," which proved to be a signal for the larger group to be alert. As Henry rounded a bend in the street he saw them, suddenly one of these fools jumped from the wall, ran over to the brother and started swinging wildly at his head and body. This white fool racist was immediately joined by a couple more of his cowardly cohorts. The brother at this time was standing his ground and dealing with them. Being the cowards

that they are, these dogs knew it would take more than that to beat the brother and finally knocking him to the ground.

These mad dogs are a good example of how racism runs to the very core of this profiteering capitalistic society. They stomped the brother in the head and body kicking out three of his teeth and dislocated his left shoulder, At one point Henry was able to ask them why they were beating him for he knew he had done nothing to provoke the attack. The reply was "because you're a nigger" For ten minutes these insane dogs attacked Henry, trying to bring him as close to death as possible. Henry describes this nightmare as terrible, " they were animals, like cannibals, like they were trying to eat my body." Finally these cowardly fools were scared off by a black motorist who was passing by and saw what was happening and yelled for them to stop, Henry was left lying on the ground until the pigs arrived on the scene 15 minutes later. Instead of conducting a search of the area which undoubtedly would have lead to the capture of some of the attackers, the pigs asked for a lot of senseless information which they will never use because we know the pigs do not exist for our protection.

Henry was finally taken to Boston City Hospital (Boston Butcher Shop), The violation of human rights did not stop at the doors of the Butcher Shop , for when a friend discovered what had happened to Henry and came to aid in any way possible. He

was met by sarcasm and inhuman treatment by another pig of the Boston Pig Department, who was acting as a guard in the admitting room. He yelled at Henry's friend not to try to go into the treatment room but to go to the waiting room and sit there. Then the pig went into Henry's room and lied to him about letting his visitor into the room to see him. This lying pig was fooled because Henry's friend slipped past the pig and visited him anyway.

Henry had planned to go to the funeral of his Grandfather in Alabama the next day, Arrangements were made and his family in Alabama were expecting him there. Now his family has not only one sorrow to share in the form of the death of the Grandfather, but also the knowledge of the near death of Henry at the hands of the cowardly mad white racist dogs.

The constitution of the United States says that every man is entitled to the right of life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness; but we know the black man in this country has never enjoyed this right. So we say let us define these terms for ourselves and draw up a constitution which will guarantee our basic necessities and end once and for all the criminal abuse directed against black people forever. all power to the people

upon the perpetrators of these atrocities, until revolution wipes the oppressor's bloody slate clean of all his foul deeds. Only when the oppressed have decided that an armed struggle is the only way that they can gain freedom from this monster called America can there be freedom

Anyone who decides that he is going to be free through armed struggle must realize that he is going to be considered subversive by the Fascist Power Structure. Being put in this category he will be subjected to harrassment, brutality, confinement for long periods of time and also murder. So this being the case each individual should mentally prepare himself for any of these situations. This mental preparedness will strengthen the revolutionary and consequently help him to be loyal to the cause that he is fighting for.

Realizing political education plays an important part in solidifying the revolutionary to the cause, there can never be enough emphasis put on the revolutionary's level of the correct political knowledge. The higher the political education level the more loyal the revolutionary, the more loyal his thoughts are, the more intense he is. This in itself will result in a faster victory for the people. With the correct knowledge, regardless of the situation the revolutionary can cope with it. This is especially important in confinement when the pig oppressor is using all of his pig tactics to get information or to psyche one into giving false information on a comrade, or comrades. If the revolutionary political education is high enough he will know that if he gives into the pig he will not only let himself down, he also will be letting the people down, perhaps to the exten of losing the struggle

Revolutionary struggle and loyalty must be carried out from the beginning to the end. This loyalty must deal with the seemingly trivial matters in the most efficient manner. Nothing can be taken lightly in the process of carrying out revolution. If it is giving out leaflets, or if it is selling newspapers. These tasks which may not seem strategic should still be done with the same zeal that a top secret mission would be done with. Functioning at a Free Breakfast Program, Free Clothing Program or at the Free Medical Clinic must be carried out earnestly. Sincerity and honesty from the revolutionary to the people has the most important part in the struggle because the people look at the revolutionary questionably. Until he has proven himself to be really for the people he will not be fully trusted. Loyalty to the masses by the revolutionary is another part of revolutionary loyalty, because the struggle is for the masses, carried out by the masses. There can be no half stepping or jiving, if there is then one becomes a reactionary in his practice. Therefore he does not aid the revolution but hinders it. With the correct political education, correct practice there will be revolutionary loyalty, the end result being victory for the people. No victory is achieved without sacrifices, that sacrifice may go to the extreme of one giving up his most precious possession, the breath in his own body. When this happens we can say that his is a revolutionary loyalty in its true sense. In revolution one wins or one dies.

ELAINE: No. our trip was organized by the Minister of Information of the Black Panther Party, Eldridge Cleaver, who as you know, has been forced into exile by the pigs; and has, however, used this opportunity to organize the International Section of the Black Panther Party, And in conjunction with the work of the International Section a visit was organized to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, In the early part of July, 10 of us left to meet with Eldridge and go on to Pyongyang, North Korea, The group was mainly composed of anti-war activists here in the

ELAINE: Yes we travelled from Pyongyang on to Hanoi and eventually wound up in Peking, People's Republic of China,

ELSA: Well that sounds like a very fascinating trip, let's go back to North Korea and begin there. What type of program was arranged for you there, what did you do?

ELAINE: Of course Americans do not frequent the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and we were welcomed with open arms. And as a matter of fact we were treated as delegates, as diplomats, representing the people as opposed to the government, the fascist, imperialist government of the United States. So that we were

called North Korea and South Korea, And in South Korea, of course, the government is a fascist government under American puppet Pak Jung Hi, who most Americans know as Chung Hee Park, because he allows the U.S. to change his name. But, at any rate, we were greeted warmly, and immediately we were impressed with the beauty and the life of the Korean people. There were children who greeted us at the airport, for example, who wore very colorful outfits, and they had flowers. And we were greeted by some of the officials of the Party Central Committee in Korea, From that time on we began to see for ourselves the realities of a human society and socialist country where the people have, as they themselves say, "nothing to envy in the world", and that they are strong and they are happy and that they have nothing to worry about in terms of attacks from other countries, from imperialist powers because they usually say that they have an impregnable fortress.

