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Chile Private Journey

THE LAKE DISTRICT AND PAINE NATIONAL PARK

This Private Journey features Chile's volcano-dotted Lake District and the sublime world of Patagonia's Torres del Paine National Park, one of the scenic masterpieces of the planet. In the Lake District, enjoy day hikes on immense Volcán Osorno, the snow-crested icon of the Lake District, and in the mist-shrouded mountains of Alerce Andino National Park. In Paine National Park, hike fantastic trails amid Paine's famed peaks, known as The Towers for their vertical spires. Paine Grande, the highest tower, tops 10,000 feet, its dazzling rock pinnacles rising from snow and ice. Accommodations in Torres del Paine National Park are lodges in majestic settings with hiking trails right at the door step. Extend your journey to the world-famous wine country of Chile's Colchagua Valley, or to mysterious Easter Island, an open-air archaeological museum of a fascinating but vanished Polynesian culture.

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Itinerary

Please note: You must depart the US a day early to reach Chile on Day 1 of the program. Most airlines arrive in Santiago in the very early morning. We recommend an overnight in Santiago to rest up from the flight. We are happy to book a hotel and city tour for you (an 'on your own' expense).

DAY 1

SANTIAGO, CHILE / PUERTO MONTT / PUERTO VARAS

Arrive in Santiago, Chile, in the early morning and connect directly with your flight to the small city of Puerto Montt in southern Chile. On arrival in Puerto Montt, you are met for a drive to the charming town of Puerto Varas in the heart of the Lake District. The town is set on the shores of volcano-ringed Lake Llanquihue. Dinner is on your own. Your lodge, the Cabanas del Lago, is on the edge of the lake, a five-minute walk from town.

DAYS 2-3

LAKE DISTRICT HIKES

The volcano-dotted Lake District is a dramatic world, with its Fuji-like peaks, lava fields, emerald lakes, and enchanted forests filled with rare native flora. One of your Lake District options is a full-day visit to immense Volcán Osorno, the snow-crested icon of the Lake District. From the slopes of Osorno, surrounding views include the huge, symmetrical volcanoes of Calbuco, Antillanca, and Tronador, with the Andes in the background. Trails high on the mountain cross fields of Osorno's sculpted lava. The next day, head out to mist-shrouded Llanquihue National Reserve, with its native forests of coigüe, mañío, and tepa, and Volcán Calbuco dominating the views. Overnights at Cabanas del Lago...BL each day

DAY 4

PUERTO MONTT / PUNTA ARENAS / TORRES DEL PAINE NATIONAL PARK

Transfer to Puerto Montt and fly to the city of Punta Arenas on the Strait of Magellan, where you are met for an afternoon drive by private vehicle into the sublime world of Torres del Paine National Park, one of the scenic masterpieces of the planet, declared a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO. The park's centerpiece is the Cordillera Paine Massif, a wonderland of eye-popping scenery that emerges in a breathtakingly sheer rise from the plains of the Patagonian steppes. Overnight at Hotel Las Torres, situated on a private 4,000-acre ranch just below the magnificent Paine Towers, with a fine restaurant and spa services...BLD

Optional Upgrade: For your four-day stay in Torres del Paine National Park, we offer an optional upgrade to the Explora Lodge, strategically set on the shore of Lake Pehoé in Paine National Park. This stunning hotel offers gourmet meals, vintage wines, a heated pool, and a fantastic view of Paine's granite towers and Lake Pehoé. Please call us for cost details.

DAY 5

TORRES DEL PAINE NATIONAL PARK

Torres del Paine's famed peaks are known as The Towers for their vertical spires. Paine Grande, the highest tower, tops 10,000 feet, its dazzling rock pinnacles rising from snow and ice. The east face of the Central Tower ends in a sheer 4,000-foot-high rock wall that challenges the world's mountaineers. One of the best hiking options today is to set out with your guide through beautiful old-growth beech forests to reach the ultimate views of the Paine Towers. Other hiking options are available, as are horseback rides from the lodge (at extra cost). Overnight at Hotel Las Torres...BLD

DAY 6

TORRES DEL PAINE NATIONAL PARK

A beautiful drive by private vehicle brings you to your accommodation at the southern end of the Paine Massif, where you are close to Massif's famous cuernos (horns)—incredible twisting monoliths of granite with knife-edged ridges, famously photogenic when they are mirrored in the emerald waters of Lake Nordenskjold. This afternoon, enjoy a boat excursion across iceberg-dotted Lago Grey to the edge of the huge Grey Glacier. Your accommodation, Hosteria Lago Grey, has walking trails and a breathtaking location on Lago Grey, with its active calving glaciers.....BLD

