Daily Devotions

These are provided for mid-week personal spiritual growth. Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message. MONDAY // Read Mark 1:16-20

- Jesus' call to Simon, Andrew, James and John was to drop everything and follow Him. How does this relate to the call you received from Jesus to follow Him? How is it similar? How is it different?
- As we see in these verses, Jesus' call to us is both an individual call and immediately a call into community. In your life, how do you see and pursue this dual call of Jesus in your life, both individually and into His community?

TUESDAY // Read Mark 3:13-15; Luke 6:12-16

- Before Jesus calls the 12, we see Him withdraw and spend time in prayer with God. How does this impact our view of the power of prayer?
- Why do you think Jesus gave the 12 disciples this type of power?
- What do you make of this diverse community of people that Jesus chose to call forward?

WEDNESDAY // Read Genesis 1:27; Ephesians 4:20-24

- How does the truth that you are created in the image of God impact you?
- What are tangible ways that you seek to put on 'the new self' in your life? How are you encouraging others to do the same?

THURSDAY // Read Matthew 28:18-20; John 20:21

- Why do you think Jesus focused on His followers to go?
- How in your life and in your community are you 'Go'ing? Making disciples? Baptizing?
- What is the significance of Jesus sending us just as the Father sent Him?

FRIDAY // Read Luke 9:1-6; Luke 10:1-9

- What stands out to you in these instances of Jesus sending out His disciples?
- Why do you think Jesus sent them 2x2?
- Why do you think Jesus desired them to take nothing on their journey?
- What is the significance of the power Jesus gave to the disciples?

SATURDAY // Review the passages for the week

- What did you feel God was saying to you this week?
- What does it look like for you, this week, to Be With Jesus, Become Like Jesus, and Do What Jesus Did in your life?
- What does it look like for you, this week, to Be With Jesus, Become Like Jesus, and Do What Jesus Did in your community?