ELSA: It's a mountainous country

ELAINE: The Korean people have been very creative. And since they were able to defeat the United States in 1953 they have been building their society. So that, for example, the entire countryside has electricity in all houses and so forth - we're not talking about a completely rural society where there is no electricity, no toilet facilities and so forth. And it's very easy to see in Korea, especially what advances they've gained in this area, And they are moving, as I said, to free man from arduous labor, Politically; As I said we were greeted by the Committee for the Peaceful Reunification of the Fatherland. We were at Panmunjom, We saw the MP's at the DMZ, the line of demarcation. And you see all of a sudden, having seen the beauty of the people and how they can function together, and how they want to live together in peace and harmony, and you know that they have never aggressed upon any other country, and certainly ob-

viously not against the United

States, you see this country is divided. So their main aim is to reunify their one country. Korea is one country. It is not two, And it's only been through the U.S. invasion that their country has been split. So that their major goal at this time is to peacefully reunify their Fatherland.

ELSA: How do they expect to do that. Do they think it will be as a result of war ultimately, or do they think that it will be as a result of the fact that news travels fast and that if in fact their society is providing for their people more than the South Korean society is providing, that the South Koreans will arrange to do something about their condition? I mean how do they envisage what they want taking place?

ELAINE: Well first of all in South Korea, the people are not fooled by the pupper government there. There are constant moves. There are revolutionary organizations in the South that are fighting right now. The kind of fascism under which they live right now is - the degree the intenseness of of it is almost beyond belief, from the pictures and things we saw, of course we did not go into South Korea, But from the beginning Comrade Kim II Sung has issued statements that he would like, for example, just communications through letters to be permitted. Right now people that have relatives in the South can't write to them. They can have no communications, they cannot call them or write to them. They cannot on some holiday come and meet at the borders and say hello. So that they have been cut off from each other for years. But it is true that the people themselves are rising up. For example prior to Pak Jung Hi's being installed by the U.S.-C.I.A. as the so-called President of the South, Syghman Rhee was the President of the South. And the people themselves just completely threw him out of office. And what happened was that the U.S. government along with the C.I.A. operation, which at that time was headed by Kim Jong Pil, who is now running for President of the South, installed Pak Jung Hi through an alleged coup d'etat. But the people themselves are rising up. So that the only program that the North Korean people themselves are putting forward for example is a program of exchange of letters. Or exchange of food. People there in the South are starving and those in the North have the food and the ability to give them food. And they would like to just give their people food in the South. And they would also like to allow for free elections, have one election of all of the people there, North and South, free and open elections. But all of these moves have been denied. Right now as a matter of fact this is being discussed in the United Nations. I mean there are basic and very simple requests for in fact peaceful unification of Korea. ELSA: Do they broadcast from

North Korea into South Korea? ELAINE: As far as I know there is hardly any communication. The Pak Jung Hi regime is very tight and it does not allow hardly any propaganda to reach the South, the South Korean people. So that they are basically isolated from each other. That is why they would like to just open up communications. If they could talk to each other. they themselves, of course, could work out their own problems. But the U.S., of course, is interfering with this, and knows that if they would allow for free elections, that the people themselves would unite. And they would immediately

eliminate Pak Jung Hi from being President of the South, Because they never voted for the man. ELSA: What is their attitude toward China?

ELAINE: Well, of course, these are the socialist countries, and it would be foolish to say that they have anything but comradely love for each other. That they certainly have a common enemy, which is the U.S. imperialist. So that they are united in common struggle to, for example in terms of Korea, all of the Chinese and the Korean people are united around the Korean Fatherland. The Korean

has come up. That would be probably an American theory, Because the Korean people are an independent people, in fact that is a major point that they make. There is a phrase known as great * power chauvinism, that refers to an imperialist power. China is indeed a large country, but it has no intention of dominating a smaller country and doesn't * impose its will on smaller countries as the U.S. and some of * its allies do. But China recognizes the sovereignty and independence of other peoples, their right to their determination. So that the Korean people, the people are are living in the North are independent, it is their country. And that is not even an issue in Korea, to talk about being dominated by a large, major socialist country. The only threat they may have, may not come from China, but more probably from the social-imperialist country, known as Russia. But that isn't their preoccupation. What they are concerned with now is the reunification of their country, and the withdrawal of the over 50,000 U.S. troops which now occupy the Southern half of Korea, * under the United Nations banner. So that they are not concerned with aggression by their own friends, by their comrades-in arms, the Chinese people, or any other comrades, because they have common goals and they are agreed on all these points.

ELSA: Did you go direct from North Korea to Hanoi?

