













# electoral politics: chicago cip

A meeting called by the Chicago Citizens for the Independent Political Action on July 17th ended unexpectedly to leave the Chicago Independent Party in a state of confusion and uncertainty. The group, organized in the 1940s because of the Negroes had been, elected a platform and elected two candidates for the November election. They nominated two Arthur Hays Sulzberg for State Treasurer and Nathan Green for State Representative, both were residents of Rogers Park.

The new party needs to address itself to a major problem facing voters in Chicago. First is the realization of the established political power to provide education and constructive alternatives to the social system, the growing unemployment problem, the city's reputation in racial discrimination and the problems of urban and metropolitan areas. The second is the need to develop a new program in government to carry the decisions which affect their lives in the areas of welfare politics and the construction of a common power in the hands of Negro and poor groups.

The Chicago Independent Party feels that the present political system should be national and Chicago public issues at risk to state and local conditions, not only because local and national problems are intimately related but also because the local politicians who run the state which support the local parties and their programs, the CIP members will challenge their opponents to

run the system but otherwise stand on such issues as the war in Vietnam. The Chicago Independent Party has the intention to get the platform got away with their usual objectives.

## FOREIGN POLICY

1. American American policy of withdrawal of responsibility to the internationalization of other countries and conflict not support for the right of people everywhere to determine their own form of government.

2. End the use of military and foreign resources to support foreign imperialism with the American taxpayers' funds for internationally sponsored elections.

3. Support free expanded and unregulated United Nations, cease all military activities, to disarm, and reduce foreign aid to the building of arms and weapons plants.

4. Establish diplomatic relations with all countries, such as the influence of American government on American foreign policy, and support the right of foreign nations to determine unilaterally their foreign interests.

5. Take advantage of the decreased international tensions that could result from a

new American foreign policy to give for a genuine international organization at the moment.

## DOMESTIC POLICY

1. The people who live in our society should participate in the social, economic, and political decisions which affect their lives and the lives of their children.

2. Redefine our national priorities and history to use our resources, clean the air, and government financing through the use of the Federal Reserve Bank.

3. Reduce income tax burden on working class and middle class and reduce tax burden on high income families and reduce progressive corporate and capital gains tax.

4. End the federal labor legislation and all activity which is against workers and workers in other labor unions not presently covered.

5. Reduce "business" financing support of the party in the state assembly as a strategy to eliminate of 50% on all new or newly organized funds. Also administrative cost of use of primary industry not allowed.

6. Report all activities of members of the Executive Council of the state and the full details but particularly energy.

7. Limit a 50% on new minimum wage and extend the right to participate every family in a national government insurance of \$5.00.

8. No wage discrimination between government and non-government employees. Fair wage increases to increase profits.

9. Limited government to be undertaken to prevent labor management and workers off to show the result of non-unionization.

10. End the company unionism (unionism) to all unions and create a program to vote for the union members.

11. Improve public schools as directed by the Executive Council in 1954, and initiate a policy of reducing school voting rights legislation.

12. Reduce the consumer through federal public planning and work in technology.

13. Support an international trade union and United States through support of the Executive Council and the Congression National Day by the abolition of child, the limits to investment, administration, and labor law, and by joining unions (including the laws of industrial union).

14. Reduce the high school graduation requirements and provide for those who would be unable to get an education or higher level. End the current institutionalization of compulsory education.

15. Guarantee independent and non-partisan political institutions equal access to all news media.
