

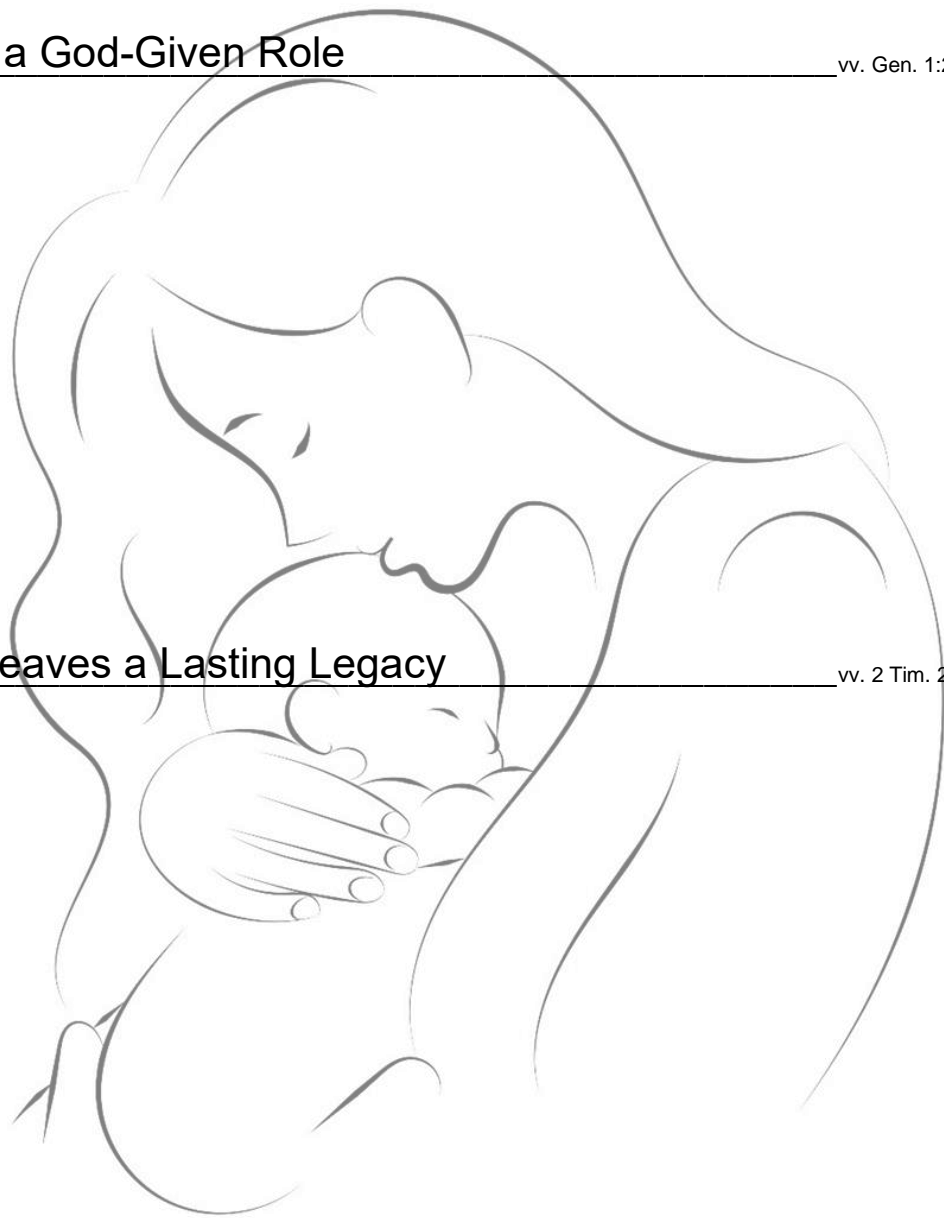

### Point #1

- Read Genesis 1:26-28, 2:18, 24. Explain why God made woman. What does this imply about moms?
- How does this relate to Point #1? Why is this an important message in today's culture? Be specific.
- What will ultimately happen when culture tries to redefine motherhood? How does Point #1 encourage you?

### Point #2

- Read 2 Timothy 1:2-5. In what way did Timothy's mom and grandma influence his call into ministry?
- How does this highlight Point #2? Why is this important for every mom to remember? Be specific.
- How is culture trying to minimize Point #2? Give an example. How have you personally experienced Point #2?

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## Daily Devotions

These are provided for mid-week personal spiritual growth. Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message.

### **MONDAY // Read Genesis 1:26-28, 2:18-24, Psalm 127:3**

- When God made man and woman, what did He tell them to do? What is the context for this instruction?
- What does this imply about why God made woman? Be specific. How is motherhood a divine role?
- How is culture trying to redefine a mom today? How does God's view on motherhood encourage you?

### **TUESDAY // Read Genesis 3:20, Proverbs 22:6, 2 Timothy 1:2-5, Romans 16:13**

- As you reflect on the original God-given role of a mother, what do you see? Be specific.
- In what way can a woman fulfill the role of a mother without having biological children?
- How is this an encouragement to all women? How can it also relate to the children's ministry at PCC?

### **WEDNESDAY // Read Genesis 1:26-28, John 15:7, 2 Corinthians 12:7-9, Philippians 4:6-7, James 5:16**

- Why should prayer be an important topic when it comes to motherhood? (Hint: God-given role)
- What distinction is important to make when it comes to "answered" prayer? (Hint: the unexpected)
- What can happen if moms miss this truth? How do you see God answering prayer in your family's life?

### **THURSDAY // Read 2 Timothy 1:2-5, Acts 16:1**

- In what way did Timothy's mom and grandma ultimately influence his call into ministry?
- Why is this important for every mom to remember? How does this encourage and create accountability?
- How is culture trying to minimize this truth? Describe how you've personally experienced a mom's legacy.

### **FRIDAY // Read 2 Timothy 1:2-5, Exodus 1:15-2:10**

- How did Eunice and Lois protect Timothy? How did Moses' mother do the same?
- How did Eunice and Lois play a special role in God's plan? How did Moses' mom play a similar role?
- What does this teach you about the legacy of motherhood? Give an example from your own life.

### **SATURDAY // Read Luke 1:26-38, 46-56, 2:21-35, 41-48, John 2:1-5, 19:25-27**

- Throughout Jesus' life we see a unique and special relationship between mother and son. Explain.
- What does this implicitly teach about God's plan for moms and their kids? How is it different than dads?
- What is God teaching you about being a mom or valuing motherhood? How has culture pushed back?
