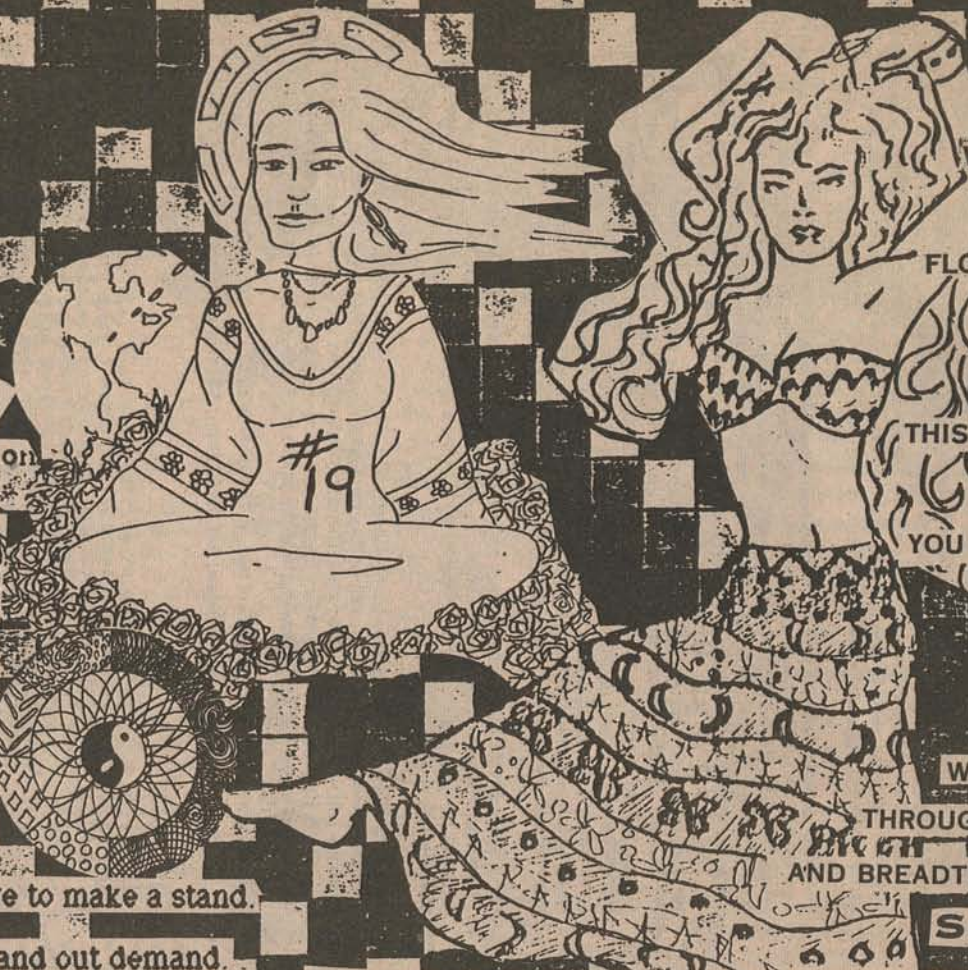


Dear Friends,

violent forms of conflict resolution,

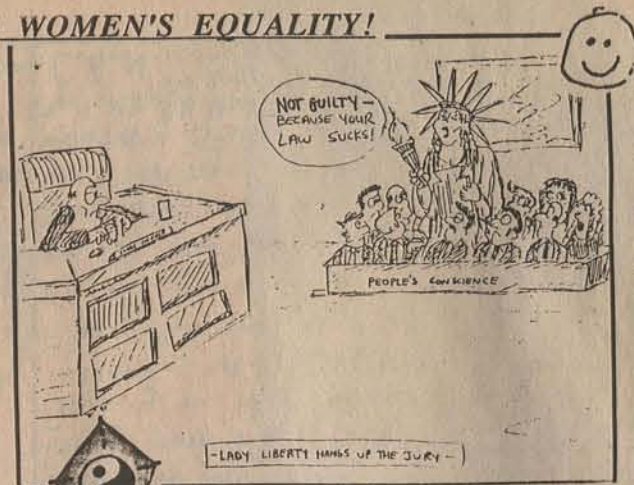

One Person-One Vote or One Dollar-One Vote?

