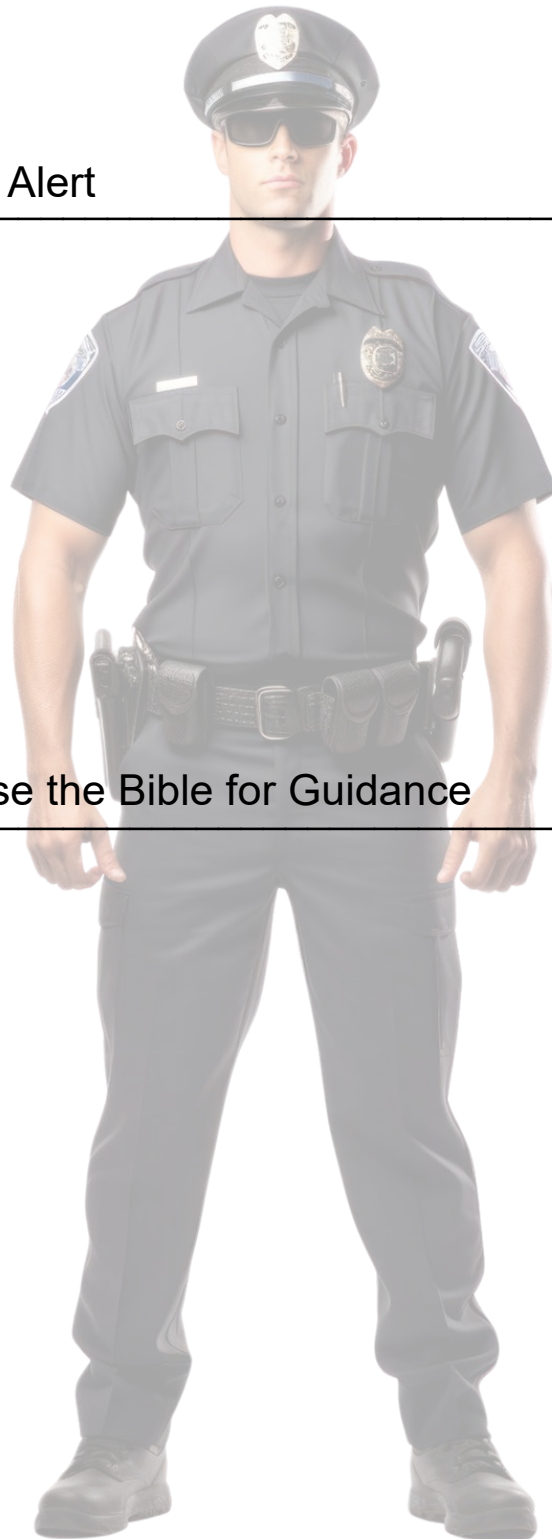

Grow Group Discussion Questions

Point #1

- a) Read 1 Timothy 6:20a. In what way is Paul repeating himself to Timothy? (c.f. Acts 20:28-31) Why?
- b) What does this highlight about the importance of Point #1? Why will this always be an issue? (i.e., spiritual warfare)
- c) How can this easily be overlooked? Give an example. How can you be more involved in applying Point #1?

Point #2

- a) Read 1 Timothy 6:20b-21. What is the implied risk? How does Point #2 provide the protection needed?
- b) In what way will this be a challenge in today's culture? (i.e., "truth") How have you seen this happen to churches?
- c) How does "avoiding irreverent babble" provide protection? How can you do a better job of applying Point #2?

- As you read through 1 Timothy 6, list the topics or truths that jump out for you. Why? How can you apply it today?