ELAINE: Yes, we spent most of our time in Korea, and we were





These are the kind of jurors that they are trying to say can judge young Black people who are simply saying and demanding and they've taken action to gain our freedom, our liberation and to bring about a new order. And this is the kind of order that they now have in the court, where they have people so old they can't control their bowels right there in the courtroom. This literaly happened And it is madness. This shows you their nature, what their plans are, to continue to try and use the courts to try to justify their actions. And then to stick people on juries and or have judges who not only can't control themselves, who can't think, who are so ingrained with fascism and racism that they don't even see anything except for the fact that these are Black people. They introduced this openly in the case of our Chairman in Chicago, to use this to justify all kinds of murders and acts of aggression upon our homes, upon our lives, you see. So that these are just excuses. They are using the courts right now and this is what you see when you come in. It's a very clear pattern. We learned that not only have they been attacking our offices in Philadelphia, but also our National Committee to Combat Fascism office in New Orleans. And just two months before this attack, the governor of New Orleans, who is obviously a Ku Klux Klan member, or something - certainly doesn't matter what organization he belongs to, he belongs to the U.S. government. His name is John McKisshen. This man said two months ago, when our N.C.C.F. office opened in New Orleans, that the Panthers are not going to survive there; that they didn't tolerate this kind of thing in his town, in his state; and, that they would show us. And they did. They attacked the office viciously. Every single person that was working with the N.C.C.F. was arrested, brutalized and not only that - 20 people were arrested in all - 13 of those were workers in our community center but the other 7 were people from the community. The area where our office is in New Orleans is an area where there is a major government housing project (Desire Projects), if people can understand figures, there are 10 thousand families that occupy this project in New Orleans, 10 thousand families, that is approximately 60 thousand people, occupy these projects. So that when they attacked our office in New Orleans they just began shooting at people and arresting people in the community. And out of the 20 they arrested, 7 were people just from the community, that had nothing to do, as such, with the Panther Party, or with the N.C.C.F. there. And then they had the nerve to issue the statement that they're looking for Willie Dawkins, Now I don't know why they claim that they're looking for a brother named Willie Dawkins, because he hasn't been hiding. To say you're looking for somebody tends to imply that they are lost or something, Well, Willie Dawkins hasn't been hiding. In fact he's been doing very key work, he was one of the key organizers of the Convention in Philadelphia, But maybe he passed through New Orleans a year ago or something. He's never worked officially in New Orleans. Yet they have a warrant that's





PREVENTIVE DETENTION AND POLITICAL PRISONERS

To all the people and the members of the Black Panther Party What I want to say first of all is ALL POWER TO THE PEOPLE and we will surely win.

As we look out over the vast reaches of Babylon (Amerika), from Connecticut to California, from Wisconsin to Louisaina, we see that there are untold numbers of political prisoners in jails (concentration camps) across

(concentration camps) across
Babylon. We also see that the vast
majority of these prisoners are in
fact revolutionaries, conscious of
their situation. So then we check
out what conscious of their situation means and we will begin to
understand what preventative detention means.

The political prisoner is no new phenomena that fell out of the sky but is as old as politics itself. A political prisoner is one who is imprisoned for his political beliefs and views by whatever status quo happens to be in power at a particular time, The political prisoner is dedicated to abolishing the status quo by any means necessary. He is, in fact, by not being willing to submit to the brutal oppression being waged against his people, a revolutionary. He would cease to be a revolutionary if he were to accept or submit to daily oppression meted out by the vicious oppressor.

Huey has taught us that the difference between the political prisoner and the common prisoner (Huey has called them the illegitemate capitalist) is that the sole reason the political prisoner is detained is because of his activities to change/abolish the immediate society, and for the political prisoner to be (so called) rehabilitated would be tantamount to rejecting all of his revolutionary ideas, ideals and objectives, which are in fact the reason he is there.

The common (illegitamate capitalist prisoner) on the other hand is there Lecause of his efforts to get the same material possessions that his oppressor has, but in a way deemed by the oppressor to be illegitamate (a crime). He is willing to be rehabilitated, not in the sense of changing his values, but with the hopes of getting out sooner to take up his same old ways, but only with more success. So we see that the oppressor is willing to let the illegitamate capitalists back out into society to repeat his endeavors because he knows that he is not a threat to his existence or his power. In fact the illegitamate capitalist is actually helping to reinforce his position.

So then we come back to the political prisoner and it would be disasterous (for the ruling class) to let these revolutionaries go, because they still have their unshakeable beliefs and concepts and to let them go without breaking the will to resist would only serve to solidify the revolutionary's position. (We have only to look as far as Huey to verify this).

So then the oppressor thinks that he has an invincible weapon to combat the unrelenting position of the political prisoner, which he calls preventative detention. That is, to keep the prisoner incarcerated to prevent him from spreading the concepts and beliefs that he is there for. The oppressor is not so much afraid of the physical man. It is the ideas and the unshakeable will that

horrifies him. And he (the oppressor) doesn't understand that
the very weapon (preventative detention) he is using against the
Black Panther Party is like a
shot of adrenalin, it only makes
the revolutionary that much
stronger. He can't understand the
words spoken by Deputy Chairman
Fred that you can jail a revolutionary but you can't jail a revolution. He is blind to the fact
that ideas and not bodies motivate a great historic struggle.

So we see that the concept and the reality of preventative detention is merely a stepping stone to higher levels for prisoners jailed for their political beliefs, and we see that preventative detention is nothing more than another obstacle thrown in the way by those (the ruling class) that are laboring so desperately against what they know is to be the inevitable. At this stage of the struggle the oppressor thinks that his weapon of preventative detention is most potent. But we in the people's struggle know it to be nothing but another weapon that is already obsolete. Some revolutionaries are subject to be deluded momentarily by the outward sense of strength and power by the oppressor not understanding that he is on the verge of extinction, trying to make a last desperate effort to stop the raging tide of the revolution.

VI. APPELLANT'S CONDUCT DID NOT CONSTITUTE CONTEMPT WITHIN THE SCOPE OF 18U.S.C.

None of the cited incidents constitutes a violation of 18 U.S.C. • 401 (152).

That section provides in pertinent part: "A court of the United States shall have power to punish by fine or imprisonment, at its discretion, such contempt of its authority, and none other, as -- (1) Misbehavior of any person in its presence or so near thereto as to obstruct the administration of justice."

A. Incidents 1, 2, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 12, 13, 15 and 16 Were Not Contemptuous Because Appellant's Remarks Were Necessary, or at Least Reasonably Believed Necessary, to Preserve His Constitutional Claims for Appellate Re-

During trial appellant sought to assert and, if denied, to preserve for appeal two claims; his right to the assistance of attorney Garry and his right to represent himself. Appellant (Bobby) had a legal obligation to first present these matters to the trial court; complete silence by appellant might well have entailed their waiver (153). Moreover, it was essential not merely to raise his claims but to present the court with the facts and arguments as to why they were legitimate. Thus, for the trial court intelligently to rule on appellant's claims it was essential that it be informed, for example, that Seale had never agreed to be represented by any attorney other than Garry, and that he had not known until September 25 that Garry would not be at trial. But the court, see supra, Argument I, refused to allow any inquiry into such facts. For appellant to get those essential facts on the record he had to defy the trial court's attempts to silence

Appellant's objections and requests were relevant whenever some statement or action on his behalf was appropriate. The first cited incident consisted solely of his reading of his September 26 motion firing his attorneys of record other than Garry and asking for a continuance. Compare Holt v. Virginia, 381 U.S. 131 (1965).


