Daily Devotions

These are provided for mid-week personal spiritual growth. Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message.

MONDAY // Read Psalm 145

- Read the passage. Read it again. Pray and ask God to highlight in your heart one or two verses.
- What sticks out to you from this passage? How can you incorporate this truth into your life?
- Why is it important to live this out? How can you participate in passing on God's Truth to the next generation?

TUESDAY // Read 2 Timothy 1:1-7, 3:10-17

- Timothy had, at minimum, three people pouring into his faith from a young age. Why is that important?
- Who led you in the faith? Have you expressed your gratefulness to them? How can you lead others?
- What are areas of your life you wouldn't want emulated? How can you take steps to change that to be an example?

WEDNESDAY // Read Joshua 24, Judges 2:7-11

- What happened between the generation of Joshua and the generation that came after? Could that happen today?
- How can we make sure that the generation to come knows the Lord? What are you doing to ensure that happens?
- Pray and ask God to give you specific steps to take in passing on the faith. How will you step into those?

THURSDAY // Read Deuteronomy 6

- What are the "gods of the people around you" in our culture? In what ways have you fallen into worshipping them?
- Why is it important to live out the faith while also teaching your children (or others' children)?
- How would you answer the question in v. 20? Do you share your testimony of God's faithfulness with others?

FRIDAY // Read Matthew 18:1-6, Mark 10:13-16

- In these passages Jesus extols childlike faith. Why is it important? How have you grown out of it?
- How can childlike faith be restored? What are the attributes of childlike faith? Which do you need to work on?
- Why does Jesus seem to value children so much? Does your attitude reflect His? What are you doing about it?

SATURDAY // Read 2 Chronicles 34:1-21, 2 Timothy 3:14-17

- What benefit did Timothy have over Josiah? How are you helping children to have that same benefit?
- What was Josiah's attitude towards God's Word? How is that same honor reflected in your life and time spent in it?
- How do we receive the benefits from God's Word listed in 2 Timothy? How can we pass on those benefits to others?

MEDITATION VERSE: *Psalm 145:4 One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts.*