Campaign 1992 has brought us much "politics as usual:" grand ideas
without practical solutions, promises without conviction, and mudslinging
without relevance. Despite the politicians puffed up rhetoric, a concept of true
reform was proposed.

It was Jerry Brown who platformed for this real change. He called for a
fundamental restructuring of the way our political system works. Mr. Brown put
a \$100 limit on his campaign contributions, unlike the \$1000/\$5000 present
limits.

Real democracy works on a one person-one vote system. Our
democracy is much closer to a one dollar-one vote system. The rich and
powerful of this country: the presidents and CEOs of companies and political
action committees (PACs) play a major role in determining the policies of our
government. They fund election campaigns and lobby for certain programs.
Elections are won or lost because of expensive political networking and media
advertising space. Anybody can say Anything in a 30-second spot. We need
open, informed political debates, not sound bites. We must rethink our political
system. Publicly funded campaigns would change political campaigns from
form to substance from a Money game to an integrity contest. We need to make
politics about the People not about the People's Money!

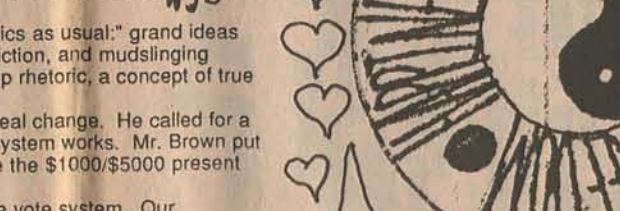

Amendment 1
Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the government for a redress of grievances.

Teen Lovegroups Share "Outercourse", Find Support, Community

Two new words in one title? Well, lots of new things are happening as A NEW WORLD RISES.

What can we do in a society that's falling apart? There are (according to USA TODAY - recent article) 200,000 Americans living in at least 3,000 communal groups in the U.S. The figures fit my own information based on 20 years of communal experience and contact with the movement for decades. As our competitive system collapses, communal life is rising (even communes for the homeless) and will, within the next decade replace much of our present society.

But that's not much help if you're under 18 and in prison. Under present laws, till 18 we are treated as prisoners of the system who escape only at our peril. Not an easy life. God made us mature at 13, but society has other views. Did God make a mistake? Or is the system weird? Any system making weapons to destroy a planet is very weird.

What's happening? Some young folks have formed lovegroups as a solution to tide them over until they can escape. In one school 4 boys and 4 girls (age 14) saw kids were having sex that could cause disease or pregnancy. They agreed not to date outside the group and not to do anything that could cause such problems. They began to practice "outercourse", a new name for any sex where the boy never puts his penis inside.

STARTING A LOVEGROUP

Starting a lovegroup is hard because it's so difficult to talk about some of these things until you know someone really well (which may not happen till you're in a group). Each group started differently. It's o.k. to discuss this article or the audiotape I can send you, with others. If you can trust a relative, preferably one with a good marriage, and are able to share your needs with that person, such support is very good to reduce secrecy or guilt.

AN OPEN LETTER FROM A SIXTEEN YEAR-OLD LOVEGROUP MEMBER

I was asked to write a letter for NWR to try and describe for other teens the "love" group I'm in. There has been a lot of written and talked about lately on this subject and I guess I'm partly responsible since I belong to such a group. The problem I have is that when you write about it, it always sounds so formal and a little cold. The reality is totally different. The important part is to have friends with whom you have built such trust and intimacy that you can discuss your most innermost and private thoughts without fear of ridicule or guilt. It is especially important that these friends include others of the opposite sex. I'm a 16 year old girl. Being able to discuss very intimate subjects with boys without guilt and fear, and having them discuss the same with me has allowed us to have a much better understanding of what the other goes through. When one has a serious problem or is feeling very down about something group support is critical. Having people who know and love you makes all the difference. No, the group is not meant to replace your family. But how many of you are lucky enough to be able to discuss everything with your parents? How many have a dysfunctional family? We don't live in a perfect world. But just because our family life may not be all we want or need does not mean we can't have those things. It all comes down to love and trust. When you have people who you love deeply and trust completely so many of the problems of life become pretty small.

