CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I

Section 1. A Democratic Society is an organization of young people in the United States to create a national movement of autonomous political education and action to help the people liberate and realize, individually and collectively, their potentialities.

It is a voluntary organization of individuals who act of their own free will, under the control of the decisions which they make, and the decisions to which they are dependent in order to influence through their conduct the course of events and the development of the society. It is a movement of young people, individuals and groups, organized and united to participate in the struggle to end the present economic, political and social system and to create a new society which will include the liberation of man.

ARTICLE II

The apex of the organization shall be the National Convention.

ARTICLE III

Members of a Democratic Society shall be affiliated with the League for Industrial Democracy, Inc., or another organization which is committed to the struggle of democracy and all areas of social, cultural and economic life.

ARTICLE IV

Section 1. Membership is open to students, faculty, and others who share the common goal of the organization to democracy in every area of social life.

Section 2. SDS is an organization of and for students in the United States, and is composed of those with similar interests, but there is no restriction on who can join. SDS activities shall be for governmental, social, and political education.

Section 3. SDS has the present and potential of national scope and shall be determined by the National Council.

Section 4. Any individual who does not wish to join the SDS, but who shares the major elements of the organizational philosophy, may be admitted to the National Council.

ARTICLE V

Section 1. Any group of three or more members may apply to the National Office for charter as a chapter.

Section 2. A chapter may be chartered in any locality in the United States to be governed by the decisions of the local members of the chapter. Each chapter is free to determine its own structure, but it is a responsibility that a representative statement of principles and objectives be developed and approved by the central Bureau for circulation to the general membership in the form of a letter which will state the chapter's financial standing, the chapter's goals, its approved officers of the Executive of the President.

Section 3. Chapters are expected to support other local areas of policy and activity in the National Office according to the National Council's recommendations. Each chapter shall be free to determine its own structure, but it is a responsibility that a representative statement of principles and objectives be developed and approved by the central Bureau for circulation to the general membership in the form of a letter which will state the chapter's financial standing, the chapter's goals, its approved officers of the Executive of the President.

Section 4. Chapters chartered through independent groups are eligible as members of SDS, if the vast majority of their membership and majority of their resources are devoted to SDS.

Section 6. National Representative Meetings or regional conferences which progress toward organizing an organization with the League for Industrial Democracy, Inc., may be held by the National Council and be held in the United States and beyond national boundaries. Such organizations shall operate as national organizations and shall be members of SDS.

Section 7. SDS welcomes the opportunity to cooperate with other individuals and organizations to carry out its objectives in areas where approved and coordinated efforts would be most effective. The National Council shall be empowered to determine specific agreements relating. Cooperation does not imply endorsement.

ARTICLE VI

Section 1. The SDS shall consist of national, state, and local chapters free to be formed by the National Council.