The trial court could, of course, have easily obviated the need for repetition of objections and requests by ruling that, once denied, they need not be repeated at every relevant juncture (154). However, it took a firm position that all objections had to be repeated at every relevant occasion if they were to be preserved. This was evident from the very first day of the trial when Weinglass sought to object to certain prosecution evidence on the ground that no foundation had been laid, an objection which the court had already rejected:

MR. WEINGLASS: To avoid repetition, may I have a standing objection.

THE COURT: I don't deal in standing objections on anything. MR, WEINGLASS: I will state my

objection once again. THE COURT: Every time you have an objection you make it, and every time you make one, I will rule on it. I might sustain it, too.

(TR 113) Thereafter defense counsel repeated previously rejected objec-



tions throughout the trial (155), vant to the charges against him However, when appellant renewed his objections and requests at appropriate points, the court abruptly silenced him without ever indicating why it was improper for him to renew his claims. The court, moreover, reacted differently to appellant's remarks and requests, at times ignoring them, at times loguy (discussion) and a ruling, any right to speak and issuing some sort of threat (156).

Appellant was thus confronted with a dilemma. The court's direction that objections be repeated was quite explicit and uniformly applied; the court's opposition to appellant's remarks was to be gleaned (gathered) from a series of erratic ad hoc orders. Appellant had ample reason to doubt whether the court's erratic hostility to his remarks would be treated as an excuse for his failings to renew his claims. And appellant's fears in this regard were aggravated by the trial court's and the prosecution's continual assertions that he was represented by Kunstler and therefore that he had in effect waived his Sixth Amendment rights, and their overt attempts to coerce an explicit waiver of those rights (157).

Later in the day, after appellant had been bound and gagged by the marshals, the prosecution suggested to the court that if the court informed appellant that his "objection" was preserved, he might agree to sit quietly through the trial. Only then did the court offer appellant any sort of assurance, telling him that all of his "constitutional and statutory rights have been and will be preserved in the trial." (160)

160. TR 4764-65. With regard to the subsequent contempt charges, these statements were plainly inadequate to make it clear that further objection was unnecessary. The court's statement that appellant's "rights" rather than his "objections" had been and would be preserved seemed a mere reassertion that appellant was infact receiving all the rights and privileges accorded to him by federal law. More fundamentally, it was unreasonable to assume that appellant, five weeks into a trial dominated by hostile exchanges and at the time enraged by his bonds, would understand or accept legal advice from the court and the prosecution which had persecuted him for so many weeks.

While as a general rule even invalid court orders must be obeyed, an essential exception has been recognized by federal courts where disobedience is, or is reasonably believed to be, necessary to make or preserve a record for appeal. Ordinary court orders, if erroneous, are readily remediable on appeal, but an order which obstructs the making of a record or the presentation of an important right undermines the very appeal process itself.

Thus, in Re McConnell (161) the plaintiff's attorney was torn between the defense counsel's insistence that he ask certain questions before the jury, as is literally required by F. R. Civ. P. 43 (c), and the trial court's order that he not do so. This order "placed (plaintiff's) counsel in quite a dilemma because...there was no way of knowing with certainty whether the court of appeals would treat the trial court's order to dispense with questions before the jury as an excuse for his failure to comply with the Rule." (370 U.S. at 252) Counsel resolved this dilemma by repeatedly objecting that questions in the presence of the jury were proper, and even threatening to ask them maless stopped by a bailiff. For this coaduct he was held in contempt and sentenced to 10 days in jail by the trial court.

161, 370 U.S. 230 (1962), decided by this Court sub nom. Parme-

lee Transportation Company v. Keeshin, 294 F.2d 310 (7th Cir. (END OF FOOTNOTE)

On appeal, this Court reduced the penalty to a \$100 fine. While acknowledging a general obligation to seek "redress in the court of review", this Court held that the alleged contemnor had a right to make a record to provide a "proper basis for review", and was immune from punishment for good faith representation of his client until he had been permitted to make such a record, This Court reasoned that only the threat to ask the forbidden questions unless physically restrained was punishable, and that for it only a very slight penalty was appropriate (162).

162. 294 F.2d 310.

Judge Duffy dissented, urging that any punishment at all was inappropriate:

The attorneys for plaintiff were driven to a sense of frustration due to the District Court's rulings on offers of proof. Under such circumstances, it is understandable that an attorney might say things which should not have been said. (294 F.2d at 317) (END OF FOOTNOTE)

The Supreme Court, stressing the dilemma which the alleged contemnor faced, reasoned that his conduct had not interfered with the performance of a judicial duty and therefore reversed the conviction in its entirety. Both this Court and the Supreme Court agreed that It was irrelevant to their decision whether plaintiff's counsel was in fact entitled to ask questions in the presence of the jury, so long as he believed in good faith that he was required to do so (370 U.S. at 232, n. 4; 294 F.2d at 313) (163).

