"I have 18 years (on the job) and I'm very bitter," said Mancieri, who is married and has two young children. "I think they use us for everything they can get out of us."

To hear certain government officials and communities, is drugs. Unemployment, drugs, and the people themselves are to blame.

Yes, there is a drug problem, and people want to get rid of the truly dangerous drugs. But what do they get instead?

They get mass arrests, roadblocks, warrantless searches, and mandatory tests. ID checks to enter their own home, evictions, and confessions of automobiles. Armored cars in front lawns and front doors bashed in with battering rams. Laws changed to permit attorneys to testify against their own clients.

The principal thrust of new drug legislation increases the armaments of the police, deploys the armed forces in domestic law enforcement, and creates regional "Command, Control, Communications and Intelligence Centers." The Mexican border is made a military zone with armored cars, surveillance balloons, and the digging of border trenches. Justice Department agents fly armed helicopters against revolutionaries in South American jungles.

And, at the same time, all programs to help poor and oppressed people are systematically cut back.

The police sweeps, beatings, and registration of Black and Latino youth in sophisticated computer systems is depressingly like the systems used to register Blacks in South Africa or the Jews in Nazi Germany. Yet as soon as the magic justification of "drugs" is invoked, many people who basically know better silently line up behind the "War on Drugs." Is there any shred of evidence to make us believe that a society that offers most Black and Latino youth nothing but a choice between unemployment, the army, a prison cell, or an early grave, is actually trying to protect them from crack?