DAY 7

TORRES DEL PAINE NATIONAL PARK

Options today include a half-day hike (about four hours) up the slopes of Mt. Ferrier for panoramic views of the cuernos. This is a moderately strenuous hike with a steep climb of about 1,500 feet to a magnificent viewpoint of Paine's mountains, lakes, and glaciers. An easier option is a half day (3-4 hours) hike through classic lush meadows and forests of giant lenga and coigüe trees, with river views, some Paine views, and a chance to spot huemul (Patagonian deer). Overnight at Hosteria Lago Grey...BLD



DAY 8

DEPART

A private transfer brings you back to Punta Arenas, where you connect with flights to Santiago and homeward (or join one of our extensions)...B

Upon receipt of your deposit, we will send you a Welcome Packet that includes a letter of confirmation, Detailed Itinerary, Trip Application, Medical Form, and Pre-Departure Information Booklet with information to help you prepare for your adventure. Arrival & Departure

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

Upon confirming your trip reservation, we will send you a Welcome Packet that includes a list of documents (passport, visas, etc.) required for your trip. Please feel free to call if you would like this information before making your air arrangements.

Our local agent will meet your flight at the Puerto Montt, Chile, airport on Day 1. At the end of the trip, you are transferred to Punta Arenas airport for a flight to Santiago, where you connect with international flights. Our Arrival & Departure Logistics memo, included in your confirmation packet, has details.

FLIGHT ARRANGEMENTS

Trip members are responsible for making their own arrangements for air transportation. Please do not purchase your airline tickets until you are confirmed on the trip and have reviewed your proposed air schedule with our office. Once your tickets have been purchased, please send us a copy of your airline schedule so that we can send it on to the local guide (make sure to include your Trip Name and Trip Dates on it). Note: The name on your airline ticket must match the name on your passport exactly; otherwise you may be denied boarding. Please remember this when reserving your flights. In addition, your passport must be valid for at least six months after your date of return to the US (in most cases).

Lodging



CABAÑAS DEL LAGO

Puerto Varas, Chile

Days 1 to 3 (3 nights)

The Cabañas del Lago has unobstructed views of Lago Llanquihue and the surrounding volcanoes, and it's just a five-minute walk into town. Rooms are simple but clean, and the staff is professional and helpful. There is a swimming pool, and spa services are offered.



HOTEL LAS TORRES

Paine National Park, Chile

Days 4 to 5 (2 nights)

Las Torres is located in an extraordinary, privileged site—inside Paine National Park and right at the foot of the majestic Torres del Paine. Founded as an 8,000-acre cattle ranch before the park even existed, the property has stunning Paine views, a stable of Patagonian horses, and direct access to trails. The guest rooms are comfortable, spa services are available, and the restaurant was recently recognized with an award for the best cuisine in the park.



EXPLORA LODGE

Paine National Park, Chile

Days 4 to 7 (4 nights)

Strategically set on the shore of Lake Pehoè in Paine National Park, the 5-star Explora Lodge is a luxurious respite with sweeping views that frame Paine's granite towers and Lake Pehoè. Constructed in a modern, sleek Scandinavian style with beautiful exposed wood and glass, the Explora has attractive decor, delicious food (given the remoteness of the location), a good Chilean wine list, and panoramic mountain vistas from the public areas as well as most of the rooms. Many of the guest rooms also have jacuzzi-type bathtubs (great for a soak after a long hike) and there is a heated indoor pool. The Explora offers explorations including horseback riding, hiking, and overland adventures led by the expert staff. Please note that the Explora Lodge requires a 3-4 night minimum (depending on the season).



HOTEL LAGO GREY

Paine National Park, Chile

Days 6 to 7 (2 nights)

With its prime setting along an iceberg-dotted lake in Paine National Park, Hotel Lago Grey gives us direct access to Paine's glaciers and trails. From the dining room's large picture windows, we'll have a stunning perspective on the calving ice of the Grey Glacier. There are great places around the property to watch the sunset, and the views of massive Paine Grande provide a constant visual feast.

Trip Details

WHAT THE TRIP IS LIKE

This trip is Level 3, Moderate. It features vehicle-based sightseeing and day hikes, with hotel accommodations. Although the pace of this trip is relaxed, this is an active vacation. The shape you're in is an important factor in your enjoyment of your trip. We recommend you make a special effort to get in good condition by walking, bicycling, swimming, or other forms of exercise.

WEATHER

This journey can be enjoyed from November through March, which is “summer” in the Southern Hemisphere. The region is characterized by a cool climate with plenty of rain year-round. Southern Chile's weather can provide spectacular clear days but can also be very changeable, and we want you to be well prepared for all that you may encounter. The average annual rainfall is approximately 23 inches in higher elevations, while it may rain as much as 100 inches per year closer to the sea. The average temperature is 50°F, and from December to March, the average often reaches 70°F or more. Come prepared for some rain and bring appropriate rain gear so you can remain comfortable no matter what weather blows in.
