

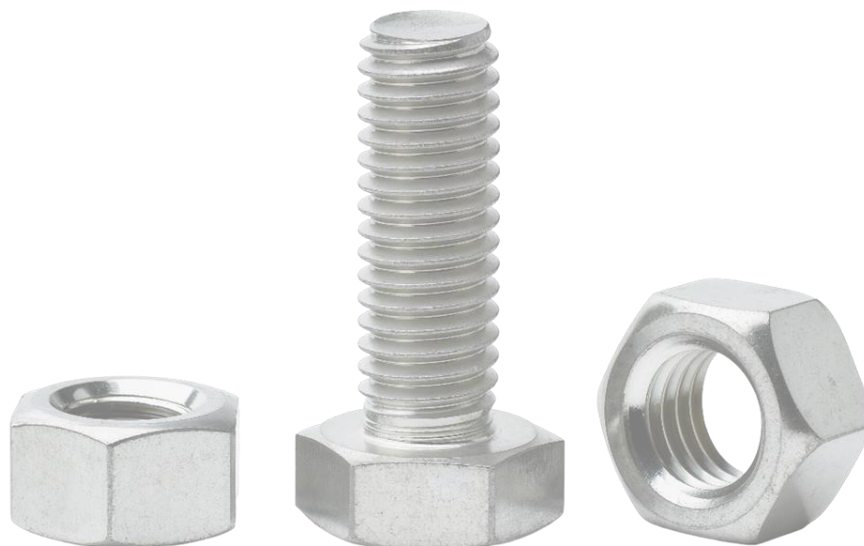

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## Daily Devotions

### **MONDAY // Read Acts 15:19-21, Matthew 5:23-24**

- Why do you think James diverted the discussion from circumcision and offered a different solution?
- What does this highlight about the need to be solution oriented rather than rehashing a disagreement?
- What can happen if this isn't understood? How can you be more solution oriented this week?

### **TUESDAY // Read Acts 15:20-21, Leviticus 17:10-16, 18:6-18**

- Explain the four purity laws James presented to offer as a compromise on circumcision.
- How did they relate to sexual sin and idols? Why would this have been important for Gentile churches?
- How did James resolve both the circumcision concern and the godly living concern? What does this teach you?

### **WEDNESDAY // Read Acts 15:22-31**

- How did the Antioch church respond to the Jerusalem offer? What does this highlight about flexibility?
- What two critical components were applied in order to provide clarity and accountability? Be specific.
- Why is this important when resolving personal conflict? How can you step into this truth currently?

### **THURSDAY // Read Acts 15:22-31, Galatians 2:9-14**

- In what way did Paul and Peter have a disagreement about Gentiles and Jews? Be specific.
- Given clarity brings accountability when resolving conflict, how was this demonstrated by Paul?
- How was this similar to the Antioch and Jerusalem resolution? How does this encourage you?

### **FRIDAY // Read Acts 15:32-35**

- What took place immediately after unity was achieved between the Antioch and Jerusalem churches?
- What does this highlight about the importance of conflict resolution and church health? Be specific.
- How does this motivate you to be more intentional about handling disagreements at PCC?

### **SATURDAY // Read Acts 15:36-41, 1 Corinthians 9:3-6, Colossians 4:10, 2 Timothy 4:9-11**

- How long did it take for another disagreement to surface between Paul and Barnabas? What was the issue?
- What indications reveal that they ultimately resolved the issue and came back together? Be specific.
- What does this highlight about the ongoing process of resolving conflict? How does this motivate you?
