<u> Point #1</u>

a) Read John 15:7-8. Explain what "my words abide in you" means? Given there is an "if" attached, what does this imply?b) How does this relate to Point #1? Since this is the key to abiding and spiritual growth, how is God challenging you?

c) What specific steps will you take this week to apply Point #1? How can your Grow Group keep you accountable?

Point #2

a) Read John 15:9-10. Explain the difference between knowing God's word and applying it. How did Jesus address this?

- b) What can happen if this truth isn't kept as a priority? (i.e., abiding) How does Point #2 encourage or challenge you?
- c) Read Galatians 5:22-25. Pick an area of abiding you believe God wants you to work on. How will you step into Point #2?

Daily Devotions

These are provided for mid-week personal spiritual growth. Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message. MONDAY // Read John 15:7-8, Hebrews 4:12, 2 Timothy 3:16, 1 Timothy 4:13

- How did Jesus instruct His disciples to keep spiritually learning and growing? (i.e., abide in my words)
- What does this highlight about the importance for Christians to study their bible? How often do you do this?
- How have you possibly taken God's word for granted? What specific steps will you take this week to improve?

TUESDAY // Read John 15:7-8, Matthew 6:9-15, 28-33, James 4:1-4

- What promise does Jesus give His disciples if they continue learning and grow in His word?
- In what way should "whatever you wish" be qualified? How does Matthew 6:10 help? Be specific.
- How would you rate your prayer life? Why? How can Bible study help? Explore your prayers in light of God's word.

WEDNESDAY // Read John 15:7-8, Matthew 5:16, Ephesians 4:8-15

- In what way did Jesus tell the disciples they could prove to be true disciples? What is the path to get there?
- How have you seen this truth misunderstood? What is the result? How might you have fallen into this trap?
- What are some practical things you can put in place to step into this truth? Be specific.

THURSDAY // Read John 15:9-10, Matthew 7:24-27, James 1:22-25

- How did Jesus relate "keeping my commandments" to abiding in His love? Why was this clarification needed?
- Explain the difference between knowing God's word and growing in God's word. How does this relate to abiding?
- How can simply knowing God's word become a trap? How will you avoid this trap? Be specific.

FRIDAY // Read John 15:9-11, Galatians 5:22-25

- How does the fruit of the Spirit in Gal. 5:22 & 23 relate to abiding in Jesus and spiritual fruit in John 15:9-10?
- Given "peace" and "joy" are gifts from God, what does this imply about the other fruits of the spirit? (i.e., obedience)
- What does this teach about spiritual growth? What fruit of the Spirit do you need to work on? How will you do it?

SATURDAY // Read John 15:7-10

- Given this week's overall message is the importance of reading & applying God's word, how does it encourage you?
- What has been your experience in studying the Bible? What are some study tools you can get to help?
- Why should the application of God's word always be your endgame? What, in particular, spoke to you this week?
