Daily Devotions

These are provided for mid-week personal spiritual growth. Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message. MONDAY // Read Acts 5:1-6, Hebrews 12:5-11

- Explain why Ananias was confronted by Peter. How did this relate to tithes and offerings to the church?
- Given God's judgment/discipline of Ananias, what does this highlight about God's view on tithes and offerings?
- In what way is this also a spiritual battle? (i.e., "Satan filled your heart") How have you minimized the issue?

TUESDAY // Read Acts 5:1-6, Matthew 25:14-30

- What are two truths being presented in the Parable of the Talents? Be specific. How does this relate to Ananias?
- What does this reveal given today's Christian gives 2-3% of their income to the local church?
- How does this challenge your current approach to giving at PCC? How will you prevent an Ananias factor?

WEDNESDAY // Read Acts 5:1-6, Luke 18:18-30, 1 Timothy 6:17-19

- What was Jesus addressing by requiring the rich ruler to give away 100% of his money to the poor?
- How did he respond? Why? In what way was this more about priorities and not percentages?
- How is this also an Ananias issue? How does your giving to PCC reflect your spiritual priorities? Be specific.

THURSDAY // Read Acts 5:7-11, 2 Corinthians 9:6-15

- What was the primary difference between Ananias and Sapphria's decision to hold back money from God?
- In what way did Sapphira have an opportunity to repent? What was the result of her avoiding this opportunity?
- What does this reveal about the challenges when giving to God? How can you overcome this challenge?

FRIDAY // Read Acts 5:7-11, James 1:9-11, 2:1-7, 4:1-3, 4:13-17, 5:1-3

- Describe the context for each time James discusses money. Is it positive or negative? Why?
- How does this support the warning in Acts 5:7-11? What does this highlight about money in the Cristian life?
- In what way do you see these same issues today? How is God speaking to you about giving your money?

SATURDAY // Read Acts 5:1-11, Matthew 6:19-21, Mark 12:41-44, 1 Corinthians 16:2

- In what way did God's judgment of Ananias and Sapphira reflect to the teachings of Jesus (i.e. treasures, offerings)?
- How do you think the seriousness of this topic, from God's perspective, is a surprise to most Christians today?
- What has God impressed on you over the past two weeks when it comes to stepping into this topic at PCC?