United States. 182 F.2d 880, 887 (9th Cir. 1950). an attorney was cited for contempt because, inter alia, he asked a series of similar prejudicial questions in the presence of the jury, even though the trial court repeatedly sustained objections to the questions. The contemnor urged that "before the (court's alleged error in barring the questions) can be considered elsewhere, the record must be sufficiently explicit to enable a reviewing court to understand the nature and purpose of the excluded evidence." The court of appeals agreed with this general proposition of law, but held it afforded no defense because an adequate record had been made before the contempt oc-

Appellant does not claim any general right to disobey court orders merely because they may be erroneous or even unconstitutional. But fundamental fairness requires that appellant not be forced to guess at his peril which of two inconsistent and unreconciled court orders must be obeyed and which may be disregarded (164). Since the actions of the court and the prosecution brought into question the availability of "an adequate remedy...by way of appeal" (165) for the denial of appellant's Sixth Amendment claims, his repeated objections in the above-cited 11 incidents cannot be punished as contempt.

true nature when dealing with Black soldiers. The brothers are the main soldiers to be sent to the front line in Vietnam. The greedy. blood-thirsty nature of pigs enables them to use peoples' lives, especially Black people's lives as expendable items for profit sake. Some people may not want to believe this but the government has brothers in the stockade for the purpose of denying benefits to Black soldiers who are wounded in Vietnam because of their political beliefs. The following brothers are in the Fort Dix, New Jersey stockade for such reasons:

A brother by the name of Mc-Cloud from Brooklyn, N.Y., was put in the stockade for 10 months for going AWOL, At the time the U.S. Army knew full well that the brother had been incarcerated at Riker Island for supposedly committing a robbery which the pigs had no proof of. The Army could have vouched for the brother but instead, allowed the local pigs to keep him in jail for eighteen months. After getting off the rock (Rickers Island), this racist government had the nerve to try him for going AWOL, knowing his whereabouts for the past eighteen dope. The pigs have no proof except months.

Another brother by the name of Tare had hurt his back while he was in the Nam. When he got back he asked to " medical discharge. These two brothers have been in fighting. the stockade for the same amount of time and are to this day still SET OUR BROTHERS FREE there on trumped-up charges.

Brother Bobby Burton had injuries of his leg and arm while he was in Vietnam. This brother tried also to get a medical discharge,

Pigs are known to show their he also was due to receive about \$700,00 a month in benefits. In mid-May, pigs planted dope on the brother and are now in the process of railroading him to jail for a possible three to five years. If he is found guilty he will receive a Bad Conduct Discharge, which under this system would disqualify him

Mike Moore, while over in the Nam became addicted to opium, like so many others. Now this brother had served four years in Vietnam for this racist, sadistic government and when he got back to the states, he asked the Army to help him. The pigs told him that the Army didn't have any rehabilitation centers and instead of helping him in any way the pigs gave the brother active duty in the fascist states of Babylon, He went AWOL to try and support his habit. Mike Moore has been in the stockade for over nine

Another brother by the name of Max got his leg messed up in Vietnam. When he got back he was admitted to a hospital. After a short stay, the pigs snatched him out of the hospital and put him in the stockade for supposedly dealing that he was supposed to receive \$300.00-\$400.00 a month in benefits and the pigs would lose more money to a nigger.

In Soledad State Prison, as in prisons throughout this country, brothers are being subjected to extreme persecution, a mental and physical torture, by the fascist institution and its racist lackeys -the prison guards. There have been several examples of brothers being charged with trumped-up charges of murder of a prison guard, for the sole reason that they are Black, poor and are revolutionaries.

The most recent example of the racism and fascism rampant in Soledad Prison is the case of seven brothers from L.A. County who have been charged with the murder of a prison guard. On July 23rd, aguard was allegedly stabbed

of Soledad, Several brothers were placed in the hole and held incommunicado. These brothers were denied their rights and privileges. Some brothers were transferred to other prisons and the rest were held in detention for more than a month while the mad-dog administrators Fitzharris and Donnelly, working hand-in-hand with this system of injustice, fabricated a case, built their evidence and finally charged seven brothers with murder and conspiracy to commit murder.

Everyday, the chief pig, the pig D.A. would harass the brothers to take lie-detector tests, saying that the tests doesn't prove or mean anything. Unable to convince the over 40 times in the North Wing brothers to admit to something

they have no connection with, the fascist pigs of Soledad also tried three means of deception: (1) informers--Black, White, Brown plants were placed among the brothers in hopes of breaking them; (2) cold reality-of a worse prison. longer terms and death was daily shoved into the consciousness of the brothers and (3) doubt-otherwise known as divide and conquer. The pigs attempted to physically and ultimately mentally divide the brothers. Jesse Phillips was left alone on 'O' Wing, Roosevelt Williams was moved to the 'X' Wing (hole designated for homosexuals and informers). James 'Doc' Holiday was kidnapped in the middle of the night and shipped to Folsom. Many brothers went to San Quentin and a few brothers destination is unknown.

On September 18th, Barnes, Assistant Chief D.A. of Monterey, finally filed charges against Jesse Lee Phillips, 20 yrs; Roosevelt Williams Jr., 26; Jimmy James, 23; James Wagner, 26; Alfred Dunn; O.C. Allen, 25; and Walter Jose Watson.



B. Appellant's Remarks During Incidents 6, 7 and 11 Were Not Contemptuous Because Those Remarks Were Necessary, or at Least Because Appellant Reasonably Believed Them Necessary, to Present a Defense to the Charges Being Tried.

In addition to this problem about preserving his claims for review. appellant faced a second and even more excruciating dilemma. The prosecution and the court consistently maintained that he was properly represented by Kunstler because the latter had filed an appearance for him. The clear implication was that if Kunstler did represent him at trial it would provide further proof that Seale had waived his rights to Garry and to self-representation. At no time Id either the prosecution or the court suggest that once appellant's

claims had been denied, Kunstler could proceed to act on his behalf without impairing appellant's right to subsequent review of those denials. Through no fault of his own. therefore, appellant was put in an impossible position, for he was forced to choose between representation by Kunstler, whom he barely knew, whom he did not want, with whom he had never consulted regarding his defense, and, most important, whose involvement threatened a loss of appellant's claim to representation by Garry or by himself, and sitting entirely defenseless through a criminal prosecution which might lead to ten years' imprisonment. Throughout the trial, appellant vainly pleaded that "someone" had to ask questions for him (166). It is understandable that appellant felt he had no choice but to press with increasing persistence for the only alternative to waiver and defenselessness - self-representa-

Thus, although appellant refrained in general from questioning witnesses, he performed other legal functions on his own

behalf several times. He asked spectators to obey the court's orders (167) and objected when the prosecution inaccurately described a photograph being offered as an exhibit (168) and when the prosecution misrepresented to the court the content of a statement by appellant to the spectators (169). The court cited these actions and the colloquies which ensued therefrom as contemptuous (170).