As these groups have been discussed the subject of sex has also come up. Obviously it is a major topic of discussion among us simply because it's a major factor in the life of a teen. Do you have to have sexual activity to have a group? No. Can you love someone and trust them completely without sharing sex? Of course. Is there likely to be some sexual activity among the group of friends? Probably. Not necessarily but it is a likely event. When you share love and trust and your at the time of your life when your hormones are raging and you're curious and all the rest it would be stupid to think that sex might not happen. But it's a side event, not the main issue. It's a natural outgrowth of the love and trust, not the glue that holds the group together. We have eliminated rivalries, jealousy, dishonesty with each other; so many of the things which get in the way of true love and trust. Is it for everyone? Of course not. But start with a support group and see what happens. Share. Open yourself up and you will blossom to your full potential.

ONE RIGHT WAY TO LIVE may exist for George Bush and his clones, but simply does not exist for actual human beings.

For centuries, even millennia, life has usually been tribal. Humans need each other and do well cooperatively. A tribal culture won't destroy a planet. The planet is being destroyed by competition which, centuries ago, began to destroy tribal cultures. But natural life is strong, and creates new forms. Today many cooperative cultures are alive and well in America - but a deep secret to most corporate media.

VARIETIES OF COOPERATIVE EXPERIENCE There are three to ten thousand cooperative communities in the U.S. Here's a sample list. For details see the GUIDE TO INTENTIONAL COMMUNITIES.

SEX AND DRUG COMMUNES - The "60's" type mostly failed. Folks high on drugs fail to solve problems. Now very rare.

ASHRAM - All is owned/controlled by the "guru", a charismatic leader who answers problems and guides the life of the group. Love of the Guru is assumed.

CULTS - are ashrams taken to the extreme that members are prevented from leaving by inducing guilt or other measures. The "MOONIES" are an example. They're omitted from the Guide Book.

EGALITARIAN communities are run by all members, mostly by committees, voting and/or "consensus" (general agreement). They emphasize equality of sexes and usually share all property, income, childcare, etc. Some are monogamous and some not. There's a Federation of Egalitarian Communities helping each other.

Here's how one group began: Four girls had a sleepover and were talking sex. It took them hours to admit that each one knew how to pleasure herself to orgasm and did it often. Two who felt very close tried pleasuring each other and later told the others and one girl's married sister about it. Soon they also got four boys into the group and often petted and massaged each other to orgasm as separate couples. They could talk to the boys because they already had that group support.

Because of their prisoner (18-) status, it was not so easy for the whole group to get together so they decided it was o.k. If any girl shared massage with any boy. When even numbers of boys and girls couldn't meet it was difficult. Someone said instead of doing it as couples, one on one, it might be fun if the whole group massaged one person to orgasm, and then all worked on the next and so on.

Since each had already been naked with every other (during 2 years) that seemed o.k. My friend told me it was the best sex she ever had. A boy massaged each breast while others massaged her inside and all over. When all had come they felt really good because they'd shared so much love without any danger. They also learned together. When a person started to come, they'd stop massaging sensual parts until he/she relaxed and then start again. That gave much better orgasms.

Sexuality is very important as it's such an intimate area. Once we can be open and free with each other about that, we're also able to share all sorts of other things we were once terrified to discuss.

These kids were able to talk about the things that were getting them depressed, things they couldn't share with anyone before. Over time, those who'd been very quiet and fearful learned to open their hearts to one another and create a real feeling of trust and community. These teens will be leaders in

the NEW WORLD that's RISING, because they can now share much more honestly with others.

