Daily Devotions

These are provided for mid-week personal spiritual growth. Prayerfully writing out your answers will help you experience real life transformation as you dig deeper into the spiritual truths of God's word and today's message. MONDAY // Read John 1:1-5, 14

- How does John describe Jesus before Christmas? Explain how this relates to the doctrine of the trinity?
- What about this perspective is challenging to you? Why will this always be a bit of a mystery?
- In what way does this encourage your perspective when celebrating Christmas this year? Be specific.

TUESDAY // Read John 3:16-18, 14:6, Mark 10:45, Acts 4:11-12, Romans 5:12-19, 6:23, Eph. 2:8-9

- In what way did Jesus come on a rescue mission? What was the motivation behind this mission?
- What did Jesus require in order to experience this truth? How does this all relate to Christmas?
- How have you stepped into this truth? Why will double-checking your faith help you celebrate Christmas?

WEDNESDAY // Read John 3:16-18, 16:8-11, 17:17, Ephesians 1:13-14, Jude 20

- In what way is Christmas the ultimate demonstration of God's love for you and me?
- Given Jesus requires "belief" to experience this love, what are some indicators that someone has truly believed?
- Describe how the fruit of the Holy Spirit has given you confidence in your faith. If not, what can you do?

THURSDAY // Read Matthew 1:18-25 (Advent Reading)

- MERRY CHRISTMAS!

FRIDAY // Read John 15:10-12, Galatians 5:22-23

- As Jesus describes what it means to stay close to him (abide), what is required? (verse 10)
- What should it look like when abiding is taking place? How will Christians ultimately benefit? (i.e., joy)
- In what way does this relate to experiencing God's love? How can you step into this promise this week?

SATURDAY // Read John 15:10-12, 1 Corinthians 13:4-7

- What does Jesus present as being the secret to expressing God's love? Why is "as I have loved you" important?
- How can this be misunderstood, especially at Christmas time? Give an example.
- In what way can you apply this truth to those around you during this holiday season? Be specific.
