Point #1

- a) Read John 7:37-39. What does "rivers of living water" highlight about the Holy Spirit in the life of a believer?
- b) In what way was Jesus challenging the audience's view of a fake Jesus? How does Point #1 relate? Be specific.
- c) How have you seen people today create a boring Jesus? What is the result? How is Point #1 a warning for you?

Point #2

- a) Read John 7:40-52. In what way did the local leaders think they were in control and could outsmart Jesus?
- b) What does this highlight about Point #2? How can this same thing happen with Christians or non-Christians today?
- c) How can prayer be an indicator if Point #2 is taking place? How does Point #2 currently challenge you? Be specific.

Daily Devotions

These are provided for mid-week personal spiritual growth. Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message.

MONDAY // Read John 7:37-38, Leviticus 23:40-41, Proverbs 4:23, Isaiah 44:3, 55:1, Joel 3:18, Zech. 14:8

- Based on today's reading, how would the Jews have viewed "water" both literally and metaphorically?
- In what way would the festival of Tabernacles have provided a great context for Jesus in John 7:37-38?
- What does this highlight about the way Jesus speaks to peoples' hearts? How does this spiritually encourage you?

TUESDAY // Read John 7:37-39, 4:7-15

- In what way was the offer of Jesus to both Jews and the woman at the well similar or different?
- Explain what the offer and promise entails? Be specific. Describe an example of how this takes place.
- What does this highlight about the work of God in the life of a believer? How have you experienced this truth?

WEDNESDAY // Read John 7:37-39, 3:3, 14:16-17, 2 Corinthians 5:17, Ephesians 1:13-14

- What does "living water" reveal in relationship to the ministry of the Holy Spirit? What does "rivers" imply?
- In what way does this relate to the metaphor of being "born again"? How has this been your experience?
- How do you think this challenges the world's perspective about Jesus? What does it reveal about a fake Jesus?

THURSDAY // Read John 7:40-52, 2 Kings 14:25, Nahum 1:1, 1 Kings 17:1

- How did the religious leaders display both pride and arrogance toward Jesus? (i.e., trying to take control)
- How did they lie about prophets from Galilee to prove their point? How did they underestimate Jesus?
- What does this reveal about a fake Jesus? (i.e., inept) How have you seen this happen today? Give an example.

FRIDAY // Read John 7:47-52, Matthew 6:30-34, 10:29-31, Philippians 4:6

- How does scripture instruct Christians to handle the anxiety and worry of everyday life?
- What will this approach reveal about Christians slipping into an "inept" perspective of Jesus? Be specific.
- As you reflect on your prayer life, what does it reveal about a fake Jesus? How do you need to adjust?

SATURDAY // Read John 7:40-52, Ephesians 3:20-21

- Clearly the religious leaders thought they could outsmart Jesus. What does this reveal about self-confidence?
- Living in Orange County, how could a similar perspective be adopted? How does it ultimately lead to a fake Jesus?
- Ponder today's reading in light of trusting Jesus to work in your life. How does this challenge you?

MEDITATION VERSE: ³⁷On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. ³⁸Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, 'Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.' " **John 7:37-38**