The court had an obligation to make it clear that unwanted representation could have been accepted without compromising appellant's claim to self-representation or to a different attorney. Since the court failed to do so. and instead implied that acceptance of such representation would indeed constitute a waiver of constitutional claims, appellant cannot be punished for refusing such representation and attempting to present his own defense.

> HOSPITAL **PRACTICES** GENOCIDE

Attempted genocide, as practiced by hospital personnel and reactionary doctors is a common everyday occurance wherever poverty exists. In areas where money is readily available there is no problem getting proper medi-

The bureaucratic capitalist of the hospital system practice genocide mainly through their bureaurocracy. When you enter the emergency ward they ask you a million irrelevant questions before a doctor ever asks you what is hurting you. They use the excuse of not wanting to get tied up in a lawsuit as a way out, but the people can see that in actuality they don't give a heck about the well being of the people they are supposed to serve.

A good example of this fascist tactic is what happened recently to a sister named Fay in Los Angeles. On Sunday, September 20th two brothers Henry, and Rick, were going door to door with newspapers and information to get out to the people. When they got to Faye's door they found the sister in too much pain to walk. They called the nearest N.C.C.F. Community Information Center to arrange a ride to the hospital for the sister. After arriving at the emergency ward of Morningside hospital, and filling out a number of forms, the sister was told that they could not examine or treat her without her parents signature because she was only 18 years old.

The sister lived with her grandmother. Her parents are nowhere around, yet the fascists demanded the signature of her parents. After nearly begging for anhour they finally agreed to seeing her with only her grandmother's consent "over the phone." If they finally gave in and examined her, they could have done so from the start. This is just one tactic used by the ruling class to oppress the poor masses of the people who know no better. But the people are waking up and will not stand for anymore murdering and killing of their brothers and sisters. As the masses awake and continue to struggle, justice will be brought to those who deserve it.

PHILLY FASCISTS BRUTALIZE PREGNANT WOMAN AND HER HUSBAND

The beast of fascist terrorism here in Philly has extended its bloody claws from the confines of the Black Colony into the White Mother Country, In the communitysponsored court action to depose (remove from office) 'Bozo' (Rizzo) from his fascist throne as chief pig of Philly, the Party was informed of another of Bozo's hideous crimes against the people.

Sunday morning, September 20, Oliver Locke, a White construction worker and his wife, Linda, who is five months pregnant were the victims of an attack conducted by Philly's Finest Swine, At 8:00 a,m. that morning, Locke looked out their 3rd floor window and noticed that someone had broken into a friend's car parked on the street below. (The owner of the car, Bill Perry, who lives at the same Mascher Street address as the Lockes, has also been constantly subjected to pig tactics of harass- who was looking out the window, ment and illegal seizure), Seeing someone looking through some papers in the car, Bill, naturally decided to tell Perry.

Perry took a glass of water and poured it out the window to let whoever it was know that he was watching. Well, who else would it turn out to be but one of Rizzo's law and order boys! A few drops of water hit his feet, which scared him; being caughtre-hooved in this illegal act, he dashed to his car and oinked an "Assist Pig" over the radio. As evidence of the pigs' fascist moves, there were 12 pigmobiles and three wagons surrounding the house, including highway patrol pigs in the backyard with shotguns within a few seconds.

Meanwhile, twenty pigs were doing a job on Locke, beating him with clubs. They threw him out in the street, blood streaming down his face from where his head was split open. The pigs dragged Linda out by her hair (still only in her nightgown) who screamed, "If that's all you can beat is pregnat women, you're nothing but filthy pigs! Go home and beat your own wives!" Moffa oinked, "Take Pig Ir, Mafioso Moff arrived on She kicked him, only to be grabbed her, too." Another foul element

too?" pointing to Bill Perry and his wife, Toy. "We'll get them later," Moffa replied.

The pigs threw Linda into the wagon by her hair and was taken to the 25th Pig District and then to Temple Hospital where she was x-rayed and the baby's heartbeat listened for. Locke was taken to pig headquarters at 8th and Race and then taken to Episcopal Hospital where the wounds in his head were stitched up, Linda was let out on \$300 bail and Locke on \$800 at a hearing Sunday after being incarceratd for 10 hours with no food or water. During the hearing, Bill Perry told the judge that the pig broke into the house illegally only to find himself being dragged outside by two pigs and told to get a haircut.

FALLS AT THE HANDS OF HIRED PIG MERCENARIES

Due to the constant escalation of the peoples political consciousness in this city caused by the gestapo raids conducted against the Black Panther Party in Philadelphia, and the commencing of the Revolutionary People's Plenary Session and also the offing of a pig in a guard house, the pigs have gotten uptight and are shooting potential revolutionaries at random.

On September 9, 1970, Babylon claimed another Black body that was forced to live by the repression that exists in this country. Once again Black persons have chosen to liberate money to meet their basic needs and wants rather than wait for this government, that has proved to be apathetic. Irwin Bundy who lived near 53rd & Chestnut Streets, along with some other brothers attempted to rip off the Gatewood Realty Corp., 5151 Walnut St., which has been described by the people in the community as being a foul slumlord. Irwin entered the office and exited into the street to find pig Lt. Edward McDonough and Pig Frank Celluci. Brother Irwin began to run and the pigs gave chase with pig Celluci opening fire on the brother without firing a warning shot or giving any kind of signal to let the brother know his escape attempt was futile. The brother dropped the gun and kept running. The first shot fell in front of the Afro-American Auto Insurance Agency located at 51 Walnut St. protest-aimed right between the Having realized the brother had thrown his gun away and was slow-DEATH TO THE FASCIST PICS; ing down, pig Celluci fired again hitting Bundy in the back of the neck. The impact was so forceful it took this brother off his feet. Irwin Bundy who layed seriously wounded, was choked by an unidentified pig, who claimed to attempt to terminate the bleeding. Lt. Flintstone Fencl was on the scene oinking to the people that it was self-defense. He did this to prevent the people from moving on behalf of the brother.

