Point #1

- a) Read Matthew 20:17-21. Given the context, why did the mother of Zebedee's sons ask Jesus for a favor?
- b) How does this highlight the heart of a mother and Point #1? How can this be misinterpreted today?
- c) How have you experienced the truth of Point #1? How does this help you appreciate your mom? Be specific.

Point #2

- a) Read Matthew 20:20-24. In what way was this a picture of a mother praying for her children?
- b) How does Point #2 and spiritual protection apply? How can this get misinterpreted by children today?
- c) What is God teaching you about the value of your mom? What steps will you take to appreciate her?

Daily Devotions

These are provided for mid-week personal spiritual growth. Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message.

MONDAY // Read Matthew 19:28-30, 20:17-21

- Explain the significance of sitting on the right and left hand of a king. (i.e., power, authority, etc.)
- Why did the mother of Zebedee's sons ask Jesus for a favor? How was she taking a risk?
- What does this imply about a mother and her children? How does this help you see the value of a mom?

TUESDAY // Read Exodus 1:8-2:10

- What instructions did the new king give to the midwives? How did they respond? Why?
- What does this tell you about the heart of a mother? How do you see this in other parts of the story?
- How has your mom sacrificed for you? Be specific. How can you regularly show her your appreciation?

WEDNESDAY // Read 1 Kings 3:16-27

- Describe the dilemma King Solomon was facing with the two women. How did he test them?
- In what way was he testing a mother's instincts? What does this teach about a mother's primary concern?
- How does this perspective help you view the importance of your mom? How can you be a blessing to her?

THURSDAY // Read Matthew 20:20-23, 27:54-56

- How was the mother of Zebedee's sons spiritually concerned for her boys? (Hint: her request)
- In what way was she essentially praying for her sons? How can mothers be misunderstood in this area?
- What is the primary way a mom feels validated for her spiritual concerns? What do you need to do?

FRIDAY // Read 1 Samuel 1:20-28, 2:19-21

- Why did Hannah give her son Samuel to the Lord? Be specific. How did Hannah give Samuel to the Lord?
- In what way do you see this same thing happening with Christian moms today? Give an example.
- How has your mom tried giving you to the Lord? (i.e., spiritual influence, protection, etc.) Thank her today!

SATURDAY // Read Proverbs 31:10-28, Exodus 20:12

- What does God tell children to do for mothers? Why? What does this imply about God's values?
- In what way have you seen motherhood devalued today? How is this being disobedient to God?
- What practical steps of appreciation will you take in honoring your mother in the next few months?
