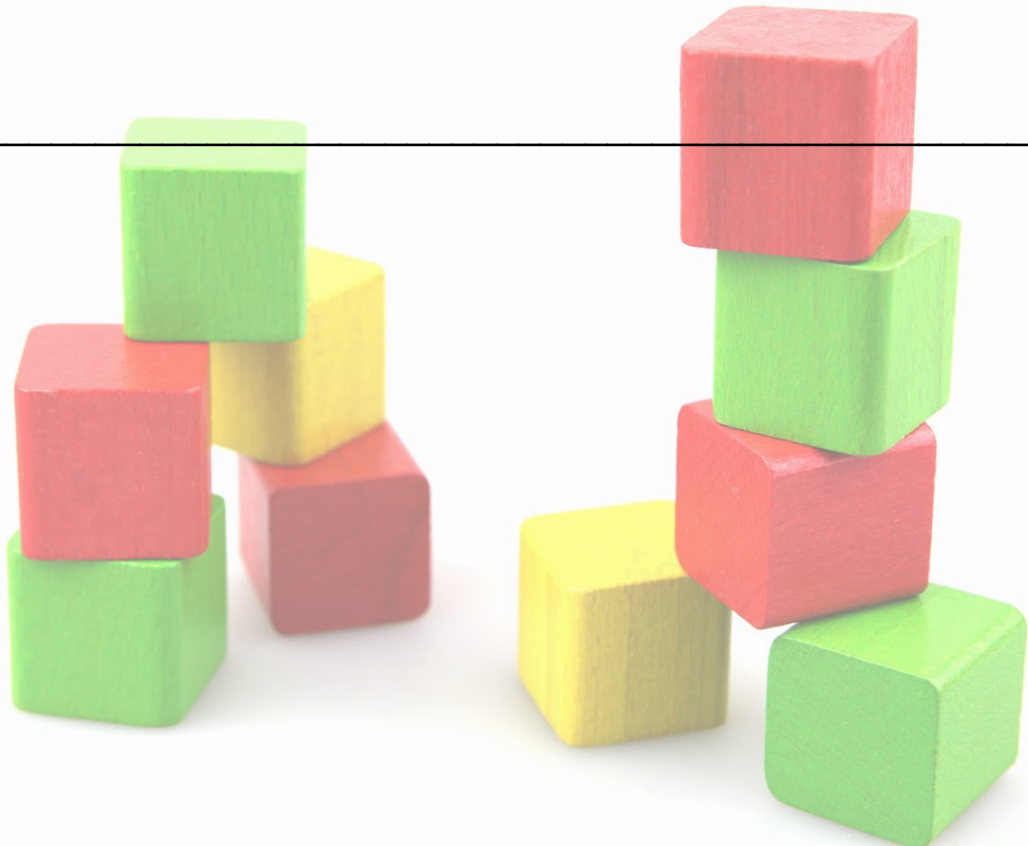

Grow Group Discussion Questions

A grow group is 8-16 people who get together weekly to study God's word and the previous Sunday's message. There is a time of discussion, support, encouragement, and learning how the message applies to daily life. **PCC uses the ESV (English Standard Version).**

Point #1

- Read John 21:1-7. Do you think the disciples were expecting Jesus to show up? Why? How does fishing relate?
- What happened when they did what Jesus told them to do? In what way was this a historical reminder about Point #1?
- Why is this a fundamental truth for every new believer to understand? How can this also apply to you? Be specific.

Point #2

- Read John 21:8-14. Describe how Jesus made His reunion with the disciples personal. What were the alternatives?
- What does this highlight about Point #2 and what it means to follow Jesus? Why is this important?
- How can prayer help? Be specific. Describe your current relationship with Jesus. How does Point #2 adjust you?

Daily Devotions

These are provided for mid-week personal spiritual growth. Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message.

MONDAY // Read John 21:1-5, Matthew 26:31-32, 28:5-7, Mark 16:6-7

- How would you describe the demeanor of the disciples after they arrived in Galilee? What did they decide to do?
- In what way does this highlight they weren't expecting Jesus? What does it say about returning to their old lives?
- Given Jesus and the angels told the disciples about going to Galilee, how is this a warning for new believers today?

TUESDAY // Read John 21:1-7, Luke 5:1-11

- In what way did Jesus provide a lesson on obedience by filling their nets with fish?
- How was this also a historical reminder of their initial calling when Jesus told them to follow Him? Be specific.
- Since Jesus was ultimately leaving, why was this important for them to remember? How does this encourage you?

WEDNESDAY // Read John 21:5-6, 15:5, 9-11, Matthew 28:20, Galatians 3:2-3

- What were the disciples able to accomplish based on their efforts to fish? How did that compare to obeying Jesus?
- In what way is this an application of the vine and branch discussion Jesus had with His disciples? Be specific.
- What happens if new believers overlook this truth? How do you need to be more intentional to obey Jesus today?

THURSDAY // Read John 21:7-8, 13:6-9, 36-38, Matthew 14:25-31

- How does Peter respond to the claim made by John in verse 7? ("It is the Lord") How was he different than John?
- In what way has this been a pattern for Peter's personality? What has been the result? Be specific.
- What does this highlight about the interpersonal work needed for Peter? How does this truth apply to you?

FRIDAY // Read John 21:8-12, 15:15, 10:14, Luke 5:15-16, 1 Thessalonians 5:17

- How did Jesus regroup with His disciples after fishing? Be specific. What does this reveal about their relationship?
- Why is this important for every new believer to understand and foster in their walk with Jesus?
- How can prayer help? How would you describe your relationship with Jesus? How can you be more personal?

SATURDAY // Read John 21:9-14, 6:1-15, Revelation 2:3-5

- In what way did Jesus repeat the loaves and fishes miracle found in John 6:1? What was the only difference?
- Why do you think Jesus did this? What does it imply about the need to remember these fundamental truths?
- What can happen if these are forgotten? What is the solution? (Rev. 2:3-5) How do you need to adjust?
