Point #1

- a) Read 1 Timothy 3:14-15a. How does Paul indirectly highlight Point #1 when it comes to guiding the church?
- b) Why is this important? What can happen if Point #1 isn't kept in check? Give an example. How does this help you?

Point #2

- a) Read 1 Timothy 3:15b. In what ways does Paul highlight the church as being a spiritual family? (i.e., household)
- b) How should Point #2 impact attendance, church hopping, relationships, conflict, etc.? How does this challenge you?

Point #3

- a) Read 1 Timothy 3:16. What does the "mystery of godliness" mean? Explain the six areas that relate to Jesus.
- b) How does this highlight Point #3? How can this priority get replaced with something else? How does Point #3 protect you?

Daily Devotions

Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message. MONDAY // Read 1 Timothy 3:14-15a, 2 Timothy 2:15, 3:16-17, Hebrews 4:12-13

- Why do you think Paul wanted to visit Timothy in Ephesus? What was his backup plan if he couldn't make it?
- How does this highlight the importance of God's word and guiding a church? Be specific.
- What can happen if this isn't the commitment of every member of a church? How does this truth help you?

TUESDAY // Read 1 Timothy 3:14-15a, Hebrews 5:11-14

- In what way does the Hebrew writer rebuke long time church members? Be specific. Why is this important?
- What can happen if church members are not committed to the continual study and application of the Bible?
- Given how long you've been a Christian, how would you rate yourself? (i.e., milk, solid food) What will you do?

WEDNESDAY // Read 1 Timothy 3:15b, Ephesians 2:19-20, 1 Peter 2:4-5

- How would the illustration of a building have resonated with people living in Ephesus? (i.e., pillar, foundation)
- In what way does the church of the "living God" or "living stones" distinguish Christian churches?
- Given most people think of a building when they hear "church", how does this send a different message?

THURSDAY // Read 1 Timothy 3:15b, Romans 12:10, Galatians 5:10, Ephesians 3:15, 1 Peter 3:8

- How did Paul describe the church in terms of a spiritual family? How would this have been countercultural?
- In what way does this also define the relationships that should be taking place within churches today?
- What has been your experience at PCC? How does this also redefine your view of church membership?

FRIDAY // Read 1 Timothy 3:16, Colossians 2:1-2, John 1:14, 32-34, Luke 2:9-11, Matthew 28:19, Acts 1:9

- What does the "mystery of godliness" mean? Explain the six areas that Paul presents as relating to Jesus.
- What does this highlight about Jesus and the church? Why is this critical for every Christian to understand?
- In what way can this impact the health of a church? How have you seen this take place in your life?

SATURDAY // Read 1 Timothy 3:16, Ephesians 2:21-22, Hebrews 12:2, Matthew 5:14-16

- How does Paul illustrate the truth of 1 Timothy 3:16 in terms of a building? (Ephesians 2:21-22)
- In what way does the church only exist for Jesus? Why is this important for every church to keep in check?
- What are some ways you can get distracted from this truth? How do you need to keep yourself in check?
