# **Grow Group Discussion Questions**

A grow group is 8-16 people who get together weekly to study God's word and the previous Sunday's message. There is a time of discussion, support, encouragement, and learning how the message applies to daily life.

#### <u>Point #1</u>

- a) Read Numbers 13:1-24. Why do you think God sent this group to spy out the Promise Land? What do you make of the specific instructions they were given?
- b) What do we learn about God's character and promises to us through these verses?

#### Point #2

- a) Read Numbers 13:25-33. What do you notice about the contrast of responses from Caleb and the other spies?
- b) Do you tend to be someone who minimizes or maximizes the challenges before you?

#### Point #3

- a) Read Numbers 14:1-10. What do you notice about Caleb's faith? What helps you move forward in faith in the midst of fear?
- b) How do you balance sight vs faith? Where have you seen God's faithfulness in your life? How does that impact your steps?

# **Daily Devotions**

### MONDAY // Read Genesis 12:1-9 // Genesis 15:18-20

- What do we learn about God's plan for Abram, the Israelites and us in these verses?
- What do we learn about Abram's faith in these verses?
- How would you have (or have you) responded to a call like this from God?

### TUESDAY // Read Exodus 3:7-10 // Exodus 13:21-22 // Exodus 14:19-31

- What do these verses reveal about God's promises?
- How do these verses impact our view of God and His promises?

### WEDNESDAY // Read Hebrews 11

- How do verses 1-3 define faith? How would you define faith in your own words?
- How does this chapter impact your view of faith in action?
- Which person's walk of faith had the greatest impact on you? Why?

### THURSDAY // Read Numbers 13:1-33

- Why do you think in verse 2 God says He is giving the land to the people but then also sends spies?
- How do you respond when there are differing views on the next steps of a big decision?

### FRIDAY // Read Numbers 14:1-9

- What do you make of the people's response towards God and Moses?
- How do you balance fear vs faith when making decisions?
- How do you discern if God is telling you to go, to stay or to wait?

### SATURDAY // Reflection Questions – Take Time Today to Rest + Reflect + Seek Him

- Where in your life has God grown your faith in His truth and promises?
- What areas in your life do you feel your faith is often tested?
- What would it look like for you to operate with greater faith this week?