Almost everyone in a competitive system is running scared. The system's designed that way in order to keep us as sheep so that we're easily controlled. We each have something to hide. Keeping that secret makes it a mountain in our own mind. But once we can open our hearts to one another and share those secrets we find that they're not that bad after all, or at least not that different from what others do (Like when the girls learned that all 4 of them pleased themselves - and then that boys did also). Many secret thoughts have to do with sex because it's such a powerful drive and we're given so little honest support for it.

"OUTERCOURSE" EXPERT ON RADIO

After a conference on sex in Philadelphia, Jay Friedman, one of the experts from Planned Parenthood did a 40 minute radio talk show here. He said U.S. has the most teen pregnancy and we teach kids the least about sex. Kids tend to have intercourse sooner in societies that don't give them full information. I have tapes of the broadcast I can send out for a small donation. "Outercourse" encourages singles to share our sexuality in total safety.

MOST TEENS ARE NOT READY for a lovegroup. They need other support groups like the 12-step programs all over; no sex or nudity involved. Teens ready to form a lovegroup are self-selecting, but intercourse is all the media encourages. Sex of any kind is only healthy when we are ready to handle it.

At this time, support groups where teens can share what they are ready for right now are the urgent need. If you'd like to locate or form a support group in your area, send a name and phone number (where you can get messages) to Aquarian (see later) and we'll publish it in the next NWR. We may not have room for complete addresses.

WHAT ALTERNATIVES EXIST?

Experiencing intimate sharing groups takes us to new dimensions far more than a high with pot because that intimacy remains with us ever after. Even if circumstances separate us from our group, once having had that experience we know it can be created again. My 20 years in communal societies never leaves me but gives me the courage to do what few dare. Though we live below poverty level I work full time without pay to make sure this planet will have a positive future. We trust in miracles to keep going. We own a house and Birdie, a 1958 four place Cessna and do our own printing to avoid debt.

We're still communal as we do take in other people and are working to start a large city community called The Peace Factory. We also connect with others by computer nets like Prodigy (TJCN72A), PeaceNet & MCI (I.D. is AROSENBLUM.) and a free system for our newsletter subscribers. (Samples free.)

My work took me to Moscow in 1986. I met Gorbys's Advisor on U.S. Affairs which led to a video on U.S. communal groups (WHERE'S UTOPIA?) with a Soviet scientist. Now communal groups are growing all over Russia. Gorbys's advisor also helped us get Ted Turner (CNN) to create films on a positive future for the planet. In 1990, Ted offered \$500,000 for the best novel to film on a positive future set before 2021. 2,358 novels came forth in 100 languages. Ours is OH BEAUTIFUL UPON THE EARTH which did not win, but is now being published in futuristic way, its preface written by Daniel Quinn who did win the prize with ISHMAEL.

OH BEAUTIFUL is published so that each of you can become its co-publisher. Instead of paper (which wastes trees and pollutes) it's out as shareware on computer disks for any computer so you can make copies. You buy one for \$10 and make all the copies you want to sell for \$10 each. You keep \$5/copy.

WILD RIDE INTO POSITIVE FUTURE

Our story takes you on a wild ride into the future and lets you see a time (2008) when we've given up the notion that there's only one right way to live. Existing communes are projected ahead and many other lifestyle possibilities are described including "floaters", twin-engined motor-gliders that take off on alcohol and fly 80 mph on solar. They're safe and teens fly them. Also in OH BEAUTIFUL, by 2,008 today's lovegroup movement has led to a law giving kids their own centers. Parents must let them go.

Because it's so easy to copy and co-publish as shareware (an honor system), OH BEAUTIFUL UPON THE EARTH may soon become an underground classic. Many adults love it, and it could help us build a healthy youth movement. Orders? tell us your computer type & disk size. Send \$5 cash if you don't have ten.

FINDING YOUR OWN COMMUNITY

Another current project of Aquarian is helping folks find real work in community. We sell the latest community guide book which lists 400 groups in the U.S. and others elsewhere for \$16 plus postage (\$1, slow, \$4 -2 days). If you're 18 you can visit any community but if younger, you need permission or a community open to "runaways", of which there are only a few.