Too many times have Black people been shot in the back, shot while sleeping in their beds, or by some other act of genocide being practiced by the pigs, and it has been labeled justifiable homicide. The pig stated that Irwin turned and Bundy pointed and that is why he fired. This is clearly an outrageous fabrication because the brother was shot in the back of his neck.

This amounts to two brothers that have been murdered by these hired mecenaries in less than three weeks. Robert Clark was the brother that was killed by a pig in North Philly, because he allegedly attacked him with a knife. These are all social deaths that can and must be eliminated. Boys' Rizzo has ordered the pre-dawn raids against the Party, along with the ruthless killings of our comrades in the streets, All in all, the pigs are retaliating for the one pig that was offed by killing innocent people, while subjecting others to harassment. There is only one language that the pigs understand, and that is the language of the gun.

MEXICO CITY **AUGUST 30, 1970**

October 2, 1970, marks the second anniversary of the masat Tlatelolco, Mexico. During the 1968 Mexican Student Movement (immediately preceeding the Olympic Games), police and soldiers descended upon a peaceful mass meeting in the Plaza of Three Cultures and shot and bayonetted to death an estimated 500 students, teachers,

workers and bystanders. Bodies were carried off unidentified, many of the wounded were killed rather than taken to a hospital, and doctors in hospitals helplessly watched many bayonetted victims bleed to death while the authorities refused to admit blood donations from friends.

During the entire 1968 Student Movement the police consistently terrorized real and suspected leaders of the movement. They were harassed, arrested, tortured and even murdered, Over 150 political prisoners are still being held in Mexico City jails. Most of them have neither been tried nor sentenced. They have been imprisoned for over two years.

As a protest against this form of political repression, a boycott

of Mexico and Mexican products has been called. There is also an international effort to organize acts of protest before Mexican Embassies and Consulates throughout the world. These demonstrations will appropriately take place on October 2, 1970.

What We Want What We Believe



Huey P. Newton Minister of Defense Black Panther Party

1. We want freedom. We want power to determine the destiny of our Black Community.

We believe that black people will not be free until we are able to determine our destiny.

2. We want full employment for our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white American businessmen will not give full employment, then the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living

3. We want an end to the robbery by the CAPITALIST of our Black Community.

We believe that this racist government has robbed us and now we are demanding the overdue debt of forty acres and two mules. Forty acres and two mules was promised 100 years ago as restitution for slave labor and mass murder of black people. We will accept the payment in currency which will be distributed to our many communities. The Germans are now aiding the Jews in Israel for the genocide of the Jewish people. The Germans murdered six million Jews. The American racist has taken part in the slaughter of over fifty million black people; therefore, we feel that this is a modest demand that we make.

4. We want decent housing, fit for shelter of human beings.

We believe that if the white fandlords will not give decent housing to our black community, then the housing and the land should be made into cooperatives so that our community, with government aid, can build and make decent housing for its people.

5. We want education for our people that exposes the true nature of this decadent American society. We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present-day society.

We believe in an educational system that will give to our people a knowledge of self. If a man does not have knowledge of himself and his position in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

6. We want all black men to be exempt from military service.

We believe that Black people should not be forced to fight in the military service to defend a racist government that does not protect us. We will not fight and kill other people of color in the world who, like black people, are being victimized by the white racist government of America. We will protect ourselves from the force and violence of the racist police and the racist military, by whatever means necessary.

7. We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY and MURDER of black people.

We believe we can end police brutality in our black community by organizing black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all black people should arm themselves for self-defense.

8. We want freedom for all black men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails.

We believe that all black people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

9. We want all black people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peer group or people from their black communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that black people will receive fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a man a right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the black community from which the black defendant came. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man" of the black community.

10. We want land, bread, housing, education, clothing, justice and peace. And as our major political objective, a United Nations-supervised plebiscite to be held throughout the black colony in which only black colonial subjects will be allowed to participate, for the purpose of determining the will of black people as to their national destiny.

When, in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume, among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and, accordingly, all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed But, when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same object, evinces a design to reduce them under absolute despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new guards for their future security.

HOSPITAL LINCOLN


Lincoln Hospital was thrown together in 1835 as a home for slaves who could no longer serve the needs of their money hungry masters. Since then, they have moved to another level. Lincoln Hospital is now used to perpetrate genocide against the poor Black and Puerto Ricans who are forced to use the facilities. Lincoln, with only 350 beds, is the only hospital in a community of 500,000 people. This is no accident because again, it is used as an instrument of death and destruction by the power structure. Hospitals are supposed to serve the people, but Lincoln serves the pigs through its genocidal type medical service and care. Perhaps one of the most recent, outstanding examples of this occurred in the OB/GYN department. As of July 1, 1970, it became legal for women to have abortions. The law in and of itself is very progressive, for it gives women the freedom to decide whether or not they want to have a child once they become pregnant. However, within the context of a capitalist society many progressive programs and laws which were intended to help the people, have become avenues for oppression, destruction and death. Such is the case with the new abortion law. The first death to occur as a result of this new abortion law was at Lincoln Hospital. The operation was performed under the direction of Dr. Joseph Jay Smith, head of OB/ GYN; the victim, Carmen Rodriguez, Albert Einstein College of Medicine, which supplies the hospital with interns, residents, and

doctors, is a factory which produces racist, mercenary doctors whose only interest is the knowledge and profit gained by experimenting on Black and Puerto Rican people, Carmen Rodriguez was one of those experiments.

