Daily Devotions

These are provided for mid-week personal spiritual growth. Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message. MONDAY // Read Psalm 51:1-5, Ephesians 2:4-5

- How would you describe God's "steadfast love", His "great love" for us?
- We can sometimes think that God is reluctant to love us. How does reflecting on His great love change our view of Him?
- David sinned against everyone but says "Against you, you only, have I sinned." Why is recognizing our sin before God of first importance?

TUESDAY // Read Psalm 51:6, John 14:6, 1 John 1:8, 3:18

- What does Jesus mean in John 14:6?
- What is the connection between love and truth?
- Can you think of a time in your life when God brought areas of "darkness" out into the light of truth?

WEDNESDAY // Read Psalm 51:7-12, Lamentations 3:22-23

- Do you think David doubted he could get a fresh start after the sin he committed?
- How hard is it to get a fresh start today?
- How does knowing "God's grace is new every morning" encourage you today?

THURSDAY // Read Psalm 51:13-15, Matthew 5:16, Romans 10:14-15

- What did David come to understand about God that caused so much joy?
- Can you think of a season of your life where the joy of salvation overflowed?
- What are ways we can reflect on grace that will cause us to overflow with joy?

FRIDAY // Read Psalm 51:16-19, Ephesians 2:8-9, 2 Corinthians 12:9-10

- What does David mean when he says that God only requires the sacrifice of a broken and contrite heart?
- What does Paul mean when he says, "I will boast in my weakness so that the power of Christ may rest upon me."?
- Salvation is not about what we do but what has been done for us. How does this empower transformation in our lives?