In addition to selling guide books, we also fly people in Birdie to visit communities. We need real donations for that. We rarely fly (at 15 cents/mile) unless others are paying gas. Our business cards ("hug pass" on one side) tell folks to call us to find community. You can get them with a sample Aquarian newsletter.

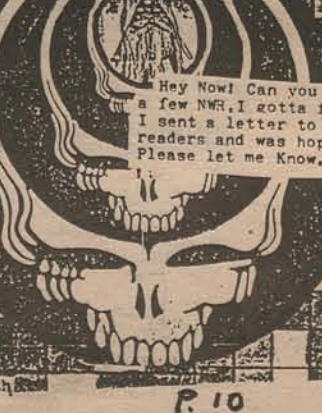

This demo by Jerry Kitzrow & Wild Honey comes with instructions that I agree wholeheartedly with: (1) free your mind (2) play it loud (3) listen. Kitzrow's press kit says "it's his love of texture that create the sublime whirl of sound" and that is exactly what he does on this 4 song demo. On the second song "Soft Lies" he and Wild Honey use mainly acoustic instruments with fairly good lyrics. On the song "Shitkicker", which is one of the most enjoyable of the 4 alternative songs, he sings "I won't be too sad although I'll be leaving some people behind/I might end up in a conceptual world so of course I'm gonna bring my mind/I'm gonna give up the dope gonna give up being attached to things/I don't mind leaving the cruelty". If you enjoy alternative music I suggest you order the free "Hear No Evil" compilation of 17 unsigned bands, including Jerry Kitzrow and Wild Honey, on Gait Records. THE SELVES (Box 1792, Hoboken, N.J. 07030-1306 TEL. 212-929-5538) **SPACE GIRL AND OTHER DELIGHTS.** The Selves are self described as spaghetti-funk, which is agreeable. They have a good history; 2 demos, 2 albums all influenced by Brand Nubian and LL Cool J, though they are compared most to the Red Hot Chili Peppers. They have a more straight forward approach to music than the R.H.C.P have had in five albums and have a better balance of styles. If this band were given more publicity and a better known label they would be played more and known more.

They are a good example of a great talent in need of more finance and a new press agent. If you like a mixture of cyberfunk and rap trilogies get in contact with John Raso.

YA-NE-ZNIYOO (C/O Syncartz, P.O.B. 789, Fairview, N.J. 07022 TEL. 201-941-0976) Whatever Goes Where. This five dollar first album by this Jersey trio on Syncartz Records was put together to "create emotive poetical compositions". They say they utilize those things discovered "while a persons mind is floating in the orbits between order and disorder." I agree, I agree, I agree! If only I could find out who did the album illustration, featuring my favorite moons. Buy this album and you get to love Edco's vocals into eternity.

THE RAKE'S PROGRESS (P.O.B. 430, N.Y.C 10185 TEL. 212-799-9680) The band is the very upbeat alternative music you need to make you happy, very happy. This formula boyhood-friends-meet-up-then-add-a-cousin-make-great-band is really working for them. This music will give you the natural high we all need. Lead singer Tim Cloherty is relaxing, but I was influenced by the drumming of Pete Klinger. Rake's progress future famous ones who have opened for acts such as Sonic Youth and the Spin Doctors.

HIT SQUAD (163-18 Cyders Lane, Whitestone, N.Y. 11357 TEL. 212-330-8287) This multiracial rap group makes a statement, a major statement. These two guys, Kage and K-Plus, are future O.G.'s (original gangsters) Ice T's. This four song demo had us waiting for much more. The perfect demo filled with four songs named "Sellout", "Go For Mine", "Talking Facts", and "I Died a Little Today" which was too heartbreaking dealing with the prejudices against products of interracial relationships.

Tell him you strongly oppose HR 4168, and that you support legislation that allows free trade with Cuba, ends the travel ban for U.S. citizens, and lifts the remaining limitations on the free flow of information across the Florida Straits.