Sister Carmen had to have an abortion. She had a heart disease and suffered from asthma, The doctors said that if she didn't have a heart operation, she would die giving birth. From this it is very clear to see why she couldn't have the baby. The doctor gave her

The workers in the hospitals and the community decided to move on J.J. Smith. They told him that he had to leave; because it was clear that he had no regard for human life and due to his racist actions which had lead to the unjust firing of a Black doctor, J.J. tried to pacify the community by reinstating the Black doctor, The community saw this action for what it was and still insisted that he leave the hospital at once. J.J. began to vacillate, he called on everyone but his mamma, said that the community was "interfering with patient care" didn't come to work. They completely abandoned the sisters who had come for their help. These sisters were made to either go home or transfer to other overcrowded hospitals. Even the bedridden were turned out. The doctors finally came back

after a week, but only after they were assured that the community would not be allowed to interfere with the genocidal programs and services of the hospital. The hospital is now an armed camp; pigs are everywhere to insure that the community does not interfere with the butcher shop operations of the hospital. From a recent visit as

something to kill the baby and make her abort. This caused Carmen to have a heart seizure. The doctors treated her for asthma which is dangerous for patients with heart disease. After an hour, they found the real problem, there has been no reasonable explanation as to why it took so long for some "doctors" to tell the difference between a heart seizure and an asthma attack. By that time the sister had another seizure, because of the doctors' negligence along with his staff, the sister died.

Finally the community got tired of his jive and told him to get to stepping or else.

When he left, 24 of the 27 doctors left in support of J.J. Smith, their partner in crime. One of the doctors that stayed was the Black doctor. This was indeed a clear indication of what the majority of doctors felt about the actions of J.J. Smith. For what kind of doctors would leave wards of patients unattended to show that Einstein was still all powerful? For a week these "doctors" who

the pictures indicate, the waiting rooms are still crowded, the hospital is unsanitary and the service is very poor, to mention but a few of the short comings.

In order to insure our salvation the people, along with the revolutionary doctors, nurses, techniclans and other workers must completely take over the hospital. For life has become a contradiction, when the society through its very institutions plots death and destruction for its people.

Paul Redd and Jackie Johnson are no longer members of the Black Panther Party: Because they didn't measure up to the standards of a Panther, they will no longer participate or function as Party members.

Isaiah Houston, Wayne Pharr, and James Spencer are no longer members of the Black Panther Party. Their practice has been erratic and they have not measured up to the standard

They say the Black Panthers are crazy, they say that they are gangsters, hoodlums, thieves, liars and fools because they are standing up and throwing off the shackles that have held us for so long in bondage, held us for so long in the dark, like an animal in a dark cave looking out afraid to move because of fear instilled with him. But what they are really saying inside those closed doors - where all the big time capitalist, the big politicians, and the other leading fools get together to decide just what kind of a plot would be effective enough to get rid of those niggers with the guns - is, that we are men and women who have stood up and gotten off our knees and have taken this foot off our neck. We have gotten off our knees to grab any available weapon near to deal with the man who comes around the house every month, with the nerve to ask Mama, "where's his rent money." (WE WANT AN END TO THE ROBBERY BY THE CAPITALIST OF OUR BLACK COMMUNITY.)

You feel mad and sick and tired of seeing her cry every night because she loves you, but can't give you the proper food and clothing that you need so badly, you see your father out there, old, tired and sick, working on two or more jobs trying to make enough money to keep his family living from day to day. (WE WANT FULL EMPLOYMENT FOR OUR PEOPLE.) There are the children, you love them all, and want them to have the best, but you know that the dream is an impossibility. (WE WANT EDUCATION FOR OUR PEOPLE THAT EXPOSES THE TRUE NATURE OF THIS DECADENT AMERICAN SOCIETY. WE WANT EDUCATION THAT TEACHES US OUR TRUE HISTORY AND OUR ROLE IN THE PRESENT DAY SOCIETY.)

Things are bad, the children are fed up and they go through all kinds of changes trying to escape the big hand of oppression that seems to constantly swing out at you to pull you back into the hole you are so desperately trying to get out of.

The pig phones your mama and tells her that they arrested her son for robbery, (WE WANT FREEDOM FOR ALL BLACK MEN HELD IN FEDERAL, STATE, COUNTY AND CITY PRISONS AND JAILS) or that they have your daughter in juvenile hall because she took a coat to wear

to keep from freezing to death at home when it rains, and water is everywhere from all the holes the landlord has been promising to fix ever since you moved in. (WE WANT DECENT HOUSING, FIT FOR SHELTER OF HUMAN BEINGS) and they send your child to jail to serve time only for taking what was rightfully theirs. (WE WANT ALL BLACK PEOPLE WHEN BROUGHT TO TRIAL TO BE TRIED IN COURT BY A JURY OF THEIR PEER GROUP OR PEOPLE FROM THEIR BLACK COMMUNITIES, AS DEFINED BY THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES.) Your older son has run away to join the service not knowing what he is doing, but thinking that this is a way out. (WE WANT ALL BLACK MEN TO BE EXEMPT FROM MILITARY SERVICE.) You sit down and you begin to cry, you wonder where you failed in raising your children, you wonder just what you did to push them to this. But it's not a question of fail on your part, just stop for a second and think, think of all the times, all the years they've seen you suffer, all the times they saw you go without to make sure that they had

The brothers and sisters now are changing all of this, the members of the Black Panther Party know what they must do and they are going forth in a beautiful fashion known as love for their people, revolutionary love for each other and what is known as

It seemed strange to a lot of people, they were confused and didn't know what those Black Panthers were up to, or what they wanted, (WE WANT FREEDOM, WE WANT POWER TO DETERMINE THE DESTINY OF OUR BLACK COMMUNITY.) They were lied to by pigs and the news media. They built the Panthers up as being wrong-doers, but they never printed in their paper our ten point platform and program, or what the real cause behind Lil' Bobby and so many endless others was for being MURDERED; or why Bobby Seale our Chairman, was gagged and chained to a chair in a courtroom of so-called justice. For this we have been labled every insult known, our brothers and sisters have been jailed on instant or charges put together with time and precision so

keep them away from the people by making them seem insane killers.






